THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR CIVIC LAWS
(SPECIAL PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2017

[L. A. Bill No. 5 of 2017.]

A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Civic Laws (Special Provisions) Act, 2014.

Be it enacted by the Jammu and Kashmir State Legislature in the Sixty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Civic Laws (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 2017.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 1st day of April, 2017.

2. *Amendment of section 1, Act III of 2014.*—In section 1 of the Jammu and Kashmir Civic Laws (Special Provisions) Act, 2014 (hereinafter referred to as ‘the Principal Act’), in sub-section (2), for the words and figures, “31st day of March, 2017”, the words and figures “30th day of September, 2017” shall be substituted.

3. *Amendment of section 3, Act III of 2014.*—In section 3 of the Principal Act, for the words and figures, “31st day of March, 2017”, the words and figures, “30th day of September, 2017” shall be substituted.

4. *Amendment of section 4, Act III of 2014.*—In section 4 of the Principal Act—

- (i) in proviso to sub-section (1), for the words, “after coming into force of this Act”, the words and figures, “after 31st of December, 2016”, shall be substituted ; and

- (ii) in sub-section (2), for the words and figures, “31st day of March, 2017”, the words and figures, “30th day of September, 2017” shall be substituted.

5. *Amendment of section 5, Act III of 2014.*—In section 5 of the Principal Act, in clause (a), for the words “on the date of commencement of this Act”, the words and figures, “on 31st of December, 2016” shall be substituted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The J&K Civic Law (Special Provisions) Act, 2014 was enacted which extended to the local areas of Jammu, Srinagar and Katra town. In pursuance to the section 3 of the Act, the Government had to formulate a policy to deal with or regulate the unauthorized construction in the aforementioned local areas. This policy should be in consonance with the Master Plan as may be modified as reviewed under the sub-section (2) of section 12 of the H&U Development Act, 1970.

The mid-term revision of the Master Plans of Jammu, Srinagar and Katra under J&K Development Act, 1970 has been undertaken by the department but due to certain unavoidable circumstances the deadlines projected for completion of the Master Plan could not be accomplished, thereby causing a delay in finalization of the proposed policy required under the Act for regularization of unauthorized construction to the extent possible within the ambit/framework of the modified Master Plans. Now, the said policy has been framed and also approved by the State Cabinet.

As the term of the Act consequent to its extension vide J&K Civic Laws (Special Provision) Amendment Act, 2014 expired on 31st day of March, 2017, and required further extended up to 30th day of September, 2017 to implement the policy to regulate the unauthorized construction in the aforementioned local areas.

SRO-230.—Whereas, on 04-05-2012, the guard personnel deployed on security duty at minority picket Pargochi-B, Shopian were attacked by five (05) militants who also snatched two (02) service weapons and ammunition from the guard personnel ; and

Whereas, with regard to the aforementioned incident, a case FIR No. 129/2012 under sections 307, 395 of RPC, 7/27 Arms Act, sections 16,

18 and 38 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 (for short, "UA (P) Act"), section 3 of Police Enhanced Penalties Ordinance, 2005 (1948 AD) (for short, "PEPO") and section 30 of the Police Act was registered in Police Station, Shopian and the investigation was initiated ; and

Whereas, during the course of investigation, all the four police personnel deployed on the guard duty were arrested by the Investigating Officer ; and

Whereas, during the course of investigation, on the basis of statements of witnesses recorded under sections 161 and 164-A of Cr. P. C. and based on the circumstantial and documentary evidence, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* case under section 3 of PEPO and section 30 of the Police Act, against the four police personnel deployed on guard duty viz., 1) Sg. Ct. Mohammad Abdullah No. 264/Spn, 2) Ct. Mushtaq Ahmad No. 510/Spn., 3) SPO Mohammad Amin No. 224/Spn. and 4) SPO Ayash Ahmad No. 114/Spn. ; and

Whereas, during the course of investigation, three persons namely, Muzamil Bashir @ Umer, Mukhtar Ahmad Dar and Shabir Ahmad Malik have also been arrested and on the instance of accused Muzamil Bashir, 08 live rounds of SLR and 13 live rounds of 303 have been recovered from an orchard at Lassipora, Pulwama. Besides, the snatched weapon has also been recovered from two militants namely Arshid Ahmad Sheikh (one of the accused persons in instant FIR) and Tawseef Ahmad, who were killed during an encounter, and on the basis of statements of witnesses recorded under sections 161 and 164-A of Cr. P. C. and based on the circumstantial and documentary evidence, the Investigating Officer has also established a *prima facie* case under sections 395, 307 RPC, 7/27 Arms Act and sections 16, 18 and 38 of ULA (P) Act against the five militants, out of whom Arshid Ahmad Sheikh has been killed in an encounter viz., 1) Inam-ul-Haq Malla @ Waseem S/o Mohammad Iqbal Malla R/o Pehlipora, Shopian (Active Militant), 2) Mukhtar Ahmad Dar S/o Gh. Mohammad Dar R/o

Haripora, Shopian, 3) Shabir Ahmad Malik S/o Mohammad Khalil R/o Sugoo, Hindhama, Shopian and 4) Muzamil Bashir Mir S/o Bashir Ahmad Mir R/o Lassipora ; and

