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Officer Commanding 58RCC GREF vide No. 2004/RSPR/F-71/67/E2 LA dated 08-10-2009 has placed an indent before the District Collector, Reasi for land measuring 02K601M605S bearing Khasra No. 45 situated in Village Kalakote, Tehsil Pouni, which is required

for public purpose viz. õWidening of Reasi-Pouni-Siar-Rajouri road betweeen Km 51.705 to 54.450 at Village Kalakoteö, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi.

Accordingly, a notification under section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act, Svt. 1990 was issued by this Collectorate vide No. COL/LA/ADC/Rsi/19-20/34-41/NSQ dated 11-9-2019 and was served upon the land owners/interested persons who were asked to file objections, if any, within 15 days from the date of issuance of said notification. In response to said notification, no objection was received by this Collectorate. The case was submitted to the District Collector, Reasi vide No. COL/LA/ADC/RSI/19-20/145-48/NSQ dated 04-10-2019 with the request that the matter may be referred to the Government for issuance of declaration under sections 6 & 7 of the Act.

Thereafter, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu was requested vide Deputy Commissioner (District Collector), Reasi No. DC/Rsi/19-20/1228-32/SQ dated 12-10-2019 for obtaining the declaration under Sections 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act from the competent authority. Thereafter, the Commissioner/Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, J&K issued notification under section 6 vide Notification No. 269-Rev(LAJ) of 2019 dated 25-10-2019 under endorsement number Rev/LAJ/249/2019 dated 25-10-2019 that the land is required for public purpose viz. õWidening of Reasi-Pouni-Siar-Rajouri road between Km 51.705 to 54.450 at Village Kalakoteö, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi and directed this Collectorate under section 7 of the said Act to take order for acquisition of land.

Thereafter, a notification under sections 9 & 9A of Land Acquisition Act was issued vide this Collectorate No. COL/LA/ADC/RSI/19-20/280-86/NSQ dated 14-03-2020 and was served upon the land owners/interested persons and Indenting Department asking them to file objections, if any, regarding measurement, title and quantum of compensation within stipulated period. In response to said notification, no objection has been received. The payment of compensation will be made to the land owners/interested persons as per rules and provisions in vogue.

Principle of Compensation

The land is located in Village Kalakote, Tehsil Pouni and is being acquired for public purpose õWidening of Reasi-Pouni-Siar-Rajouri road between Km 51.705 to 54.450 at Village Kalakoteö, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi.

Field staff has reported that no sale/purchase of land has taken place in the said village during the last three years but the Tehsildar concerned has recommended a rate of Rs. 1.00 Lacs per local Kanal for unirrigated land situated on the main axis of the existing road in the Villageô

- I. As per Stamp Duty rates for the year 2019, the rates of land in the Village Kalakote have been fixed by competent authority which are Rs. 1.15 Lakh for irrigated, Rs. 0.81 Lakh for unirrigated per local Kanal and Rs. 1.38 Lakh for small piece of land.
- II. The kind of soil involved in the instant acquisition is W-I (Agricultural land with good fertility).
- III. The land being acquired is located immediate adjacent to the existing road and bears a commercial potential.

Keeping in view all the factors to be considered for determination of rates of land compensation, this Collectorate proposed a rate of Rs. 1.50 Lakh per local Kanal for cultivable land (W-I) and Rs. 1.40 Lakh per local Kanal for uncultivable land (GM) involved in the instant acquisition and submitted a draft award vide No. COL/ADC/Rsi/20-21/ 02-03 dated 03-07-2020 to the District Collector for determination of rates of land compensation in the Collectors meeting. the case was put up in the Collectors meeting held on 06-07-2020 and after threadbare discussion a uniform rate of Rs. 1.50 Lacs per local Kanal irrespective of kind of classification of soil has been determined in the said Collectors meeting, minutes of which are communicated to this Collectorate vide No. DC/Rsi/20-21/332-40/SQ dated 15-07-2020. On the basis of rate of land compensation determined in the Collectors meeting, Collectorate vide No. COL/ADC/Rsi/20-21/191-92 dated 22-02-2021 prepared the revised draft award and submitted the same to the District Collector, Reasi for the approval of rates of land compensation and sanction of awarded amount. The District Collector, Reasi vide No. DC/ Rsi/20-21/2074-77/SQ dated 24-02-2021 accorded the approval of rates

of land compensation and sanction of awarded amount in the light of provisions of SRO-132 of 2019 dated 25-2-2019 issued by the Revenue Department, J&K Govt. No structure/trees has been reported to be involved in the instant acquisition.

