 - (a) There are four alternatives for the answers to every question. For each question for which a wrong answer has been given by the candidate, one-fourth (0.25) of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty.
 - (b) If a candidate gives more than one answer, it will be treated as a wrong answer even if one of the given answer happen to be correct and there will be same penalty as above for that question.
 - (c) If a question is left blank i. e. no answer is given by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.

The Syllabus for the written/MCQ examination is given below :

General Knowledge about current Affairs :

Covering the subjects of History, Geography, Poltical Science, Economics, and issue of National and International importance.

Computers and Telecommunication:

(B) Interview/Viva-Voce :

On the basis of the marks obtained by the candidates in the written examination, an interview/vivaóvoce test will be conducted. The number of candidates called for interview/vivaóvoce test shall be restricted, as far as practicable, to a minimum of three times the number of vacanvies in order of merit. The interview/viva-voce will have 25 points.

(C) The detailed selection criteria has been given in the Rule 42 (ii) of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission (Business and Procedure) Rules, 2021 and the same is available on the Commission website.

10. Provision of Compensatory Time and Assistance of Scribe:

(i) On the request of a visually impaired (Blind) or any other candidate with Locomotor Disability and Cerebral Palsy where dominant (writing) extremity is affected to the extent of slowing

the performance or function (minimum of 40% impairment), the candidate shall be provided assistance of an amanuensis (Scribe) on production of a Disability Certificate issued by the Standing Medical Board or Medical Board constituted by the Government. The suspect tried to escape from the spot but was arrested by the naka party. During his search Police recovered 01 hand grenade and 05 Pistol rounds from his possession; and

2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 13/2021 under sections 20, 23, 38 of ULA (P) was registered in Police Station, Bandipora and investigation of the case was set into motion; and

- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, accused Imtiyaz Ahmad Khan disclosed that he was working for JeM terrorist outfit and had concealed some arms/ammunition near Degree College Bandipora. On his disclosure Police recovered 01 Pistol, 01 Pistol Magazine, 05 Pistol rounds and 04 hand grenades from a bag which was concealed near the Degree College; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused Imtiyaz Ahmad Khan was member of terrorist gang/organization and was active for carrying out the terrorist activities in District Bandipora; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused person for the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against him of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
- 7. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused person; and
- 8. Whereas, during investigation, it was revealed that on 29-06-2014 the accused Hurriyat activist apprared in Markundal Sumbal area for participating in a gathering held in connection with those who had died in the previous years and raised anti-National slogas, besides instigated the general public against the accession of the Jammu and Kashmir with the Union of India and therefore caused threat to sovereignty and integrity of the country; and
- 5. Whereas, during further investigation, accused person namely Gh. Ahmad Parray was arrested in connection with the case, whileas accused Nayeem Ahmad Khan is under custody of NIA; and
- 6. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons in commission of offence punishable under section as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
- - 1. Gh. Ahmad Parray S/o Ab. Satar Parray 13 ULA (P) Act R/o Parray Mohallah Hajin.
 - 2. Nayeem Ahmad Khan S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Pattan A/p Ibrahim Colony Hyderpora, Srinagar.
 - Mohammad Yousaf Naqash
 S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Safakadal, Srinagar.
- 7. Whereas, the accused Mohammad Yousuf Naqash has absconded against whom proceedings under section 299 Cr. PC have been proposed to be initiated; and
- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act,

- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the view of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section 2 of section 45 Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act 1967 the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above mentioned accused for the commission of offence punishable under section 13 ULA (P) Act, in case FIR No. 134/2014 of Police Station Sumbal.
