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In the Matter of :—Reference under section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

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### Award

1. Vide SRO No. 232 dated 30th July, 2008, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, on being satisfied over the existence of industrial dispute between the parties, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (XIV of 1947), has referred the dispute to this tribunal for adjudication in respect of the following matter :—

- (a) Whether the termination of services of Shri Karnail Chand is legally justified ?
- (b) If not, to what relief they are entitled to ?

2. On notice, both the parties filed their respective claims. The petitioner has pleaded that his services were terminated arbitrarily, wrongfully and illegally on 18-06-2001 vide letter No. DTJ/2001/913 dated 18-06-2001 (Annexure P/1). The workman had been working as Room Attendant-Cum-Storekeeper in Dharmarth Trust for the last more than eleven years regularly and continuously. There was no break in service and record was neat and clean.

3. That the employees of trust formed a Trade Union in the year of 1993 in the name of Dharmarth Trust Employees Association, Jammu duly registered by the Registrar Trade Union of Jammu and Kashmir under Trade Union Act, 1926 on dated 22-02-1993 and the same was affiliated to Bhartiya Mazdoor Sangh (A Federation of Trade Unions) vide affiliation No. JK-37 dated 07-09-1993.

4. That the petitioner workman was President of said Trade Union and he was an active office bearer of Trade Union and has been playing a vital role to solve the problems/grievances and demands of employees before the management of trust under the banner of employees association. The petitioner always look after the interest of the employees.

5. That the trust management arrived at a settlement on 01-07-2000 between management and the striking employees Association of the Dharmarth Trust on 29-06-2000 in which the petitioner workman

participated and agreed upon for the grant of 15% D.A. to the employees for the years 2000 and 2001. The Association President and General Secretary wrote a letter vide No. DTEA/16/2001 dated 12-06-2001 for release of D.A. Installment in favour of employees due from April, 2001 and also copy to all concern. the Association President and General Secretary also wrote a letter on 16-06-2001 about the revision of daily wagger rate according to minimum wages notification dated 19-03-2001. There was strike of the employees of Dharmarth Trust, in support of their demands against Dharmarth Trust, the management to get dearness allowance and other long pending demands of the employees.

6. That the management always remained annoyed with the President and Gen. Secretary of the trade union as the union office bearer always represent the problems, demands and grievance of the employees before the management, Employees Association also held "Dharnas", "Demonstration", Rallies and Strike in support of their demands to get the demands accepted. The respondent/employer terminated the services of petitioner workman on 18-06-2001 with malafide attention to get rid from the officc bearers of Trade Union which amounts the victimization of union office bearers which is unfair labour practice on the part of the respondent employer under Industrrial Disputes Act, 1947. The act of employer is malafide using his colorable exercise of power to remove the General Secretary of the union with such type of alleged letter of termination. The previous record of service was neat and clean. He was an important office bearer of the union. To remove the petitioner in such way is malafide and amount to victimization which is unfair labour practice under Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. Therefore, such alleged termination order is not sustainable under law and be set aside. This order is not *bona fide* and the petitioner is entitled for reinstatement with full back wages.

7. That the respondent, trust management terminated the service of workman/petitioner on 18-06-2001 which is illegal, wrong, unjustified, victimization and also against the principle of natural justice. No inquiry has been held in this case as the workman was a permanent employee. Termination without any inquiry cannot be sustained. If there was any misconduct against the petitioner then inquiry must be held. Without

law and also against the principle of natural justice. The impugned order of termination cannot be sustained in the eyes of law as the employer has adopted "Hire and Fire" policy about termination of workman with *malafide* attention, therefore, termination is illegal.

8. The workman filed a civil suit on 09-07-2001 before the Hon'ble District Judge, Jammu for reinstatement with stay application against order dated 18-06-2001 by virtue of which services were terminated is null and void in the eyes of law. The Hon'ble Court transferred the suit to the Hon'ble 1st Additional Munsiff (Forest Magistrate), Jammu for disposal and remained pending for long time before different course i.e. (1) Hon'ble 2nd Additional District Judge, Jammu, Hon'ble Sub-Registrar Munsiff, Jammu, Hon'ble High Court, Jammu and Kashmir, Jammu and Court of Hon'ble 2nd Additional Munsiff, Jammu. The workman after long perusal knew that being a workman and the dispute being an industrial dispute, the Civil Court has no jurisdiction to try the suit for reinstatement, even issues framed has not been rightly considered and properly answered. The workman approached the Civil Court wrongly which on the facts and circumstances of the case had no jurisdiction to entertain and try the suit.

