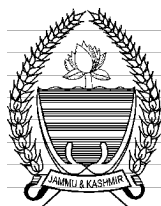

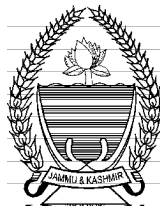

analogy the Junior colleagues Cushioners were given and recovery of the benefits thereof in terms of S.33©(2) of the I. D. Act, 1947 and S.15(2) of the Payment of Wages Act, 1936 .

Award/Order

Present : Mohammad Ali Khan, Presiding Officer

The applicant/petitioner had filed an application before this Tribunal Labour Court in the year 2012 dated 05-04-2012 stating therein that the applicant was engaged as a Daily Wager by the non-applicants on daily wages basis w. e. f. September, 1968. The applicant's service was regularized and brought on regular establishment in the grade of 750-15-840-EB-20-1000 w. e. f. 01-04-1994 as Asstt. Cushioner vide order No. JKI/960/1994 dated 07-12-1994. After that the above mentioned grade was revised in the year, 1996 to the pay scale of Rs. 2550-55-2660-64-3300 vide Government order No. 47-F-of 1998 dated 19-01-1998 and the said grade was also released in favour of the applicant along with other Co-workers.

That the applicant continued to serve in the abovementioned revised grade till date of retirement on superannuation in the year, 2010 without given any chance of promotion though having a superior claim being senior to other colleagues who were engaged on daily wages much later to the applicant.

That one worker namely Mohammad Ashraf Chishti token No.100 was engaged on daily wage basis w. e. f. November,1972 i. e. after four years the applicant was engaged and his services too were regularized along with the applicant w. e. f. 01-04-1994 vide above mentioned order as Asstt. Cushioner. He too was brought in regular establishment in the revised grade of 2550-3300 along with applicant in the same year of 1996.

That surprisingly, the junior colleague namely Mohammad Ashraf was given another promotion as Cushioner in the grade of 2610-70-3175-75-3795 w. e. f. 01-09-1997 ignoring the superior claim of the applicant being senior to the promotee.

That again the said promotee (junior colleague) was bestowed with another promotion and promoted to the grade of 3000-85-4020-90-4560

w. e. f. 01-12-2000 vide order No. JKI/422/2000 dated 01-12-2000 ignoring  
again the genuine claim of the applicant to next promotion.

That the applicant's superior claim of promotion to the next higher post of "Senior Cushioner" was ignored and favoritism was shown towards the Junior worker Ashraf Chesti by giving him promotion to the other highest grade of Rs. 4000-110-6090 in the year 2007 issued vide order No JKI/24/2007 dated 08-05-2007.

That the applicant had made oral as well as written representations before the authorities against this discrimination and favoritism to the blue eyed one ignoring his genuine and superior claim of seniority and right to promotion but no action was taken and the lawful right of superior claim was not considered by the Non-applicants.

The applicant after exhausting all his efforts to get justice at the hands of the authorities of respondents (Non-applicants) approached this Court for seeking justice and redressal of his grievance and equal treatment of his demand at par and at the same analogy the promoted (junior colleague) namely Mohammad Ashraf Chesti was given.

This Tribunal/Labour Court after taking cognizance of the case under the relevant provisions of law called upon both the parties. Initially the respondents caused their appearance through their counsel who were provided the basic claim application of the claimant applicant with the direction to file the objections which they did not file. After 02.09.2014, the respondents chosen to remain absent and did not appear and not participated in the proceedings before this Tribunal/Labour Court either personally or through their counsel or representative with the result the court had not any alternative but to proceed ex parte against the respondents and the applicant was directed to produce the evidence in support of his claim application.

On the day of May, 2016 the authorized representative of respondents approached the Court/Tribunal and filed an application for setting aside an ex parte proceedings initiated against them on 02-09-2014 and also filed objections along with annexures and power of attorney and the same form part of the file. The copy of the same were furnished to the petitioner/ applicant in the open Court with the direction to file the counter objections / reply. The file was posted for 13-06-2016 .The applicant along with his learned Counsel appeared and filed an application seeking therein an amendment of main application which form part of Court file. The respondent were not present and again were absent and did not make their appearance either in person or through any counsel or any representative ,therefore the exparte proceedings initiated against them earlier continued

