No. 1094 of 2022/RG Dated 02-09-2022.

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 30 of the Jammu and Kashmir State Civil Courts Act, Svt.1977, the High Court has effected amendments to 'the Jammu and Kashmir Ministerial Staff and other Staff of the Subordinate Courts (Recruitment and Conditions of Service) Rules, 2016ø, as amended from time to time, as per **Annexure-"A"** and Schedules to the aforesaid Rules have been recast as per **Annexure-"B"** to this notification.

Annexure-A

- (i) The expression "High Court of Jammu and Kashmir" wherever appearing in the Rules be read as "High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh".
- (ii) The expression "State" wherever appearing in the Rules be read as "Union Territory".
- (iii) In Rule 2, clause(r) be inserted after clause (q) to read as under :ô
 - (r) **'Union Territory Level Recruitment Board'** means the Board constituted under the Rules or Regulations for the appointment of a person borne on the Union Territory cadre.

- (iv) In Rule 5, the expression "and A-1" appearing at both the places be deleted.
- (v) In Rule 10 (i), the expression "and B-1" be deleted.
- (vi) Rule 10 (ii) be recast as under :ô
 - õOnly domiciles of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir shall be eligible for appointment in the serviceö.
- (vii) In Rule 11, the words "permanent residents" be substituted by the expression "domiciles" and the expression "State" be substituted by the expression "Union Territory".
- (viii) the first para of Rule 12(i) be recast as under :ô
 - oThe appointments of ministerial staff of the Union Territory cadre and the Divisional Cadre shall be made by the Chief Justice, whereas the appointments of ministerial staff of District cadre shall be made by the District Judge of the District concerned in accordance with the procedure prescribed therefor under the Regulations framed by the Chief Justiceö.
- (ix) In clause (i) of sub-rule (i) of Rule 12, after the expression "Divisional", the words "or Union Territory level" be inserted.
- (x) In Rule 16 (I) (b), the words "Union Territory cadre and" be inserted after the words "belonging to the".
- (xi) In Rule 16 (I) (d), the words "belonging to both Divisional as well as the District Cadre" appearing after the words "members of the service" be deleted.
- (xii) In Rule 20, the words "Union Territory cadre and" be inserted after the words "ministerial staff of the".
- (xiii) In Rule 22, the words "Divisional or District Cadre" appearing after the words "belonging to the" be deleted and substituted by the expression "Service". In the same Rule, in its later part, the words "Union Territory cadre and" be inserted after the words "belonging to".

Subject :ô Acquisition of land measuring 90 Kanals 17 Marlas 98 Sft. situated at Village Mamath, Tehsil and District Budgam for construction of Semi Ring Road around Srinagar City.

Notification No. 36-Rev (LAK) of 2022

Dated 04-08-2022.

Whereas, on the basis of indent placed by the Project Director, National Highway Authority of India Limited (NHAI) vide No. PD/Sgr/14010/01/2014/LA-BDG/13 dated 20-04-2016, notification under section 4(1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition/ACR,

Whereas, Project Director, NHAI vide letter dated 11-08-2020 raised observations regarding the alignment and requested for de-notification of the land and fresh notification as per the approved alignment; and

Whereas, the land owners/interested persons objected to the said alignment and a writ petition titled Khursheed Ahmed Nazki & Ors. Vs. UT of J&K was filed in the Honøble High Court. Another writ petition titled Ghulam Hussain Bhat & Others Vs. State was also filed in the Honøble High Court and vide Order dated 10-09-2020 in the said writ petition it was ordered to complete acquisition proceedings strictly in terms of notification dated 28-03-2019, if there is no legal impediment; and

Whereas, fresh demarcation was carried out by revenue field staff in presence of representatives of NHAI and requested District Collector (DC), Budgam vide letter dated 25-03-2021 for preparation of fresh revenue papers as per the said demarcation. Accordingly, fresh revenue papers were prepared by the revenue field agencies as per the fresh demarcation for land measuring 92 Kanals, 18 Marlas and 06 Sft. and Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide letter dated 19-05-2021 submitted the case to Project Director, NHAI for authentication, who authenticated the revenue papers and returned the case vide letter dated 28-05-2021 with some observation as enumerated below :ô

- a. Land coming within the alignment under Survey No. 01 is
 01 Kanal, 19 Marlas instead of 03 Kanals 05 Marlas.
- b. Land coming within the alignment under Survey No. 2 is 3 Marlas instead of 15 Marlas.
- c. Survey No. 4 is not coming under the alignment of the road.

Whereas, keeping in view the approved alignment and fresh authenticated Khasra Paimaish of Village Mamath, corrigendum to

Whereas, few land owners submitted the objection and the brief account is given as under :ô

- i. Mr. Khurshid Ahmad Nazki S/o Mubarak Ahmad Nazki R/o Mamath has objected on the ground that the fresh notification is not as per the previous alignment and has prayed that the acquisition should be carried out as per the notification dated 28-03-2019. After 06 months fresh alignment was initiated to benefit some other person, as a result the land and house of applicant was shown in the alignment for which corrigendum notification was also issued on 17-03-2022. Various representations were made to the authorities and later on a writ petition was also filed in the Honøble High Court. He has requested to consider his objections and cancel the corrigendum notification in the light of HHC orders and in the interest of justice.
- ii. Mr. Aijiz Ahmad S/o Mohd. Ibrahim R/o Gupkar Road, Srinager and Abdul Salam Dar S/o Gh. Mohammad Dar R/o Razwen have objected to the proceedings as per the erstwhile land acquisition Act and have prayed that the notification be withdrawn and fresh acquisition proceedings be initiated as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

