ORDER/AWARD

The brief facts of the instant case are that the petitioner being permanent resident of the State of Jammu and Kashmir, came to be engaged by the Respondents as Nursing Orderly in the Imam Hussain Hospital from 1st July, 1992 up to 27th September, 2010 and after his engagement, the petitioner was smoothly working as without any service break and vide Hospital Director Order No. IHH/7051-7055 dated 28-09-2010 was promoted as Sanitary Supervisor, consequently all the Nursing Orderlies and Sweepers working under his supervision and control and also was authorized to drive the Hospital vehicle by virtue of Director respondent No. 2 vide Order No. IHH/7337-40 dated 04-12-2010 for official purposes at any time. The petitioner/complainant rendered his continuous and uninterrupted services in the industry of the respondents hospital to the best satisfaction of opposite parties and during in the course of his employment the respondents undertook some repairs/renovation/construction of Toilets etc. in their industry (Hospital) and the petitioner/complainant was directed to keep Check, Watch and Ward of workers, so that the workers should not waste time and loiter here and there.

The petitioner/complainant performed his job *bona fide* and some workers intentionally with the personal grudge filed a false and frivolous complaint against the petitioner/complainant before Chairman respondent No. 1 alleging therein misuse of Hospital vehicle and presentation of fake bills of the material purchased for the construction/renovation of industry (Hospital).

The respondent No. 2 Director on the directions of Chairman, respondent No. 1 issued a suspension Order No. IHH/1171-1172 dated 25-04-2012 and thereby suspended the services of the petitioner/complainant with immediate effect without assigning any reason for the same besides the wages/salary and other emoluments of the petitioner/complainant were stopped. The petitioner/complainant approached to Respondents/Opposite Parties for release of his wages/salary where he was informed that he is under suspension because of some allegation leveled against him by some workers, hence his salary was not released.

The petitioner/complainant besides directed the respondent No. 2 (Doctor, N. A. Malik) for conducting investigation as to the veracity of allegation against the petitioner/complainant. The Director submitted his report to respondent No. 1 (Chairman) bearing No. IHH/1180 dated 25-04-2012 despite the report submitted by the Director to the Chairman the petitioner/complainant was not reinstated nor his salary was released instead the petitioner/complainant was disengaged by respondent No. 2 Director of the said industry (Hospital) under disengagement Order No. IHH/6013 dated 04-05-2013.

The petitioner on seeing the arrogant and illegal and arbitrary attitude of respondents, approached to Conciliation Officer (ALC, Srinagar) for conciliation. Who after admitting the conciliation application served a notice upon Respondents/Opposite Parties however the respondents did not appear before the Conciliation Officer for conciliation, hence the conciliation could not be held and the Conciliation Officer issued a certificate in favour of the petitioner/complainant bearing No. ALC/Sgr/2013/163 dated 18-09-2013 for approaching before this Court/Tribunal for redressal of grievances of the petitioner/complainant.

After receipt of the application of petitioner, this Court/Tribunal issued summons to the respondents, who did not choose to appear before this Court/Tribunal though respondents were duly served, but they did not bother to appear before this Court. The Court finally in terms of order dated 03-09-2014 respondent No. 1 was set *ex parte* and in terms of order dated 29-01-2015 respondent No. 2 was also set *ex parte*. The petitioner/complainant was directed to adduce evidence in support of claim petition in *ex parte*.

