Notification

Srinagar, the 15th July, 2014.

SRO-219.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 26 of the
Jammu and Kashmir General Sales Tax Act, 1962, the Government hereby

direct that in the Jammu and Kashmir General Sales Tax Rules, 1962, the following amendments shall be made, namely :—

1. In rule 15,—

- (a) In sub-rule (b) after entry 4, the following entries shall be added, namely :—

“5. Statement of contracts sanctioned and executed in Form ST-13E.

6. Statement of premium collected from insurance policy holders in Form ST-13F.

7. Statement of banking services and tax collected in Form ST-13G.

8. Statement of other service and tax collected in Form ST-13H”.

- (b) After sub-rule (d), the following sub-rule shall be added, namely :—

“(e) Notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, any dealer or class of dealers as may be specified by the Commissioner by a notification, shall file the return electronically along with the proof of payment within the period prescribed in this rule”.

2. In rule 71,—

- (a) after sub-rule (c), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely :—

“(cc) Notwithstanding anything contained in this rule, the returns, as specified in sub-section (8) of section 16-C can be filed electronically through a computer network in Form ST-61 along with proof of payment.”

- (b) after sub-rule (d), the following sub-rules shall be added, namely :—

“(dd) Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 71, the person deducting the tax under section 16-C may deposit the tax so deducted electronically in Form ST-59A.


(ddd) Where the payment of tax deducted at source or any other sum has been made electronically, the authorized bank shall generate e-Challan in Form ST-59A through a computer network. The authorized bank shall also forward a statement of such e-Collections (called as e-Payment Scroll) daily in Form ST-59B to the authorities as may be notified by the Commissioner. The date of payment for the purpose of these rules shall be the date of deposit generated on the e-Challan in Form ST-59A. The date of payment for all accounting purposes shall be the date of generation of e-Challan and the daily statement from the bank shall mention the date.”

- (3) The Form ST-12 and ST-13 shall be substituted by forms appended hereto.
- (4) Form ST-59 referred to in rule 71(d) shall be substituted by the form appended hereto this notification.
- (5) Form ST-58A referred to in rule 71(a) shall be substituted by the form appended hereto this notification.

GOVERNMENT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR
ELECTION DEPARTMENT

Notification

Srinagar, the 29th August, 2014.

SRO-263.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to section 124 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor hereby makes the following rules, namely :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Election Department (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

2. *Definitions.*—In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) “Administrative Department” means the department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding administrative charge of the service ;
- (b) “Head of the Department” means the Chief Electoral Officer of the State ;
- (c) “Cadre” means the cadre of the service ;
- (d) “Board” means the Jammu and Kashmir State “Service Selection Board” ;
- (e) “Member of the Service” means a person appointed to a post in the Election Department (Subordinate) Service under the provision of these rules ;
- (f) “Schedule” means a schedule annexed to these rules ;
- (g) “Service” means the Jammu and Kashmir Election Department (Subordinate) Service ; and
- (h) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations.

3. *Constitution of the Service.*—(1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the Jammu and Kashmir Election Department (Subordinate) Service.

(2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules appointment to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding substantively any post included the cadre of the service.

(3) Provide that for the purpose of initial constitution of the service the person holding any post included on the cadre of the service in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules, if he is qualified to hold the post.

4. *Strength and composition of the Service.*—(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts shall be determined by the Government from time to time and shall at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in Schedule I to these rules :

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, at the expiry of every three years or at such intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alteration therein as it may deem fit.

5. *Qualifications and Method of Recruitment.*—(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class or grade in the service unless he/she possess the qualifications as laid down in Schedule II of these rules and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.

(2) Appointment to the service may be made—

(a) By direct recruitment ; or

(b) By promotion ;

Provided that,—

(i) All posts to be filled by direct recruitment/promotion shall be filled through J&K SSB/Departmental Promotion Committee ;

- (ii) The department shall refer vacancies in the direct/promotion quota to SSB and Departmental Promotion Committees as the case may be in terms of SRO-166 dated 14-06-2005.

6. *Probation.*—(1) Persons appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall be on probation for two years and their confirmation shall be made under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

(2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regulated as per the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Service Regulations or general rules as issued from time to time.

7. *Reservation in appointments.*—While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes or any other category or class of permanent resident of State under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act and the Reservations Rules in force.

