- 1. **Name :** The name of the Society shall be the Society for Revival, Restoration, Preservation and Maintenance of Architecture and Heritage in J&K.
- 2. Area of Operation : The Headquarter of the Society shall be at Lal Mandi, Srinagar and Camp Office at Mubarak Mandi, Jammu.
- 3. Objectives : The objectives of the Society shall be,ô
 - to highlight the need and necessity of revival, restoration, renovation of the shrines, temples, other religious places and historic monuments of Jammu and Kashmir and facilitate such a process;
 - ii. to guide in creating a branding/positioning strategy and to ensure protection and longevity of these places ;
 - iii. to evolve and approve mechanisms for creating innovative platforms so that visitors and other stakeholders can be engaged while they visit these places ; and
 - iv. to identify the sacred places and heritage sites requiring intervention and to promote restoration wherever damage has occured to these places.

- 4. **Authorities of the Society :** The following shall be the authorities of the Society ; namely :ô

BYE-LAWS OF SOCIETY FOR REVIVAL, RESTORATION, PRESERVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ARCHITECTURE AND HERITAGE IN J&K

- Title : These Bye-laws may be called Bye-laws of Society for Revival, Restoration, Preservation and maintenance of Architecture and Heritage in J&K.
- 2. **Definitions :** In these Bye-laws, also known as Rules of Society, the following words and expressions shall have the following meaning unless repugnant to the subject or context :ô
 - a. Act means the Societies Registration Act, 1860;
 - b. Governing Body means the Governing Body of the Society ;
 - c. **Executive Committee** means the Executive Committee of the Society ;
 - d. **District Level Committee** means the District Level Committee of the Society ;
 - e. Chairman means the Chairman of the Society ;
 - f. **Chief Executive Officer** means the Chief Executive Officer of the Society ;
 - g. Financial Advisior means the Financial Advisor of the Society ;
 - h. Society means the Society for Revival, Restoration, Preservation and Maintenance of Architecture and Heritage in J&K;
 - i. Words and expressions used in these bye-laws and not defined herein but defined in the Act shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Act.

- 3. **Officers of the Society :** The following shall be the officers of the Society :ô
 - i. Chairman;
 - ii. Chief Executive Officer;
 - iii. Financial Advisior.
- 4. Chairman : Honøble Lieutenant Governor of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir shall be the Chairman of the Society.
- 5. **Powers and duties :** In order to ensure the efficient administration of the Society, the Chairman shall have the following powers and duties namely :ô
 - i. to exercise all financial and administrative powers in respect of the Society;
 - ii. to exercise all powers of appointing authority in respect of staff of the Society ;
 - iii. call for reports from the Chief Executive Officer as per his discretion;
 - iv. preside over the meeting of the Governing Body of the Society ;
 - v. issue such instructions as he may consider necessary to the Chief Executive Officer for smooth functioning of the Society.
- 6. Chief Executive Officer : (1) The Director, Archives, Archaeology and Museums, J&K shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Society.

(2) The Chief Executive Officer shall be the Ex-officio Member Secretary of the Governing Body, Executive Committee and any other Committee as may be constituted by the Government from time to time.

- 7. **Powers and duties :** The Chief Executive Officer shall have the following powers namely :ô
 - i. to be the custodian of the records and other property of the Society as the Government may commit to his charge ;
 - ii. to conduct official correspondence on behalf of the authorities of the Society;

- iii. to issue all notices convening meetings of the authorities of the Society;
- iv. to keep minutes of the authorities of the Society ;
- v. to exercise all the powers administrative and financial for the Society;
- vi. to supervise accounts of the Society to be operated by the Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the Society ; and
- vii. to execute all contracts on behalf of the Society.
- 8. **Financial Advisior :** The Finance Secretary of Jammu and Kashmir shall be the Financial Advisor of the Society.
- 9. **Powers and duties :** The Financial Advisior shall have the following powers and duties namely :ô
 - i. to advise the Society in all matters relating to the management of finances of the Society ;
 - ii. to consider all proposals for new expenditure ; and
 - iii. to consider the audit report of the Society.
- 10. Authorities of the Society : The following shall be the authorities of the Society :ô
 - i. Governing Body;
 - ii. Executive Committee ;
 - iii. District Level Committee.
- 11. **Governing Body :** The Governing Body of the Society shall consist of the following namely :ô
 - i. Chairman;
 - ii. Chief Secretary ;
 - iii. Administrative Secretary, Finance Department ;
 - iv. Divisional Commissioner, Jammu/Kashmir;
 - v. Administrative Secretary, Culture Department;