The petitioner/complainant on 05-05-2015 lead evidence on affidavits which were taken on recorded. Two independent witnesses namely Tasaduq S/o Ibrahim R/o Bemina, Srinagar and Imtiaz Hussain S/o Mohammad Yousuf R/o Bemina, Srinagar deposed on affidavits that Mohammad Yousuf Sofi (petitioner/complainant) was appointed as Nursing Orderly in the industry (Hospital) by the Respondents/Opposite Parties on 01-07-1992 and was promoted as Sanitary Supervisor on 28-09-2010 and also was authorized to drive the hospital vehicle by virtue of respondent No. 2 vide Order No. IHH/7337-40 dated 04-12-2010 for official purposes at any time. The petitioner/complainant has rendered his continuous and uninterrupted services in the industry of respondents (Hospital) to his best satisfaction and during the course of employment of petitioner/complainant the respondents took some repairs/renovation/construction of toilets etc. in their industry and petitioner Mohammad Yousuf Sofi was directed to keep check, watch and ward of the works so that the workers should not waste time and money of the respondents/opposite party. Petitioner Mohammad Yousuf Sofi performed his job *bona fide* and some workers intentionally with personal grudge filed a false and frivolous complaint against him (petitioner) before the Chairman alleging misuse of hospital vehicle and presentation of fake bills etc. The respondent No. 2 suspended the services of petitioner with immediate effect without assigning any reason whatsoever and stopped the wages/salary of the petitioner/complainant. The witnesses also deposed that the petitioner/complainant approached to the respondents for release of his salary/wages and redressal of his grievances, but the respondents did not pay any heed to the genuine grievances of the petitioner/complainant, however, an enquiry was

conducted into the allegations leveled against petitioner which could not be proved and subsequently the petitioner/complainant was disengaged from the services of the respondents industry/hospital.

The petitioner/complainant requested redressal of his grievances, but same were not redressed which compelled him to approach before ALC, Conciliation Officer for conciliation of the dispute arising in between the petitioner/complainant and the respondent, however the Ops. even did not bother to attend the office of Conciliation Officer which led the Conciliation Officer to direct the petitioner/complainant for approaching before this Court/Tribunal for adjudication of industrial dispute/his grievances.

The petitioner/complainant himself appeared in witness box as his own witness and deposed his statement on affidavit on the same day i. e. 05-05-2015 ratifying the contentions contained in the complaint and sought reliefs as prayed for in the complaint.

In terms of section 2-A of ID Act and individual dispute between the employer and the employee is deemed to be an “industrial dispute” and this Court/Industrial Tribunal is the forum designated under the said Act to adjudicate upon the dispute and pass its award within a period of 03 months from the date of presentation of application before it under section (2) r/w 10(2)A of Industrial Dispute Act.

In terms of section 2-J of the Industrial Disputes Act the Respondents Hospital constitutes an Industry and in terms of section 2-K of the said I. D. Act. The dispute so arising between the petitioner/complainant and respondents/Ops constitute an “Industrial Dispute” and under section 2-S the petitioner/complainant is a skilled workman, hence the respondents are/were liable for the action which they have taken against the petitioner/complainant in violation of various provisions of Industrial Dispute Act. A disciplinary action be directed to be taken against the persons who have leveled false and frivolous allegations against the petitioner/complainant which has proven false in terms of the report of enquiry officer [Director, Imam Hussain (A. S.) Hospital] annexed as Annexure-B with the complaint on record.

The petitioner who was even exonerated from all the allegations by the enquiry officer is to be deemed to be in-service of opposite party's hospital continuously and is entitled to arrears of salary arbitrarily withheld by the respondents/Ops.

Respondents/Ops. has chosen not to appear and subsequently when the Ld. Assistant Labor Commissioner, Srinagar failed to submit the failure report within the period of 45 days despite lapse of more than three months, the petitioner in view of above referred provision incorporated in the said Act by the Govt. of India in 2010 which is in force w. e. f. 15th day of September, 2010 by virtue of notification issued by Ministry of Labour and Employment, Noti. No. S. O. 227 (E) dated 15th September, 2010 published in the Gazette of India, Extra, dated 15th September, 2010, P. 1. No. 1928, the petitioner without wasting any further time presented the instant reference petition before this Tribunal on 29-10-2013. Under the said amended Act, 2010, this Tribunal has powers to entertain and receive a reference petition directly from the workman after expiry of 45 days, from the date of receipt of application by the Conciliation Officer of the appropriate Government.