8. *Training and Departmental Examination.*—Persons appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall be recruited to undergo such training during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation such departmental examination as the Government may prescribe.

9. *Eligibility of Government servants for direct recruitment.*—A person already in the Government service may apply, through proper channel for recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class and category in the service, if he possess the educational and other qualification prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of posts. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be as provided in the general rules.

10. *Maintenance of seniority lists.*—Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Head of Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the service.

11. *Residuary matter.*—In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the member of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the State Civil Service in general.

12. *Interpretation.*—If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision thereon shall be final.

13. *Repeal and savings.*—(1) The Jammu and Kashmir Election Department (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 1997 are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Notification

Srinagar, the 29th September, 2014.

SRO-392.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 168 of the Jammu and Kashmir Representation of the People Act, 1957 (Act No. IV of 1957), the Government, in consultation with the Election

Commission of India, hereby makes the following amendments in the Jammu and Kashmir Registration of Electors Rules, 1966, namely :—

I. In rule 2, in sub-rule (1),—

- (i) after clause (b), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(bb) “Electronic Gazette” shall have the same meaning as assigned to it in clause (s) of sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000).”; and

- (ii) after clause (c), the following clause shall be inserted, namely :—

“(cc) “Overseas elector” means a permanent resident of the State referred to in section 16A and who is not less than eighteen years of age on the qualifying date.”

II. In rule 5, after sub-rule (3), the following sub-rule shall be inserted, namely :—

“3 (A) The name of every overseas elector who is entitled to be included in the roll under section 16A, shall be included in the part of the roll pertaining to the locality in which his place of residence in India as mentioned in his passport is located.”

III. In rule 7, in sub-rule (1), for the words and figures “Forms 1, 2 and 3”, the words and figures “Forms 1, 2, 2A and 3” shall be substituted.

IV. After rule 8, the following rules shall be inserted, namely :—

“8A. Manner of giving notice for registration of persons as overseas electors.—On the commencement of the Jammu and Kashmir Representation of the People (Amendment) Act, 2014 (IX of 2014) and at such other times as the Election Commission may direct, the Chief Electoral Officer may, for the

purpose of inclusion of names of overseas electors in the roll, make a public notification requesting every person entitled to be registered as an overseas elector under section 16A to make an application under rule 8B and a copy of such notification shall be forwarded to all Foreign Missions of the Central Government and also make such further publicity as he may consider expedient and necessary.

8B. Inclusion of names of overseas electors in the rolls.—(1) Every overseas elector, who is not otherwise disqualified for registration and is desirous of being registered in the roll for the constituency pertaining to the locality in which his place of residence in the State as mentioned in his passport is located, may make an application in Form 6A to the concerned Registration Officer directly or send the application to him by post.

(2) The provisions of sub-rules (2), (3) and (4) of rule 13 shall *mutatis mutandis* apply for filing of claims or objections to the inclusion of name or to any particulars of an entry or for transposition of any entry from one place to another in the roll as an overseas elector.

(3) Every application in Form 6A sent by post shall be accompanied by copies of all the documents mentioned in the said form duly self attested.

(4) Every application in Form 6A presented in person to the Registration Officer shall be accompanied by photocopies of all the documents mentioned in the said form along with originals thereof for verification by the Registration Officer.

(5) Where a personal hearing is necessary in respect of any claim for inclusion or objection to the inclusion of name in the roll as an overseas elector, the Registration Officer may, if considered necessary, designate an official in the Indian Mission in the concerned Country for the purpose.”

V. In rule 10,—

- (i) in clause (b), for the words “specified by him for the purpose” the words “specified by him for the purpose or in the official website of Chief Electoral Officer, Jammu and Kashmir” shall be substituted ; and
- (ii) after clause (b), the following proviso shall be inserted at the end, namely :—

“Provided that where such draft contains names of overseas electors, the copies of such rolls shall also be published in the Electronic Gazette or in the official website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Jammu and Kashmir.”

VI. In rule 13,—

- (a) in sub-rule (1)—
 - (i) in clause (a), the word “and” shall be added at the end ;
 - (ii) in clause (b), the word “and” occurring at the end shall be omitted ; and
 - (iii) clause (c) shall be omitted.
- (b) in sub-rule (2)—
 - (i) in clause (a), the word “and” shall be added at the end ;
 - (ii) in clause (b), the word “and” occurring at the end shall be omitted ; and
 - (iii) clause (c), shall be omitted ; and
- (c) in sub-rule (4), for the words and figure “Form 8” the words and figure “Form 8A” shall be substituted.

