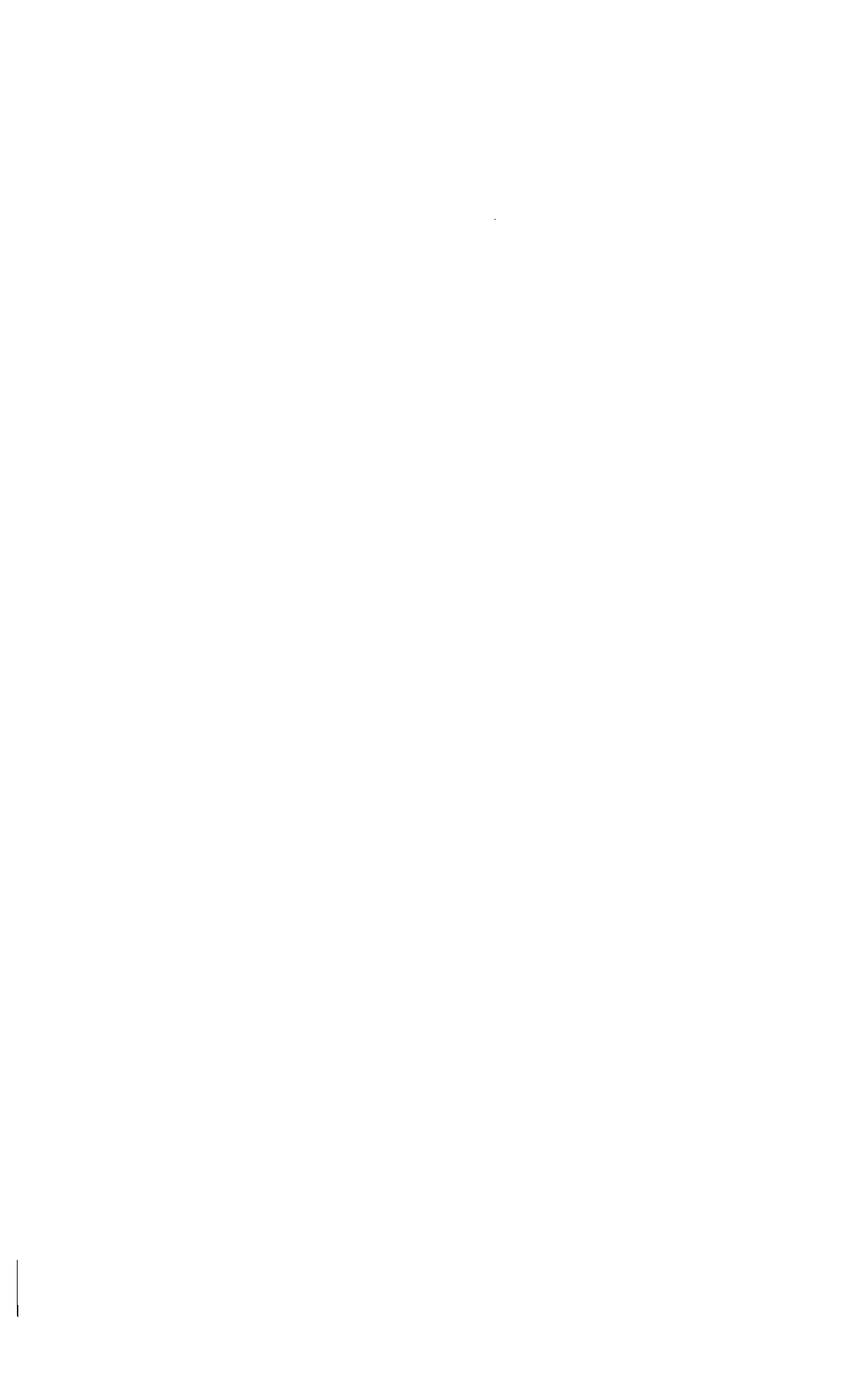

Award

1. This tribunal has received a reference by virtue of a notification dated 10th July, 2008 wherein SRO-204 was issued by the Government of J&K and referred the dispute to this tribunal for adjudication.

2. Both the parties to the petition have submitted that they are ready for compromise. Time was granted for negotiation. They have compromised and settled at Rs. 20,000/- (Twenty Thousand only) towards the satisfaction of all the claims arising out of the employment of the petitioner with the respondent. Statements of the petitioner was recorded besides obtaining their signature on the margin of the order sheet. The petitioner has been identified by his AR Sh. L. R. Laxman. Respondent has also put his signature in token of his acceptance to the terms and conditions of the agreement arrived between the parties. Respondent has paid rupees twenty thousand only to the petitioner in the open court.

3. After this settlement of workmen/petitioner has left with no of his claims/dues towards the management.

4. Consequence to the compromise arrived between the parties, respondent has paid the agreed amount of Rs. 20,000/- to the petitioner who has received the same in the court and has also executed an receipt toward the full and final settlement of all dues which include earned wages, encashment of leave, notice pay, retrenchment, compensation, bonus, gratuity and all other dues which could accrue during the employment with the management of M/s Power Cable, Birpur Industrial Area, Bari Brahmana, Jammu.

5. After this settlement petitioner has left with no cause of action against the management.

6. Since the settlement amount has been received by the workman and his claim stands disposed off accordingly.

7. In view of the settlement executed between the parties, this court hereby passes this award in terms of the memorandum settlement and holds that no other relief is required to be granted to the petitioner.

8. Copy of the award be sent to the concerned authorities for necessary action.

9. File shall go to record.

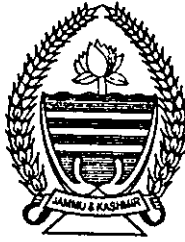