and remained in force till last. Meanwhile the application of the applicant  
presented on 13-06-2016 seeking for amendment in the main original claim  
application was allowed and the petitioner/applicant was directed to lead his  
evidence in light of amended application which he did. Three witnesses  
including the petitioner applicant were examined on affidavit namely Abdul  
Rehman Sofi son of Kh. Ghulam Mohammad Sofi resident of Shari Bhat,  
Hawal, Srinagar, aged 65 years the applicant himself (2) Ghulam Mohammad  
Mistri S/o AU Mohammad Mistri, resident of Dalgate, Srinagar aged 70  
years occupation retired employee of the respondents and (3) Ghulam  
Mohammad Bhat son of Abdul Rehman Bhat resident of Pampore, Pulwama  
aged 50 years, occupation Government employee. All of the three witnesses  
in one voice had stated that the applicant was working in the respondent  
department and was their fellow worker who was engaged as a daily wager,  
on 09/1968 and had worked with dedication and zeal and zest pursuant to  
SRO-64 of 1994 whereby the daily wagers who had put on seven consecutive  
years of service were regularized as a matter of Government policy and  
petitioner/applicant was also regularized as Assistant Cushioner with other  
workers and later on he was promoted from Asstt. Cushioner to Cushioner  
but the grade of the said post was not released in his favour whileas his  
Juniors namely Ghulam Hassan Mir, Ali Mohammad Ganaie and Mohammad  
Ashraf Chesti were also promoted as Cushioner and the grade of the said  
post was released in their favour but not in favour of the applicant. The  
applicant got aggrieved with the promotion and release of higher grade to  
his colleagues and Junior to him therefore agitated this discrimination before  
the higher authorities of the respondents but with no result. The applicant  
had served the respondents department with his utmost honesty, dedication,  
zeal and zeal but was deprived of the grade attached to the post of  
Cushioner from time to time. The most unfortunate was that his Juniors  
were given the grade of the said post particularly the abovementioned  
employees at the very same moment they were promoted but the same  
consideration was not given in the petitioner's case which is discrimination  
and against the policy of the employment. The indifferent attitude of the  
respondent towards the petitioner constrained him to serve the legal  
notice to the respondent for seeking redressal of the discrimination but of no  
use and thereafter petitioner had approached to the office of Assistant  
Labour Commissioner (ALC), Pulwama and the said competent authority  
had also recommended the respondents to make necessary grade entry in  
his service book and referred the matter for the final settlement before this  
forum.

The applicant in his statement filed in the shape of affidavit had stated

In this connection the applicant/petitioner had made many

The other two witnesses, namely Ghulam Mohammed Mistri, and

The other two witnesses namely Ghulam Mohammad Mistri and Ghulam Mohammad Bhat stated that they know the applicant as they were working with him as daily wagers, in the respondents department they were also regularized vide SRO-64 of 1994 as Assistant Cushioner and were given all the benefits under rules but the grade of the post of Cushioner and senior cushioner was not released in favour of the applicant/petitioner while

as the grade of the post of the Cushioner and senior Cushioner was released  
in favour of other employee particularly in favour of Mohammad Ashraf  
Chesti. The applicant had agitated this discrimination with the respondents  
and had even filed a case against them against this unjust favoritism to  
which the applicant had suffered a lot as his retirement benefits were not  
released as per the grade of :-Cushioner and Senior cushioner.

Thus the statement of the petitioner and other two witnesses corroborated clearly established the fact that the petitioner has been discriminated by the respondents in implementing the orders passed by them where by the juniors of the petitioner had been given the grade of the higher post but the petitioner has been denied the same for the reasons better known to the respondents. The statements of both the said two witnesses are important as both of them were working with the respondents at the time when the applicant was in service as such they have first hand information knowledge regarding the discrimination which the petitioner faced at the hands of the respondents. Further the petitioner has already annexed and submitted the relevant documents in the form of his own service book and that of his Junior Mohammad Ashraf which also support the contentions of the petitioner. The evidence of the petitioner has not been rebutted by the respondents and in absence of any rebuttal the evidence of the petitioner recorded on affidavit is to be considered as sole evidence besides other relevant documents filed and produced by the petitioner before the Court/Tribunal, support the Claim petition of the applicant.

The Scrutiny and examination of the case file and all the relevant documents attached with the file reveals that the applicant was engaged and appointed as a daily wager in the year Sept., 1968 and another employee namely Mohammad Ashraf was also engaged and appointed as daily wager by the respondent department in the year 1972 i. e. four years later the engagement of the applicant and both the daily wage employees were posted in the industrial unit of Government Ply Board Industries Ltd., Pampore a substituent industrial unit of the Respondent's department ( Industries and Commerce Department). Then after putting in a period of at least 26 years of service as a daily wager by the applicant, the Government of the State formulated a policy to give protection of the service of the daily wagers and to regularize the services of the daily wagers and bring them on regular establishment and on a graded posts. The Jammu and Kashmir Daily rated workers/work charges employees (Regularization) Rules, 1994 came in existence vide SRO-64 dated 24-03-1994 whereunder the daily wagers who have seven years of continuous service were brought on regular establishment and both the applicant as well as the other mentioned employee

 Mr. Chasti were benefitted and both the said employees were brought on the regular service and on the post of Asstt. Cushioner w. e. f 01-04-1994 were regularized both continued to service in the Govt. Ply Board Industries Ltd., Pampore till another Promotion to the post of Cushioner was given to both the two employees including the applicant but unfortunately the grade attached with the post of Cushioner was not given and granted to the applicant but the same was given to the other employee namely Mr. Chesti who happened to be junior to the applicant in terms of the engagement as daily wager in the year, 1972. This conferring of the grade attached with the post of cushioner upon the Junior employee irked the applicant and he raised voice against this discrimination and pleaded his case of discrimination before his bosses and the higher authorities of the respondent but to no avail. He also had approached the concerned authority of the Labour department (Assistant Labour Commissioner, Pulwama) with his grievance but his grievance could not be solved despite the assurances of the respondents. With the result the applicant's pay scale and grade stuck to the post of Asstt Cushioner till date of his retirement while as the junior employee not only enjoyed the full pay scale and grade of the post of Cushioner but also was favoured with further promotions to the post of Senior Cushioner with full pay scale and grade under the garb of an employee of the Govt. Joinery Mill, Pampore where he was transferred from his initial place of appointment and posting i. e Government Ply Board industries under Order No. JKI/110/2005 dated 02-12-2005. Thus several discrimination not only at the level of official with the respect to the promotion but huge monetary losses even at the date of retirement on superannuation as his retirement benefits were assessed and calculated at the post of Asstt. Cushioner were faced by the applicant. This jeopordical treatment of the respondent with the applicant, this Court/Tribunal feels is unethical and injustice in case of the applicant without considering the long span of about 50 years of service rendered by the applicant in the respondents department. Further the transfer of the junior employee from one industrial unit to another industrial unit does not change the status of the employee and does not confer any superior right or claim for further promotion upon him ignoring the seniority and superior claim of the applicant. Thus the act of the respondent department in this context is not found genuine and is condemnable. Therefore this Court/Tribunal held the applicant entitled to be treated at par with the junior employee namely Mr. Chesti in terms of promotion along with the scale and grade attached to the higher post from time to time. The plea of the respondent's department that the Claim application of the applicant is governed under J&K Industries Employees Service rules and is therefore not maintainable does not hold good and is time bar. The claim application has filed within period of 2 years in terms of