- vi. Administrative Secretary, Tourism Department ;
- vii. Director, Archives, Archaeology and Museums, J&K ;
- viii. Chief Town Planner, Jammu/Kashmir ;
- ix. Chief Architect, Jammu/Kashmir ;
- x. Director, Tourism, Jammu/Kashmir;
- xi. Director, Planning, Culture Department;
- xii. Five experts to be nominated by the Government.
- 12. **Powers and duties :** The Governing Body shall have the following powers and duties namely :ô
 - i. to consider and approve programmes and projects proposed by the Executive Committee or District Level Committee of the Society, as the case may be ;
 - ii. to do all other such act as may be required for the maintenance, organization and performance of the functions of the Society.
- 13. **Meetings :** The Governing Body shall meet at least once a year. However, in certain circumstances a special meeting of the Governing Body may be convened as and when necessary.
- 14. **Executive Committee :** The Executive Committee of the Society shall consist of the following :ô

- 15. **Power and duties :** The Executive Committee shall have the following powers and duties namely :ô
 - i. to exercise the Executive Authority of the Society in all matters of finance, administrative and organization ;
 - ii. to consider and approve programmes, proposals and projects of the Society.
- 16. **Meetings :** The Executive Committee shall meet at least twice a year alternately at Srinagar and Jammu.
- 17. **District Level Committee :** The District Level Committee shall be the Coordination-cum-Implementation Committee of the Society, which shall consist of the following :ô
 - i. District Development Commissioner ;
 - ii. Additional Deputy Commissioner;
 - iii. Superintending Engineer, PW(R&B) Department (concerned district);
 - iv. Deputy Director, Archives, Archaeology and Museums of the respective division ;
 - v. Representative of the Director, Tourism, of the respective division not below the rank of Deputy Director ;
 - vi. Chief Education Officer (concerned district) ;
 - vii. District Statistics and Evaluation Officer.

- 18. **Powers and duties :** The District Level Committee shall have the following powers and duties namely :ô
 - i. to conduct the heritage census and survey of the shrines, temples and other religious and historic monuments in coordination with the Directorate of Archives, Archaeology and Museums for their restoration, revival, preservation and maintenance, after such activity is approved by the Executive Committee ;
 - ii. to ascertain need and necessity of revival/restoration and renovation of sacred religious assets and historic monuments, and facilitate and coordinate such restoration, revival, preservation and maintenance work;
 - iii. to collect/receive funds and give grants for fulfillment of the objectives of the *::*Society for revival, restoration, preservation and maintenance of architecture and heritage in J&Kø;
 - iv. to prioritize and propose steps for protection and longevity of identified sacred and heritage structures and suggest steps for restoration, wherever any damage has occurred, and also formulate and finalize appropriate action plan for this purpose and for the approval of the Executive Committee ;
 - v. to restore to original position, the designated heritage/sacred structure or place, adhering to same building material and workmanship, as per the approved action plan;
 - vi. to upgrade the infrastructure at these places of worship and heritage monuments and develop the land appurtenant to the sites and their surroundings, in consultation with stakeholder, as per the approved action plan;
 - vii. to monitor and supervise the execution and restoration work in close consultation with management of trust of religious place/ heritage monuments, wherever in place ; and
 - viii. to report the progress to the Executive Committee on quarterly basis.
- 19. **Corpus Fund :** The Society shall have a Corpus Fund to be determined by the Department of Culture in consultation with the Finance Department which shall be supported by Annual Grants by the

20. Activity : (1) The scheme for revival, restoration, preservation and maintenance of architecture and heritage in J&K shall be run as per the objectives, given in the policy document circulated by the Department of Culture as amended from time to time.

(2) The revival, preservation and restoration work, wherever, required shall be carried out by the Society strictly in accordance with laws/ regulations governing heritage conservation.

21. **Casual vacancies :** (1) A casual vacancy in any of the authorities of the Society shall be filled either by appointment of nomination as the case may be.

(2) No act or proceeding of the Society shall be deemed to be invalid by reason merely of the existence of any vacancy or any defect in the Constitution of the committees.

22. **Staff**: (1) The Society may create such staff as is required for its smooth functioning with prior approval of its Executive Committee.

(2) The staff requirement of the Society shall be met by the Government as per Society requirement to be projected by the Chief Executive Officer from time to time.

