2. Whereas, a case FIR No. 177/2018 under sections 20, 21 of ULA of (P) Act, 1967, was registered in Police Station, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu and investigation of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence, seizure memo was prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

4. Whereas, during investigation the accused disclosed that he was deputed to Jammu by the Ansar-Gazwatul-Hind terrorists namely Sahil Mohammad Akhoon S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Arampora, Tral and Faisal Javaid Khanday S/o Javaid Ahmad Khanday R/o Tral to execute subversive activities in Jammu District. The accused also disclosed that he received a bag containing 08 live grenades, incriminating material and cash amounting to Rs. 60,540/- from an unknown person at Jammu on the directions of the above two terrorists ; and

5. Whereas, during further investigation it was revealed that the accused Irfan Hassan Wani was a member of terrorist outfit Ansar-Gazwatul-Hind and was deputed to Jammu by the above two terrorists of the outfit to carry out subversive activities in the Jammu City; and

6. Whereas, the terrorists Sahil Akhoon and Faisal Javaid Khanday have been killed in an encounter at Arampora on 22-12-2018 and accordingly dropped from investigation of the case ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of offences punishable under Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 as shown against the name of the accused as under :ô

Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diar File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub- section (2) of Section 45 of ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused person for the commission of offences punishable under sections 20, 21 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, in the case FIR No. 177/2018 of Police Station, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu.