S.15(2) of the payment of wages Act, 1936. Further the claim of the applicant  
has remained a continuing during in service period and even after retirement.  
The contention of the non-applicant is therefore vague and is not allowed.

Further another plea of the non-applicant with respect to non-maintainability under Industrial Dispute Act, 1947 is not relevant because any dispute or difference between Employer and Worker connected with the employment or terms of employment or conditions of labour given rise to an industrial dispute as defined in S.2(K) of the I.D. Act, 1947. The dispute in the present case is related to the employment of the applicant is therefore covered under the above mentioned industrial dispute in terms of S.2 (K) of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947. Another plea of the respondents w.r.t. time bar claim application of the applicant is well addressed in the case of State power Holding Company Ltd Raipur and Another V/s. Johri Lal Sharma and Ors. 2017 Lab.I.C 3132 ( C H M ) wherein Chitigarh Honøble High Court has held that the employee at any time, during his service can challenge his promotion and the fixation of pay as it is a Continuous Wrong which give rise to a recurring cause of action each time he is paid a salary which is not computed in accordance of the rules.

Payment of correct salary computed on the basis of proper pay fixation as per rules, is a right which subsists during the entire tenure of service and can be exercised at the time of each payment of the salary. Further the Honøble High Court has held that the doctrine of laches/limitation will apply to cases relating to seniority or promotion etc. if affects others . But in the present case only the applicant was affected with undue promotion of the junior colleague and fixation of his pay in the higher grade leaving behind the superior claim of promotion and allocation of higher grade attached to the post. Therefore the contention of the respondents in the context has no weight and is rejected . This Court/Tribunal lays its hand on a judgement of Honøble Supreme Court delivered in the case of Union of India Versus Tarsem Singh (2008) 8 S.C.C 648 where under the Honøble Supreme Court of India has held that where a service related Claim is based on a continuing wrong, relief can be granted even if there is a long delay in seeking relief. After examining and discussing all the aspects of the case in the above mentioned paras, the Court/Tribunal feels that indeed the applicant has been discriminated at all stages of promotion and grant of the grades attached with the posts and favoritism has been shown and showered upon the juniors ignoring the genuine and rightful and legal right of superiority and seniority of the applicant at the times of the granting of the promotions. This part of attitude on the part of the employer amounts to unfair labour practice as is well defined at items 7 and 9 under schedule 5th of the Industrial Dispute

Act in terms of S.2 (ra) and amounts to an offence and can be penalized according to the law. Therefore the Court held the applicant entitled to all the promotions and relaease of full grade attached with the higher posts at par with other junior colleague who were bestowed with the higher promotions and grade at the behest of their employers. The court therefore directs the respondents to re-fix the salary and wages of the applicant at par and at the same analogy the other junior employees especially Mr. Chesti has been granted and his salary fixed. Meanwhile the applicant had presented a due and drawn statement of his wages w. e. f. 01-04-1997 till his date of retirement along with all his retirement benefits which forms part of the Court file.

The Court estimates the total benefits of entitlements of the applicant to Rs. 3,32,974/- and passes the order in favour of the applicant and against the respondents with the direction to them to deposit the decreed amount of Rs. 3,32,974/- rupees three lac thirty two thousand nine hundred and seventy four only.

The respondents are accordingly directed to deposit the decreed amount of Rs. 3,32,974/- with this Court/Tribunal within one month from the date of announcement of this Judgement failing which the same decreed amount shall be recovered as per Law.

Award is accordingly passed in favour of the applicant and against the respondents. A copy of order be sent to the appropriate Government through its Commissioner/Secretary, Labour Department for information and its publication in the Govt. Gazette.

The file, after due completion, be consigned to records.

SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BYE-LAWS, 2019**

Notification

Rajouri, the 4th of September, 2019.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (9) of rule 3 read with clauses (e), (f), (zf) and (zg) of rule 15 of the Solid Waste Management Rule, 2016, the Authority hereby make the following bye-laws ; namely :ô

**CHAPTER I**

1. *Short title and commencement.*ô (1) These bye-laws shall be called the Municipal Committee, Rajouri, Solid Waste Management Bye-Laws, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the J&K Government Gazette.