- 23. Audit : The accounts of the Society shall be audited by Statutory Auditors who shall be specifically appointed by the Society for the purpose.
- 24. **Sue and be sued :** The Society may sue or be sued in the name of the Chief Executive Officer.
- 25. **Miscellaneous :** The development of heritage sites, architecture and such other assets shall be as per the provisions of relevant laws governing maintenance and preservation of architectural heritage in the Union of India.
- 26. **Amendment :** The rules of the Society shall not be amended except by a resolution passed by two-third majority of the members present at the meeting of the Executive Committee convened for the purpose.

27. **Right of the Government :** Notwithstanding anything contained in any of the clauses of Memorandum of Association/Bye-laws of the Society, the Government may issue such directives as it may consider necessary for smooth functioning of the Society. The Society shall give immediate effect to the directives so issued.

1. Whereas, Municipal Committee, Qazigund is charging different taxes on different trades/activities undertaken within the limits of Municipal Committee, Qazigund and perusal of the tax schedule presently in force has been sanctioned in the year-2014.

2. Whereas, Director, Urban Local Bodies, Srinagar (Kmr.) vide No. DULB/G/994/8731-8812 dated 14-03-2022 and letter No. DULB/G/ 994/2022/10786-10866 dated 28-03-2022 has directed that Trade Tax and License fee schedules in respect of all commercial trades be immediately revised to bring it at par with the market potential of concerned areas.

3. Whereas, in pursuance to section õ66ö of J&K Municipal Act, 2000 and by virtue of resolution passed on 30-03-2022, passed in the meeting of elected body of Municipal Committee, Qazigund, the Municipality decided to revise its existing Fee/Tax Schedule within the Municipal Limits of Qazigund and its urban outgrowths w.e.f. 01- 04-2022, as per the enclosed fee structure.

4. Whereas, by virtue of sub-section (6) of section 70 of J&K Municipal Act, 2000 (which is reproduced hereinafter) that Municipal Committees are empowered to sanction the tax schedule at their own level, when the Municipality has finally settled its proposal, it shall, if the proposed tax falls under clause (i) to clause (XVI) of sub-section (i) of section 66 direct that the tax be imposed, and shall forward a copy of its order to that effect, to the Deputy Commissioner, Director, to the Government.

5. Whereas, a notification vide this office No. MC/Qzd/2022-23/ 588-94 dated 11-04-2022, has been issued and published in two newspapers against Acknowledge No. 105540 for the information of General Public that objections with regard to revised fee structure/tax schedule (if any) shall be submitted in the office of undersigned as well as in the Office of Director, Urban Local Bodies, Srinagar within 30 (thirty days) from the publication and after expiry of the stipulated period, no objection will be entertained/considered and the revised tax schedule shall be deemed to have been sanctioned/implemented.

Award

Synopsis :

1. The application have alleged in this claim petition that they (35-Noø.) were engaged as Security Guards Supervisor and Lady Searcher through Security Contractor for a period of one year i. e. for a period from 01-05-2003 to 30-04-2004 with the stipulation that applicantsø services will be terminable by serving a notice of two months but their services were terminated on 13-06-2003 without following the terms and conditions of the contract and allegedly without adhering to the principles of natural justice in as much as no notice was served on them as mentioned herein above. It is pleaded by the applicants that they had been working since prior to the above referred period/contract and their termination being against the law therefore their services need to be restored. They have also pleaded that they even contributed towards Provident Fund and their termination/ retrenchment is tantamount to their victimization.

2. This is their further case that they were appointed against clear vacancies after an agreement for supplying Security Guards for watch and ward, prevention of pilferage, protection and safeguarding the respondentøs hotel properties was reached between M/S National Security Consultant (respondent No. 2) with respondent No. 1. They discharged their duties without a single complaint and in an unblemished manner, therefore their termination from service is against the provisions of Section 25 G of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 as such their retrenchment order is unlawful and unwarranted and therefore it must be withdrawn and the services of the retrenched petitioners need to be revived with full back wages and interest. They have prayed that the non-applicants may be directed to allow the applicants to continue on their respective posts which they were holding at the time of termination.