9. The workman is a workman under I. D. Act, 1947 and is a permanent employee and he is entitled to all benefits under Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. The services of workman cannot be terminated without any inquiry. The workman is a workman and the provisions under the section 25F of the Act are to be complied with if he had put 240 days of service in a year prior to date of termination.

10. Thereafter file was posted for filing of the objections whereupon the respondent filed objections on 16-03-2007 averring therein :—

- i. That the above titled petition is liable to be dismissed outrightly as the Learned Court/Forum has no jurisdiction to entertain and adjudicate upon the subject matter.
- ii. That neither the petitioner workman falls within the definition of workman as specified in Industrial Disputes Act nor the respondent employer comes within the definition of employer as provided in the said Act



- iii. That the above titled petition is also not maintainable on the ground that the Dharmarth Trust Council is a religious and charitable trust and the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act are not applicable to it as the same does not fall within the definition of Industry as provided under the said Act. It is further humbly submitted that the Hon`ble High Court of J&K vide its Judgement dated 24-05-2004 passed in OWP 60/2003 titled J&K Dharmarth Trust Council Vs. State of J&K and in OWP 1064/2001 titled J&K Dharmarth Trust Council Vs State of J&K has held that the said trust does not fall within the definition of establishment or employer as definition under Payment of Gratuity Act as well as under Shops and Establishment Act and set aside the order passed by the Controlling Authority under Payment of Gratuity Act, Jammu.
- iv. That the above titled petition is also hit by the Provisions of *res-judicata*. The respondent employer humbly submits that the petitioner workman herein has earlier filed a Civil Suit titled Karnail Chand Vs. Thakur Diwakar Singh for declaration to declare the said order of termination dated 18-06-2001 as null and void and the said suit has been dismissed as withdrawn by the Court of Learned 2nd Additional Munsiff, Jammu Vide its order dated 11-10-2006, copy whereof has already been annexed as Annexure P-5 with the Petition. It is pertinent to mention here that although the petitioner workman herein sought permission from the Court of Learned 2nd Additional Munsiff, Jammu, to withdraw the said suit with a permission to invoke other legal remedies but no such permission was granted and the suit was simply allowed to be withdrawn by the Learned Court vide its said order dated 11-10-2006, as such, the petitioner workman is debarred under law to file the present petition.
- v. That the respondent employer further humbly submits that in the said civil suit the Court of Learned Additional Munsiff,

judgement dated 08-08-2005, in an appeal filed by the petitioner workman herein against the said order of Learned 2nd Additional Munsiff, Jammu dated 28-08-2003 has already rejected the allegation of the petitioner workman to the effect that the said order of termination dated 18-06-2001 has been passed revengefully and further that the respondent employer herein has the competence to issue the said termination order. Not only this, the court of Learned 1st Additional District Judge, Jammu in its said judgement dated 08-08-2005 has also held that the case of the petitioner workman herein also not covered under the Industrial Disputes Act. It is humbly submitted that once all these points have already been considered and adjudicated upon and the petitioner workman also accepted the same as no further appeal or revision has been filed against the said Orders/Judgement, as such the petitioner workman cannot re-agitate the same again before the Learned Forum.

- vi. That the above titled petition is also to be dismissed outrightly on the ground that admittedly the petitioner workman was an employee of the Dharmarth Trust Council and the said trust has not been arrayed as a party in this petition.
- vii. That the above titled petition is hopelessly time barred. In this regard, it is humbly submitted that the petitioner workman has challenged his order of termination dated 18-06-2001 by filing the present petition in the year-2007.

11. It is also submitted that the petitioner workman was working as a Room Attendant and vide Order No. 2471-73 dated 25-11-2000 was attached in the Central Office till further orders. It is further humbly submitted that the said termination order has been passed under rules and is legal and proper as already been adjudicated upon by the Civil Court.

12. It is further submitted that the services of the petitioner workman was terminated vide order dated 18-06-2001 with entitlement of a sum equivalent to the amount of his pay plus allowances for a period of one

13. However, it is reiterated that Industrial Disputes Act is not applicable to the respondent employer.

14. The petitioner has filed the rejoinder to the objections of the respondent thereby denying the objections and reiterated the contents of the statement of claim already filed by him.