VII. In rule 16, the following proviso shall be inserted at the end, namely :—

“Provided that where any claim or objection relates to registration of a person as an overseas elector, a list of such claim or objection shall be exhibited on the notice board in his office and shall also be published in the Electronic Gazette or in the official website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Jammu and Kashmir in such form as the Election Commission may direct.”

VIII. Rule 21A shall be substituted by following rule, namely :—

“21A. **Deletion of names.**—If it appears to the Registration Officer at any time before the final publication of the roll that owing to inadvertence or error or otherwise, the names of dead persons or of persons who have ceased to be, or are not, ordinarily residents in the constituency or of persons who are otherwise not entitled to be registered in that roll, have been included in the roll and that remedial action should be taken under this rule, the Registration Officer, shall—

- (a) prepare a list of the names and other details of such electors ;
- (b) exhibit on the notice board of his office a copy of the list together with a notice as to the time and place at which the question of deletion of these names from the roll will be considered, and also publish the list and the notice in such other manner as he may think fit ; and
- (c) after considering any verbal or written objections that may be preferred, decide whether all or any of the names should be deleted from the roll :

Provided that before taking any action under this rule in respect of any person on the ground that he has ceased to be, or is not, ordinarily resident in the constituency, or

is otherwise not entitled to be registered in that roll, the Registration Officer shall make every endeavor to give him a reasonable opportunity to show cause why the action proposed should not be taken in relation to him.”

IX. In rule 22,—

- (a) in sub-rule (1) in clause (b) after the word “office”, the full stop shall be substituted by colon and following proviso shall be inserted, namely :—

“Provided that where the roll contains the name of any overseas elector the same shall also be published in the Electronic Gazette or in the official website of the Chief Electoral Officer, Jammu and Kashmir ; and” ; and

- (b) after clause (b), the following clause shall be added, namely :—

“(c) subject to such general or special directions as may be given by the Election Commission supply, free of cost, two copies of the roll, as finally published, with the list of amendments, if any, to every political party for which a symbol has been exclusively reserved by the Election Commission.”

- X. In rule 25, in sub-rule (3), for the word and figures “rules 9 to 23”, the word, figures and letter and letter “rule 8A to 23” shall be substituted.

XI. In rule 26,—

- (i) in sub-rule (1)—

- (a) for the figures “6, 7, 8”, the figures and letter “6, 6A, 7, 8” shall be substituted ;

- (b) after the word "appropriate" the following proviso shall be inserted :—

"Provided that the statements in Forms 2, 2A and 3, from persons having service qualifications, received after the final publication of the electoral roll shall be deemed to be the applications under sections 18 and 19." ; and

- (c) the following proviso shall be inserted at the end, namely :—

"(1A) Every such application as is referred to in sub-rule (1) shall be presented to the Registration Officer in such manner as the Election Commission may direct."

- (ii) in sub-rule (3), for the words "that the applicant is entitled to be registered in the roll, direct his name to be included therein" the words "direct the inclusion, deletion, correction or transposition of entries in the roll, as may be necessary : " shall be substituted.

- XII. In rule 27, in sub-rule (1), in clause (c), the following proviso shall be inserted, namely :—

"Provided that the Chief Electoral Officer may condone the delay in the presentation of the appeal to him, if he is satisfied that the appellant has sufficient cause for not presenting it within the time prescribed."

XIII. After Form 2, the following form shall be inserted, namely :—

GUIDELINES FOR FILLING UP THE APPLICATION FORM-6A

General Instructions :

Who can file Form-6A :

1. Every permanent resident of the State staying in a foreign country, who has not acquired citizenship of a foreign country, and has completed 18 years as on the qualifying date, can make an application in Form 6A for being registered in the roll for the constituency pertaining to the locality in which his place of residence in India as mentioned in the passport is located. The application in Form-6A can be presented to the Registration Officer concerned.

2. The applicant should have completed eighteen years of age as on the qualifying date of the year. For example, if the application is for inclusion of name in the electoral roll with reference to 01-01-2011 as the qualifying date, the applicant should have completed 18 years as on 01-01-2011.

Where to submit the application in Form-6A :

3. The application should be submitted directly to the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) of the constituency within which the place of ordinary residence of the applicant as given in the valid passport falls. The application in Form-6A can be presented in person to the ERO or sent by post addressed to the ERO concerned.

