Whereas, District Collector (DC), Ramban vide No. DC/LA/Rbn/
1498-99 dated 03-12-2021 resubmitted after addressing clarifications to
the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, who vide No. 502/4314/NABARD-
RIDF-XVI/Tethar/Rbn/21/2711 dated 31-12-2021 forwarded to Financial
Commissioner (Revenue), J&K for issuance of declaration/notification
under sections 6, 7 & 17 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 ; and

Whereas, Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K vide No. FCR/
LAND/15/2022-06/124594 dated 08-02-2022 returned the case to District
Collector (DC), Ramban for some clarification, who clarified the deficiencies

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM),
Banihal vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector
(DC), Ramban, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu and Financial
Commissioner (Revenue), J&K has been examined and it has been observed/
found that no one has filed any objection to the proposed acquisition ; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required
for public purpose i. e. construction of road from Khairkoot to Zabban
under NABARD RIDF-XVI situated at Village Tethar, Tehsil Banihal and
District Ramban.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K Land Acquisition
Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 43 Kanals
04 Marlas situated at Village Tethar, Tehsil Banihal and District Ramban is
required for public purposes i. e. construction of road from Khairkoot
to Zabban under NABARD RIDF-XVI. Further, the Collector, Land
Acquisition (SDM), Banihal is directed under section 7 of the said Act to
take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to
the interested person(s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Further, in pursuance of section 17 of the Land Acquisition Act,
Samvat 1990, it is also ordered that on expiry of fifteen days from the

Collector, will take possession of the aforementioned land at Village Tethar,

to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed under section 9(2) and

SO-166.ô Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity ; and

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Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the respective Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the scheme conveniently, the respective Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely :ô

- (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the respective Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
- (b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar one Time password or Time-based one-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered ;
- (c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar one Time password or Time_based one-Time password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the quick Response code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its implementing Agency.

4. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no *bona fide* beneficiary under the scheme is deprived of his due benefits, the respective Directorate of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs shall follow the exception handling mechanism put in place by Department of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, by way of providing nominee facility vide Government Order No. 61-JK(FCS&CA) of 2021 dated 04-08-2021 or as outlined in the office Memorandum of DBT

5. Whereas, the investigation in respect of the PAK handler namely Khubaib shall continue to bring out his role/involvement in the case ; and

SO-112.—Whereas, on 17-08-2021, Police Station, Yariapora received reliable information to the effect that some unidentified terrorists barged into house of one Javid Ahmad Dar S/o Mohammad Abdullah Dar R/o Brazloo, Jagir and fired indiscriminately upon him, resulting his on spot death. The terrorists after commission of crime fled away from the spot ; and

2. Whereas, upon the information, a case FIR No. 55/2021 U/Ss 302 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 13, 16, 18, 38, 39 ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Yariapora and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during investigation, Sections 201 IPC, 19, 23 ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, site plane of place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during investigation, one suspect namely, Owais Gulzar Tantray S/o Gulzar Ahmad R/o Kujar, Frisal was arrested in connection with the case and during investigation, it was established that the accused alongwith two terrorists of HM banned outfit Mohammad Aslam Dar S/o Mohammad Rafiq R/o Redwani Bala, Basit Amin Bhat S/o Mohammad Amin R/o Palpora Frisal and one Over Ground Worker (OGW) Aqib Shafi Badder S/o Mohammad Shafi R/o Badderpora, Qaimoh hatched conspiracy to carry out terror attacks on security forces and also to kill the said political activist Javaid Ahmad Dar ; and

5. Whereas, it was established that on 17-08-2021, terrorists Mohammmd Aslam Dar and accused OGW Aqib Shafi Badder barged in the house of deceased Javaid Ahmad Dar and fired indiscriminately upon him and other accused persons facilitated the above accused to carry out the said attack which resulted on spot death of Javaid Ahmad ; and

6. Whereas, terrorist namely, Mohammad Aslam Dar has been killed in an encounter with security forces and proceedings under law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :—

Hassan R/o Waghama and (5) Umar Ismail Dass S/o Mohd. Ismail R/o Waghama were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused were arrested in connection with the case ; and

5. Whereas, during further investigation, it was established that the above accused were working as OGWs for the terrorists of JeM outfit namely Amir Hussain Ganie S/o Abdul Rashid R/o Goriwan, Bijbehara, (2) Towseef Ahmad Bhat S/o Mohd. Ashraf R/o Marhama and (3) Sajad Ahmad Bhat S/o Mohammad Maqbool R/o Marhama active in the area and were providing shelter/logistic support to the above terrorists, besides were providing information about the movement of Security forces in the area ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation two terrorists Towseef Ahmad Bhat and Sajad Ahmad Bhat have been killed in an encounter on 18-06-2019 at Ompora Marhama for which case FIR No. 81/2019 stands registered in Police Station, Bijbehara ; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has *prima facie* established involvement of the below mentioned accused persons for commission of offences punishable under section(s) as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :—

3. Whereas, during investigation, accused Tariq Ahmad Najar was arrested in connection with the case and on his disclosure two other accused Liyaquat Ahmad Lone and Mohammad Shafi Bhat were also arrested in the case. However, accused Umar Khaliq Mir was arrested by Sopore Police in case FIR No. 142/2016 of P/S Sopore and his custody was changed in this case ; and

4. Whereas, during further investigation, site plane of place of occurrence was prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused Liqayat Ahmad Lone had joined the HM banned outfit after his release on bail from the said case and later on was killed in an encounter with the Security forces at Galoora Handwara, against whom proceedings shall abate ; and

Whereas, , it was also established that the accused Mohammad Shafi Bhat, Tariq Ahmad Najar and Umar Khaliq Mir were members of HM banned outfit and were under well knit criminal conspiracy were motivating/instigating youth of the area to join the terrorist ranks, besides, accused Mohammad Shafi and Tariq Ahmad facilitated the joining of accused Umar Khaliq with the HM banned outfit ; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused persons for commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :—

Whereas, during investigation, it was established that both the accused were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM banned outfit and procured two hand grenades from the terrorists under a well knit criminal conspiracy to carry out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused persons for commission of offences punishable under section(s) as shown against each of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :—

2. Whereas, upon the information, a case FIR No. 31/2019 U/Ss 10, 13 ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Handwara and investigation of the case was taken up ; and

3. Whereas, during course of investigation, site plane was prepared and statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohammad Ismail Lone has been found to have been associated with Jamaat-i-Islami, Jammu and Kashmir an unlawful association, even after the association was declared unlawful by the Central Government and continue advocating the secession of the Jammu and Kashmir from the Union of India and propagating anti-national and separatists sentiments prejudicial to the integrity and security of the country ; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against his name Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 :—