On placement of indent by the Inspector General STC, BSF, Udhampur vide his office No. 4086/Engg/STC/Land Acq/17/17136-39 dated 29-09-2017, the proceedings were initiated for acquisition of land measuring 19 Marlas situated in Village Roun, Tehsil and District Udhampur for public purpose viz. approach path to dug well near STC, BSF under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir State Land Acquisition Act, 1990 Svt.

õNo Objectionö to the acquisition of land measuring 19 Marlas bearing Khasra No. 586 min situated in Village Roun, Tehsil and District Udhampur for approach path to dug well on the bank of river Tawi near STC, BSF, Dhar Road conveyed by the Home Department, Government of Jammu and Kashmir vide No. Home/Land-Acq/65/2018-II dated 17-10-2018 and the same endorsed by the Divisional Commissioner Office, Jammu under endorsement No. 502/3138/Acq/NOC/STC-BSF/Roun/Udh/18/3380 dated 08-11-2018. The land under acquisition is the State Land.

Accordingly, notification under section 4(1) of J&K State Acquisition Act, 1990 Svt. was issued vide this Collectorate No. SCDU/LA/BSF/1497-1506 dated 10-01-2019, wherein objections were invited from the land owners regarding acquisition of land. Copies of the said notices were served upon to the land owner through Tehsildar, Udhampur as well as by publication in the local leading newspaper and Government Gazette. No objection was received in the prescribed time period. The specification of the land under acquisition is given below :ô

Thereafter, District Collector, Udhampur was requested vide this Collectorate No. SCDU/LA/BSF/1561-62 dated 11-02-2019 for taking up the matter with the competent authority for according declaration under sections 6 & 7 of the land Acquisition Act. The District Collector,

Udhampur has taken up the matter of according declaration under sections 6 & 7 in light of SRO-25 dated 28-01-2016 with the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide his letter No. DCU/SQ/LA/BSF/4407-10 dated 13-02-2019 and same submitted to the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K Government under endorsement No. 502/3138/Acq/Aprh/ Path/Roun/Udhampur/19/5391-93 dated 28-03-2019. Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K Government, the case was returned to the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu with the observations that the revenue papers appended with the case are was received in this office from the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu under endorsement No. 502/ 3138/Acq/Aprch/Path/Roun/Udh/19/249 dated 24-04-2019. The case was re-submitted to the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu through District Collector, Udhampur vide this office letter No. SCDU/LA/BSF/110-11 dated 11-05-2019 and the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu was same submitted to the Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K Government, Srinagar vide his office letter No. 502/3138/Acq/Aprch/Path/Roun/Udh/ 19/863-64 dated 02-07-2019 and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K Government, Srinagar was endorsed the case to the Commissioner/ Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, J&K, Srinagar vide his office letter No. FC-LS/LA-4862/2019 dated 19-07-2019. The Government of Jammu and Kashmir, Revenue Department, Civil Secretariat vide Notification No. 112-Rev(LAJ) of 2019 dated 19-09-2019 has issued notification under sections 6 & 7 of J&K State Land Acquisition Act in the instant case and has directed to Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of land involved in the case and apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award.

Consequent upon this notification under sections 9 & 9A of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, 1934 AD was issued vide this Collectorate No. SCDU/LA/BSF/576-84 dated 25-10-2019 and the copies of the same were served upon the land owner (Revenue Department) as well as Indenting Department to state their interests in the land, amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests and their objections, if any, to measurement of land within the period of fifteen days. Neither the Indenting Department not the land owners/interested persons have filed any objection within the stipulated period.

