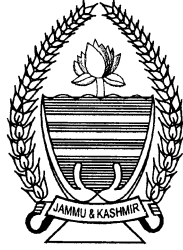

HIGH COURT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR  
(OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL AT JAMMU)

Notification No. 42

Jammu, Dated 24-04-2015.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 25 read with section 2 (b) (ii) of the Right to Information Act, 2009, Hon'ble the Chief Justice of the High Court of J&K, hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(i) These rules shall be called the Jammu and Kashmir High Court (Right to Information) Rules, 2014.



(ii) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Definitions.*—(1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) 'Act' means the Right to Information Act, 2009 (No. VIII of 2009);
- (b) 'appellate authority' means designated as such by the Chief Justice of the Jammu and Kashmir High Court ;
- (c) 'authorized person' means Public Information Officers and Assistant Public Information Officers designated as such by the Chief Justice of the Jammu and Kashmir High Court ;
- (d) 'form' means the Form appended to these rules ;
- (e) 'section' means a section of the Act ;
- (f) words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act ;
- (g) 'High Court' means High Court of Jammu and Kashmir.

3. *Application for seeking information.*—(a) Any person seeking information under the Act, shall file an application during working hours of the court to the authorized person, in Form A and deposit application fee as per Rule 10 with the authorized person.

(b) The authorized person shall dully acknowledge the application as provided in Form B :

Provided that a person who makes a request through electronic form shall ensure that the requisite fee is deposited in cash with the authorized person within 7 days of his sending the request through the electronic form, failing which his application shall be treated as dismissed.

*Explanation* :—For each information sought separate application shall be made. However, where more than one information sought is consequential or related to one another, the applicant

will be permitted to seek the information through one application only.

4. *Disposal of application by the authorized person.*—(i) If the requested information does not fall within the jurisdiction of the authorized person, it shall transfer the application or such part of it, as is beyond his jurisdiction, to that other authority along with fees, as soon as practicable but not later than five days from the date of receipt of application, in Form C.

(ii) If the requested information is within the authorized person's jurisdiction but falls in one or more of the categories listed/mentioned in the sections 8 and 9 of the Act, the authorized person, on being satisfied, will issue the rejection order in Form D as soon as practicable, as expeditiously as possible and in any case not later than 30 days from the date of receipt of the application.

(iii) If the requested information falls within the authorized person's jurisdiction, but does not fall in one or more of the categories listed in sections 8 and 9 of the Act, the authorized person, on being so satisfied, shall supply the information to the applicant in Form E, falling within its jurisdiction as expeditiously as possible and in any case within 30 days of the receipt of the request. In case the information sought is partly outside the jurisdiction of the authorized person or partly falls in the categories listed in sections 8 and 9 of the Act, the authorized person shall supply only such information as is permissible under the Act and is within its own jurisdiction and reject the remaining part giving reasons therefor.

(iv) The information shall be supplied as soon as practicable and in any case not later than 30 days from the date of receipt of the application :

Provided that, if the information sought for, concerns the life or liberty of a person, same shall be provided within 48 hours of the receipt of the request.

However, the date of the application shall be deemed to be the date of deposit of the entire fee or the balance fee or deficit amount of the fee to the authorized person.

A proper acknowledgement shall be obtained from the applicant in token of receipt of information after production of Form B.

5. *Exemption from disclosure of information.*—The information specified under section 8 of the Act shall not be disclosed and made available in particular the following information shall not be disclosed :—

- (a) Such information which relates to judicial functions and duties of the Court and matters incidental and ancillary thereto :

Provided that the question as to which information relates to judicial functions and duties of the Court and matters incidental and ancillary thereto, shall be decided by the competent authority or by his delegate which decision shall be final ;

- (b) Information which has been expressly forbidden to be published by the Court or the disclosure whereof may constitute Contempt of Court ; or information which includes commercial confidence, trade secrets or intellectual property, the disclosure of which would harm the competitive position of a third party, unless the competent authority is satisfied that large public interest warrants the disclosure of such information ; or information which would impede the process of investigation or apprehension of prosecution of offenders ; or information which relates to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information ;
- (c) Any information affecting the confidentiality of any examination conducted by High Court. The question of confidentiality shall be decided by the competent authority whose decision shall be final ;
- (d) Any information supplied by third party which has been treated as confidential by that party, unless third party who has supplied

the information, is given an opportunity of making his/her submissions.

6. Information which is to be furnished and access to records shall be subject to the restrictions and prohibitions contained in rules/regulations and destruction of records in force from time to time which may have been notified or implemented by this Court.

7. *Appeal.*—(i) Any person—

- (a) who fails to get a response in Form C or Form D from the authorized person within 30 days of submission of Form A ; or
- (b) is aggrieved by the response received within the prescribed period, may file an appeal in Form F before the appellate authority and deposit fee for appeal as per Rule 10 with the appellate authority.

(ii) On receipt of the appeal along with required fee the appellate authority shall acknowledge the receipt of the appeal and after giving the appellant an opportunity of being heard, shall endeavor to dispose it of within thirty days from the date on which it is presented and send a copy of the decision to the authorized person concerned.

(iii) In case the appeal is allowed, the information shall be supplied to the applicant by the authorized person within such period as ordered by the appellate authority. This period shall not exceed thirty days from the date of the receipt of the order.

8. *Penalties.*—(i) Whoever being bound to supply information, fails to furnish the information asked for under the Act within the time specified or fails to communicate the rejection order by notification, or where the information supplied is found to be false in any material particular and which the person is bound to supply it knows and has reasons to believe it to be false, or does not believe it to be true, shall be liable to pay penalty up to Rupees 250 per day for the delayed period beyond 30 days subject to maximum of Rupees 25000 per application filed under Rule 3, as may be determined by the appellate authority and or the appellate authority shall

recommend the disciplinary action against the authorized officer under the service rules applicable to him.

9. *Suo moto publication of information by public authorities.*—

(i) The public authority may *suo moto* publish information as per sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Act by publishing booklets and/or folders and/or pamphlets and update these publications every year as required by sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Act.

(ii) Such information may also be made available to the public through information counters and may also be displayed on the notice board at a conspicuous place in the office of the authorized person and the appellate authority.

10. *Charging of application fee.*—(i) The authorized person shall charge the fee in the following manner :—

The fee shall be charged by way of cash against proper receipt or by demand draft or banker's cheque or indian postal order payable to the authorized person at the following rates :—

- a. rupees two for each page (in A-4 or A-3 size paper) created or copied ;
- b. actual charge or cost price of a copy in larger size paper ;
- c. actual cost or price for samples or models ;
- d. for inspection of records, no fee for the first hour ; and a fee of rupees five for each fifteen minutes (or fraction thereof) thereafter ;
- e. for information provided in diskette or floppy rupees fifty per diskette or floppy ;
- f. for information provided in printed form at the price fixed for such publication or rupees two per page of photocopy for extracts from the publication :

Provided that no fee shall be charged from the persons falling below poverty line as may be determined by the competent authority ; and

g. the appellate authority shall charge a fee of Rs. 50/- per appeal.

11. *Maintenance of Records*.—(i) The authorized persons shall maintain records of all applications received for supply of information and fee charged.

(ii) The appellate authority shall maintain records of all appeals filed before it and account of fee charged.

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AWARD

1. Briefly stated facts of the case are as that petitioner preferred instant petition under section 33-C (2) of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for computing and for payment of due which are payable. Petitioner claim on the ground that he is a workman as defined under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 and was in the employment of respondent factory. He joined on 11th July, 2011 on the post of Senior Executive on the cadre (Chemist-cum-Supervisor) and his nature of job was analysis stability sample management, analytical date review, planning stability analysis and his work reporting to Manager, Q. C. He resigns from the service on 09-03-2012 and his last salary was Rs. 37,500/-. His resignation was accepted by the respondent. They have deducted Rs. 2884/- per month from wages as earned leave and bonus for every month during the period of the service and applicant was getting Rs. 34,616/- as net salary after deduction leave and bonus. After joining he remained continuously and regularly there was no break in service. Petitioner sent a register legal notice through counsel for payment of dues i. e. salary not paid w. e. f. 01-01-2012 to 10-03-2013 with earning leave and bonus right from July to December, 2011. But respondent did not pay his pending dues nor replied the notice. So the total amount due against the respondent is Rs.103843/-.

So finally prayed for computing the amount due to applicant as delayed wages adjudicated to be due payable by the respondent to the applicant with interest @ 14% and Litigation expenses of case Rs.10,000/-.

2. On the presentation of this petition notice has been issued to other side through register cover so many times and in ordinary course also but

respondent never appear. On 20-05-2014 this tribunal ordered for service of respondent through publication in a National Daily Newspaper widely circulated in the area. And accordingly notice for service of respondent published in daily news paper "Times of India" but even then respondent did not appear. As such court vides its order dated 01-08-2014 passed an ex parte order against them and petitioner was directed to lead the evidence in ex parte.

3. Petitioner has filed his affidavit as a witness to the matter and in affidavit he has repeated the same version which is in the petition. There is no rebuttal to his statement.

4. I have thoughtfully considered the petition and argument of the petitioner in ex parte and had a minute study of the documents which are available on the file.

5. This is an application under section 33-C (2) for computing and for payment of dues which are due to him from the employer respondent. As per petitioner he joined the service with the respondent company in July, 2011 and submitted the resignation on 09-03-2012 and same has been accepted by the company on 10-03-2012. But company has not paid him the salary for the month of January, February and 10 days of March, 2012. Petitioner have also file the salary statement which indicate that petitioner was receiving net salary of Rs. 34,616/- minus deduction. The copy of resignation which has been accepted by the Manager, HRD shows that he has work up to 10-03-2012 and his conduct was satisfactory. So it is established by the record as well as the pleading of the petitioner that he remains on the roll of factory up to 10-03-2012 and he was not paid salary of 70 days because there is nothing in rebuttal from other side. He also claimed earned leave and bonus w. e. f. July, 2011 to December, 2011 which come to amount of Rs. 16,343/- from the photocopy of pay slip it is clear that net salary was being paid to an amount of Rs. 34,616/- and gross salary was shown as Rs. 37,500/- P. M.

6. Respondents has not contested the case in court and in ex parte petitioner proved its claims on the basis of documents submitted by him along with the petition and his ex parte evidence. When respondent did not



appear and contest the case, no option left for the court to reject the claim of the petitioner. As such he is entitled for the salary for the month of January, February and 10 days of March, 2012 which is computed to Rs. 87,500/- @ 37,500/- per month along with the benefit of earned leave and bonus from July, 2011 to December, 2011 amounting to Rs. 16,343/- it becomes the total Rs. 103843/-. As such the respondent is hereby directed to pay the above-mentioned amount to the employee within three months from today failing which petitioner shall also be entitled to interest on the awarded amount @ 9% per annum till final realization of the wages. A copy of the award be sent to appropriate Govt. for necessary action under law. File shall go to record after its due completion.
