Whereas, the land, specification whereof are given in Annexure-"A" to this notification is required for construction of widening/upgradation of Panthal-Jhajjar PWD Road from 1st to Km. 13th (under CRF) situated at Village Sira, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi;

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Chief Manager, PWD, (R&B) Department, Jammu, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Katra, vide letter No. SDM/K/CLA/2019-20/128-34 dated 12-07-2019 for land measuring 35 Kanals, 19 Marlas and 04 Sirsai situated in Village Sira, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi for construction of widening/upgradation of Panthal-Jhajjar PWD Road from 1st to Km. 13th (under CRF);

Whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Katra, vide letter No. SDM/K/CLA/2019-20/223-25 dated 02-09-2019 has reported that the notification issued under section 4 (1) of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act by him was served upon the interested persons for filing objections, if any, to the proposed acquisition, but no objection was received from the land owners/interested persons within the prescribed period as required under sections 5 & 5-A of the Land Acquisition Act;

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Katra vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Reasi vide No. DC/Rsi/2019-20/891-95/SQ dated 09-09-2019 duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/3632/PWD/Sira/Reasi/19/2635 dated 29-12-2019 and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K Jammu vide No. FC-LS/LA-5123/2020 dated 12-03-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objection to the proposed acquisition;

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. for construction of widening/upgradation of Panthal-Jhajjar PWD Road from 1st to Km. 13th (under CRF) situated at Village Sira, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 35 Kanals, 19 Marlas and 04 Sirsai situated in Village Sira, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi for construction of widening/upgradation of Panthal-Jhajjar PWD Road from 1st to Km. 13th (under CRF). Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Katra is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/ rules in force, while making the award.



2. Whereas, during search, terrorists hiding in the village fired upon indiscriminately on the search party, resulting in injuries to one CRPF personnel who later on succumbed to his injuries. During encounter two terrorists identified as (1) Owais Ahmad Bhat S/o Mohammad Yousuf

- 3. Whereas, a case FIR No. 150/2020 under sections 16, 19, 20 ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Pulwama and investigation was set into motion; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memo was prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the course of investigation it was revealed that the Asiq Hussain Wani S/o Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Bandzoo, Pulwama was voluntarily harbouring terrorists in his residential house; and
- 6. Whereas, the accused Asiq Hussain Wani was arrested in connection with the case and it was revealed that on the date of encounter, the killed terrorists were hiding in the house of accused Asiq Hussain Wani; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has *prima facie* established case of harbouring of terrorists against the accused namely Asiq Hussain Wani S/o Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Bandzoo, Pulwama an offence punishable under section 19 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967; and
- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case dairy file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima* facie case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention)

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accords sanction for launching prosecution against the abovementioned accused for the commission of offence punishable under sections 19 of ULA (P) Act, in the case FIR No. 150/2020 of Police Station, Pulwama.

SO-144.ô In exercise of the power conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules nameJy:ô

1. Short title and commencement :ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2020.

- - (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
 - 2. **Definitions** :ô In these rules unless the context otherwise requires :ô
 - (a) õAdministrative Departmentö means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
 - (b) õCadreö means the cadre of the service;
 - (c) õCommissionö means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
 - (d) õ**Government**ö means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (e) õHead of the Departmentö means the Major Head of the Department holding the Administrative control of the Organization/Department;
 - (f) õMember of Serviceö means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules;
 - (g) õ**Post**ö means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the competent authority;
 - (h) õ**Rules**ö means the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2020;
 - (i) õ**Schedule**ö means the schedule (s) annexed to these rules;
 - (j) õServiceö means the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service;
 - (k) $\tilde{o}UT\ddot{o}$ means the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir ; and
 - (2) Words and expression used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations.

- 3. **Constitution of Service** :ô (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the "Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service.
 - (2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service:

Provided that for the purposes of initial constitution of service, the person holding any post in a substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the competent authority under rules included in the cadre of the service in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

- **"Explanation**: ô The word õholdingö means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basic or in a stop-gap arrangementö.
- (3) Fifty percent (50%) of the service shall be in the Selection Grade (non-functional) of Rs. 15,600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5,600/- on completion of five (05) years of service on the basis of recommendations of Departmental Promotion Committee as may be constituted by the Government in this behalf from time to time.
- 4. **Strength and composition of the service :—**(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time and shall at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre or the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

- - (2) The Government shall, at the interval of every five years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.
 - 5. Qualifications and Method of Recruitment.ô (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he/she possesses the qualifications as laid down in the Schedule-II and fulfils other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.
 - (2) First appointment to a service or class may be made:-
 - (a) by promotion or
 - (b) by direct recruitment
 - (c) partly by (a) and partly be (b) in the ratio and in manner as mentioned against each post in Schedule-II.

Provided that all posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through a Combined Competitive Examination to the Junior Scale of KAS in accordance with the relevant rules issued from time to time by the General Administrative Department.