15. Heard arguments and perused the material available on record, from the perusal of the record. It appears that the maintainability of the petition is in question. Before proceeding further, it is imperative to see whether the petitioner can be benefitted by the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act. For that we have to see whether the petitioner is a workman and if so, then whether the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act are applicable to the petitioner. So let us go through the definition of a workman under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

16. Section 2(S) deals with the definition of a workman, which is reproduced as under :—

[(S) 'Workman' means any person (including an apprentice) employed in any Industry to do any manual, unskilled, skilled, technical, operational, clerical or supervisory work for hire or reward, whether the terms of employment be expressed or implied, and for the purposes of any proceeding under this Act in relation to an industrial dispute, includes any such person who has been dismissed, discharge or retrenched in connection with or, as a consequence of, that dispute, or whose dismissal, discharge or retrenchment has led to that dispute, but does not include any such person :—

- (i) who is subject to the Air Force Act, 1950 (45 of 1950), or the Army Act, 1950 (46 of 1950), or the Navy Act, 1957 (62 of 1957); or
- (ii) who is employed in the police service or as an officer or other employee of a prison; or
- (iii) who is employed mainly in a managerial or

- (iv) who, being employed in a supervisory capacity, draws wages exceeding one thousand six hundred rupees per mensem or exercises, either by the nature of the duties attached to the office or by reason of the powers vested in him functions mainly of a managerial nature.]

17. Keeping into consideration the above quoted provisions, there is no doubt that the petitioner can be declared as a workman.

18. Secondly, whether the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act can be invoked against the respondent, which is a charitable and religious institution, whether the management/respondent can be termed as an industry, for that, the definition of industry defined in section 2 clause J of Industry Disputes Act is apt to reproduce, which is as under :—

“Section (J) “Industry” means any business, trade, undertaking, manufacture or calling of employers and includes any calling, service, employment, handicraft, or industrial occupation or avocation of workmen :

Section 2(J) shall be substituted with effect from the date to be notified as under :—

1[(J) “Industry” means any systematic activity carried on by co-operation between any employer and his workmen (whether such workmen are employed by such employer directly or by or through any agency, including a contractor) for the production, supply or distribution of goods or services with a view to satisfy human wants or wishes (not being wants or wishes which are merely spiritual or religious in nature), whether or not—

- (i) any capital has been vested in for the purpose or carrying on such activity ; or
- (ii) such activity is carried on with a motive to make any gain or profit, and includes—

(a) any activity of the Dock Labour Board established

by Section 6-A of the Dock Workers (Regulation

(b) any activity relating to the promotion of sales or business or both carried on by an establishment, but does not include—

(1) any agricultural operation except, where such agricultural operation is carried on in an integrated manner with any other activity (being any such activity as is referred to in the foregoing provisions of this clause) and such other activity is the predominant one.

Explanation :—For the purposes of this sub-clause, “agricultural operation” does not include any activity carried on in a plantation as defined in Cl. (f) of Section 2 of the Plantation Labour Act, 1951 (69 of 1951) ; or

(2) hospitals or dispensaries ; or

(3) educational, scientific, reserch or training institutions ; or

(4) institutions owned or managed by organization wholly or substantially engaged in any charitable, social or philanthropic service ; or

(5) Khadi or Village industries ; or

(6) any activity of the Government relatable to the sovereign functions of the Government including all the activities carried on by the departments of the Central Government dealing with defence, research, atomic energy and space ; or

(7) any domestic service ; or

(8) any activity, being a profession practiced by an individual or body of individuals, if the number of persons employed by the individual or body individuals in relation to such profession is less than ten ; or

(9) any activity, being an activity carried on by a co-operative

the number of persons employed by the co-operative Society, club or other like body of individuals in relation to such activity is less than ten.]

19. As per Section 2(j) clause b, sub-clause 4, the institutions owned and managed by organizations wholly or substantially engaged in any charitable and social institution or philanthropic service are not covered under the umbrella of the provision of Industries Disputes Act, 1947.

20. In Dharmarth Trust Council, Jammu V/S State of J&K and others in OWP No. 1064/01 and 60/03 decided on 24-05-2004, our own Hon'ble High Court has held that—

“From the above definitions it is apparent that trust does not fall within the meaning of commercial establishment or establishment as indicated in sections 2(4) and 2(8). In addition to this, Government has power to declare any establishment as an establishment for the purposes of Shops and Establishment Act, 1966. Therefore, even if contention of the respondents is accepted, trust does not fall within the definition of establishment as defined under the Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 as also under the Shops and Establishment Act, 1966. Expression employee used in the Shops and Establishment Act, 1966 is not for purpose of payment of gratuity. Some expression may have different meaning under the different statutes. Meaning prescribed under one Act cannot be carried into other unless legislative intend is clear in this regard. Since expression employee and employer have been specifically defined under the provisions of Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, same cannot be borrowed from the other statute including Shops and Establishment Act. From the reading of the provisions referred to above, it is clear that trust does not fall within the definition of establishment or employer. Contention of the respondent of the respondents that alternate efficacious remedy is available also cannot be accepted for the reasons that writ petition was entertained in the Year, 2001 and it is too late to dislodge the petitioner on the ground of availability

efficacious remedy of writ jurisdiction under Article 226 of Constitution of India read with Section 103 of Constitution of State of Jammu and Kashmir is no bar. In the present case orders impugned are clearly without jurisdiction and therefore, the remedy of invoking writ jurisdiction is available to the petitioner. For what has been stated above. these petitions are allowed.”

