Rasool R/o Marhatgam, Zargar Mohalla, Handwara (presently under NIA custody in another case) who was in constant touch with a PoK based terrorist namely Abid Qayoom Wani S/o Ab. Qayoom Wani R/o Wussan Khoie Pattan. He further disclosed that accused Afaq Ahmad Wani was receiving the money from the said terrorist Abid Qayoom for onward distribution among the terrorists active in the area ; and

Whereas, the accused Asif Gul further disclosed that the accused Afaq Ahmad Wani used to transfer the money in his account for further distribution among the terrorists and he and Asif Gul recruited two more persons namely Muneeb Rasool Shinwari S/o Gh. Rasool R/o Ganie Hamam, Baramulla and Shabir Ahmad Teli S/o Gh. Mohammad Teli R/o Banglow Bagh, Baramulla to work as OGW for the terrorists of LeT outfit and handed them over an amount of Rs. 4,60,000/- which was recovered from the residential house of accused Shabir Ahmad Teli ; and

S.O-205. In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules; namely :

1. **Short title and commencement.** (I) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

she was appointed by the Competent Authority under rules included in the cadre of the services in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

Explanation :- The word 'holding' means a person holding a post included in the cadre of Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the Competent Authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.

4. Strength and composition of the service. (1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government. from time to time and shall, at the initial constitution of the services under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules :

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre or the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, at the interval of every three years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alteration therein as it deem fit :

Provided that nothing in this sub-rule shall be deemed to affect the power of the Government to alter the strength and composition of the cadre at any time.

5. Qualification and Method of Recruitment. (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he possesses the qualifications as laid down in the Schedule-II and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.

(2) Appointment to a service or class shall be made :

(a) by direct recruitment ; or

(b) by promotion : and

(c) partly by direct recruitment and partly by promotion in the ratio and in manner mentioned against each post in Schedule II :

Provided further that all posts to be filled by promotion/transfer shall be filled through Departmental Promotion Committee/Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board, unless any post/category of posts is exempted from the purview of the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board.

6. **Probation.** Probation of the Members of the Service shall be governed by the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020.

7. Reservation in appointments. While making appointments reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Castes/Schedule Tribes/Backward Classes or any other category or class of persons under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and rules made thereunder in force.

8. Training and Departmental Examination. Persons appointed to the service by competitive examination by direct recruitment/promotion shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation or training such departmental/Training examination as the Government may prescribe:

Provided that the Government may exempt either wholly or partly, from such training or departmental examination persons who have passed the departmental examination or undergone training declared by Government to be equivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

Provided that in case of a post which requires a higher degree of specialization and or experience, the Government may prescribe higher age limit.

11. **Residuary Matters.** In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service in general.

13. Repeal and savings. (I) The Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979 are hereby repealed.
