Jammu, the 23rd of February, 2021.

SO-60.ô In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 and section 23C of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act No. 67 of 1957), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

1. **Short title, extent and commencement**.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Stone Crushers/Hot and Wet Mixing Plants Regulation Rules, 2021.

- (2) They shall extend to whole of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.
- (3) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Definitions**.ô In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,ô
 - (i) õ**Act**ö means the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957);
 - (ii) "Government" means the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (iii) õ**Minor Mineral**ö means the minerals as defined in the section 3(e) of the Act;
 - (iv) õMineral Concessionsö means a mining lease, mining license, quarry license, short term permit and disposable permit in respect of minor mineral permitting the mining of minor mineral in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral (Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Minings) Rules, 2016;
 - (v) õStone Crusher Unit/Hot and Wet Mixing plantö means the industrial units/plants/crushers installed or established for the processing of the Minor Minerals into value added/ finished products;
 - (vi) õProcessingö means all physical processes such as grading, washing, crushing, pulverization, calcinations, powdering, cutting and polishing of Minor Minerals; and
 - (vii) õProcessorö means a unit/plant/crusher holder involved in processing, value addition and sale of Minor Minerals under these rules.

Words and expression used but not defined in these rules shall have the meaning respectively assigned to them under the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral (Concession, Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining) Rules, 2016.

- 3. **General Requirements**.ô (1) A Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant is not a mining unit but a processor of minerals obtained from a source with a valid mineral concession. Such units shall be regulated by laws, rules and other provisions applicable to industrial units.
- (2) No permission/license would be needed by a Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant from the Mining Department except where it also engages in mining, which activity shall be regulated by laws/rules applicable to mining.
- (3) Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant shall establish/operate only on securing,ô
 - (i) Consent to establish/operate from the Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Board issued as per the procedure/ guidelines and siting criteria prescribed by the Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Board;
 - (ii) No Objection Certificate from Deputy Commissioner concerned regarding title verification of land and its usage; and
 - (iii) Registration with the District Industries Centre (DIC) if the unit holder intends to avail any incentives available in the Industrial Policy.
- 4. Raw/Processed Minor Minerals.ô Every Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant established/operating under these rules shall procure minor minerals, for storage and processing in the Unit/Plant/Crusher for conversion to finished goods and sale, from a valid mining concessionaire only under the relevant provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016.
- 5. **Power of Inspection/Penalties**.ô The provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016 shall apply to seizure of Minor Minerals and tools and associated penalties for their illegal procurement, transportation and storage in any Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant.
- 6. **Protection of Environment**.ô Every Stone Crusher/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant established under these rules shall strictly comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, the Water

- 7. **Fixation of Price and Sale**.ô (1) The Deputy Commissioner of the district may from time to time, by notification in the Official Gazette, fix the maximum price of finished product per cubic meter for whole of the district or different areas and different prices may be fixed for different kinds having regard to specific gravity, size, compressive strength colour and end use. While fixing such price per cubic meter for a minor mineral all relevant cost factors would be taken into account.
- (2) No processor shall sell or offer/cause to sell or otherwise dispose of, to any person finished goods for a price or at a rate exceeding the maximum selling fixed under rule 7(1).
- (3) Every consignment of finished goods shall invariably be accompanied by a valid sale bill indicating the quality, price and tax charges.
- (4) No processor shall refuse to sell the goods to any person if he is holding the stock for such sale. Such refusal by the above unit holder or dealers shall constitute an offence under relevant provisions of law in force.
- (5) Each processor shall maintain all records/accounts of the minor minerals procured, processed and supplied to further destinations and submit monthly returns.
- (6) Any processor who contravenes the provisions of these rules shall be liable to pay penalty as per the provisions of the Act.
- 8. **Delegation of powers**.ô The Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, direct that any or all the powers exercisable by it under these rules may in relation to such matter and subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified in such notification, be exercisable also by such officers or authority subordinate to the Government:

Provided that powers already delegated under Rule 84 of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Storage, Transportation of Minerals and Prevention of Illegal Mining Rules, 2016 shall also be exercised by such officers under these rules.