3. Respondents 1, 4 and 5 have submitted objections jointly stating that respondent No. 1 is in the practice of inviting tenders annually for

4. Respondent No. 3 has however filed his sparate written demurrer wherein it is stated that the portioners are not sure which agency has employed them ; that the selection process was initiated by appointing authority ; that even the contract with appointing authority had expired much before 05-05-2003. So respondent No. 3 is not liable for their termination from service ; that this Tribunal lacks jurisdiction in view of the petitioners averment in para 8 of claim petition that they had entered into contract with the employer as such they have the remedy under the Specific Relief Act only and not under Labour Laws ; that the respondent No. 3 is absolved of its liability, if any, on the petitionersø admission in para 11 of the petition that they were selected and engaged by respondent No. 2.

5. The matter-in-controversy was taken up for conciliation before the Deputy. Labour Commissioner, Srinagar (Kashmir) under the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 but the conciliation fail and this reference for adjudication by this Tribunal is made by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir through Commissioner Secretary to Government, Labour and

- Legality or otherwise of the action of the Management viz.; General Manager Centaur Lake View Hotel, Srinagar, Kashmir, National Security Consultant, Abid Security Consultants in terminating the services of its workers (35 Security Guards); and
- 2. Awards for appropriate relief to the said employees in case the illegality of the action of the Management is established.

6. Parties appeared through advocates Petitioners have filed evidence in the shape of affidavits etc. and both the parties have filed a number of documents that include copies of agreement showing terms and conditions ; copies of payments etc. of Provident Fund etc.

7. Heard learned counsel for the parties. They have also filed written arguments each. I have gone through the entire record on file.

8. In the light of documentary as well oral evidence on file and in view of arguments advanced on behalf of the parties the controversy appears to be much simple and can be precisely resolved with the aid of settled position of law. There is no denying the fact that petitioners (35 Noø.) were working in **"Centaur Lake View Hotel, Srinagar"** when their services were terminated on 13-06-2003 notwithstanding the fact that they were engaged by contractor viz. respondent No. 3 for a period of one year from 01-05-2003 to 30-04-2004. The Conciliation proceeding initiated by the Deputy Commissioner, Labour Department, Srinagar having been failed, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir referred the matter to this Tribunal in terms of Section 10(1)(c) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 by framing the above noted issue. The Conciliation Authority has referred the matter to this Tribunal for appropriate findings with respect to the controversy between the parties. The issue of references are already reproduced hereinabove. Obviously the scope for adjudication by this

9. This Tribunal is therefore required to address the pivotal question as to whether the petitioners were employees of respondent No. 1, if yes, their termination against the terms and conditions, without service of the required notice and payment of back wages, appears to unwarranted. In coming to this conclusion the core question is "whether they were the employees of respondent No. 1, CLVH, Srinagar"?

10. Let us see the record on file in order to trace the reply of the supra question. On behalf of the petitioners much emphasis is laid on the terms and conditions of agreement@clause 9....] and it is seriously canvassed that no adherence is made in terminating the petitioners. This needs to be stated at the outset that there is no agreement between the petitioners and the respondent No. 1 CLVH, Srinagar. The agreement which is vehemently harped at by the petitioners advocate is between the petitioners and respondent No. 2, National Security Consultants and not with respondent No. 1. The agency supplying workers/petitioners to the respondent No.1 agreed that it has no privity even with respondent No. 3. As per clause 9 of the contract that -The security staff posted to CLVH Unit will be under the Administrative discipline and functional control of the General Manager/Security Manager CLVH, Srinagar and will carry out the duties and functions as assigned to it from time to time by the General Manager/Security Manager. The Security staff will however be under your overall control which includes punctuality of the staff provided by the contractor of The concluding words in this clause make it amply clear that the õStaff i. e. the 35 petitioners were employed and provided to respondent No. 1 by respondent No. 3, National Security Consultants". This is only after their employment by respondent No. 3 that respondent No. 2, CLVH with whom they were to work is given a

