Whereas, the Director School Education Kashmir has placed an indent through Chief Education Officer Pulwama vide his office No. CEO/Pul/Plg/21/206-208 Dated 28-08-2021 for acquisition of land measuring 04 Kanals 15 Marlas falling under khasra No. 279 min situated in estate Bathen required for public purpose, namely construction of Government High School Bathen Tehsil Pampore.

Whereas, in accordance with Sub-Section 1 of Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013, the Committee of officers for conduct of field inspection stands already constituted by the Deputy

Commissioner Pulwama vide his office order No. DCP/LA/2020/610-630 dated 25-08-2020. Accordingly, the Committee was directed by this Collectorate vide office letter No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/588-96 dated 05-11-2021 to conduct a field inspection.

Whereas, members of the constituted Committee submitted their report through Tehsildar Pampore vide his office No. TP-OQ/1717 dated 14-12-2021. The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report/ Preliminary investigation reveals as under :ô

1. That the proposed acquisition of land serves the public purpose, as the establishment of Government High School Bathen upon land measuring 04 Kanals 15 Marlas bearing Survey No. 279 situated at Village Bathen shall benefit a huge number of students of the area.
2. The proposed land is absolute bare-minimum needed for the said institution at the said spot.
3. That the acquisition of land at an alternate place could not be considered as the school building has already been constructed on the said patch of land in the year 2015.
4. That no unutilized land has previously been acquired in the said area for the said purpose.
5. Recommendations.

The establishment/construction of the said school at Bathen, Tehsil Pampore will surely benefit a huge population of the area, especially the student community.

Moreover, the land identified for the construction of Government High School at Village Bathen of Tehsil Pampore does not have any social impact on local public.

On the basis of committee report it transpires that the land acquisition is a *bona fide* one as it is in the interest of the school education department for establishment of the school for the local population. Moreover, the school building stands already constructed over the private land. As such requires acquisition.

Now, therefore, it is notified that for the above said project land measuring 04 Kanals 15 Marlas is required for the construction of Government High School Bathen Tehsil Pampore District Pulwama.

Subsequently, 302 IPC was added in the case ; and
