Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Project Director, NHAI vide PD/JMU/LA/Udhampur/2016-17 dated 08-04-2016 a notification under section 4(1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Udhampur vide No. LA/ADC/285-93 dated 23-05-2016 for land measuring 88 Kanals and 18 Marlas, situated in Village Lota, Tehsil and District Udhampur.

Whereas, the land, specifications whereof are given at “Annexure-A” to this notification, is required for public purpose viz. “widening four lanning of National Highway” ;

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Project Director, NHAI vide PD/JMU/15011/1998 dated 03-10-2005, accordingly a notification under section 4(1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Ramban vide No. 509-14/ACQ/NH-AI dated 08-11-2016 for land measuring 308 Kanals situated in Village Ramban, Tehsil and District Ramban ;

Whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Ramban vide letter No. 509-14/ACQ/NH-AI dated 08-11-2016, has reported that the notification issued under section 4(1) of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act by him was served upon the interested persons for filing objections, if any, to the proposed acquisition but no objection was received from the land owners/interested persons in the prescribed time period as required under sections 5&5-A of the Land Acquisition Act ;

Whereas, the Collector has further stated that the Hon'ble High Court had restrained the Collector vide Order dated 03-05-2010 in OWP No. 477/2010 read with CMP No. 644/2010 from issuing final award on the acquisition proceedings initiated earlier ;

Whereas, it has also been stated that the earlier acquisition proceedings have been quashed by the Hon'ble Court vide Order dated 06-10-2016, and it has been ordered that the date of notification under section 4(1) of the LA Act shall be treated as the date of order passed by the Hon'ble High Court ;

Whereas, the report furnished by the Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Ramban vide No. 509-14/ACQ/NH-AI dated 08-11-2016 and endorsed by the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/2739/Acq/NHAI/ Rbn/2016/2256-58 dated 21-11-2016, has been examined and it has been found that the order of the Hon'ble High Court is applicable to the petitioners, it would not be appropriate to apply the judgment to some of the land owners as it would embolden the non-petitioners also to take recourse to litigation, which may further delay the acquisition process. It has, therefore, been decided to initiate the fresh proceedings in respect of the entire land irrespective of the applicability of the judgment or the HHC to the petitioners only, with a view to obviate the possibility, or further litigation ; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof mentioned are given at "Annexure-A" to this notification, is required for public purpose viz. widening four lanning of National Highway.

Now, therefore, in supersession of the declaration issued already on the subject matter and in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat, 1990, it is declared that land measuring 308 Kanals situated in Village Ramban, Tehsil and District Ramban, particulars whereof are given at “Annexure-A” to this notification is required for public purpose viz. widening four lanning of National Highway. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Ramban is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take order for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person(s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of land involved in the case and apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award.

Whereas, under sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952 (31 of 1952), the Election Commission of India is required to so appoint the dates for the election to fill the office of the Vice-President of India that the election will be completed at such time as will enable the Vice-President thereby elected to enter upon his office on the 11th day of August, 2017.

Now, therefore, the Election Commission of India hereby—

- (A) **calls upon** the Electoral College, referred to in Article 66 of the Constitution, to elect a person to fill the above vacancy in the office of Vice-President of India before the expiration of the term of the incumbent Vice-President, in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the Presidential and Vice-Presidential Elections Act, 1952 (31 of 1952), and the Rules and Orders made thereunder ; and
- (B) in pursuance of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the said Act, appoints—
 - (a) the 18th July, 2017 (Tuesday), as the last date for making nominations ;
 - (b) the 19th July, 2017 (Wednesday), as the date for scrutiny of the nominations ;
 - (c) the 21st July, 2017 (Friday), as the last date for the withdrawal of candidatures ; and

(d) the 5th August, 2017 (Saturday), as the date on which a poll shall, if necessary, be taken.