- (1) **“Agency”** means Municipal Committee, Rajouri ;
- (2) **“Aerobic composting”** means a controlled process involving microbial decomposition of organic matter in the presence of oxygen ;
- (3) **“Anaerobic digestion”** means a controlled process involving microbial decomposition of organic matter in the absence of oxygen ;
- (4) **“Authorization”** means the permission given by the State Pollution Control Board, to the operator of a facility or Urban Local authority, or any other agency responsible for processing and disposal of Solid waste ;
- (5) **“Biodegradable waste”** means any organic material that can be degraded by micro-organism into simpler stable compounds ;
- (6) **“Bio-methanation”** means a process which entails enzymatic decomposition of the organic matter by microbial action to produce methane rich biogas ;
- (7) **“Brand owner”** means a person or company who sells any commodity under a registered brand label ;
- (8) **“Bulk Garden and Parks & Horticultural Waste”** means bulk waste from parks, gardens etc. including grass clippings, weeds, woody brown carbon-rich material such as branches, twigs, wood chipping, straw, dead leaves, tree trimmings, etc. which cannot be accommodated in the daily collection system for bio-degradable waste ;
- (9) **“Bulk Waste Generator”** means bulk waste generator defined under Rule 3(1)(8) of the Solid Waste Management

Rules, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as "SWM Rules") and any other waste generator including buildings occupied by the Central Government departments or undertakings, State Government departments or undertaking, Local bodies, public sector undertakings or private companies, hospitals, nursing homes, schools, colleges, universities, other educational institutions, hostels, hotels, commercial establishments, markets, places of worship, stadia and sport complexes having an average waste generation rate exceeding 100 Kg. per day ;

- (10) **"C&D waste (Construction and Demolition waste)"** means Construction and Demolition Waste (Debris) that are non-hazardous in nature generated out of building materials, debris and rubble in the jurisdiction of Municipal Committee, Rajouri.
- (11) **"Clean Area"** means the public place in front of and all around or adjacent to any premises extending to the kerb side and including the drain, foot path and kerb cleaned and so maintained in accordance with these bye-laws ;
- (12) **"Cleanliness Fee"** means an amount of fees collected by the managers/Organizers for cleaning the site by the Agency ;
- (13) **"Collection"** means lifting and removal of solid waste from source of waste generation, collection points or any other location ;
- (14) **"Collection Counter"** means where the user charges shall be remitted which will be available at all Zonal Officers and headquarters.
- (15) **"Combustible waste"** means non-biodegradable, non-recyclable, non-reusable, non-hazardous solid waste having minimum calorific value exceeding 1500 kcal/kg and excluding chlorinated materials like plastic, wood pulp, etc.;
- (16) **"Community waste storage bin"** means any storage facility setup and maintained by the Municipal Committee,



medicines, broken mercury thermometers, used batteries, used needles and syringes and contaminated gauge, etc., generated at the household level ;

- (24) **“Door to door collection”** means collection of solid waste from the door step of households, shops, commercial establishments, offices, institutional or any other non-residential premises and includes collection of such waste from entry gate or a designated location on the ground floor in a housing society, multistoried building or apartments, large residential, commercial or institutional complex or premises ;
- (25) **“Dry waste”** means waste other than bio-degradable waste and inert street sweepings and includes recyclable and non recyclable waste, combustible waste and sanitary napkin and diapers, etc. ;
- (26) **“Dump sites”** means a land utilized by local body for disposal of solid waste without following the principles of sanitary land filling ;
- (27) **“Event”** means any gatherings for the purpose of functions, celebrations, meetings, rallies, processions, open air theatre activities, cinema shootings in public places.
- (28) **“Extended producer responsibility”** (EPR) means responsibility of any producer of packaging products such as plastic, tin, glass, wrappers and corrugated boxes, etc., for environmentally sound management, till end-of-life of the packaging products ;
- (29) **“E-waste”** shall have the same meaning as defined under Rule 3(l) (r) of the E-Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.
- (30) **“Facility”** means any establishment wherein the solid waste management processes namely segregation, recovery, storage, collection, recycling, processing, treatment or safe disposal are carried out ;
- (31) **“Familiarization/warning period”** means that specific period, during which there is a relaxation in the fines for contravention of these bye-laws ;



- (38) **“Incineration”** means an engineered process involving burning or combustion of solid waste to thermally degraded waste materials at high temperatures ;
- (39) **“Inerts”** means wastes which are not bio-degradable, recyclable or combustible street sweeping or dust and silt removed from the surface drains ;
- (40) **“Informal waste collector”** includes individuals, associations or waste traders who are involved in sorting, sale and purchase of recyclable materials ;
- (41) **“Leachate”** means the liquid that seeps through solid waste or other medium and has extracts of dissolved or suspended material from it ;
- (42) **“Litter”** means all refuse and includes any other waste material which, if thrown or deposited as prohibited under these Bye-Laws, tends to create uncleanness or a danger or nuisance to public health, safety or welfare ;
- (43) **“Littering”** means putting litter in such a location that it falls, descends, blows, is washed, percolates or otherwise escapes or is likely to fall, descend blow, be washed, percolate or otherwise escape into or onto any public place, or causing, permitting or allowing litter to fall, descend, blow, washed, percolate or otherwise escape into or onto any public place ;
- (44) **“Local body”** for the purpose of these bye-laws means JMC/SMC and other Local Bodies including, Municipal Councils, Municipal Committees, Town Area Committees, in the State ;
- (45) **“Materials Recovery facility”** (MRF) means a facility where non-compostable solid waste can be temporarily stored by the local body or any other entity or any person or agency authorised by any of them to facilitate segregation, sorting and recovery of recyclables from various components of waste by authorised informal sector of waste pickers, informal recyclers or any other work force engaged by the

local body or entity for the purpose before the waste is delivered or taken up for its processing or disposal ;

- (46) **“Neighbourhood”** means a clearly defined locality, with reference to its physical layout, character or inhabitants ;
- (47) **“New construction”** means all buildings under construction within the limits of the Municipal Committee, Rajouri ;
- (48) **“Non-biodegradable waste”** means any waste that cannot be degraded by microorganisms into simpler stable compounds ;
- (49) **“Nuisance”** includes any act, omission, place or thing which comes or is likely to cause injury, danger, annoyance or offence to the sense of sight, smelling or hearing or which is or may be dangerous to life or injurious to health or property ;
- (50) **“Nuisance Detectors”** (NOs) means those employees of the Municipal Committee, Rajouri who are appointed to detect the acts of Public nuisance, etc. ;
- (51) **“Occupier/occupant”** includes any person who for the time being is in occupation of, or otherwise using, any land or building or part thereof, for any purpose whatsoever ;
- (52) **“Operator of a facility”** means a person or entity, who owns or operates a facility for handling solid waste which includes the Municipal Committee, Rajouri and any other entity or agency appointed by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri ;
- (53) **“Owner”** means any person who exercises the rights of an owner of any building, or land or part thereof ;
- (54) **“Pelletisation”** means a process whereby pellets are prepared which are small cubes or cylindrical pieces made out of solid waste and includes, fuel pellets which are also referred as refuse derived fuel ;

- (55) **“Primary collection”** means collecting, lifting and removal of segregated solid waste from source of its generation including households, shops, offices and any other non-residential premises or from any collection points or any other location specified by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri.
- (56) **“Processing”** means any scientific process by which segregated solid waste is handled for the purpose of reuse, recycling or transformation into new products ;
- (57) **“Public place”** includes any road, arch road, viaduct, lane, footway, alley or passage, highway, causeway, bridge, square alley or passage whether a thoroughfare or not over which the public have a right of passage, and such places to which the public has access such as parks, gardens, recreation grounds, playgrounds, beaches, water bodies, water courses, public plazas and promenades, government and municipal buildings, public hospitals, markets, slaughter houses, courts, etc. ;
- (58) **“Prescribed”** means prescribed by SWM Rules and/or these bye-laws ;
- (59) **“Receptacle”** means any storage container, including bins and bags, used for the storage of any category of MSW ;
- (60) **“Recycling”** means the process of transforming segregated non-biodegradable solid waste into new material or product or as raw material for producing new products which may or may not be similar to the original products ;
- (61) **“Recyclable Waste”** means the waste that is commonly found in the MSW. It is also called as "Dry Waste". These include many kinds of glass, paper, metal, plastic, textiles, electronics goods, etc.
- (62) **“Redevelopment”** means rebuilding of old residential or commercial buildings at the same site, where the existing buildings and other infrastructures have become dilapidated ;

- (71) **“Sanitary worker”** means a person employed by the municipal corporation for collecting or removing MSW or cleansing the drains in the municipal/corporation areas ;
- (72) **“Schedule”** means the Schedule appended to these rules ;
- (73) **“Storage”** means the temporary containment of solid waste in a manner so as to prevent littering, attraction to vectors, stray animals and excessive foul odour ;
- (74) **“Secondary storage”** means the temporary containment of solid waste after collection at secondary waste storage depots or MRFs or bins for onward transportation of the waste to the processing or disposal facility ;
- (75) **“Segregation”** means sorting and separate storage of various components of solid waste namely biodegradable wastes including agriculture and dairy waste, non biodegradable wastes including recyclable waste, non-recyclable combustible waste, sanitary waste and non recyclable inert waste, domestic hazardous wastes, and construction and demolition wastes ;
- (76) **“Service provider”** means an authority providing public utility services like water, sewerage, electricity, telephone, roads, drainage, etc. ;
- (77) **“Solid waste”** means and includes solid or semi-solid domestic waste, sanitary waste, commercial waste, institutional waste, catering and market waste and other non-residential wastes, street sweepings, silt removed or collected from the surface drains, horticulture waste, agriculture and dairy waste, treated bio-medical waste, Hazardous waste excluding industrial waste, bio-medical waste and e-waste, battery waste, radio-active waste generated in the area under the local authorities and other entities ;
- (78) **“Sorting”** means separating various components and categories of recyclables such as paper, plastic, cardboards, metal, glass, etc., from mixed waste as may be appropriate to facilitate recycling ;



