- 1. **Short title and commencement**.ô (I) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

- 2. **Definitions**.ô In these rules. unless the context otherwise requires :
 - (a) õAdministrative Departmentö means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
 - (b) õBoardö means the Jammu and Kashmir "Service Selection Board;
 - (c) õCadreö means the cadre of the service;
- ~ (d) õGovernment" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (e) õMember of the Serviceö means a person appointed to a post in the (Subordinate) service under the provisions of these rules;
 - (f) õRulesö means Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021;
 - (g) õScheduleö means the schedule annexed to these rules;
 - (h) õSelection Agencyö means the agency constituted by the Government for making recruitment to a particular class of post;
 - (i) õServiceö means Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service:
 - (j) õUnion Territoryö means Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.
 - (k) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations.
- 3. **Constitution of Service**.ô (1) From the date of commencement of these rules there shall be constituted the õJammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Serviceö.
 - (2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service :
 - Provided that for the purposes of initial constitution of the services, the person holding any post in substantive capacity to which he/

she was appointed by the Competent Authority under rules included in the cadre of the services in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

Explanation: -ô The word õholdingö means a person holding a post included in the cadre of Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the Competent Authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.

4. Strength and composition of the service.ô (1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government. from time to time and shall, at the initial constitution of the services under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre or the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, at the interval of every three years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alteration therein as it deem fit:

Provided that nothing in this sub-rule shall be deemed to affect the power of the Government to alter the strength and composition of the cadre at any time.

- 5. Qualification and Method of Recruitment.ô (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he possesses the qualifications as laid down in the Schedule-II and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.
 - (2) Appointment to a service or class shall be made :ô
 - (a) by direct recruitment; or
 - (b) by promotion : and

- - (c) partly by direct recruitment and partly by promotion in the ratio and in manner mentioned against each post in Schedule II:

Provided that all the posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board as per the rules/orders of the Government issued for the purpose.

Provided further that all posts to be filled by promotion/transfer shall be filled through Departmental Promotion Committee/ Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board, unless any post/ category of posts is exempted from the purview of the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board.

- (3) The department shall refer vacancies in the direct promotion quota to Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board and Departmental Promotion Committee as the case may be in terms of SRO-166 dated 14.06.2005.
- 6. **Probation**.ô Probation of the Members of the Service shall be governed by the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service. Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020.
- 7. **Reservation in appointments**.ô While making appointments reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Castes/Schedule Tribes/Backward Classes or any other category or class of persons under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and rules made thereunder in force.
- 8. **Training and Departmental Examination**.ô Persons appointed to the service by competitive examination by direct recruitment/promotion shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation or training such departmental/Training examination as the Government may prescribed:

Provided that the Government may exempt either wholly or partly, from such training or departmental examination persons who have passed the departmental examination or undergone training declared by Government to be equivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

9. Eligibility of Government Servant for Direct Recruitment.ô A person already in the government service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to vacant post in any particular class or category in the service if he/she possesses the educational and other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of post. The upper age limit of such government servants shall be such as provided in the general rules:

Provided that in case of a post which requires a higher degree of specialization and or experience, the Government may prescribe higher age limit.

- 10. **Maintenance of seniority lists**.ô Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Administrative Department in the Civil Secretariat shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of members of the service.
- 11. **Residuary Matters**.ô In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Service in general.
- 12. **Interpretation**.ô If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.
- 13. **Repeal and savings**.ô (I) The Jammu and Kashmir Legal (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 1979 are hereby repealed.
 - (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

SO-252.ô Whereas, on 30-01-2021, Anantnag Police during naka checking at Doonipora, Bijbehara intercepted a vehicle (Alto) for checking. The driver of the vehicle tried to flee away from the spot along with the vehicle but was chased down by the naka party. During checking of the vehicle two persons boarding in vehicle identified as Imran Ahmad Hajam S/o Gh. Nabi R/o Nathpora, Khanabal and Irfan Ahmad Ahanger S/o Mohd Altaf R/o Nandpora were arrested and during checking Police recovered 02 Pistols, 03 Pistol Magazines and 116 Pistol rounds from the said vehicle; and