Provided further all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled through Departmental Promotion Committee/Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission in terms of J&K Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1957 by the Government by specific order.

- (3) The Department shall refer vacancies in the direct quota to General Administration Department upto 30-12-2008 only and promotion quota to Departmental Promotion Committees/Public Service Commission as per SRO-166 dated 14-05-2005.
- 6. **Probation**.ô (1) Persons appointed to the service, either by dtrect recruitment or by promotion shall be on probation for two yearso and their confirmation in any class or category shall be made under the provision of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

- (2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regularized as per the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules as issued by the Government from time to time.
- 7. **Reservation in appointments**: ô While making appointments either by promotion or by direct recruitment, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Castel Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes or any other category or class as defined under the provision of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules made thereunder.
- 8. **Maintenance of seniority lists**: ô Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 1956. The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of members of the service.

Filing of End use certificate.ô (1) For the purpose of subclause (3) of clause 3 of the Solvent, Raffinates and Slop (Acquisition, Sale, Storage and Prevention of use in Automooile) Order, 2000, the end-use certificates and the particulars regarding customer-wise sales shall be furnished to the licensing authority of respective divisions with a copy to the State Level Co-ordinator of the Oil Industry for information.
- (2) For the purpose of sub-clause (4) of clause 3 of the Solvent, Raffinates and Slop (Acquisition, Sale, Storage and Prevention of use in Automobile) Order, 2000, the end use certificates shall be filed before the concerned licensing authority on a quarterly basis with a copy to the State Level Co-ordinator of the Oil Industry for information.

- 4. Mohammad Rafiq Drangay S/o Gh. Nabi Drangay R/o Hayar (Active Terrorist);
- 8. Whereas, accused Mohammad Rafiq Drangay is an active terrorist of HM outfit and proceedings under section 299 Cr. PC. have been initiated against him; and
- 9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accords sanction for launching prosecution against the above mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18-B, 38 ULA (P) Act, in the case FIR No. 92/2019 of Police Station, Bijbehara.

SO-245.66In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 309 of the Constitution or India, the Government hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

1. **Short title, commencement and application**.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service Recruitment Rules, 2020.

- (2) The Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint different dates for giving effect to different provisions of these rules and any reference in any provision to the commencement of these rules shall be construed as a reference to the coming into force of that provision.
- 2. **Definitions**.ô (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,ô
 - (a) õAdministrative Departmentö means the Home Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of service;
 - (b) õCadreö means the cadre of the service;
 - (c) õCadre Officerö means a member of the service ;
 - (d) õCadre Postö means the posts borne on the service;
 - (e) õCommissionö means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
 - (f) õCompetitive Examinationö means such examination, including intermediate stages, as may be specified by the Government from time to time;
 - (g) \tilde{o} Government \tilde{o} means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (h) õMember of the Serviceö means a person appointed to a post in the service under the provisions of these rules or the rules/orders superseded by rule 16 of these rules;
 - (i) õPostö means a permanent post in the pay level, duly sanctioned by the competent authority;
 - (j) õRulesø means the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service Recruitment Rules, 2020 ;
 - (k) õScheduleö means a schedule annexed to these rules;

- (l) õServiceö means the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service;
- (2) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as assigned to them respectively in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations.
- 3. Constitution of Service.—(1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the õJammu and Kashmir Prosecution Serviceö.
- (2) The service shall comprise of the persons indicated in Annexure to Government Order No. 1104-Home of 2019 dated 30-10-2019 and such other persons as may be appointed to the service from time to time in accordance with the provisions of these rules.
- (3) The Government may, for the purpose of initial constitution of the service, notify the details of the persons holding any post included in the cadre of the service in its sanctioned scale of pay, in substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the competent authority under rules, either by direct recruitment or by promotion and such persons shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules.
 - Explanation: ô The word holdingø means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not include the persons holding a post on ad hoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.
- 4. Strength and composition of the Service.ô (1) The authorized permanent strength of the cadre and the nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government from time to time and shall, with effect from the date as may be notified by the Government, be such as that specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the service for a specified period as may be considered necessary from time to time:

Provided further that the direct recruitment post of Prosecuting Officer, indicated at S. No. 8 of Schedule-I, held by a person appointed

- (2) At the initial constitution of the service under these rules, the authorized permanent strength of the service and the nature of the posts including therein shall be such as specified in Schedule-IA annexed to these rules, which shall be deemed to have been substituted by Schedule-I from the date sub-rule (1) of this rule comes into force.
- (3) The Government shall, at the interval of every five years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit:

Provided that nothing contained in this sub-rule shall affect the power of the Government to alter the strength and composition of the service at any other time, by making temporary additions or deletion or reduction to the cadre on need basis.