- (86) **“Transfer station”** means a facility created to receive solid waste from collection areas and transport in bulk in covered vehicles or containers to waste processing and, or, disposal facilities ;
- (87) **“Treatment”** means the method, technique or process designed to modify physical, chemical or biological characteristics or composition of any waste so as to reduce its volume and potential to cause harm ;
- (88) **“User fee/Charges”** means fees or charges imposed by Municipal Committee, Rajouri through general or special order of the Competent Authority from time-to-time, on the waste generator to cover full or part cost of providing solid waste collection, transportation, processing and disposal services ;
- (89) **“Vacant Plot”** means any Land or open space belonging to a private party/person that is not occupied by them/him ;
- (90) **“Vermi composting”** means the process of conversion of bio-degradable waste into compost using earth worms ;
- (91) **“Waste hierarchy”** means the priority order in which the solid waste is to be managed by giving emphasis to prevention, reduction reuse, recycling, recovery and disposal, with prevention being the most preferred option and the disposal at the landfill being the least ;
- (92) **“Waste generator”** means and includes every person or group of persons, every residential premises and non-residential establishments including Indian Railways, defence establishments, which generate solid waste or other institutions i. e. Hotels, restaurants, malls, private/government business/ industrial establishments falling within the limits of Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(4) All resident welfare and market associations shall ensure segregation of waste at source by the generators, facilitate collection of segregated waste in separate streams, handover recyclable material to either the authorised waste pickers or the authorised recyclers. The bio-degradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed of through composting or bio-methanation within the premises as far as possible. The residual waste shall be given to the waste collectors or agency as directed by Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(5) All gated communities and institutions with more than 5,000 sq. m. area shall ensure segregation of waste at source by the generators, facilitate collection of segregated waste in separate streams, handover recyclable material to either the authorised waste pickers or the authorised recyclers. The bio-degradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed off through composting or bio- methanation within the premises as far as possible. The residual waste shall be given to the waste collectors or agency as directed by Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(6) All hotels and restaurants shall ensure segregation of waste at source, facilitate collection of segregated waste in separate streams, handover recyclable material to either the authorised waste pickers or the authorised recyclers. The bio-degradable waste shall be processed, treated and disposed of through composting or bio-methanation within the premises as far as possible. The residual waste shall be given to the waste collectors or agency as directed by Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(7) No person shall organize an event or gathering of more than one hundred persons at any unlicensed place without intimating Municipal Committee, Rajouri along with payment of user fee as prescribed in the schedule, at least three working days in advance and the person or the organizer of such event shall ensure segregation of waste at source and handing over of segregated waste to waste collector or agency as specified by Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(8) Used sanitary waste are to be securely wrapped as and when generated in the pouches provided by the manufacturers or brand owners of these products or in a news paper or suitable biodegradable wrapping material and place the same in the bin meant for non-biodegradable waste or dry waste.







(7) Manual handling of waste in the containers shall be prohibited. If unavoidable due to constraints, manual handling shall be carried out under proper protection with due care for safety of workers.

(9) Changing needs and advances in technology shall be taken into consideration for selection of collection equipment and vehicles. Auto-Tippers or vehicles of specific capacity with hydraulically operated hopper covering mechanism from top having two compartments for carrying biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste separately with a hooter shall be deployed for collection of waste.

(11) Route plans for each primary collection and transportation vehicle shall be provided by Municipal Committee, Rajouri or by the notified authorised waste collector. These plans in tabular as well as GIS map form, duly approved by Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall mention starting point, start time, waiting points, waiting time on route, end point and end time of the specified route. Municipal Committee, Rajouri or the notified authorised waste collector shall provide a Board at each street to display time-table of primary collection and transportation vehicles to allow residents avail the facility at prescribed time. Such information shall also be uploaded on the website of Municipal Committee, Rajouri and published in the local leading newspaper periodically for the information of General Public.

(12) In narrow streets that cannot be serviced by auto tipper or the vehicle, a 3-Wheeler or smaller motorized vehicle with hydraulically operated hopper covering mechanism from top having two compartments for carrying wet and dry waste separately with a hooter, compatible with mobile transfer station shall be deployed.



(3) Different containers shall be used in the areas demarcated by Municipal Committee, Rajouri to keep segregated waste in the following manner :ô

- (a) green- for biodegradable waste ;
- (b) blue - for non-biodegradable ;
- (c) black - for domestic hazardous waste ;

Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall separately notify, from time to time, mandatory colour coding and other specifications of receptacles prescribed for storage and delivery of different types of solid waste to enable safe and easy collection without any mixing or spillage of waste, which generators of different types of solid waste shall have to adhere to.

(4) Municipal Committee, Rajouri on its own or through outsourcing agencies shall maintain the storage facilities for solid waste in a manner that does not create unhygienic and unsanitary conditions around it.

(5) Containers of various sizes in the secondary storage depots shall be provided by Municipal Committee, Rajouri or any assigned agencies in different colours as mentioned in these bye-laws.

(6) Storage facilities shall be created and established by taking into account quantities of waste generation in a given area and the density of population.

(7) Storage facilities shall be user friendly and shall be so designed that it ensures compaction of waste and that the waste stored is not exposed to open atmosphere.

(8) All the housing cooperative societies, associations, residential and commercial establishments and gated communities etc. shall have the responsibility to put coloured bins as prescribed by these bye-laws and to keep adequate number of containers in appropriate places in their own complexes, so that the daily waste generated there can be properly deposited.

(9) The collection vehicles engaged for the purpose shall deposit/ transfer waste only at the MTS (Mobile Transfer Station) or FCTS (Fixed compactor Transfer Stations) wherever provided.

(10) In case MTS/FCTS is not stationed at the designated location at that point of time for any reason, then the 'loaded vehicle' shall go to the next designated location of the MTS or FCTS or the site specified by Municipal Committee, Rajouri to unload the waste.

(11) Fixed compactor transfer station shall be transported through hook loader.

(12) MTS or FCTS shall transport the waste directly to compost plant, waste to energy plant or any other site/plant designated by Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(13) There should be no inter-mixing of waste from various sources during the transportation of waste.

(14) The services of street level collection and transportation of waste shall be provided every day including holidays.