Documents to be attached :

4. Paste one recent passport size coloured photograph with a light background (preferably white) showing the full face of the applicant.

5. Fill in all the columns in Form-6A. Write your name and other particulars as given in the valid Indian Passport.

6. If application is sent by post, it should be accompanied by photocopy of the relevant pages of the passport containing the photograph

and all other particulars of the applicant and the page containing the valid visa endorsement. **These photocopies should be duly self attested.** Applications without the attested photocopies of these documents will be liable to be summarily rejected.

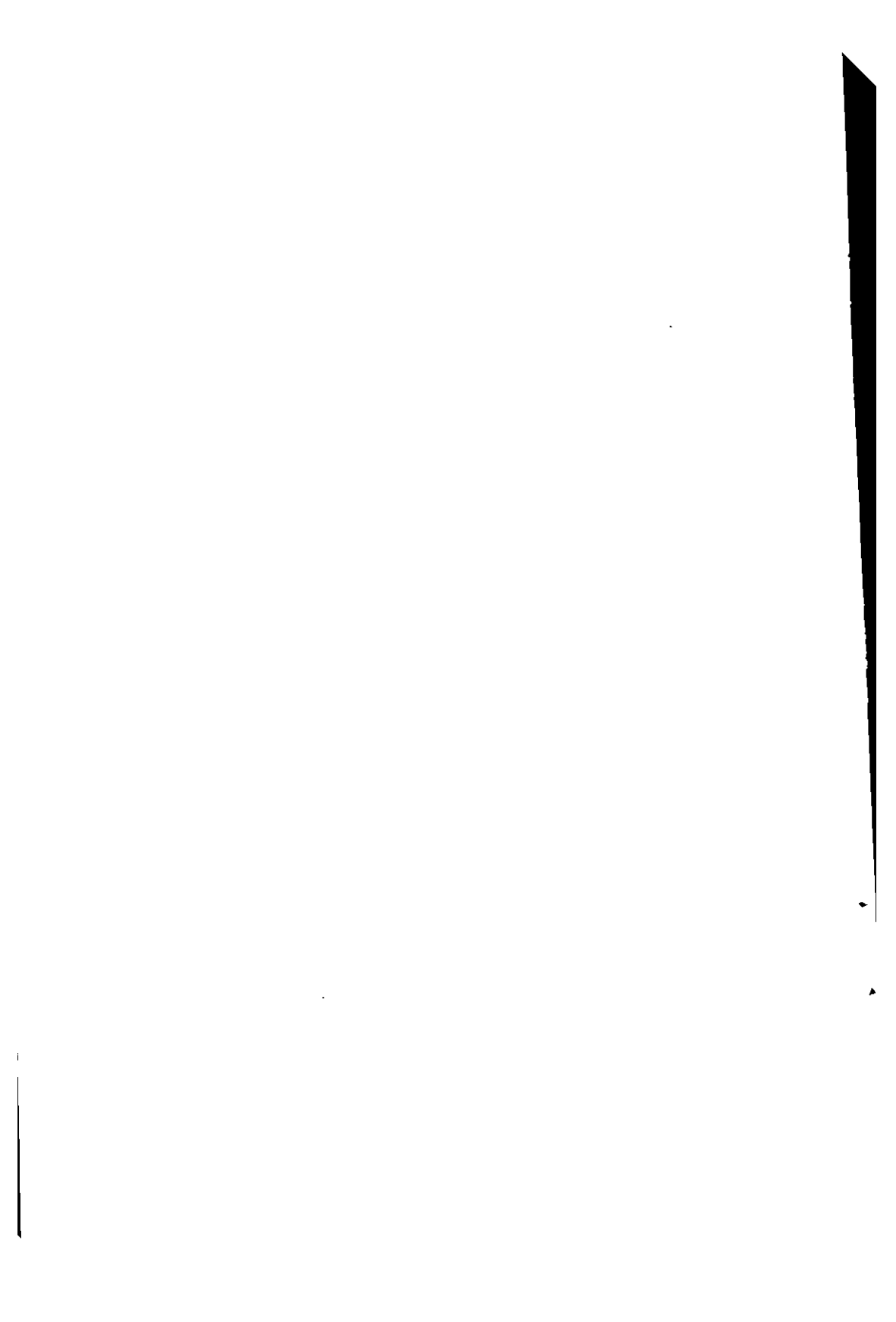
7. If the application is submitted in person before the ERO, the application should be accompanied by a photocopy of the relevant pages of the passport as mentioned above. The original passport should also be produced along with the application for verification by the Registration Officer. The passport will be returned immediately after verification.