Now since after the expiry of 45 days, a right accrued to the petitioner under the aforesaid amendment of 2010 to approach directly to this Tribunal with a reference petition but question here arises that whether the Ld. Assistant Labour Commissioner, Srinagar who acted as Conciliation Officer in the instant reference prior to the presentation of the instant reference before this Tribunal, has jurisdiction to act as Conciliation Officer in the instant matter, I am of this opinion that it is immaterial to this Tribunal whether the appropriate Govt. for the present reference is State Govt. or Central Govt. because under the Act, this Tribunal has jurisdiction for both State Govt. as well as Central Government. But for the maintainability of the present reference which has been presented before this Tribunal directly by the petitioner without reference by the appropriate Govt. because of the aforesaid amendment of 2010 but the material point is that the instant reference moved under amendment of 2010, is only maintainable when this reference petition is moved after the expiry of 45 days from the date of receipt of the application by the Conciliation Officer of the appropriate Govt., the same

fact is proved from the record that the instant reference petition has been moved before this Tribunal after the expiry of 45 days from the date of receipt of the application from the petitioner, by the Ld. Assistant Labour Commissioner, Srinagar but the question here arises whether the Assistant Labour Commissioner, Srinagar has powers to intervene in the dispute referred to, in the instant reference petition, the answer is certainly 'yes' because had he not having such powers for the purpose of the dispute with reference to the instant petition, then he would not have entertained the said application nor he would have acted upon nor he would have issued a notice to the respondents. Besides that undisputedly the Ld. Assistant Labour Commissioner and Dy. Labour Commissioner, Kashmir is the referral authority and also Conciliation Officer in view of THE INDUSTRIAL DISPUTES (JAMMU AND KASHMIR STATE) RULES, 1972 read with SRO-405 of 1986 Dated 18-07-1986 Labour, Stationary and Printing Department.

Government for the purpose of the amendment of 2010 of the Act especially for the purpose of amendment of sub-section (2) of section 2A of the I. D. Act. No doubt that the above said officers of the Labour Department of Central Government are referral Authorities under the aforesaid rules but not Conciliation Officer for the purpose of amendment of sub-section (2) of section 2A of the Act incorporated by amendment of 2010 by Govt. of India. But despite of that the petitioner has approached the Ld. Assistant Labour Commissioner, Srinagar at the first instance and then to this Tribunal, after the expiry of more than 03 months from the date of receipt of the application by the Ld. Assistant Labour Commissioner as such the conditions laid down in the sub-section (2) of section 2A of the I. D. Act has been strictly complied with as such this Tribunal has jurisdiction under sub-section (2) of section 2A of the ID Act, to adjudicate upon the instant reference petition. In support of this, the petitioner has produced two witnesses, in addition to his own statement, all of them corroborated the stand of the petitioner. The petitioner was engaged as Nursing Orderly from 01-07-1992 but it is admitted fact the petitioner has been disbanded w. e. f. 04-05-2013. Taking July 1st, 1992 as date of engagement instead of September, 2002 as date of engagement, as

such on the basis of such admission on the part of the respondents, i. e. for more than 240 days for a calendar year as such under law a petitioner is a protected workman and a statutory right has accrued to him under section 25B and 25F of the Act by virtue of which the petitioner cannot be disengaged from his services, by the respondents, without following the due procedure laid down under section 25B and 25F of the Act and any dereliction from such set procedure makes the termination order illegal, and bad in the eyes of law as such being that legal position, the termination of the petitioner from his services, by the respondent is illegal, invalid, unwarranted and uncalled for and against the principle of natural justice. In view of the above facts and circumstances, the petitioner has rendered services for more than 240 days in calendar year as required as such is protected workman in terms of Act as such since statutory obligation castes upon the respondent to assign reasons for termination and to give prior notice to the petitioner before terminating his services, which has not been done in the present case but in turn the respondent has terminated the services of the petitioner in gross violation of the provisions of section 25B and 25F of the Act. In support of this, the petitioner relied upon case law, Titled Ramesh Kumar V/s. State of Haryana at Para No. 13 (AIR 2010 SC 683) in which the Hon'ble Apex Court held as under :—

“it is to be noted that in the case of termination of casual employee what is required to, be seen is whether a workman has completed 240 days in the proceeding twelve months or not. If sufficient materials are shown that workman has completed 240 days then his service cannot be terminated without giving notice or compensation in lieu of it in terms of section 25F. The High Court failed to appreciate that in the present case appellant has completed 240 days in the preceding 12 months and no notice or compensation in lieu of it was given to him, in such circumstances, his termination was illegal.”