(15) MTS engaged in this service shall receive waste only from designated auto tippers, 3-wheelers or vehicle/bins collecting waste from street level operations.

(16) Dedicated MTS shall be deployed at specified locations to receive waste from the Auto Tippers, 3-Wheelers, Rickshaws etc. engaged in street-level and door-to-door collection of solid waste from households and commercial establishments as per the approved route plans.

(17) Design of MTS and FCTS shall allow unloading of waste from primary collection vehicles by consuming minimum time and without littering waste.

(18) Garbage spilled near MTS and FCTS, while transferring the solid waste, should be cleaned so that no spillage is left. Disinfectant should be used after cleaning process at that location.

(19) Municipal Committee, Rajouri or its specified agency shall install CCTV cameras at all secondary storage facilities.

## PROCESSING OF SOLID WASTE

- (a) to minimise transportation cost and environmental impacts, preference shall be given to decentralised processing such as bio-methanation, microbial composting, vermi-composting, anaerobic digestion or any other appropriate processing for bio-stabilisation of biodegradable waste ;
- (b) through medium/large composting bio-methanation plants at centralised locations ;
- (c) through waste to energy processes by refuse derived fuel for combustible fraction of waste or supply as feed stock to solid waste based power plants ; and/or
- (d) through construction and demolition waste management plants.

(3) In waste to energy plant by direct incineration, absolute segregation shall be mandatory and be part of the terms and conditions of the relevant contracts.





(6) There shall also be a system of yearly or half yearly payment. If the user fee is paid in advance for the entire year, then amount for ten months will be charged instead of twelve months. Similarly, for six months advance payment, five and half months demand amount will be charged instead of six months.

(7) The user fee mentioned in Schedule-I shall stand automatically increased by 5% after every 3 years with effect from 1st January of the year.

(8) The user fee shall be collected only by the institution/person authorised by the competent authority by a general or special order in this behalf.

(9) In case of default of payment of user fee/fine, the competent authority may recover the same from the defaulter as an arrear of land revenue as per the provision of Land Revenue Act, 1996. However, Municipal Corporation, Jammu/Srinagar shall be allowed to effect the recovery under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000.

12. *Fine/Penalty for contravention of SWM Rules.* (1) Whosoever contravenes or fails to comply with any of the provisions of SWM Rules or these bye-laws shall be imposed with fine as mentioned in Schedule-II appended to these bye-laws.

(2) In case of repeated contravention or non-compliance as mentioned in clause (a) above, fine amount for every such default shall be levied per day or month, as the case may be.

(3) The Commissioners shall designate officers for levying fine or penalty by a general or special order in this behalf. The fine/penalty amount is specified in Schedule-II.

(4) The fine or penalty mentioned in Schedule-II shall stand automatically increased by 5% after every 3 years with effect from 1st January of the year.

(5) The fine shall be levied and collected on the spot by the designated officers. In case of non-payment of fine at the spot, the procedure for prosecution prescribed under provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 shall follow.

(6) In realization of fines imposed on defaulters, the J&K State Pollution Control Board shall not renew the licenses of hotels and other

business units unless an NOC is not procured by the business unit/s from  
the concerned Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(7) Fine shall be imposed on the hospitals and allied concerns if they are found mixing bio-medical wastes with municipal solid waste.

(h) Charges for the material recovery by rag pickers or waste dealers to be decided by the concerned Local Bodies.

(8) Concession to bulk purchasers of compost/plastic/tin and recyclables on the price of by product, if any, as a result of processing of Solid Waste shall be decided by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri.

(j) The cement manufacturing units shall be responsible to lift the RDF from municipal dumping sites and their license renewals be linked with Municipal Committee, Rajouri NOCs.

(9) Tippers ferrying building material and causing avoidable waste on the streets shall be liable for fine to be decided by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri but not less than Rupees Five Hundred (500/-) per default.

13. *Responsibilities of Waste Generators.* (1) Prohibition of littering

- (a) Littering in any public place : No person shall litter in any public place except in authorised public or private litter receptacles. No person shall repair vehicles, wash/clean utensils or any other object or keep any type of storage in any public place except in such public facilities or conveniences specifically provided for any of these purposes.
- (b) Littering on any property : No person shall litter on any open or vacant property except in authorised private or public receptacles.
- (c) Litter-throwing from vehicles : No person, whether a driver or passenger in a vehicle, shall litter upon any street, road, sidewalk, playground, garden, traffic island or other public place. No vehicle shall be washed on roads, river banks, near public parks, water bodies.

(d) Litter from goods vehicles : No person shall drive or move any truck or other goods vehicle unless such vehicle is so constructed and loaded as to prevent any load, contents or litter from being blown off or deposited upon any road, sidewalks, traffic island, playground, garden or other public place.

(e) Litter by owned/pet animals : It shall be the responsibility of the owner of any pet animal including dog, cat etc. to promptly scoop/clean up any litter created by such pet on the street or any public place and take adequate steps for the proper disposal of such waste preferably by their own sewage system.

(f) Disposal of waste in drain etc. No person shall litter in any drain/river/open pond/water bodies.

(2) Burning of waste : Disposal by burning of any type of solid waste at public places or at any private or public property is strictly prohibited.

(3) "Clean Area" : Every person shall endeavour that any public place in front of or adjacent to any premises owned or occupied by him including the footpath and open drain/gutter and kerb is free of any waste, either in solid or liquid form.

