“33. Rate of compensation for loss of life or injury to person.—In case of death/injury to human lives due to field firing practice, the compensation shall be payable, prospectively at the following rates :—

i. Death	Rs. 2.50 lacs.
ii. 100% disability	Rs. 2.00 lacs.
iii. 50% to 100% disability	Rs. 1.50 lacs.
iv. Below 50% disability	Rs. 1.00 lacs”.

(3) Rule 34, sub-rule (a) shall be substituted by the following, namely :—

“34 (a). Rate of compensation for evacuation.—In case where the villagers are compelled to leave houses or restrictions are imposed on their movement due to field firing practice, the compensation shall be payable, prospectively at the following rates :—
