Whereas, the land, specifications whereof are given in Annexure "A", to this notification is required for widening of Bye-Pass Road from Surankote-Bufliaz by GREF situated at Village and Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch;

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by the Officer Commanding, 79, Road RCC (GREF) C/o 56, APO, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition, Defence (CLA), Rajouri vide endorsement No. Coll/Def/2019-20/735-39 dated 28-09-2019 for land measuring 96 Kanals 07 Marlas situated at Village and Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch;

Whereas, the District Collector (DC), Poonch vide No. 960/Coll/def/2019-20 dated 21-10-2019 read with No. Coll/Def/2020/262 dated

Whereas, the report furnished by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Poonch vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/3876/Acq/GREF/Surankote-I/P/20/5354 dated 31-08-2020 and by Financial Commissioner, Revenue vide No. FC-LS/LA-5220/2020 dated 12-10-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners filed objections;

Whereas, the objections have been examined and the owner/interested persons are only demanding the change of alignment and the fixing of the alignment is the exclusively domain of the Indenting Department and the project is being of national importance constructed by Defence Authorities, the objections are found to be devoid of merits, hence cannot be considered:

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for widening of Bye-Pass Road from Surankote-Bufliaz by GREF situated at Village and Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch for the public purpose.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 96 Kanals 07 Marlas situated at Village and Tehsil Surankote, District Poonch for widening of Bye-Pass Road from Surankote-Bufliaz by GREF. Further, the District Collector (DC), Poonch is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving pescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award.

The accused further disclosed that he had earlier received the terror funding money through different bank accounts from the POK based handler @ Harron and distributed the same among other associates; and

- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence was prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation accused (1) Masrat Aalam Bhat, (2) Assadullah Parray. (3) Nissar Ahmad Wani, (4) Sajad Ahmad Navoo were arrested in connection with the case. Accused (1) Showakat Hakeem and (2) Mehraj-ud-din Gojree, have not been arrested but are under trial prisoners facing prosecution in another case; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation it was revealed that the accused persons were affiliated with Hurriyat Conference and on the date of occurrence the accused had raised anti-national slogans and had instigated the youth against the sovereignty, integrity and security of the country; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons in the commission of offences punishable under Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against each accused as under :ô