Principle of compensation:

The sildar, Udhampur vide his No. TUDR/OQ/2017-18/1672 dated 06-09-2017 at the time of preparation of Revenue Documents has intimated the three years average sale deed rate as Rs. 3,62,281/- per kanal. Stamp duty rates for the calendar year 2019 have been notified

for Village Roun Rs. 4.10 Lakhs for irrigated land, Rs. 3.35 Lakhs for unirrigated/uncultivable land and Rs. 6.45 Lakhs for small pieces of land (below one Kanal) per Kanal. Due to the increase in developmental activities, the value of land has increased. Undersigned visited the spot found that subject land is using for approach path from STC, BSF to dug well nearby river Tawi. In view of this, I propose the rate of Rs. 3.35 Lakhs per Kanal in the instant case as per the rate of land for unirrigated/uncultivable in Stamp Duty rates of the Village for the year 2019 notified by the District Collector. This rate will be effective only for the Khasra No. indicated in the notification under sections 9 & 9A issued by this Collectorate. Keeping in view the above factors into consideration the rate of Rs. 3.35 Lakhs for Gair Mumkin was proposed which was considered the genuine rate in the opinion of the undersigned.

Instant case was deferred in the Collectors meeting held on 13-07-2020 and District Collector has directed to seek justification from Indenting Department regarding purpose of acquisition. There is apprehension that this acquisition may hamper the easement rights of locals regarding hassles free movement to the water body i. e. river Tawi. Indenting Department has reported vide letter No. Engg/STC/Land Acq/2020/6460 dated 17-08-2020 that planning to construct path on the land under acquisition without boundary wall/fencing. Hence, question does not arise of hampering any civilians free movement and easement rights in response to this office letter No. SCDU/LA/96-97 dated 08-08-2020.

Instant case once again has placed in the meeting of Collectors under the Chairmanship of District Collector was held on 18-12-2020 in the office chamber of the District Collector, Udhampur. The case was discussed threadbare and the committee of the Collectors under the Chairmanship of District Collector, Udhampur came to the conclusion that rate of Rs. 3.35 Lakhs per Kanal has been justified as the land under acquisition. Hence, a rate @ Rs. 3.35 lakhs per Kanal irrespective of kind of soil in the instant case was approved and minutes of Collectors meeting issued by the District Collector, Udhampur conveyed to this office under endorsement No. LA/DCU/2020-21/818-37 dated 18-12-2020.

The total amount involved in the instant acquisition came to Rs. 3,67,579/- (Rupees Three Lakh Sixty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Nine only) including 15% Jabrana. The amount involved falls within pecuniary jurisdiction of the Deputy Commissioner, Udhampur. A request was submitted to the undersigned vide No. SCDU/LA/264-65 dated 21-12-2020 to get the sanction and approval of awarded amount from the competent authority so that the Final Award is issued.

In response to the request sent by the undersigned, the District Collector (Deputy Commissioner), Udhampur accorded the approval of awarded amount in the instant acquisition vide his letter No. LA/DCU/ 2020-21/913-14 dated 07-01-2021 as per SRO-132 dated 25-02-2019 by Revenue Department, J&K Government.

Whereas, during investigation it was revealed that the accused Nazir Ahmad Wani and his son Arif Nazir Wani have been harbouring the terrorists in the hideout erected by them in their shop and after the attacks by these terrorists on the security forces, these terrorist were hiding in the said hideout; and
- 10. Whereas, the terrorist namely Faugi Bhai R/o Pakistan, (2) Owais Ahmad R/o Shopian, (3) Zahid Nazir Bhat R/o Drubgam and (4) Rouf Ahmad R/o Samboora were eliminated during an encounters; and

- 11. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has *prima facie* established involvement of below mentioned accused persons for commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

Whereas, one vehicle (Ford Figo) bearing registration No. JK05D-5835 was also intercepted by the said naka party and during checking of the vehicle, Police arrested four persons (1) Mohd Issaq Bhat S/o Bashir Ahmad R/o Narvaw, Shopian, (2) Shabir Ahmad Ganie S/o Mohd Maqbool R/o Sheikh Pora, Wathoora, (3) Sageer Ahmad Paswal S/o Nazir Ahmad Paswal R/o Amroohi, Karnah and (4) Arshid Ahmad Thoker S/o Mohd Rafiq R/o Kariwah, Manloo, Shopian and recovered 01 Pistol with Magazine and 04 Rounds, Heroin like substance 01 Kg., Indian Currency 1.5 lacs from the possession of terrorist Sageer Ahmad Paswal; and
- 4. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 82/2020, under sections 17, 18, 19, 20, 23 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, came to be registered in Police Station, Chadoora and investigation was set into motion; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation the site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared, statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

Razak Mugal S/o Mushtaq Mugal R/o Prada on the directions of accused Mushtaq Ahmad Ganie and handed over the consignment to accused Danish Ahmad Sheikh; and