(4) For Public Gatherings and Events organised in public places for any reason (including for processions, exhibitions, circuses, fairs, political rallies, commercial, religious, socio-cultural events, protests and demonstrations, etc.) where the permission from the Police Department and/or from the Municipal Committee, Rajouri is required, it will be the responsibility of the organiser of the event or gathering to ensure the cleanliness of that area as well as all appurtenant areas.

(5) Refundable Cleanliness Deposit, as may be notified by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri, will be taken from the organiser, by the concerned zonal office for the duration of the event. This deposit will be refunded on the completion of the event after it is noted that the said public place has been restored back to a clean state, and any waste generated as a result of the event has been collected and transported to designated sites. This deposit will be only for the cleanliness of the public

place and does not cover any damage to property. In case the organisers of the event wish to avail of the services of the Municipal Committee, Rajouri for the cleaning, collection and transport of waste generated as a result of that event, they must apply to the Chief Executive Officer/ Executive Officer, Municipal Committee, Rajouri for availing the services and pay the necessary charges as may be fixed by the Competent Authority for this purpose.

(6) Dumping of solid waste on vacant plot and depositing construction and demolition waste at non-designated locations shall be dealt with by the Municipal Committee, Rajouri in the following manner :

- (a) The Municipal Committee, Rajouri may serve a notice on the owner/occupier of any premises, requiring such owner/occupier to clear any waste on such premises in a manner and within a time specified in such notice.
- (b) If the person on whom the notice has been served fails to comply with the requirements imposed by the notice, such person shall be liable to pay penalties as prescribed from time to time.
- (c) If the person on whom the notice is served fails to comply with any requirements imposed by such notice, the Municipal Committee, Rajouri may
  - (i) Enter on the premises and clear the waste ; and
  - (ii) Recover from the occupier the expenditure incurred in having done so.

(7) Duty of manufacturers or brand owners of disposable products and sanitary napkins and diapers

- (a) All manufacturers/sole distributors/whole sellers of disposal products such as tin, glass, plastics packaging, wrappers etc., or brand owners who introduce such products in the market within the jurisdiction of Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall provide necessary financial assistance to Municipal Committee, Rajouri for establishment of waste management system. Municipal Committee, Rajouri may also coordinate

with the concerned departments of Central Govt. and/or the Govt. of J&K for implementation of this provision.

**0.5% of Annual turnover shall be chargeable from them for establishment/maintenance of solid waste management facilities to be deposited with the concerned corporation/local body.**

- (b) All such brand owners who sell or market their products in such packaging material which are non-biodegradable shall put in place a system to collect back the packaging waste generated due to their production.
- (c) Manufacturers or brand owners or marketing companies of sanitary napkins and diapers shall explore the possibility of using all recyclable materials in their products or they shall provide a pouch or wrapper for disposal of each napkin or diapers along with the packet of their sanitary products.
- (d) All such manufacturers, brand owners or marketing companies shall educate the masses for wrapping and disposal of their products.

(8) All industrial units using fuel and located within one hundred Km. from a solid waste based refuse derived fuel plant shall make arrangements to replace at least five percent of their fuel requirement by refused derived fuel so produced.

#### 14. *Responsibilities of* Municipal Committee, Rajouri.ô

(1) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall within its territorial area, be responsible for ensuring regular system of surface cleaning of all common streets/ roads, public places, temporary settlements, slum areas, markets, its own parks, gardens, drains etc. by employing human resources and machines and shall be bound to collect the garbage from the declared storage containers, and transport it every day to the final disposal point in closed vehicles for which Municipal Committee, Rajouri may engage private parties on contract or Public Private Partnership mechanism with the prior approval of Govt., apart from its own cleaning staff and vehicles. In addition, Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall identify all the commercial areas for carrying out sweeping twice a day.

(9) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall ensure that the authorities of Agriculture Department, Floriculture Department, Horticulture, SKAUST are supplied with sufficient quantity of compost generated out of organic waste to phase out the use of chemical fertilizers and use compost in all parks, gardens maintained by them and wherever possible in other places under its jurisdiction. Incentives may be provided to recycling initiatives by informal waste recycling sector and shall take up with the Directorate of Horticulture, Agriculture and Floriculture for use of compost.

(10) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall make efforts to streamline and formalize solid waste management systems and endeavour that the informal sector workers in waste management (waste pickers) are given priority to upgrade their work conditions and are enumerated and integrated into the formal system of solid waste management.

(11) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall ensure that the operator of a facility provides personal protection equipment including uniform, fluorescent jacket, hand gloves, raincoats, appropriate foot wear and masks to all workers handling solid waste and the same are used by the workforce.

(12) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall ensure occupational safety of its own staff and staff of outsourced agency involved in collection transport and handling of waste by providing appropriate and adequate personal protective equipments.

(13) In case of an accident at any solid waste processing or treatment or disposal facility or landfill site, the officer-in-charge of the facility shall report to Municipal Committee, Rajouri immediately which shall review and issue instructions, if any, to the in-charge of the facility.

(14) Regular checks : Chief Executive Officer/Executive Officer/ Assistant Sanitation Officer, Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall conduct regular checks in various parts of the wards and other places of collection, transportation, processing and disposal of solid waste to supervise compliance of various provisions of SWM Rules and these bye-laws.

(15) Municipal Committee, Rajouri shall develop a public grievance redressal system (PGRS) by setting up of call centre at its headquarter. The PGRS may include SMS based service mobile application or web based services.
