Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. for construction of widening/upgradation of Panthal-Jhajjar PWD Road from 1st to Km. 13th (under CRF) situated at Village Sira, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi.

Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Chief Engineer, PMGSY (JKRDDA), Jammu, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Billawar vide letter No. ADC/Blr/2018-19/285-93 dated 21-04-2018, for land measuring 23 Kanals 10 Marlas situated in Village Sadrota, Tehsil Lohai Malhar, District Kathua for construction of road from L034-Dhaman to Gali, JK07138, under PMGSY ;

Jammu, the 29th April, 2020.

SO-144. In exercise of the power conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules nameJy :

1. Short title and commencement : (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2020.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

- (a) **öAdministrative Departmentö** means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;
- (b) **öCadreö** means the cadre of the service;
- (c) **öCommissionö** means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission ;
- (d) **öGovernmentö** means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (e) **öHead of the Departmentö** means the Major Head of the Department holding the Administrative control of the Organization/Department ;
- (f) **öMember of Serviceö** means a person appointed to a post in the Service under the provisions of these rules ;
- (g) **öPostö** means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the competent authority ;
- (h) **öRulesö** means the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service Recruitment Rules, 2020 ;
- (i) **öScheduleö** means the schedule (s) annexed to these rules;
- (j) **öServiceö** means the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service;
- (k) **öUTö** means the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir ; and

(2) Words and expression used in these rules but not defined shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations.

3. **Constitution of Service :** (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the "Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service."

(2) The Government may, at the commencement of these rules appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service:

Provided that for the purposes of initial constitution of service, the person holding any post in a substantive capacity to which he was appointed by the competent authority under rules included in the cadre of the service in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

**“Explanation :**ö The word öholdingö means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on adhoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangementö.

(3) Fifty percent (50%) of the service shall be in the Selection Grade (non-functional) of Rs. 15,600-39100 with Grade Pay of Rs. 5,600/- on completion of five (05) years of service on the basis of recommendations of Departmental Promotion Committee as may be constituted by the Government in this behalf from time to time.

4. **Strength and composition of the service :—**(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and nature of the posts included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time and shall at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in the Schedule-I annexed to these rules :

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre or the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

(2) The Government shall, at the interval of every five years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.

(2) First appointment to a service or class may be made:-

(b) by direct recruitment

Provided that all posts under direct recruitment shall be filled through a Combined Competitive Examination to the Junior Scale of KAS in accordance with the relevant rules issued from time to time by the General Administrative Department.

Provided further all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled through Departmental Promotion Committee/Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission in terms of J&K Public Service Commission (Limitation of Functions) Regulations, 1957 by the Government by specific order.

(3) The Department shall refer vacancies in the direct quota to General Administration Department upto 30-12-2008 only and promotion quota to Departmental Promotion Committees/Public Service Commission as per SRO-166 dated 14-05-2005.

6. **Probation.** (1) Persons appointed to the service, either by direct recruitment or by promotion shall be on probation for two years and their confirmation in any class or category shall be made under the provision of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

(2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regularized as per the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules as issued by the Government from time to time.

7. **Reservation in appointments** :ô While making appointments either by promotion or by direct recruitment, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Caste Scheduled Tribes/ Backward Classes or any other category or class as defined under the provision of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules made thereunder.
8. **Maintenance of seniority lists** :ô Seniority of the members of the service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules 1956. The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of members of the service.
9. **Residuary matters** :ô In regard to the matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by rules/regulations and orders applicable to the Civil Services in UT of J&K in general.
10. **Interpretation** :ô If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Revenue Department whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.
11. **Repeal and Savings.**ô (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Revenue (Gazetted Service Recruitment Rules, 1977 are hereby repealed.  
  
(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions.

**1. Short title and commencement.**ô (1) This order may be called

Filing of End use certificate.** (1) For the purpose of sub-clause (3) of clause 3 of the Solvent, Refined and Slop (Acquisition, Sale, Storage and Prevention of use in Automobile) Order, 2000, the end-use certificates and the particulars regarding customer-wise sales shall be furnished to the licensing authority of respective divisions with a copy to the State Level Co-ordinator of the Oil Industry for information.

(2) For the purpose of sub-clause (4) of clause 3 of the Solvent, Raffinates and Slop (Acquisition, Sale, Storage and Prevention of use in Automobile) Order, 2000, the end use certificates shall be filed before the concerned licensing authority on a quarterly basis with a copy to the State Level Co-ordinator of the Oil Industry for information.

**5. Period of license.** Every license issued under this order, unless previously suspended, or cancelled shall be valid for a two years from the date of issuance and thereafter shall be renewed for two years on each occasion on an application made by a licensee to the licensing authority which shall be made before the expiry of the validity period of license along with fee prescribed under Schedule-I of this order.

SO-245.ôôIn exercise of the powers conferred by Article 309 of  
the Constitution of India, the Government hereby makes the following  
rules, namely :ô

1. **Short title, commencement and application.**ô (1) These rules  
may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service Recruitment  
Rules, 2020.

(2) The Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint different dates for giving effect to different provisions of these rules and any reference in any provision to the commencement of these rules shall be construed as a reference to the coming into force of that provision.

