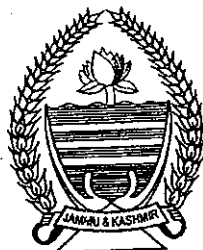

8. That the leave salary is a part of wages and claim for leave salary arises directly from the operation of payment of Wages Act.

9. That the only condition is that leave should have already been earned for the purpose of claim of leave salary from the duration of availed leave.

10. That the leave salary of six months is a part of wages which has been earned by the applicant and has not been paid till date.

11. That the applicant through his counsel has also served legal notice dated 07-02-2011 upon the non-applicants for the payment of leave encashment Rs.1,00,967/- being less paid for six months, within period of 30 days even then, the same has not been paid.

12. That the respondents are liable to pay to the applicant Rs. 1,00,967/- along with interest 18% P.A. cost being the arrears of leave encashment for six months.

13. And finally prayed that the petition may kindly be accepted and the order be passed for release of Rs. 1,00,967/- being amount of six months salary in lieu of leave encashment as well as arrear of salary with interest @ 18% P.A. from the date due till payment and cost of this petition.

14. Thereafter the file was posted for filing of the objections whereupon respondents/non-applicants have filed objections averring therein.

15. That Jammu and Kashmir Project Construction Corporation Ltd. bearing a Body Corporation Limited is governed by its own rules and regulations duly passed in consonance with the prevailing schemes.

16. That the Jammu and Kashmir Project Construction Corporation is run by its employees permanent as well as temporary, whose services and conduct are squarely governed by the Jammu and Kashmir Project Corporation Employees Service and Regulations, which were duly adopted by the answering respondent as "The JKPCC Service Regulations" which provides provisions for unveiled leave rules called as JKPCC leave rules which also applied to all the employees of the Corporation, whether permanent or temporary.

21. ~~That the application filed by the applicant is barred by limitation as such requires outright dismissal.~~

22. It is also admitted by the petitioner to the extent that the applicant was appointed on 08-08-1973 and retired on his superannuation on 31-01-2010 as Head Assistant and the Sixth Pay Commission has been made applicable notionally from 01-01-2006 to 30-06-2009 and monetarily w. e. f. 01-07-2009 by the Government however the matter shall be decided on its merits.

23. Since the complainant has retired on 31-01-2010, he was to be given the benefit of enhanced leave salary days but w. e. f. 01-04-2008 as decided in the board meeting. Therefore, his leave salary days was calculated as 120 till 01-04-2008 and his claim is totally misguided and misconceived as nothing has been withheld by the non-applicants as no cause of action has arisen to the applicant to claim leave salary and arrears of salary.

24. JKPC is a company registered under Companies Act and is not Government Department and as such is governed by its own rules and regulations and under the applicable rules the leave account of an employee is abolished in excess of 120 days and as per the decision of Board of Directors.

25. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the genuine demand/claim of the petitioner has been rejected by the respondents as the petitioner was entitled to leave salary of 300 days in view of SRO-124 dated 17-04-1998 and Order No. 82 of 2008, dated 10th July, 2008, and in terms of SRO-124 dated 17-04-1998, the respondents are bound to pay ten (10) months leave salary to the petitioner and vide Government Notification Order No. 19GR of 1980 dated 20-04-1980. Ten months leave salary is admissible. That the petitioner is a workman and Respondent No. 1 is the employer under section 22 of Industrial Disputes Act and is responsible for the payment of wages under section 3 of the Act. That the petitioner is entitled to receive the leave salary for a period of ten months whereas, the respondent has paid only 120 days leave salary to the petitioner who is otherwise entitled to receive 180 days leave salary due to him amounting Rs. 1,00,967/- along with arrears of salary as per 6th Pay Commission. That the leave salary is the retirement benefit of the petitioner and the petitioner

the amount deducted in the former case and [not exceeding twenty five rupees in the later, and even if the amount deducted or the delayed wages are paid before the disposal of the application, direct the payment of such compensation, as the authority may think fit, not exceeding two thousand rupees]”.

28. In AIR 2010 Supreme Court 3563 is a case entitled “Vijaya Bank V/s. Shyamal Kumar Lodh”, it was observed that—

“12. From a plain reading of section 33C(2) it is evident that money due to a workman has to be decided by such Labour Court “as may be specified in this behalf by the appropriate Government.” Section 7 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 *inter alia* confers power to the appropriate Government for constitution of one or more Labour Courts for the adjudication of industrial disputes. It also prescribes qualification for appointment as Presiding Officer of a Labour Court. Explanation appended to section 33-C of the Act provides to include any court constituted under any law relating to investigation and settlement of industrial disputes in force in any State as Labour Court. The underlying object behind inserting explanation seems to be varying qualification prescribed for appointment of Presiding Officers of Labour Court by different States enactments. The parliament took note of the fact while inserting explanation that there are different kinds of Labour Courts constituted under Industrial Disputes Act and State Acts and a question may arise whether a Labour Court constituted under Acts, Central or State could entertain a claim made under section 33C(2) of the Act.

13. An explanation is appended ordinarily to a section to explain the meaning of words contained in that section. In view of the explanation aforesaid Labour Court shall include any court constituted under any law relating to investigation and settlement of industrial disputes in force in any State. Money due to an employee under section 33C (2) is to be decided by “Labour Court as may be specified in this behalf by the appropriate Government”. Therefore, the expression “Labour Court” in section 33C (2) has to be given an extended meaning so as to include court constituted under any law relating to investigation and settlement of industrial disputes in force in any State. It widens the choice of appropriate Government and it can specify

Consequent upon the approval formally conveyed by the Board of Directors in its 83rd meeting held on 17-06-2008 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister for R&B (Chairman, JKPCCLtd.), sanction is accorded to the implementation of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Leave) Rules and T.A Rules as applicable to the State Government employees shall henceforth apply strictly to the employees of the Corporation. This will, however, take effect from 01-04-2008. However, cases already settled after 01-04-2008 to the date of issuance of orders shall not be reopened.