- 9. Conformity to other statutory provisions and court directions.ô Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the processor shall abide by the applicable Acts and rules or any modification/amendments made under such Acts and rules from time to time, any guidelines of Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Board and the Central Pollution Control Board.
- 10. Units existing prior to the commencement of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Exploitation and Processing Rules, 2017.ô Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, an unlicensed Crusher Unit/Hot and Wet Mixing Plant existing before the commencement of the Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Exploitation and Processing Rules, 2017 having valid consent to operate from the Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Board shall be allowed to operate. However, after expiry of consent to operate, it shall have to obtain fresh permission as per Rule 3(3)(ii) as one time requirement.
- 11. **Repeal and savings**.ô (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Minor Mineral Exploitation and Processing Rules, 2017 issued vide Notification SRO-302 of 2017 dated 19-07-2017 shall stand repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, nothing in these rules shall affect validity, effect of consequence of anything done or suffer to be done under the said law, rule or order before the date on which these rules come into force.

SO-90.ô In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor, Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

- 1. **Short title, commencement and application**.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Prisons (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- (2) These rules shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Government Gazette.

- 2. **Definitions**.ô (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,ô
 - (a) õ**Administrative Department**ö means the Home Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
 - (b) õCadreö means the cadre of the Service;
 - (c) õ**Commission**ö means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
 - (d) **©Competitive Examination**ö means such examination, including intermediate stages, as may be specified by the Government from time to time;
 - (e) õ**Government**ö means the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (f) õ**Member of the Service**ö means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules or the rules superseded by these rules;
 - (g) õ**Post**ö means a permanent post carrying a definite Time Scale sanctioned by the competent authority;
 - (h) õ**Rules**ö means the Jammu and Kashmir Prisons (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021;
 - (i) õScheduleö means the schedule(s) annexed to these rules;
 - (j) õ**Service**ö means the Jammu and Kashmir Prisons (Gazetted) Service; and
- (2) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined, shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations, 1956.
- 3. **Constitution of Service**.ô (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted of the Jammu and Kashmir Prisons (Gazetted) Serviceö.
- (2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules,

Provided that for the purpose of the initial constitution of the Service, a person holding any post included in the cadre of the Service in its sanctioned scale of pay, in substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the competent authority under rules, either by direct recruitment or by promotion shall be deemed to have been appointed to the Service under these rules if he is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules.

- Explanation:ô The word ±holdingø means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Prisons (Gazetted) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not include the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on *ad hoc* basis or in a stopgap arrangement.
- 4. Strength and composition of the Service.ô (1) The authorised permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the post included therein shall be determined by the Government from time to time and shall, at the initial constitution of the Service under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the Service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

- (2) The Government shall, after the interval of every five years or at such other intervals, as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of cadre of the Service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.
- 5. Qualification and method of recruitment.ô (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the Service unless he/she possesses the qualification as laid down in Schedule-II and fulfils other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.
 - (2) Appointment to the Service shall be made,ô
 - (a) By direct recruitment; or
 - (b) By promotion; or

- - (c) Partly by (a), and partly by (b), in the ratio, and in the manner, as mentioned against each post in Schedule-II:

Provided that all the posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through the Commission as per the rules orders of the Government issued for the purpose:

Provided further, that all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled up through Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC)/Commission, unless any post/category of posts is exempted from the purview of the Commission/DPC in terms of Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1957 by the Government by a specific order.