11. This may be stated herein that the burden to establish that the petitioners are the employees of the respondent No. 1, is on the petitioners only which they have miserably failed to discharge [General Manager (OSD), Bengal Nagpur Cotton Mills Rajnandgaon Vs. Bharat Lal, 2010 AIR SCW 7312]. The respondent No. 1 has vehemently pleaded that it never engages nor appoints security staff by itself rather it is the particular Security Agency that employs and provides such security staff to the respondent and the petitioners have brought no evidence documentary or oral, which may be so convincing that this Tribunal may be left with no option except to believe it. This is the further case of respondents that it is for the contractor viz. National Security Consultants to engage personnel to its satisfaction and provide to respondent No...It is the prerogative of the contractor to terminate the services of so engaged personnel by the Agency only and accordingly the petitioners have no relationship of master and servant. Obviously therefore none of the respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5 is under any obligation to retrench or terminate their services or serve a notice or pay the back wages. The claimants/petitioners have not proved to the contrary by any iota of evidence nor such relationship stands proved from the documents on file. The tangible case of the respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5 is that, as it is pleaded on their behalf, that the petitioners have engaged by respondents 2/3 and not by respondents 1, 4 and 5, as the petitioners were engaged by the contractor only and there is no privity between the petitioners and non-applicants 1, 4 and 5. Referring to clause 18 of the contract drawn between the contractor and respondents 1, 4 and 5 it is impressed upon by the respondents advocate that -contract regulates relationship between contractor and non-applicants and notice referred to in the said clause is required to be given to contractor and not to personnel engaged by the contractor a Therefore the argument regarding service of notice to petitioner before terminating their services is the matter between the contractor and the petitioner and not between the petitioners and respondent Nos. 1, 4 and 5, therefore this argument of the petitioner also pales into insignificance.

12. This apart, it is proved on facts on file that the petitioners were engaged by the contractors as such it was the supplying agency alone that the Security Agency was obliged to make payment to the petitioners and non-applicant Nos. 1, 4 and 5 had no obligation towards them, be it their wages or other service benefits. Clause 7 makes it further clear that liability in respect of Employees State Insurance, Provident Fund and Gratuity etc. is that of the contractor only towards the staff/petitioners supplied by him. By virtue of stipulation in the contract, the respondents are given liberty to ask for change of the security staff and the stipulation in clause 8 binds the contractor, who is under obligation to change security staff and provide adequate replacement to the respondents 1, 4 and 5, as per clause 9 of the agreement, the security staff will be under overall control of the contractor [Clause 9 and 17] that makes it further clear that monthly bills for the security staff and for services provided by the contractor shall be raised by the Contractor in the first week of next months. The overwhelming documentary evidence fully supports the respondents version that they are not employer nor obliged to terminate petitioners services nor did they do in this case, but it is the respondents No. 2 and 3 who can be said to be their employers and under legal obligation contractually to abide by the terms and conditions of the Contract between them and no liability can thus be fastened on respondents 1, 4 and 5. In view of this factual situation and settled position of law there is no illegality committed by the respondents 1, 4 and 5 viz. General, Manager Centaur Lake View Hotel, Srinagar, Kashmir etc. by asking the supplying agency that they don-t need the services of these person/persons who, in his turn discontinued their services in terms of the agreement between them and National Security Consultants/Respondent No. 2. Similarly the role of respondent No. 3 i.e. Abid is insignificant. It would not be exaggeration to say that his role is nil in this entire transaction. If at all the petitioners have some grievance, the remedy does not lie before this Tribunal. If advised they can move the other competent forum for redressal of their grievances. The reference, made by Deputy Labour Commissioner, Srinagar under section10(1)(c)

13. Kashmir, National Security Consultants, Abid Security Consultants in terminating the services of its workers (35 Security Guards) and pass any "awards for appropriate relief to the said employees in case the illegality of the action of the Management in established", as no illegality etc. is found to have been committed by the respondents, the reference is answered in the negative and claim petition is dismissed as not maintainable. Parties to bear their respective costs of the litigation. There is catena of authority on the points of controversy but as the ample available documentary or otherwise fully supports the respondents version their is no need to replete and overload the judgment by reference to various case law-judgments etc. The reference is answered accordingly.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Board of Directors, the Jammu Power Distribution Corporation Limited hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

1. Short title and commencement.

- (1) These rules may be called õThe Jammu Power Distribution Corporation Limitedö (Regularization) of PDL/TDL and other Workers Rules, 2022.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

(3) They shall apply to the PDL/TDL and other workers engaged in the erstwhile Power Development Department.