- 5. Qualification and Method of Recruitment.ô (1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in the cadre of the service unless he possesses the qualifications as laid down in Schedule-IIA annexed to these rules and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.
- (2) The Schedule-IIA shall be deemed to have been substituted by Schedule-II annexed to these rules from such date as may be notified by the Government.
- (3) All the posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled through the Departmental Promotion Committee/Commission. For the purpose of

- (4) The selection against the direct recruitment posts of Prosecuting Officer (G) shall be made through a competitive examination by the Commission, in accordance with the rules and the procedure, as prescribed.
- 6. **Reservation in appointments**.ô While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules and orders, as in force.
- 7. **Probation**.ô (1) Every person appointed to the service under sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of these rules shall be on probation for a period of two years and the confirmation in any particular class or category shall be made under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.
- (2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regulated as per the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules, as issued from time to time.
- 8. **Training and Examination**.ô (1) A probationer referred to in sub-rule (1) of rule 7 of these rules shall on appointment to the service undergo such training and for such period as the Government may prescribe from time to time.
- (2) A probationer shall attend such lectures and undergo such tests and exercises as may be prescribed from time to time.
- (3) Every probationer shall on the completion of training appear in a final examination to be conducted by Head of the Training Institute in accordance with such regulations as the Government may from time to time, make. These regulations shall, *inter alia* indicate the scheme of distribution of marks between the competitive examination and the final examination and the aggregate marks shall be the basis to determine the seniority.

- 4. Where a probationer is prevented, either through sickness or other casue over which he has no control from appearing in the final examination, mentioned in sub-rule (3), he may be allowed to appear in the examination which may be conducted by the Head of the Training Institute as early as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the last date of the final examination in which the probationer did not appear.
- 5. Where a probationer fails to obtain the minimum number of marks prescribed for any subject, group of subjects or part of the departmental examination under the regulations framed as per sub-rule (3), he may be permitted to sit for re-examination in the subject or subjects in which he has failed:

Provided that the marks awarded to a probationer in the re-examination, reffered to in sub-rule (5), shall not be taken into account for determining the seniority.

- 6. All the members of the service shall undergo such trainings/courses from time to time, including at the time of promotions, as the Government may direct.
- 9. **Power to relax**.ô Where the Government is of the opinion that it was necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of the rules with respect to any class, category of persons or posts; provided that while exercising such powers, the Government may consult the Commission,
- 10. **Seniority**.ô (1) The Government shall prepare and notify a list of all the probationers upon their confirmation. The list shall be arranged in the order of merit determined in accordance with the aggregate marks obtained by each probationer as per the regulations mentioned in sub-rule (3) of rule 8:

Provided that if two or more probationers have secured equal number of marks in the aggregate, their order of merit shall be as per the marks obtained in the competitive examination.

- (2) The inter-se-seniority of the probationers, who are appointed on the basis of same competitive examination, shall be determined in accordance with the list prepared under sub-rule (1) and probationers who are appointed on the basis of an earlier competitive examination shall be ranked above those appointed consequent to a later competitive examination.
- (3) The inter-se-seniority of the Prosecuting Officers appointed to the service prior to the initial constitution of the service shall be determined in accordance with the rules applicable on the date of their appointment to the service.
- (4) The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the members of the service.
- Posting of the cadre officers.ô (1) The posting of cadre officers shall be made against the cadre posts or such posts as are reckoned against the deputation reserve, shown in Schedule-III annexed to these rules.
- (2) Every cadre officer, unless he is appointed to an ex-cadre post or is otherwise not available for holding a duty post owing to the exigencies of service, be posted against a duty post :

Provided that no cadre officer shall be deputed to a post other than a post under the Government, carrying a prescribed pay which is less than or a pay scale the maximum of which is less than the basic pay he would have drawn in the cadre post for his deputation.

- (3) A member of the service may be appointed to an ex-cadre post for such period and on such terms as the Government may specify.
- (4) The Government may, for the purpose of facilitating leave arrangements, direct that any two cadre posts or a cadre post and an equivalent non-cadre post may be held simultaneously by a cadre officer.
- 12. **Discipline and conduct**.ô In regard to all matters governing the service conditions of the members of the service and discipline, the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification,

- 13. **Power to remove difficulties.**ô If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these rules, the Government may issue such instructions, not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules, which appear to it be necessary or expedient for the purpose of removing the difficulty and for purpose of giving effect to these rules.
- 14. **Residuary matters**.ô In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules or by regulations or orders/instructions issued thereunder or by special order, the members of the service shall be governed by rules, regulations and orders applicable to the State Civil Service in general:

Provided that any power exercisable by the Government under such rules, regulations and orders may be delegated by them to such subordinate authorities subject to such conditions as they may prescribe.

- 15. **Interpretation**.ô If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the decision of the Administrative Department thereon shall be final and binding.
- 16. **Repeal and Savings.**ô (1) All existing rules and orders relating to matters covered by these rules shall stand superseded from the date these rules come into force. The rules in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed from the date(s) the corresponding provisions of these rules are enforced.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment, order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules/orders so repealed/superseded shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
