

SOó08.ô In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

- 1. **Short title and commencement :—** (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture (Gazetted) Services Recruitment Rules, 2022;
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. **Definitions** :óIn these rules, unless the context otherwise requires.ô
 - (a) "Administrative Department" means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the administrative charge of the service;
 - (b) "Commission" means the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission;
 - (c) "Cadre" means the cadre of the Service :
 - (d) "Government" means the Government of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
 - (e) "Head of the Department" means the Major Head of the Department holding the administrative control of the organization;
 - (f) "Member of Service" means a person appointed to a post in the (Gazetted) Service under the provisions of these rules;
 - (g) "Post" means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the Competent Authority;
 - (h) "Rules" means the Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture (Gazetted) Service Recruitment rules, 2022;
 - (i) "Selection Agency" means the agency constituted by the Government for making recruitment to a particular class of post;
 - (j) "Schedule" means the Schedules annexed to these rules;
 - (k) "Service" means the Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture (Gazetted) Service ;
 - (l) Words and expressions used in these rules, but not defined, shall have the same meaning, as assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations as amended from time to time.
- 3. Constitution of Services: (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the ::Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture (Gazetted) Service@

(2) The Government may, at the time of commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person, who at the commencement of these rules, is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service;

Provided that for purpose of initial constitution of the service, the person holding any post in a substantive capacity to which he/she was appointed by the competent authority under rules, included in the cadre of the service in its sanctioned pay band with applicable grade pay, shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise withen 15 days from the commencement of these rules:

EXPLANATION: The word ::holding@means a person holding a post included in the cadre of the Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture grade pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on excadre/deputation basis or on adhoc or in a stop-gam arrangement.

(4) Strength and composition of the service :-(1) The authorized permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of posts included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time and shall at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in the ScheduleóI.

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre of the service for specified period or purpose, as may be considered necessary, from time to time.

- (2) The Government shall, at the interval or every five years or at such other intervals, as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alterations therein as it deems fit.
- (5) Qualification and Method of Recruitment :-(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he/she possesses the qualifications as laid down in ScheduleóII and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the general rules and orders for the time being in force.

- - (2) First appointment to the service or class may be made :ô
 - (a) By Direct Recruitment; or
 - (b) By Promotion; or
 - (c) Partly by (a) and partly by (b) in the ration and in the manner as mentioned against each post in ScheduleóII.

Provided that all the posts under direct recruitment shall be filled up through J&K Public service Commission as per the rules/orders of the Government issued for the purpose.

Provided further that all posts to be filled by promotion shall be filled through Departmental Promotion/Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission unless any post/category of posts is exempted from the purview of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission.

- (3) The Department shall refer vacancies in the direct/promotion quota to the Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Commission and Departmental Promotion Committee as the case may be in terms of SRO-166 dated 14-06-2005 as amended from time to time.
- (6) **Probation**:—(1) Probation of persons appointed to the Service through direct recruitment shall be regulated in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Conditions of Service, Pay and Allowances) Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 and in all other cases under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.
- (2) The pay of a person appointed to the service through direct recruitment shall be regularized in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Conditions of Service, Pay and Allowances) Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 and in all other cases as per the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulations or General Rules as issued from time to time.
- 7. **Reservation in Appointment:** While making appointments either by direct recruitment or by promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders used from time to time for members of the Scheduled Tribes/Backward Clases or any other category or class of persons under the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the Rules made thereunder.

Government may prescribe:

Provided that the Government may exempt, either wholly or partially from such training or departmental examinations, persons who have passed a departmental examination or undergone training declared by the Government to be equivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

9. Eligibility of Government servants for Direct Recruitment:— A Person already in the Government service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the service, if he/she possesses the educational and any other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of post. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be provided in he general rules.

Provided that in the case of a post, which requires a higher degree of specialization and or experience, the Government may prescribe a higher age limit in case of direct recruitment.