Voting :

8. It may be noted that after your enrolment, you will be able to cast vote in election in the constituency, if you are physically present in the polling station along with your original passport on the day of poll.

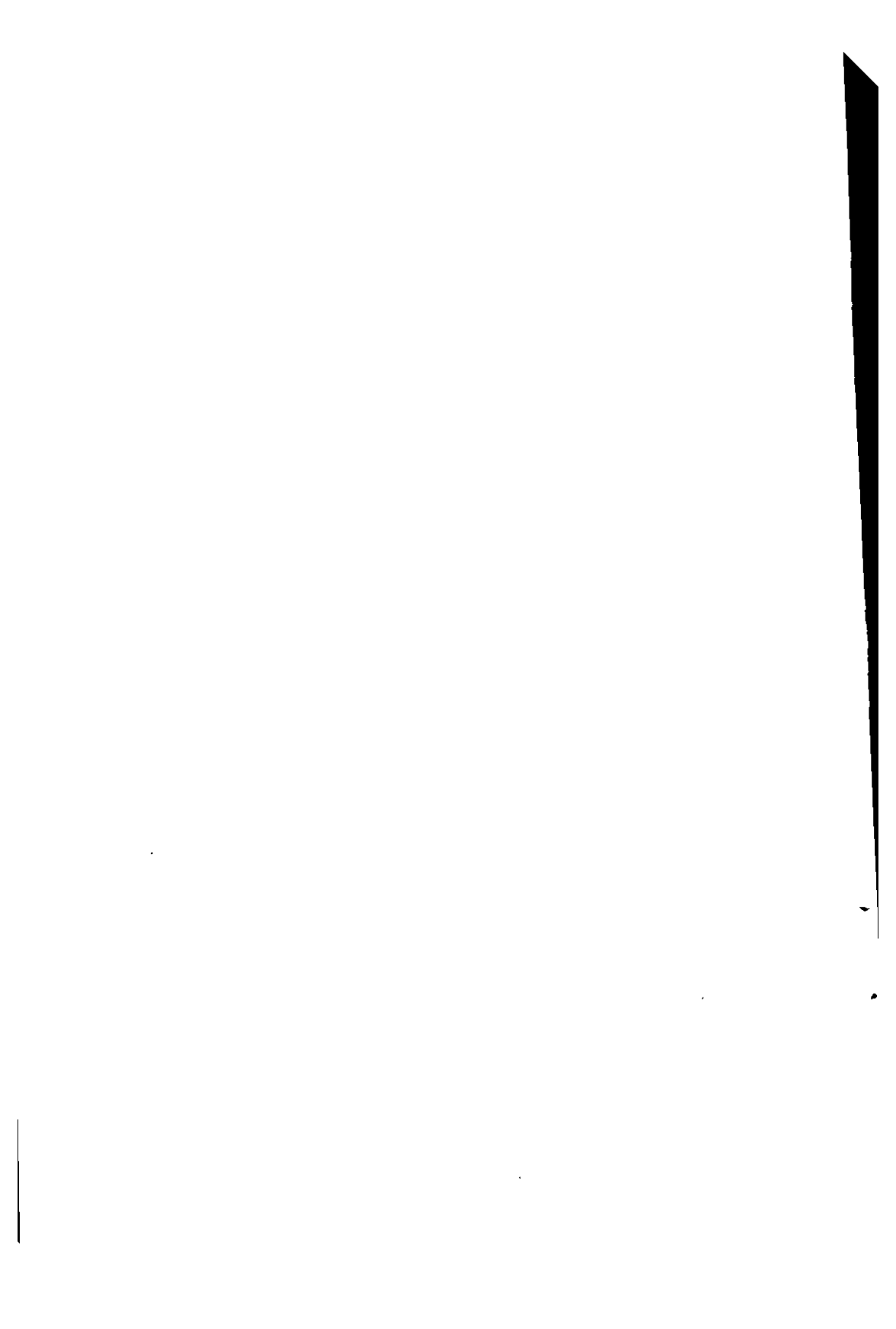