21. There is no doubt that the respondent is a trust known as “Dharamarth Trust Council dealing with the religious and charitable activities” the trust as per section 2J, is not amenable to the provisions of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

22. For what has been discussed above and in the facts and circumstances of the case it is safe to hold that the petitioner is not protected under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

23. In brief it is opined that “No Relief” can be granted to the petitioner as the respondent is a charitable institution and is immune from the provisions of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. The reference is answered and disposed of accordingly and a copy of the same be sent to the government for its publication under rules.

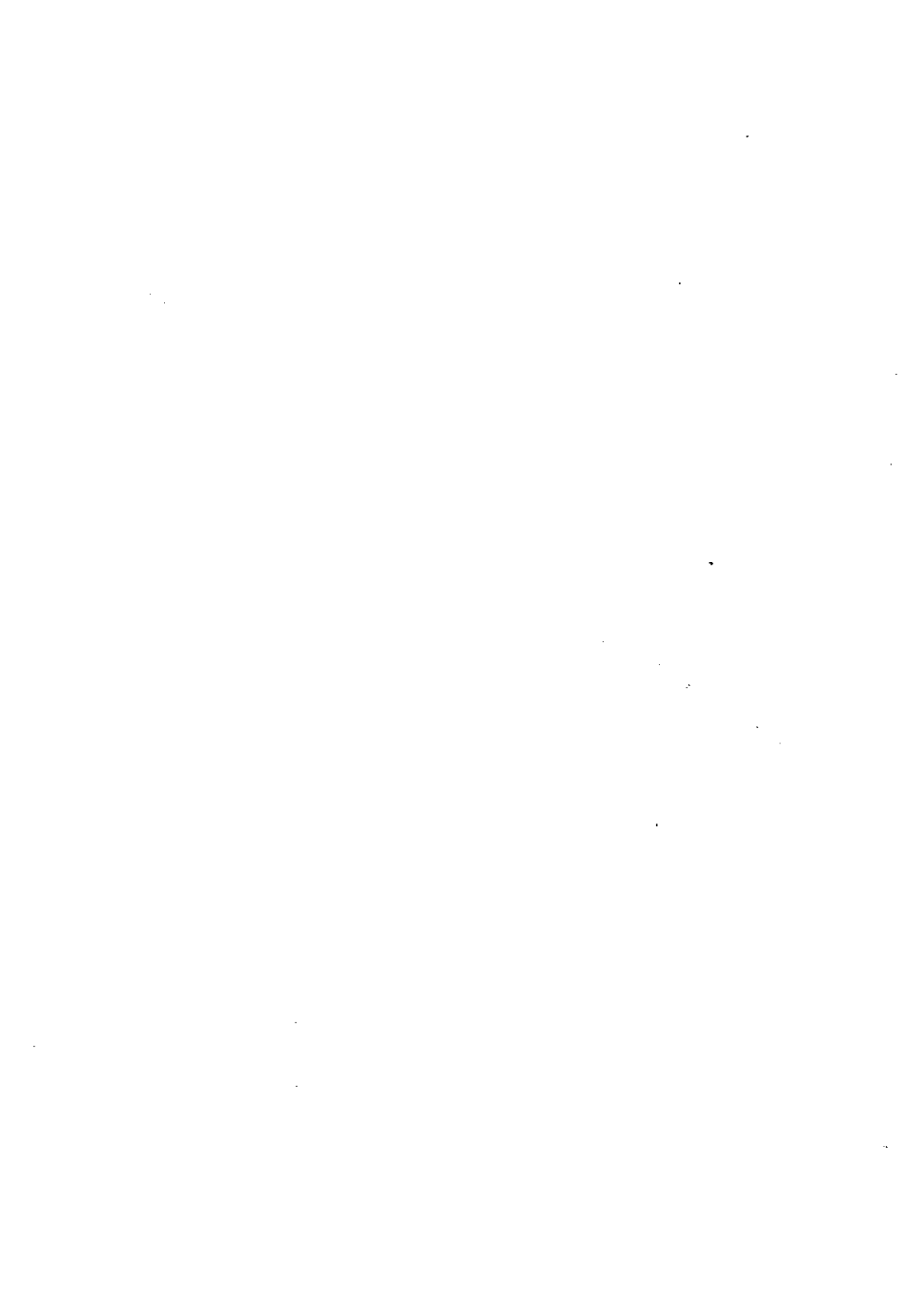