Since there is nothing sustainable accepting the averment that the petitioner had left the service at his own as such from the above referred provision and also the above referred Judgment of the Hon'ble Apex

Court, I reached on this conclusion that the termination of the petitioner from his services, by the respondents, is illegal, invalid, unwarranted and uncalled for and against the principle of natural justice. Therefore, the termination of the petitioner by respondents, is hereby set aside and respondents are directed to reinstate the petitioner forthwith since for the aforesaid reasons the termination of the petitioner from his services, by the respondents, has been declared as illegal, invalid, unwarranted and uncalled for and against the principle of natural Justice, and has been ordered to be reinstated forthwith and since the petitioner is fighting for his reinstatement from disengaged Order No. IHH/6013 dated 04-05-2013 since the petitioner has stated that he is not employed anywhere during this period and in support of this, the petitioner has furnished an affidavit to that extent, to this Tribunal and more so since the petitioner has suffered a lot during this long period of more than three years during which the petitioner not only suffered financially but also mental agony as such under these peculiar circumstances, the petitioner is entitled for all full back wages since his termination which the petitioner is entitled under law, relying upon the Judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court Titled Hindustan Tin Works V/s. its Employees (AIR 1979 S. C. 75) in which the Hon'ble Apex Court in para No. 09, 10 & 11 held as under :—

“it is no more open to debate that in the field of Industrial Jurisprudence a declaration can be given that the termination of service is bad and the workman continues to be in service. The spectre of Common Law doctrine that contract of personal service cannot be specifically enforced or the doctrine of mitigation of damages does not haunt this branch of law. The relief of reinstatement with certainty of service can be granted where termination of service is found to be invalid. It would mean that the employer has taken away illegally the right to work of the workman contrary to the relevant law or in breach of contract and simultaneously deprived the workman of his earnings. If thus the employer is found to be in the wrong as a result of which the workman is directed to be reinstated, the employer could not shirk his responsibility of paying the wages which the workman has been deprived of by the illegal or invalid action of the employer.

Speaking realistically, where termination of service is questioned as invalid or illegal and the workman has to go through the gamut of litigation, his capacity to sustain himself throughout the protracted litigation is itself such an awesome factor that he may not survive to see the day when law's proverbial delay has become stupefying. If after such a protracted time and energy consuming litigation during which period, the workman sustains himself, ultimately he is to be told that though he will be reinstated, he will be denied to back wages which would be due to him, the workman would be subjected to a sort of penalty for no fault of his and it is wholly undeserved. Ordinarily, therefore, a workman whose service has been illegally terminated would be entitled to be full back wages except to the extent he was gainfully employed during the enforced idleness. That is the normal rule. Any other view would be a premium on the unwarranted letigative activity of the employer. If the employer terminates the service, the service illegally and the termination is motivated as in this case ; viz. to resist the workman's demand for revision of wages, termination may well amount to unfair labour practice. In such circumstances reinstatement being the normal rule it should be followed with full back wages. Articles 41 and 43 of the Constitution would assist us in reaching a just conclusion in this respect.....

In this very nature of things there cannot be a strait-jacket formula for awarding relief of back wages. All relevant considerations will enter the verdict. More or less, it would be a motion addressed to the discretion of the Tribunal. Full back wages would be the normal rule and the party objecting to it must establish the circumstances necessitating departure. At that stage, the Tribunal will exercise its discretion keeping in view all the relevant circumstances."

For the foregoing reasons, the wages are also decided in favour of the petitioner and against the respondents as such the petitioner is entitled to all full back wages including the period from his termination till the petitioner resumes his services with all benefits.

Accordingly, the Respondents are directed to reinstate the petitioner forthwith and with a further direction to respondents to pay the aforesaid full back wages in favour of the petitioner within a period of three months failing which thereafter the respondents have to pay the said full back wages to the petitioner along with interest @ 08% till final realization.

The reference petition filed by the petitioner, in view of amendment of sub-section (2) of section 2A of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 incorporated by amendment of 2010, is answered accordingly. Copy of this award be sent to the appropriate Government through its Commissioner/Secretary, Labour Department for information and publication in the Govt. Gazette.

 - (b) the 29th June, 2017 (Thursday), as the date for scrutiny of the nominations ;
 - (c) the 1st July, 2017 (Saturday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures ; and

(d) the 17th July, 2017 (Monday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken.