- (3) The department shall refer vacancies in the direct/promotion quota to the Commission and Departmental Promotion Committee, as the case may be, in terms of SRO-166 dated 14-06-2005.
- 6. **Selection Grade**.ô (l) The Service shall have the Time Scale of Level-8 (47600-151100).
- (2) Twenty-five per cent of the posts in the Time Scale of Pay Class-V, Category-A indicated in Schedule-II of these rules, shall be in the Selection Grade i. e. Pay Level-10-A (56600-179800).
- (3) The members of the service shall be eligible for placement in the Selection Grade on completion of 05 years Service in the Time Scale of Pay on the basis of seniority and other eligibility criteria on the recommendations of the Departmental Selection Committee to be constituted by the Government.
- 7. **Reservation in appointments.**ô While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be provided to the eligible categories in accordance with the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules and orders, as in force.
- 8. **Probation**.ô (1) Persons appointed to the service through direct recruitment shall be regulated in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 and in all other cases under the Provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

- (2) The pay of person appointed to the Service through direct recruitment shall be regulated in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 and in all other cases under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules as notified from time to time.
- 9. **Training and Departmental Examination**.ô Persons appointed to the Service by Competitive Examination conducted by Commission shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation or trial such departmental examination(s) as the Government may prescribe:

Provided that the Government may exempt, either wholly or partly, from such training or departmental examination(s) persons who have passed a departmental examination or undergone training declared by Government to be quivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

10. Eligibility of Government servants for direct recruitment.ô A person already in the Government Service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the Service if he/she possesses the educational and other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of posts. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be as provided in the general rules:

Provided that in case of a post which requires a higher degree of specialization and/or experience, the Government may prescribe higher upper age limit.

- 11. **Maintenance of seniority lists**.ô Seniority of the members of the Service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control an Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the Service.
- 12. **Residuary matters**.ô In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the Service shall be governed by the rules, regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir in general.

- 13. **Interpretation**.ô If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the decision of the Administrative Department shall be final and binding.
- 14. **Repeal and Savings**.ô (1) All rules corresponding to these rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment or order made or action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under these rules.

SO-136ô Whereas, on 24-04-2020 Kulgam Police received reliable information that some unknown terrorists with illegal arms/ammunition with the help of their associates abducted one Police Constable namely Sartaj Ahmad Itoo S/o Gh. Mohammad Itoo R/o Shirpora from his residential house with intention to kill him. Subsequently, nakas were established in the District to nab the culprits and to rescue the said police official from the terrorists; and

- 2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 39/2020 under sections 364 IPC, 7/25 Arms Act, 13, 16, 19, 30, 38, 39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, came to be registered in Police Station, Yaripora and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation section 18 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case and section 19, 30 were dropped from the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during naka checking at Kharpora, Arwani one vehicle (Santro) was intercepted for checking. The driver of the vehicle was signaled to stop the vehicle, but the terrorists who were travelling in the said vehicle fired indiscriminately upon the naka party resulting in injuries to one Police personnel. The fire was retaliated and during cross firing two unidentified terrorists were killed on spot and some of the terrorists/OGW fled away from the spot taking advantage of darkness. Subsequently, the abducted police official was rescued in injured condition and driver of the vehicle namely Irfan Ahmad Dar S/o Ab. Hameed Dar R/o Melhora, Shopian was arrested in the case and during search some arms/ammunition was also recovered from his vehicle; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during further investigation accused Irfan Ahmad Dar disclosed that one terrorist namely, Owais Ahmad Malik S/o Mohamamd Yousuf R/o Arwani and one OGW namely Umar Salam Koka S/o Ab. Salam R/o Melhora were also in the vehicle with the other two unidentified terrorists who were killed on the spot and after indiscriminate firing on the naka party both the accused has fled away from the spot. The accused disclosed that the police official was abducted by them on the directions of HM Commander namely Burhan Majeed Koka S/o Ab. Majeed R/o Melhora; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation it was established that the accused persons namely, Irfan Ahmad Dar and Umar Salam Koka were members of the banned terrorist organization and were working for them. They were providing logistic support to them for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area. The accused persons had provided full willing assistance to the terrorists while abducting the police official from his residential house along with the other terrorists; and
- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorists Burhan Majeed Koka and Owais Ahamd Malik have been killed in the different encounters against whom proceedings would abate; and

- 9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.
