The accused Umar Ahmad further disclosed that on 10th January, 2021 he along with his associate Suhail Ahmad proceeded to Jammu for collection of arms/ammunition from Vijaypur area ; and

Whereas, accused Umar Ahmad Malik further disclosed that on 12-01-2021 he along with his associate reached Vijaypur National Highway Bridge near under construction AIIMS and searched the location sent by PoK based terrorist Aakif and after identifying the location he sent some pictures of the said location to terrorist Aakif and communicated him that the location was risky, as such the arms/ammunition could not be transported from this location without a vehicle. SO-244.ô Whereas, on 18-01-2021, Anantnag Police during joint naka checking at Showala Minder Janglatmandi Anantnag arrested one suspect namely Ayaz Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Rasool Bhat R/o Shirpora Anantnag and recovered 01 Pistol, 02 Pistol Magazines and 07 Pistol rounds from his possession ; and

2. Whereas, a case FIR No. 10/2021 under section 7/25 Arms Act, 18,20,38 ULA(P) Act was registered in Police Station Anantnag and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevent provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, one Sameer Naseer Lone S/o Naseer Ahmad Lone R/o Semthan Bijbehara was arrested in connection with the case and during investigation, accused disclosed that he was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of JeM outfit and was providing logistic support to them. The accused further disclosed that in the month of December, 2020 he was directed by unknown terrorist to receive arms/ammunition from an unknown person at Qaimoh and as per the directions he received 01 Pistol from the unknown terrorist and handed over the same to the accused Ayaz Ahmad Bhat for carrying out the terrorist activities ; and

5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that both the accused persons were working as Over Ground Worker (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM outfit and were providing shelter/logistic support to the terrorists of JeM outfit, besides were transporting the arms/ammunition of terrorists from one place to another ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has establidhed *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :ô

8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevent documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the accused namely Ayaz Ahmad Bhat ; and

9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevent documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section 02 of section 45 ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused namely Ayaz Ahmad Bhat S/o Gh. Rasool R/o Shirpora Anantnag for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18, 23, 39, of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, in the case FIR No. 10/2021 of Police Station, Anantnag.