- 10. **Maintenance of Seniority Lists:** Seniority of the members of the Service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Administrative Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of members of the service.
- 11. **Residuary Matters:** In regard to matters not specifically covered by these rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the Union Territory Civil Service in general.
- 12. **Interpretation**:— If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.

- - 13. **Repeal and Saving**:— (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Sericulture (Gazetted) Service Recruitment rules, 1995 are hereby repealed.
 - (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment, order made or action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.



- 2. Whereas, a Case FIR No. 75/2021 under Section 363 IPC, came to be registered in Police Station, Srigufwara and investigation of the case was set into motion; and
- 3. Whereas, during investigation, one suspect Shamim Ahmad Wani S/o Gh. Nabi R/o Anchidora, Anantnag was arrested in connection with the case who during questioning disclosed that he along with his associates Taffazul Ahmad Beigh S/o Gh. Mohiudin R/o Beigh Pora, Awantipora, Mohammad Abid Parray S/o Mohammad Khalil R/o Naninara, Sumbal, Ab. Rashid Mir S/o Ali Mohammad R/o Shilwat, Sumbal and Fayaz Ahmad Kallo S/o Gh. Ahmad R/o Naninara, Sumbal were working for banned HM outfit and motivated/instigated Faizan Javaid and Basit Ahmad to join the terrorist ranks. Subsequently, Section 363 IPC. was dropped and Sections 13, 18, 18-B, 23, 39 ULA (P) were added in the case; and
- 4. Whereas, on the disclosure of accused Shamim Ahmad both the missing persons Faizan Javaid Rather and Basit Ahmad Dar were recovered from the residential house of accused Ab. Rashid Mir R/o Shilwat, Sumbal and on the disclosures of accused persons Shamim Ahmad, Taffazul Ahmad, Mohammad Abid and Ab. Rashid Mir, Police recovered 106 AK-47 rounds from their instances; and
- 5. Whereas, during investigation, seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused persons Shamim Ahmad, Taffazul Ahmad, Mohammad Abid, Ab. Rashid and Fayaz Ahmad were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the HM banned outfit and were providing shelter/logistic support to the terrorists of the said outfit, besides under well knit criminal conspiracy motivated/instigated accused Faizan Javaid and Bashit Ahmad to join the terrorist ranks to commit terrorist activities; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating officer has *prima facie* established involvement of the below mentioned accused persons

Whereas, on 07-08-2021, accused Shabir Ahmad Najar was arrested from village Khrew who was hiding in a vehicle (Truck) belonging to one Mohammad Shafi Dar S/o Mohammad Akber Dar R/o Gratwali Mohalla Khrew and during his personal search Police recovered 01 Chinese Pistol, 01 Pistol Magazine, 07 Pistol Rounds, 02 AKMagazines, 50 AK rounds, 01 Hand grende and 05 Kgm of explosive material from his possession which was provided to him by foreign terrorist Baber on his joining with the outfit; and
- 4. Whereas, during investigation, accused Mohammad Shafi Dar was also arrested in connection with the case and during investigation, he disclosed that he was in constant touch with terrorist Shabir Ahmad Najar and was providing shelter/logistic support to him and
- 5. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plan of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provision of law; and
- 6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused terrorist Baber R/o Pakistan facilitated the joining of terrorist Shabir Ahmad Najar with HM banned outfit and provided arms/ammunition to him for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area and accused Mohammad Shafi Dar was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for terrorist Shabir Ahmad and was providing shelter/logistic support to him, besides under well knit criminal conspiracy harboured/concealed him in his vehicle (Truck); and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons for the commission of offences puishable under sections as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967:ô

- 8. Whereas, accused Baber R/o Pakistan being active terrorist is absconding against whom proceeding under Section 299 Cr. PC has been proposed to be initiated; and
- 9. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 has independently examined the Case Diary File and all other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused persons; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 ULA (P) Act 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the above accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 18-B, 19, 20,23, 38, 39 of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, in the case FIR No. 52/2021 of Police Station Khrew Pampore.
