Whereas, the land, specifications whereof are given in Annexure-"A" to this notification is required for construction of composite bandh/border fencing (135 ft wide strip) by BSF situated in Village Dhankot, Tehsil Marh, District Jammu;

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Inspector General, Hq. Jammu Frontier BSF, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM) Marh, vide letter No. SDM/M/

Whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Marh, vide letter No. SDM/M/2019-20/Land Acq/135ft/Dhankote/121 dated 19-06-2019 has reported that the notification issued under section 4 (1) of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act by him was served upon the interested persons for filing objections, if any, to the proposed acquisition, but no objection was received from the land owners/interested persons within the prescribed period as required under sections 5&5-A of the Land Acquisition Act;

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Marh vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Jammu vide No. DCJ/LA/BF-135ft/Dhankote/2019-2015/89-90 dated 02-12-2019, duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/2397/Acq/Bdr-fencing/135ft/Dhankote/J/19/4109 dated 27-12-2019 and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K, Jammu vide No. FC-LS/LA-4967/2020 dated 04-03-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objection to the proposed acquisition;

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. for construction of composite bandh/border fencing (135 ft wide strip) by BSF situated in Village Dhankot, Tehsil Suchetgarh, District Jammu.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 205 Kanals, 12 Marlas situated in Village Dhankot, Tehsil Suchetgarh, District Jammu for construction of composite bandh/border fencing (135 ft wide strip) by BSF.

Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Marh is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rule;

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/ rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/ rules in force, while making the award.





acquisition of land measuring 21Kó15M situated at Village Ransoo, Tehsil Pouni, which is required for public purpose viz. õConstruction/Improvement of Bharakh-Ransoo Asconsite Roadö, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi.

Accordingly, land acquisition proceedings were initiated by this Collectorate under the provisions of Land Acquisition Act, 1990 Svt., but due to non-availability of funds on account of land compensation, the said land acquisition proceedings got lapsed under section 11-B of the Act. Thereafter, land acquisition proceedings were initiated afresh and a notification under section 4(1) of Land Acquisition Act, Svt. 1990 was issued by this Collectorate vide No. COL/LA/ADC/Rsi/19-20/120-127/NSQ dated 02-10-2019 and was got served upon the land owners/interested persons who were asked to file objections, if any, within 15 days from the date of issuance of said notification. In response to the notification, no objection was received by this Collectorate. The case was submitted to the District Collector, Reasi vide No. COL/LA/ADC/RSI/19-20/255/NSQ dated 01-02-2020 with the request that the matter may be submitted to the Government for issuance of declaration under sections 6 & 7 of the Act.

Thereafter, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu was requested by Deputy Commissioner (District Collector), Reasi No. DC/Rsi/19-20/2206-10/SQ dated 04-02-2020 for obtaining the declaration under Sections 6 & 7 of the Act by the competent authority. The Principal Secretary to Government, Revenue Department, J&K issued notification under section 6 vide Notification No. 232-Rev(LAJ) of 2020 dated 21-07-2020 under endorsement Number Rev/LAJ/257/2020 dated 21-07-2020 that the land is required for public purpose viz. õConstruction/Improvement of Bharakh-Ransoo Asconsite Roadö, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi and directed this Collectorate under section 7 of the said Act to take order for acquisition of land.

Thereafter, a notification under sections 9 & 9A of the Act was issued vide this Collectorate vide No. COL/ADC/RSI/20-21/116-24 dated 29-09-2020 and was served upon the land owners/interested persons and Indenting Department asking them to file objections, if any, regarding measurement, title and quantum of compensation within

stipulated period. In response to said notification, no objection has been received. The payment of compensation will be made to the land owners/interested persons as per rules and provisions in vogue.

- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared, statement of witnesses

- 4. Whereas, during investigation the seized posters of HM outfit were found containing the incriminating material asking the youth of the area to join the terrorist organization; and
- 5. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has *prima facie* established involvement of the accused namely Mohammad Younus Makroo S/o Ghulam Nabi Makroo R/o Arwani, Bijbehara for commission of offence punishable under section 13 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967; and
- 6. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 7. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Besides above the Private laboratories shall also adhere to the following conditions namely:ô

- (i) All the testing protocols as laid down by ICMR and the Government of India from time to time shall be followed by the Private Laboratories.
