Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Doda, vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Doda vide No. 481/LAC/D/19 dated 21-10-2019 duly endorsed by Divisional Commisioner, Jammu vide No. 502/3844/PWD/Thalsara/19/Doda/4022 dated 23-12-2019 and Financial Commisioner, Revenue, J&K, Jammu vide No. FC/LS/4962/2019 dated 29-07-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objection to the proposed acquisition;

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. construction of road from Thalsara to Malothi via Derka under PWD (R&B) .

Rashid Dar R/o Naina, Batpora, Pulwama were working for the terrorist organization AGuH and were in close contact with the terrorists as Muzamil Manzoor Tantray @ Hafiz S/o Manzoor Ahmad Tantray R/o Jamnagari and Basik Ismail Bakshi S/o Mohd Ismail R/o Jamnagari. Accused Ishfaq Koka and Altaf Ahmad Dar, already arrested by Special Cell, Delhi Police in a separate case, were arrested in the instant case after being bailed out; and

Whereas, during investigation, accused Ishfaq Majid Koka disclosed that he was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists namely Muzamil Tantray and Basik @ Basu and providing logistic support to them for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area. He disclosed that he along with accused Altaf Ahmad Dar were running an OGW network in the district and were raising funds for the terrorists of the outfit and were also collecting arms/ammunition and narcotics from the border in Kupwara for the terrorists and the funds received from illegal narcotic trade were being delivered to the above terrorists from time to time; and
- 7. Whereas, during investigation, other accused persons namely (1) Abid Hussain Baksi S/o Mohd Ismail Bakshi R/o Jamnagari, Shopian, (2) Ab. Hanan S/o Ab. The investigation revealed that victim was shifted by his family members to SKIMS, Soura for treatment where doctors declared him brought dead. Subsequently, offences under section 302 IPC and section 28, 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

- 3. Whereas, during investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation one Shahid Shafi Mir S/o Mohammad Shafi R/o Kolipora, Khanyar was arrested in connection with the case and during investigation he disclosed that he was working with terrorist namely Saqib Mansoor Dar S/o Manzoor Ahmad R/o Nai Basti, Old Barzullah. He further disclosed that he along with other accused persons namely Munir Aziz War @ Qari Munir S/o Ab. Aziz R/o Hatmullah, Kupwara and Towseef Ahmad Shah S/o Gh. Mohammad Shah R/o Parimpora who were under detention in another case in the Central Jail, Srinagar hatched criminal conspiracy to kill Advocate Babar Qadri and accused Shahid Shafi procured a Pistal from his associate terrorist Saqib Manzoor for this purpose and prepared a plan with his associates namely Zahid Farooq Khan S/o Farooq Ahmad R/o Shampora and Mohammad Asif Bhat S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Jogiwan, Amda-Kada for the killing ; and

Whereas, accused terrorist Shahid Shafi Mir further disclosed that accused Mohd Asif Bhat was assigned the task to keep a close watch on the activities of Advocate Babar Qadri and on 24-09-2020, he along with his associates went to the residence of Advocate Babar Qadri where accused Zahid Farooq and Mohd Asif entered his residential house to meet him in connection with a false case while he was waiting outside the residence. Subsequently, on being signaled, he entered inside the residence and fired three rounds upon the Advocate and all the three accused fled from the spot. Subsequently, his associates namely Zahid Farooq Khan and Mohd Asif Bhat were arrested in connection with the case; and

Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused person namely Shahdi Shafi Mir was active terrorist of JeM outfit and was close associate of terrorist Saqib Manzoor Dar and both the terrorists with the help of their associates namely Zahid Farooq Khan, Mohammad Asif Bhat, Munir Aziz War and Towseef Ahmad Shah hatched criminal conspiracy for killing of Advocate Babar Qadri. On the date of occurrence accused terrorist Shahid Shafi Mir with the help of his associates namely Zahid Farooq Khan and Mohd Asif Bhat entered in the residence of Advocate Babar Qadri and fired upon him and fled away from the spot; and
