Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by Chief Engineer, PW (R&B) Department, Jammu, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Chhatroo, vide letter No. SDM/C/LA/17/23-29 dated 04-04-2018 for land measuring 20 Kanals and 01 Marla in Village Dhar, Tehsil Mugalmaidan, and District Kishtwar for construction of Khojgam to Loie Dhar Phase-III link road under PWD (R&B);

Whereas, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Chhatroo, vide letter No. SDMC/LA/19/252 dated 03-10-2019 has reported that the notification

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Chhatroo, vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector, Land Acquisition (DC), Kishtwar vide No. DCK/LA/2019/623 dated 05-10-2019, duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. 502/3786/PWD/Dhar/Kishtwar/19/2928 dated 27-11-2019 and Financial Commissioner, Revenue, J&K, Jammu vide No. FCLS/LA-5058/2020 dated 16-03-2020 has been examined and it has been found that the land owners did not file any objection to the proposed acquisition;

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the land particulars whereof are given above is required for public purpose viz. for construction of Khojgam to Loie Dhar Phase-III link road under PWD (R&B).

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 20 Kanals and 01 Marla in Village Dhar, Tehsil Mugalmaidan, and District Kishtwar for construction of Khojgam to Loie Dhar Phase-III link road under PWD, (R&B). Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Chhatroo of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person(s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be personally responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/ rules in force, while making the award.

- 1. Sub-clause (i) of clause 5 (a) shall be substituted by the following:
  - õ(i) A member with the permission of the Managing Committee of the Society may transfer his/her share of interest to his/her son/daughter, or son-in-law/daughter-in-law or brother/sister or father/mother or nephew or a cousin brother/sister or his nominees provided that the nominee abides by the terms/conditions laid down in the lease deed and the Bye-laws of the Society and is admissible to become the member of the Society, and shall not include any person who is disqualified for membership of the Society under Rule 7 of the Jammu and Kashmir Co-operative Societies Rules, 2001.ö
- 2. Sub-clause (d) of clause 9 shall be substituted by the following:
  - õ(d) Any member with the prior permission of the Managing Committee may transfer his/her residential plot/house/shop

  - 3. Advances from the Fund shall be made for the purposes of meeting unforeseen expenditure including expenditure on a new service not contemplated in the Annual Financial Statement.
  - 4. Applications for advances from the Fund shall be referred to the Finance Department by the Administrative Department. The applications shall give :ô
    - (i) brief particulars of the additional expenditure involved;
    - (ii) the circumstances in which provision could not be included in the Budget;
    - (iii) the reasons why its postponement is not possible;
    - (iv) the amount required to be advanced from the Fund with full cost of the proposal for the year or part of the year, as the case may be; and
    - (v) the grant or appropriation under which supplementary provision will eventually have to be obtained.
  - 5. Supplementary estimates for all expenditure so financed shall be presented to the Legislative Assembly at the first session meeting immediately after the advance is sanctioned. As soon as the State Legislative Assembly has authorized the additional expenditure by including it in any Supplementary Appropriation Act, the advances made from the Fund shall be resumed to the Fund.
- **Note 1 :**ô In exceptional circumstances to be recorded in writing, the supplementary estimates, when they cannot be presented to the Legislative Assembly in the ensuing session, may be so presented at a subsequent session.
- **Note 2** :ô While presenting to the Legislative Assembly estimates for all expenditure financed from the Contingency Fund, a note to the following effect will be appended to such estimates.

- Note 3:ô If the expenditure on a new service not contemplated in the Annual Financial Statement can be met, wholly or partly, from savings available within authorized appropriation, the note appended to the estimate submitted shall be in the following form:ô

2. Whereas, during their personal checking Police recovered 01 UBGL, 02 UBGL grenades and 17 AK rounds from the possession of accused Mushtaq Ahmad Mir. 01 UBGL Grenade, 02 AK Magazines

- 3. Whereas, a case FIR No. 125/2020 u/s 18, 20, 23 ULA(P) Act, 1967, was registered in Police Station Sopore and investigation of the case was taken up; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation site plan of place of occurance and seizure memo of recovered arms/ammunition was prepared, statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the course of investigation it was revealed that the accused persons were motivated by the LeT Commander Sajad Ahmad Mir @ Haider S/o Gh. Qadir Mir R/o Brath Kallan Sopore to join the LeT outfit; and
- 6. Whereas, during further investigation it was revealed that after joining the outfit the LeT commander Sajad Ahmad Mir @ Haider provided arms/ammunition to the accused persons namely 1. Mushtaq Ahmad Mir, 2. Mudasir Ahmad Mir and 3. Ather Shams Mir for carrying out the attacks on Police/Security forces in the Sopore area however, with timely arrest of the accused persons by the security forces, a big happening of terrorist action was averted; and
- 7. Whereas, the LeT commander Sajad Ahmad Mir @ Haider has been killed in an encounter at Keeri Baramulla on 17-08-2020 and was accordingly dropped from the case; and
- 8. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused persons in the commission of offences punishable under Unlawful

- - Mushtaq Ahmad Mir S/o Ab. Gaffar 18, 20, 23
     Mir R/o Brath Kallan, Sopore. ULA(P) Act
  - Mudasir Ahmad Mir S/o Mohammad Hamza Mir R/o Brath Kallan, Sopore.
  - Ather Shams-u-Din Mir S/o Shams-u-Din Mir R/o Brath Kallan, Sopore.
- 9. Whereas, the authority appointed by the Government under subsection (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the case diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section(2) of section 45 of the ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accords sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18, 20, 23 Unlawful Activities(Prevention) Act. 1967, in the case FIR No. 125/2020 of Police Station Sopore.