- 2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 20/2021 under sections 20, 38 of ULA (P) Act, 7/25 Arms Act was registered in Police Station, Bijbehara and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation sections 18, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, accused Imran Ahmad Hajam disclosed that he came in contact with one OGW of JeM outfit namely Junaid Ahmad Lone S/o Mohammad Shafi R/o Batpora, Imam Sahab who motivated him to join the JeM outfit and disclosed that later on the said Junaid Ahmad joined the JeM outfit and remained active in the area. Accused further disclosed that later on he motivated his friend namely Irfan Ahmad Ahanger to work for the terrorists of JeM outfit; and
- 5. Whereas, accused further disclosed that he was in constant touch with the said terrorist Junaid Ahmad and he along with his friend Irfan Ahmad Ahanger went to Shopian and met with the said terrorist who introduced both the accused persons with their Commander namely Hidayat-Ullah Malik @ Hasnain S/o Ab. Hamid R/o Sharatpora (arrested by Jammu Police) and both the terrorists motivated accused Imran Ahmad and Irfan Ahmad to work as OGWs for these terrorists. Subsequently, the custody of accused Hidayat-ullah Malik was changed in this case; and
- 6. Whereas, accused Imran Ahmad and Irfan Ahmad also disclosed that after ten days they along with their associate joined as Member of JeM outfit and terrorist namely Hidayat-ullah Malik provided two Pistols, 03 Pistol Magazines, 116 Pistol Rounds, 2 hand grenades, 30 AK 47 rounds and some explosive material to them for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area. Both the accused persons also disclosed that they were also in constant touch with the other terrorists of the JeM outfit namely (1) Umar @ Wahid Khan S/o Ab. Ahad R/o Pandit Mohalla, Shopian, (2) Rayees Ahmad Bhat @ Mustafa S/o Mohammad Sultann R/o Chotipora, DK Pora, (3) Aftab Ahmad @ Ali Bhai S/o Gh. Mohammad R/o Dachipora and (4) Aadil Ahmad Bhat S/o Ab. Hamid R/o Sheetipora, Bijbehara who were active in the Shopian area; and

- 7. Whereas, during further investigation, accused Imran Ahmad and Irfan Altaf disclosed that they were directed by their commander Hidayat-ullah Malik to motivate/recruit some youth to work for the JeM outfit and accordingly, both the accused persons motivated/recruited four other accused persons namely (1) Bilal Ahmad Kumar S/o Mohammad Abdullah R/o Heff Shirmal, (2) Towfeeq Ahmad Laway S/o Manzoor Ahmad R/o Pushwara, (3) Muzamil Ahmad Wani S/o Mohammad Amin R/o Munward and (4) Aadil Ahmad Rather S/o Ab. Khaliq R/o Khandpari Hernag and provided some ammunition/explosive material to them for carrying out subversive activities. Subsequently, all the four accused persons were arrested in connection with the case along with the ammunition/explosive material; and
- 8. Whereas, during further investigation, it was established that the accused (1) Imran Ahmad Hajam and (2) Irfan Ahmad Ahanger were members of JeM outfit motivated by terrorist Junaid Ahmad and I-lidayatullah Malik. The accused persons namely Bilal Ahmad Kumar, Towfeeq Ahmad Laway, Muzamil Ahmad Wani and Aadil Ahmad Rather were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM outfit and were providing shelter/logistic support to them; and
- 9. Whereas, the terrorists namely Junaid Ahmad Lone, Rayees Ahmad Bhat, Aftab Ahmad and Aadil Ahmad Bhat have been killed in the different encounters with the security forces; and
- 10. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
- 2. Irfan Ahmad Ahanger S/o Mohd Altaf R/o Nandpora

- 3. Hidayat-Ullah Malik @ Hasnain S/o Ab. Hamid R/o Sharatpora
- 4. Bilal Ahmad Kumar S/o Mohammad 18, 23, 39 of Abdullah R/o Heff, Shirmal ULA (P) Act
- Towfeeq Ahmad Laway S/o Manzoor Ahmad R/o Pushwara
- 6. Muzamil Ahmad Wani S/o Mohammad Amin R/o Munward
- 7. Aadil Ahmad Rather S/o Ab. Khaliq R/o Khand Pari, Hernag
- 8 Umar @ Wahid Khan S/o Ab. Ahad 18, 20, 38 of R/o Pandit Mohalla, Shopian ULA (P) Act
- 11. Whereas, accused namely Irfan Ahmad Ahanger has been found juvenile during the investigation and in view of section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act; and
- 12. Whereas, accused Umar @ Wahid Khan has absconded against whom proceedings under section 299 Cr. P. C. has been initiated; and
- 13. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the accused persons; and
- 14. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

- 3. Whereas, a case FIR No. 05/2021 under sections 307 IPC, 16, 18, 20, 38 of ULA (P) Act, 7/27 Arms Act was registered in Police Station, Kakapora and investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during investigation section 38 of ULA (P) Act was dropped from the case; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that accused terrorist Akeel Ahmad Lone had gone missing from his home on 11-12-2020 and joined LeT outfit, while accused Ab. Rouf Sheikh had also gone missing on 31-5-2020 and joined HM outfit. Both the terrorists remained active, carrying out terrorists activities in the area. During further investigation, it was also established that on the date of occurrence both the terrorists forcibly entered the residence of Mohammad Ashraf Bhat; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô
