1. No. 3/4/ID/ECI/LET/FUNC/JUD/SDR/VOL. II/2017.—Whereas, section 61 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 provides that with a view to preventing impersonation of electors, so as to make the right of genuine electors to vote under section 62 of that Act more effective, provisions may be made by rules under that Act for use of Electors Photo

Identity Card for electors as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling ; and

2. Whereas, Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, empowers the Election Commission to direct, with a view to preventing impersonation of electors and facilitating their identification at the time of poll, the issue of Electors Photo Identity Card to electors bearing their photographs at State cost ; and

3. Whereas, Rules 49H (3) and 49K (2) (b) of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, stipulate that where the electors of a constituency have been supplied with Electors Photo Identity Card under the said provisions of Rule 28 of the Registration of Electors Rules, 1960, the electors shall produce their Electors Photo Identity Card at the polling station and failure or refusal on their part to produce those Electors Photo Identity Card may result in the denial of permission to vote ; and

4. Whereas, a combined and harmonious reading of the aforesaid provisions of the said Act and the rules, makes it clear that although the right to vote arises by the existence of the name in the electoral roll, it is also dependent upon the use of the Electors Photo Identity Card, where provided by the Election Commission at State cost, as the means of establishing their identity at the time of polling and that both are to be used together ; and

5. Whereas, the Election Commission made an Order on the 28th August, 1993, directing the issue of Electors Photo Identity Card (EPIC) to all electors, according to a time bound programme ; and

6. Whereas, Electors Photo Identity Card have been issued to a substantially large number of electors in the States of **Assam, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Jammu and Kashmir, Karnataka, Kerala,**

**Madhya Pradesh, NCT of Delhi, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal ; and**

7. Whereas, in addition the Commission has directed that **‘Authenticated Photo Voters Slip’** shall be distributed to the electors before the date of poll for the current bye-elections.

8. Now, therefore, after taking into account all relevant factors and the legal and factual position, the Election Commission hereby directs that for current bye-elections from **02-Srinagar Parliament Constituency and 03-Anantnag Parliament Constituency in Jammu and Kashmir, 06-Malappuram Parliament Constituency in Kerala, 113-Dhemaji (ST) Assembly Constituency in Assam, 36-Bhoranj (SC) Assembly Constituency in Himachal Pradesh, 09-Ater Assembly Constituency and 89-Bandhavgarh (ST) Assembly Constituency in Madhya Pradesh, 216-Kanthi Dakshin Assembly Constituency in West Bengal, 79-Dholpur Assembly Constituency in Rajasthan, 214-Nanjangud (SC) Assembly Constituency and 224-Gundlupet Assembly Constituency in Karnataka, 11-Dr. Radhakrishnan Nagar Assembly Constituency in Tamil Nadu, 04-Litipara (ST) Assembly Constituency in Jharkhand, 28-Upper Burtuk Assembly Constituency in Sikkim, 27-Rajouri Garden Assembly Constituency in NCT of Delhi**, which have been notified on **14-03-2017,16-03-2017 and 17-03-2017** all electors who have been issued EPIC shall produce the EPIC for their identification at the polling station before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo identity documents for establishing their identity :—

- (i) Passport ;
- (ii) Driving License ;

- (iii) Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt. PSUs/Public Limited Companies ;
- (iv) Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office ;
- (v) PAN Card ;
- (vi) Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR ;
- (vii) MNREGA Job Card ;
- (viii) Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour ;
- (ix) Pension document with photograph ;
- (x) Authenticated Photo Voter Slip issued by the election machinery ;
- (xi) Official identity Cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs ; and
- (xii) Aadhaar Card.

9. In the case of EPIC, clerical errors, spelling mistakes, etc. should be ignored provided the identity of the elector can be established by the EPIC. If an elector produces an Electors Photo Identity Card, which has been issued by the Electoral Registration Officer of another Assembly Constituency, such EPICs shall also be accepted for identification provided the name of that elector finds place in the electoral roll pertaining to the polling station where the elector has turned up for voting. If it is not possible to establish the identity of the elector on account of mismatch of photograph, etc. the elector shall have to produce one of the alternative photo documents mentioned in para 8 above.

10. Notwithstanding anything in Para 8 above, overseas electors who are registered in the electoral rolls under section 20A of the Representation of the People Act, 1950, based on the particulars in their Passport, shall be identified on the basis of their original passport only (and no other identity document) in the polling station.

SRO-107.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 118 of the Constitution of Jammu and Kashmir, the Governor is pleased to make following amendment in the Jammu and Kashmir Financial Code, Volume-I ; namely :—

In chapter IX Works under the caption “Works Under The Administrative Control of the Public Works Department”, in rule 9.10

after the note appended to sub-rule (ii), the following sub-rules shall be added ; namely :—

- iii. Unless expressly provided under a scheme of State/Central Government mobilization advance is not to be given to contractors under any circumstances ;
- iv. Provision of mobilization advance shall essentially be need based. Decision to provide such advance shall rest at the level of Chief Engineer of the Organization with concurrence of Financial Advisor/CAO in Chief Engineer's office ;
- v. Mobilization Advance shall not exceed 10% of the tendered value and should be given only if requested by the contractor in writing within one month of the order of allotment of works and rules and guidelines of a particular scheme should allow such advance ;
- vi. The contractor shall execute a bank guarantee bond from scheduled nationalized Bank or Jammu and Kashmir Bank as specified by concerned department for full amount of advance ;
- vii. Such advance shall be released in two or more Installments to be determined by the Engineer incharge (concerned Executive Engineer) at his discretion ;
- viii. The first Installment of such advance shall be released on a request made by contractor to the Engineer incharge. The 2nd and 3rd Installment shall be released only after the contractor furnishes a proof of the satisfactory utilization of the earlier, installment to the entire satisfaction of the Engineer incharge (concerned Executive Engineer) ;
- ix. Mobilization Advance shall be admissible only for works where estimated cost of tender is Rs. 2.00 crore and above ;

- x. Interest free mobilization advance, if necessary in specific cases, be clearly stipulated in the tender document and its recovery shall be time-based and not linked with progress of work to ensure that even if the contractor is not executing the work or executing it at a slow pace, the recovery of advance could commence ;
- xi. The amount of mobilization advance interest to be charged, if any ; its recovery schedule and all other relevant details shall be explicitly stipulated in the tender document upfront ;
- xii. There shall be a clear stipulation of rate of interest to be charged on delayed recoveries due to the late submission of bill by the contractor, the reason giving rise to the encashment of Bank Guarantee or any other reason ;
- xiii In case of Machinery and Equipment advance insurance and hypothecation to the State Government shall be ensured ;
- xiv. A clause in the tender enquiry and the contract of cases providing for interest free mobilization advance shall be stipulated that if the contract is terminated due to default of the contractor, the Mobilization Advance shall be deemed as interest bearing advance at an interest rate of \_\_\_% (to be stipulated depending on the prevailing rate at the time of issue of NIT) to be compounded quarterly ;
- xv. The Mobilization Advance shall not be paid in less than two installments except in special circumstances for the reasons to be recorded, so as to keep check on contractor against the misutilization of advance, when the work is delayed considerably ;
- xvi. 'Bank Guarantee' (BG) against the mobilization advance shall be taken in as many numbers as the proposed recovery of

installments and shall be equivalent to the amount of each installment. This shall ensure that at any point of time even if the contractor's money on account of work done is not available with the Organization, recovery of such advance could be ensured by encashing the BG for the work supposed to be completed within a particular period of time ;

- xvii. Relevant format for BG should be provided in the tender document and conditions thereof should be enforced strictly, besides verifying the authenticity of BG from the issuing bank confidentially and independently ;
- xviii. The Bank Guarantee etc. taken towards security of Mobilization Advance shall be at least 110% of the advance so as to enable recovery of not only principal amount but also the interest portion, if so required.
- xix. The rate of interest on the Mobilization Advance shall be 12%. However, these rates shall be reviewed periodically by the Finance Department.

No. 100/ECI/TERR/NOR-I/J&K-HP/2017(2).—Whereas, the Election Commission has, by its Notification No. 100/ECI/TERR/NOR-I/J&K-HP/2017(2), dated 17th March, 2017, issued under sub-section (1) of Section 149 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, called upon the 3-Anantnag Parliamentary Constituency in the State of Jammu and Kashmir to elect a member to the House of the People, before 16th April, 2017, to fill the casual vacancy in the said House caused by the resignation of Ms. Mehbooba Mufti on 4th July, 2016 ; and

Whereas, the Election Commission has, by its said Notification dated 17th March, 2017, also appointed, under Section 30 of the above Act, the various dates for the filing of nominations, scrutiny of nominations, withdrawal of candidatures, and has also, *inter alia*, appointed 12th April, 2017, as the date on which a poll shall be taken, if necessary, in the said Parliamentary Constituency ; and

Whereas, a report has been received from the State Administration of Jammu and Kashmir on 10th April, 2017, that the law and order situation prevailing in the said 3-Anantnag Parliamentary Constituency is not conducive to the holding of free and fair poll in the constituency on 12th April, 2017, as scheduled ; and

Whereas, the State Administration has, in its said report, also expressed apprehension that there may be violent attempts by some miscreant elements to thwart the polling process in the constituency in view of the violent incidents that have taken place in some parts of the 2-Srinagar Parliamentary Constituency, where the poll was taken on the 9th April, 2017, resulting in some casualties and loss of life ; and

Whereas, the State Administration has, in its said report, further recommended that the poll scheduled to be taken on the 12th April, 2017 in 3-Anantnag Parliamentary Constituency may be deferred for the time being ; and

Whereas, the Election Commission, having considered the above report of the State Administration and also taking into account inputs received by it from various sources, including the reports from the Chief Electoral Officer of the State, Divisional Commissioner of the South Kashmir, Returning Officer of the constituency and other election authorities concerned, decided that the poll scheduled to be taken on 12th April, 2017, in the said 3-Anantnag Parliamentary Constituency may be deferred from the time being and that it shall be taken on 25th May, 2017, by which time the Commission expects the law and order situation in the constituency to improve and become conducive to the holding of free and fair election.

Now, therefore, the Election Commission, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 324 of the Constitution read with Sections 30 and 153 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and further read with Section 21 of the General Clauses Act, 1897, hereby makes the following amendments to its Notification No.100/ECI/TERR/NOR-I/J&K-HP/2017(2) dated 17th March, 2017, referred to above, namely :—

In Clause (B), for sub-clauses (iv) and (v), the following sub-clauses shall be substituted :—

“iv. the 25th May, 2017 (Thursday), as the date on which a poll shall be taken ; and

v. the 1st June, 2017 (Thursday), as the date before which the election shall be completed ; and”.
