Whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Ramban, vide letter No. Acq/Gen/19/956-59 dated 24-12-2019 has reported that the notification issued under section 4 (1) of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act by him was served upon the interested persons for filing objections, if any, to the proposed acquisition, but no objection was received from the land owners/interested persons within the prescribed period as required under sections 5 & 5-A of the Land Acquisition Act;

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Ramban, vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Ramban vide No. DC/LA/Rbn/570-71 dated 29-01-2020 duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/4138/Acq/Seri/PHE/Rbn/20/4396 dated 13-02-2020 and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K, Jammu vide No. FC-LS/LA-5113/2020 dated 11-03-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objections to the proposed acquisition;

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. for construction of Water Reservoir PHC, Seri.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 287 Kanals 01 Marla situated in Village Gharana and land measuring 16 Marlas situated in Village Seri, Tehsil and District Ramban for construction of Water Reservoir PHC, Seri. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Ramban is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested

- 2. Whereas, a case FIR No. 04/2020 under Sections 13, 18, 19 and 39 Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, came to be registered in Police Station, CIK, Kashmir and investigation was set into motion; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, one accused namely Umrat Rahi Ganie S/o Habibullah Ganie R/o Badrah Payeen, Kralgund was arrested in the case. The accused disclosed that he has contacts with active terrorist namely Azad Ahmad Lone @ Assad Lelhari S/o Mohd. Abdullah R/o Lelhar, Kakapora and had arranged shelter for the said terrorist in the house of one Nazir Ahmad Dar R/o Bucharwara, Kralgund posing the terrorist as painter by profession; and
- 4. Whereas, the accused disclosed that he also has contacts with two other accused persons namely Shahid Ashraf Dar S/o Mohd Ashraf Dar Ashminder and Waseem Gulzar Malik S/o Gulzar Ahmad Malik R/o Dalipora through Pakistani whatsapp numbers to carry out subversive and anti-national activities in the area. The accused further disclosed that above two accused had contacts with the terrorists namely Azad Ahmad and Adil Hafiz; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, it was revealed that accused Tariq Ahmad Dar S/o Gh. Rasool Dar R/o Budhbug Ashpora was also having contacts with the above terrorists of LeT outfit and was providing logistic support/shelter to these terrorists. Subsequently, the accused was arrested in the case and one Satellite phone used by him to be touch with the terrorists was recovered from his possession; and
- 6. Whereas, during further investigation three other accused persons namely (1) Anayatullah Shah S/o Ab. Rashid R/o Dangiwacha (2) Murtaza Nazir Qureshi S/o Nazir Ahmad R/o Dangiwacha and (3) Liyaqat Wahid Mir S/o Ab. Wahid Mir R/o Ongam, Bandipora A/P Kursoo Rajbagh were found involved in the case and all the accused were arrested in the case and 01 Satellite Phone and 01 Kenwood Wireless set were recovered from their possession; and

- 1. Short title and commencement.ô (a)These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir District Development Council (Reservation of Offices of Chairpersons) Rules, 2021.
- (b) They shall come into force from the date of issuance of this notification.
- 2. Reservation of offices of Chairpersons of the District Development Council.ô (a)As soon as possible after the declaration of results of the election members of the District Development Council, the Election Authority shall issue an order for reservation of office of Chairpersons of the District Development Councils in accordance with the provisions of these rules.
- (b) The office of Chairpersons of the District Development Councils shall be reserved for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and shall bear, as nearly as may be, the same proportion to the total number of such offices in the District Development Councils as population of Scheduled Castes in the Union Territory of the Scheduled Tribes in the Union Territory bears the total population of the Union Territory by applying the principles of mathematic round off with the part fraction of 0.5 and above and being rounded off to one and part fraction below 0.5 being ignored for each District Development Councils separately.
- (c) One-third of the total number of seats for the offices of Chairperson of District Development Council in the Union Territory shall be reserved for women in the manner prescribed.

- 3. Rotation of reserved offices of Chairpersons of the District Development Councils.ô The offices of Chairpersons of the District Development Councils under rule 2 shall be rotated in such a manner that as for as may be practicable the territorial constituencies reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Women in the previous elections shall not be reserved for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Women in the subsequent elections.
- 4. Allotment of seats to be reserved.ô (1)The number of seats of Chairpersons to be reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes as provided in rule 2 shall be allotted to different District Development Councils on the basis of population of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in such District Development Councils in the decending order, i. e. from amongst all the District Development Councils in the Union Territory, the District Development Councils having the largest population of Scheduled Tribes shall be allotted to the Scheduled Tribes Category and the District Development Councils having the largest population of the Scheduled Castes population shall be allotted to Scheduled Castes Category.
- (2) The allocation of seats of Chairperson to be reserved for women shall be made on a three point roster system after arranging them alphabetically. The roster point shall be taken as under :ô
  - (i) Open
  - (ii) Open
  - (iii) Women

# THE HOMOEOPATHY CENTRAL COUNCIL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2021

(No. 06 of 2021)

Promulgated by the President in the Seventy-second Year of the Republic of India.

An Ordinance further to amend the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973.

WHEREAS, Parliament is not in session and the President is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary for him to take immediate action.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 123 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to promulgate the following Ordinance :ô

- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) This Ordinance may be called the Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2021.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. Amendment of Section 3A.—In Section 3A of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 (59 of 1973), in sub-section (2), for the words õwithin a period of three yearsö, the words õwithin a period of four yearsö shall be substituted.