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the State Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the ULA (P) Act has independently scrutinized the Case Diary file and all other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to a definite conclusion that a *prima facie* case under sections 16, 18 and 38 of ULA (P) Act arising out of FIR No. 129/2012 of Police Station, Shopian is made out against the accused persons namely, 1) Inam-ul-Haq Malla @ Waseem S/o Mohammad Iqbal Malla R/o Pehlipora, Shopian (Active Militant), 2) Mukhtar Ahmad Dar S/o Gh. Mohammad Dar R/o Haripora, Shopian, 3) Shabir Ahmad Malik S/o Mohammad Khalil R/o Sugoo, Hindhama, Shopian and 4) Muzamil Bashir Mir S/o Bashir Ahmad Mir R/o Lassipora, for launching prosecution against them in the competent court of law ; and

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the observations/views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the ULA (P) Act, the State Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused persons (militants) for their prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of law ; and

Whereas, the State Government is also of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the other accused police personnel for according sanction as required under section 5 of the PEPO for their prosecution under section 3 of PEPO and section 30 of the Police Act.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 45 of the ULA (P) Act and section 5 of the PEPO, the State Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the below mentioned accused persons, for the commission of offences punishable

under sections 307, 395 of RPC, 7/27 of Arms Act and sections 16, 18 and 38 of ULA (P) Act against A-1 to A-4, and offences under section 3 of PEPO and section 30 of the Police Act against A-5 to A-8 :—

1. Inam-ul-Haq Malla @ Waseem S/o Mohammad Iqbal Malla R/o Pehlipora, Shopian (Active Militant).
2. Mukhtar Ahmad Dar S/o Gh. Mohammad Dar R/o Haripora, Shopian.
3. Shabir Ahmad Malik S/o Mohammad Khalil R/o Sugoo, Hindhama, Shopian.
4. Muzamil Bashir Mir S/o Bashir Ahmad Mir R/o Lassipora.
5. Sg. Ct. Mohammad Abdullah, No. 264/Spn.
6. Ct. Mushtaq Ahmad No. 510/Spn.
7. SPO Mohammad Amin No. 224/Spn.
8. SPO Ayash Ahmad No. 114/Spn.

SRO-231.—Whereas, on 05-07-2011, Police Station, Kulgam reliably came to know that several persons including (1) Tanveer Ahmad Rather S/o Abdul Rehman R/o Kanelwan, Bijbehara and (2) Chandia Kohli @ Chandia Gojar R/o Malwan, on the instance of terrorists of banned HM terrorist outfit and other accomplices, are providing financial assistance to the terrorists for carrying out terrorist activities ; and

Whereas, in this connection, Case FIR No. 137/2011 under section 17 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 was registered in Police Station, Kulgam and investigation initiated ; and

Whereas, during the course of investigation, the accused namely Tanveer Ahmad Rather S/o Late Ab. Rehman R/o Kanelwan, Bijbehera, Anantnag and Chandia Kohli @ Chandia Gojar S/o Jamal-ud-Din R/o Malwan, Kulgam were found counting currency notes in suspicious condition in the hospital premises, both were apprehended on the spot and an amount of Rupees one lac and nineteen thousand (Indian currency) was recovered from them and a written letter on HM letter pad mentioning receipts/ distribution details as well instruction was also recovered ; and

Whereas, during preliminary questioning, it was found that the said amount is a terrorist fund transaction/transported on the instructions of one Rafiq Ahmad Sheikh @ Basharat, Divisional Commander of Banned Outfit HM Peer Panchal Regiment, which amount was actually sent by the HM terrorist Zaffar Ahmad Bhat S/o Sonauallah Bhat R/o Liver, Pahalgam who is carrying out terrorist activities from across the LoC since last several years through these accused persons among others. The said amount being a proceed of terrorism was got retained as per the provisions under section 25 ULA (P) Act by the designated authority and the seized currency notes have also been got verified for their genuineness through J&K Bank. The involvement of other accused persons namely (1) Gh. Nabi Lone S/o Mohd. Akbar Lone R/o Thamankot, Verinag, (2) Mohd. Rafiq Sheikh @ Basharat S/o Ab. Rehman R/o Nooch Devel, Tehsil Mahore, (3) Mohd. Bashir Sheikh @ Rashid S/o Habibullah R/o Devel, Tehsil Mahore and (04) Zaffar Ahmad Bhat S/o Sonauallah Bhat R/o Lever, Pahalgam was also established in the instant case. All the above named accused persons were arrested (except accused namely Zaffar Ahmad Bhat S/o Sonauallah Bhat who is presently at PoK/Pak against whom proceedings under section 512 Cr. P. C. have been initiated) and latter released on bail ; and

Whereas, during the course of investigation, on the basis of statements of witnesses, the seizure memos and other evidence, the Investigating Officer established a *prima facie* case against the accused persons under sections 17, 20 and 21 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 ; and

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the State Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently scrutinized the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to a definite conclusion that this is a fit case for accord of prosecution sanction against the accused persons ; and

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the observations/views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the State Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused persons for their prosecution under the aforesaid provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the State Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offence punishable under sections 17, 20 and 21 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, arising out of FIR No. 137/2011 of Police Station, Kulgam :—