- (a) "Administrative Department" means the Home Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of service ;
- (b) "Cadre" means the cadre of the service ;
- (c) "Cadre Officer" means a member of the service ;
- (d) "Cadre Post" means the posts borne on the service ;
- (e) "Commission" means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission ;
- (f) "Competitive Examination" means such examination, including intermediate stages, as may be specified by the Government from time to time ;
- (g) "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (h) "Member of the Service" means a person appointed to a post in the service under the provisions of these rules or the rules/orders superseded by rule 16 of these rules ;
- (i) "Post" means a permanent post in the pay level, duly sanctioned by the competent authority ;
- (j) "Rules" means the Jammu and Kashmir Prosecution Service Recruitment Rules, 2020 ;
- (k) "Schedule" means a schedule annexed to these rules ;

Provided further that the direct recruitment post of Prosecuting Officer, indicated at S. No. 8 of Schedule-I, held by a person appointed

direct recruitment against the posts of Prosecuting Officer (G), the  
Government may refer during a calendar year as many vacancies of  
Prosecuting Officer (G) to the Commission as may be considered  
necessary.

(4) The selection against the direct recruitment posts of Prosecuting Officer (G) shall be made through a competitive examination by the Commission, in accordance with the rules and the procedure, as prescribed.

6. **Reservation in appointments.** While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules and orders, as in force.

7. **Probation.** (1) Every person appointed to the service under sub-rule (1) of rule 5 of these rules shall be on probation for a period of two years and the confirmation in any particular class or category shall be made under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

(2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules shall be regulated as per the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules, as issued from time to time.

8. **Training and Examination.** (1) A probationer referred to in sub-rule (1) of rule 7 of these rules shall on appointment to the service undergo such training and for such period as the Government may prescribe from time to time.

(2) A probationer shall attend such lectures and undergo such tests and exercises as may be prescribed from time to time.

(3) Every probationer shall on the completion of training appear in a final examination to be conducted by Head of the Training Institute in accordance with such regulations as the Government may from time to time, make. These regulations shall, *inter alia* indicate the scheme of distribution of marks between the competitive examination and the final examination and the aggregate marks shall be the basis to determine the seniority.

4. Where a probationer is prevented, either through sickness or other casue over which he has no control from appearing in the final examination, mentioned in sub-rule (3), he may be allowed to appear in the examination which may be conducted by the Head of the Training Institute as early as possible, preferably within a period of six months from the last date of the final examination in which the probationer did not appear.

5. Where a probationer fails to obtain the minimum number of marks prescribed for any subject, group of subjects or part of the departmental examination under the regulations framed as per sub-rule (3), he may be permitted to sit for re-examination in the subject or subjects in which he has failed :

Provided that the marks awarded to a probationer in the re-examination, referred to in sub-rule (5), shall not be taken into account for determining the seniority.

6. All the members of the service shall undergo such trainings/ courses from time to time, including at the time of promotions, as the Government may direct.

9. **Power to relax.** Where the Government is of the opinion that it was necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of the rules with respect to any class, category of persons or posts ; provided that while exercising such powers, the Government may consult the Commission, and would keep in view that the discretion is exercised *bona fide* and is duly notified for information of general public.

10. **Seniority.** (1) The Government shall prepare and notify a list of all the probationers upon their confirmation. The list shall be arranged in the order of merit determined in accordance with the aggregate marks obtained by each probationer as per the regulations mentioned in sub-rule (3) of rule 8 :

Provided that if two or more probationers have secured equal number of marks in the aggregate, their order of merit shall be as per the marks obtained in the competitive examination.

(4) The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the members of the service.

(2) Every cadre officer, unless he is appointed to an ex-cadre post or is otherwise not available for holding a duty post owing to the exigencies of service, be posted against a duty post :

(3) A member of the service may be appointed to an ex-cadre post for such period and on such terms as the Government may specify.

(4) The Government may, for the purpose of facilitating leave arrangements, direct that any two cadre posts or a cadre post and an equivalent non-cadre post may be held simultaneously by a cadre officer.

12. **Discipline and conduct.** In regard to all matters governing the service conditions of the members of the service and discipline, the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification,

Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and other rules and orders in force  
at the time shall apply.

**13. Power to remove difficulties.** If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of these rules, the Government may issue such instructions, not inconsistent with the provisions of these rules, which appear to it be necessary or expedient for the purpose of removing the difficulty and for purpose of giving effect to these rules.

**14. Residuary matters.** In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules or by regulations or orders/instructions issued thereunder or by special order, the members of the service shall be governed by rules, regulations and orders applicable to the State Civil Service in general :

Provided that any power exercisable by the Government under such rules, regulations and orders may be delegated by them to such subordinate authorities subject to such conditions as they may prescribe.

**15. Interpretation.** If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the decision of the Administrative Department thereon shall be final and binding.

**16. Repeal and Savings.** (1) All existing rules and orders relating to matters covered by these rules shall stand superseded from the date these rules come into force. The rules in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed from the date(s) the corresponding provisions of these rules are enforced.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment, order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules/orders so repealed/ superseded shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