35. The factum of retirement of petitioner on 31-01-2010 has been admitted by the respondent. It has also been admitted by the respondent that J&K Service (Leave) Rules have been made applicable to the employees of JKPCCLtd. Corporation with effect from 01-04-2008 dated 10-07-2008 and prior to 01-04-2008 the employees of JKPCCLtd. Corporation were entitled to 120 days leave encashment and after 01-04-2008, when the J&K Service (Leave) Rules were made applicable to the employees of the Corporation. It is also not out of place to mention here that against the clear admission of the respondents there was no scope for this tribunal to hold further enquiry.

36. From the appraisal the rival contentions of the counsel for the parties and the record, the date of retirement of the petitioner and the entitlement of leave encashment of 300 days to the employees of corporation are not in controversy. At the time of retirement, every employee of the JKPCCLtd. was entitle to leave encashment of 300 days, like of the petitioner but surprisingly the petitioner was paid leave encashment of 120 days only.

39. So, it is safe to say that the claim of the petitioner is not time barred.

40. It has also very amazing this tribunal that when the applicability of J&K Service (Leave) Rules have been admittedly made applicable then on what basis the claim of the petitioner was withheld. It is not out of place to mention that J&K Service (Leave) Rules were made applicable vide Office No. 82 of 2008 dated 10-07-2008 with effect from 01-04-2008 by none other than the respondent/corporation itself, thus non-disbursement to the petitioner amounts to withholding of valid claim of the petitioner which cannot be permitted in those circumstances. More so the claim of the petitioner has already been recognized and settled by the respondents when the J&K Service (Leave) Rules were made applicable to the Corporation as such are required to be computed and paid to the petitioner hereinabove without any inordinate delay.

41. For what has been discussed above, it is held that the petitioner is entitled to leave encashment salary of 10 months as per J&K Service (Leave) Rules and the arrears of salary in view of 6th Pay Commission along with interest @ 10% from the date of institution of this petition till its realization and any amount already received on account of leave encashment salary by the petitioner shall be deducted.

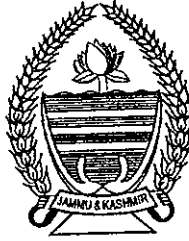
42. It is further directed that respondents shall also pay an amount of Rs. 10,000/- as compensation to the petitioners, the file after due completion be consigned to records.

7.. At the timing of filing the suit, there was no court constituted for the adjudication of the cases under the ESI Act so the civil suit was filed in the Civil Court.

8. Upon service the respondents appeared and filed written statement/objections thereby rejecting the claim of the petitioners/ plaintiffs on the plea that the suit is not maintainable in view of the provisions of ESI Act. In para 4 of the reply, the defendants have submitted that a survey of the factory of the plaintiff was conducted on 13-07-1990 and found that employer was having six employees on rolls on the attendance register and 5-6 employees in the first week of May 1990 to whom the wages were paid through voucher. It is further claimed by the defendants that the petitioners did not make any representation before the defendants.

9. Initially the suit was filed in the Court of Ld. District Judge, Jammu from where it was transferred to the Court of Ld. Sub-Judge, Jammu for its disposal under law. The Ld. Sub-Judge, Jammu vide its order dated 30-07-1996 observed—

“In view of the SRO-157 dated 10-08-94 and judgement of Hon’ble High Court Passed in 35 Writ Petition dated 26-05-95, this suit is transferred to the Employees Insurance Court. Ld.Counsel for the parties are directed to appear in that Court on 09-04-96. Office shall send the file to that Court before the next date fixed.”

10. On 17-04-1996 this file was received by this Tribunal and entered the case in the concerned registered in the proceedings were commenced.

11. During the pendency of the case, petitioner filed the present application contending therein that the provisions of ESI Act are not applicable to the unit of the petitioners as the unit is located in Industrial Estate, Digiana, Jammu and Digiana was not included in municipal limits at the time of issuing the demand notice. In fact Digiana came to be included in municipal limits vide SRO No. 291 dated 05-09-2003. Since M/s Kamal Auto Body

16. The record available on the file reveals that M/s Kamal Auto Body Industries is situated at Digiana in Industrial Estate, Digiana. From the perusal of the notification dated 06 October, 1989, Digiana Industrial Estates is not covered. When the unit of the petitioner is not covered under the notification issued by the competent authority, its applicability is not possible. Notification dated 06 October, 1989 defines the area of Jammu Division as :—

(A) For Jammu

17. There is no dispute that the unit of the petitioner was situated at Industrial Estate Digiana which has also been admitted by the respondents while issuing the recovery notices, the address of the unit of the petitioner is mentioned as, "Kamal Auto Body Builders, Industrial Estate, Digiana, Jammu." Moreover, there is a certificate

19. In view of the discussions made above, the entire proceedings initiated by the ESIC through its authorities are vitiated for want of jurisdiction. The notices for the recovery of Rs. 3640/- and interest Rs. 735/- are illegal and unsustainable and as such are liable to be set aside. Accordingly the notices No. Pb-19-0227/57/5 dated 01-08-1990/02-08-1990, PB/19/0227/57/371 Dated 24/25-4-1991 and 18/21/22-12-92 for an amount of Rs. 3640/- and interest 735/- are set aside being illegal, bad, unwarranted and unsustainable are quashed.

20. The net result is that the petition is allowed, disposed off accordingly and shall go to records under rules.