2. Definitions.

In these rules unless the subject or context otherwise requires.ô

- (a) õAppointed dateö means the date of notification of the Jammu and Kashmir Power Development Department (Re-Organization) first transfer scheme, 2020;
- (b) õAadhaar Based Bio-Metric Identification and Skill Profiling of PDL/TDL workersö means online registration/uploading of their Bio data in compliance to Government Order No. 126-F of 2016 dated. 28.04.2016.
- (c) "Board of Directors or Board" means the collective body of the Directors of the Company.
- (d) õCompetent Authorityö means the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- (e) õContinuous Workingö of a PDL/TDL worker means the working of a person after his first engagement in the Corporation continuously without any break except on account of holidays/Sundays and not more than two days break in a period of 90 calendar days;
- (f) õCompanyö or õCorporationö means the Company incorporated as a fully owned Government Company under the Companies Act, 1956/ Companies Act, 2013;
- (g) õGovernmentö means the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- (h) "Jammu Power Distribution Corporation Limitedö or õJPDCLö means the Company incorporated after the unbundling and reorganization of the Department in terms of Companies Act for managing the functions of Power Distribution in the Jammu Province.
- (i) "Managing Director" means Managing Director of the Corporation appointed by the Government ;

- (j) "PDL/TDL Worker and other Worker" means a person who is engaged through a proper order or otherwise on daily rated bases for rendering casual services in the Corporation;
- (k) õRegularizationö means absorption in the Corporation on permanent basis;
- (l) õWagesö means remuneration paid/payable to a person working as PDL/TDL in the Corporation;
- (m) Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined herein, shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956;

3. Application of Rules.

(1) These rules shall apply to PDL/TDL and Other Workers who have been :

 Engaged upto 17-03-2015 when powers to make such engagements were withdrawn vide Government Order No. 43-F of 2015 dated. 17-03-2015 read with Corrigendum issued vide No. A/Misc/20 15/391 dated. 20-03-2015.

4. Eligibility for regularization.

(1) PDL/TDL and other workers shall be eligible for regularization under these rules on fulfillment of the following conditions that;

- i. he/she is a Domicile of the Union Territory of J&K;
- ii. he/she possesses minimum educational qualification of 8th Standard ;
- iii. On the date of his/her initial engagement, his/her age was within the minimum and maximum age limit as prescribed for appointment in Government Service.
- iv. he/she must have completed seven years of continuous service and the Aadhaar based Bio metric identification and skill profiling must have been done in pursuance to Government Order No. 126-F of 2016 dated. 28-04-2016.
- v. his/her work and conduct are satisfactory, and no disciplinary/ criminal proceedings are pending against him or her.

- vi. he/she is not involved in any Anti National/Subversive activities.
- vii he/she must be alive/continuing in the Corporation as on date.
- viii. The provisions of Article 35A of the J&K Civil Service Regulations shall apply to a PDL/TDL worker in respect of the determination and the verification of the age.

5. Regularization of PDL/TDL & Other workers.

- All the PDL/TDL and other workers who on appointed date are eligible under Rule 4 for regularization shall be appointed on regular pay scale of Rs. 2550-3200 PR as prescribed under the Jammu and Kashmir (Power Development Department) Subordinate Recruitment Rules, 1981.
- (2) The regularization of the PDL/TDL and other workers shall strictly be made as per the initial engagement order in the erstwhile Power Development Department.
- (3) The process of regularization of these PDL/TDL and other workers shall be as per the following procedure.
- (4) There shall be a Divisional Level Committee (DLC) consisting of;
- i. Chief Engineer, (Distribution), JPDCL (Chairman)
- ii. Superintending Engineer, O&M Circle-1st (Member)
- iii. Chief Accounts Officer, Distribution JPDCL (Member)
- iv. Executive Engineer (Member to be nominated by the Chairman)
- v. Administrative Officer, (Distribution), JPDCL (Member-Secretary)
- (5) The cases of all the PDL/TDL and other workers eligible for regularization under rule 4 of these rules shall be placed before the Divisional Level Committee for scrutiny and verification with regard to their appointment under these rules.
- (6) After completion of the process of scrutinization and verification, the Divisional Level Committee shall forward its findings to the

Head Corporate i.e., the office of Managing Director, Jammu Power Distribution Corporation Ltd. for placing the same before the Board of Directors of the Corporation for final approval.

(7) After the approval from the Board of Directors of the Corporation, appointment orders shall be issued by the Chairman Divisional Level Committee (DLC).

6. Maintenance of Seniority lists

Seniority of the members of service shall be regulated under Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Chairman District Level Committees shall maintain their seniority.

7. Interpretation

In case of any dispute with regard to interpretation of any provisions contained in the rules, the matter shall be referred to the Board of Directors of the Corporation, whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

8. Repeal and Savings

Once the process of appointments of eligible PDL/TDL and other workers under these rules is completed, the operation of these rules shall cease to have any effect.

Notwithstanding its repeal, any action taken in pursuance of these rules shall be deemed to be valid and protected.