Whereas, the objectors were given an opportunity of being heard under section 5(2) of the Act and their statements have been recorded which were corroborated with the written objections; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam intimated that the notification under section 4 (1) and subsequent corrigendum have been under the Land Acquisition Act, as the proceedings of land acquisition for the said project in other 43 villages have also been carried out under State Land Acquisition Act and if the proceedings for these two villages are carried out under the Central Act, that would result in incongruity and would lead to further litigation; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide No. DCB/LAS/016/F-330/1755-61 dated 02-06-2022 has recommended the case duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir vide No. Divcom/LAS-4218/336 dated 05-07-2022 and Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K vide No. FCR-LAND/147/2022-06 (224903) dated 19-07-2022 along with the objections of the land owners with the request to issue notification under sections 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act, Smvt. 1990; and

Whereas, the Honøble High Court while disposing of the writ petition No. 2151/2020, WP(C) 1339/2020 C/W CCP(S) No. 13/2021 and CCP(S) No. 419/2020 titled Khursheed Ahmed Nazki & Ors Vs. UT of J&K & Ors on 31-05-2022 has directed the Deputy Commissioner to consider and decide the aforesaid objections, if any. The direction reads as under :ô

"The petitioner, at this stage submit that in view of the change of alignment of the road, a corrigendum has been issued modifying the notification issued under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act.

It has been pointed out by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that the aforesaid corrigendum was actually challenged by the petitioners by filing a separate writ petition i. e. WP (C) No. 717/2022 which has been disposed of vide order dated 12-04-2022, with liberty to the petitioners to file objections before the Deputy Commissioner. The petitioners have already filed the objections but the same have not yet been decided.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Budgam, to consider and decide the aforesaid objections, if any, of the petitioners before proceeding ahead with the acquisition proceedings in relation to the land of the petitioners.

It goes without saying that in case the objections are directed by the Deputy Commissioner, Budgam, the petitioners, would be free to take appropriate remedy as may be available to them under law to challenge the same. No. 25] The J&K Official Gazette, 22nd Sept., 2022/31st Bhad., 1944. 189

In view of above, the writ petition and the contempt proceedings CCP(D) No. 13/2021 stands disposed of."

Whereas, the objections have been examined in the department, the Collector has given due opportunity of being heard under section 5(2) of the Act to the land owners/interested persons and their statements were recorded which were corroborated with the written objections, wherein the objectors have again objected to the change in alignment and requested for acquisition as per the previous notification and if desired to acquire the land as per corrigendum, the same may be acquired as per the Central Land Acquisition Act; and

Whereas, the alignment has been fixed by the Indenting Department as per the technical feasibility, the revenue authorities have prepared revenue papers accordingly, as the process has been already initiated during 2016, at this stage by taking up these acquisitions under Central Land Acquisition Act, it would result further delay and impact on other 43 villages where the acquisition have also been initiated and concluded under the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990. Moreover this road has strategic importance as well as operational necessity and has now great public importance, therefore, the land is required for public purpose, hence the objections so raised does not merit consideration and are accordingly rejected; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land measuring 90 Kanals, 17 Marlas and 98 Sft. situated in Village Mamath, Tehsil and District Budgam is required for public purpose i. e. construction of Semi Ring Road around Srinagar City.

Now, in pursuance of section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 90 Kanals, 17 Marlas and 98 Sft. situated in Village Mamath, Tehsil and District Budgam as per annexure to this notification is required for public purpose i. e. construction of Semi Ring Road around Srinagar City. Further, the Collector, Defence/Semi Ring Road, Budgam is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/rules.

Further, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved

This notification shall be subject to outcome of writ petition pending in any competent court(s).

Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Munna and Showkat Rustam Dar through accused Manzoor Ahmad Bhat. Subsequently, the accused Showket Rustam Dar hurled the said grende upon the Police Station, Kakpora on 16-10-2021 and the accused Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Munna facilitated him for carrying out the said attack. The remaining 02 grenades were handed over to some unknown Over Ground Workers (OGWs) by the accused Aijaz Ahmad Lone; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Sahab also handed over the Pistol with Magazine and ammunition to accused viz. Showket Rustam Dar through his brother namely, Zahid Ahmad Dar. On the directions of terrorists accused viz. Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Sahab, Showkat Rustam Dar and

Whereas, during the further investigation, it was established that the accused viz Showkat Rustam Dar, Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Muna, Aijaz Ahmad Lone @ Sahab, Manzoor Ahmad Bhat and Naseer Ahmad Shah were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorist of TRF (offshoot of LeT banned outfit) namely, Lukman Bhai and under a well knit criminal conspiracy hurled a grenade upon the Police Station, Kakapora, besides, attacked upon the Kashmiri Pandith Roshan Lal Mava at Bohri Kadal, Srinagar which resulted death of his salesman namely, Mohammad Ibrahim Khan; and
- 8. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of the terrorist viz Lukman Bhai and the accused Zahid Ahmad Dar, shall continue, to bring out their role/involvement in the case; and

Whereas, a number of mega development projects are presently being executed and are at advanced stage of implementation within the local planning area of Jammu viz. Delhi-Katra Expressway, Jammu-Akhnoor Four lanning, Ring Road from Raya Morh to Nagrota, Jammu Metrolite Rail Project, AIIMS, IIT, IIM which have unleashed the development potential of the surounding areas and provided options for decongestion of the core city area which also generated ancillary developmental demands in the vicinity; and

Whereas, during the implementation phase of the regulations of the notified plan particularly while sanctioning of building permissions of various Government/Public and Private persons, many discrepancies in terms of land use were observed in which land use of many land patches had been envisaged as Open Spaces, Green Buffer, Vegetation Forest and Water Bodies which being unfit for construction activity had an adverse impact on the creation of infrastructure and other facilities in and around Jammu City; and

Whereas, many representations were received from public mostly concerning non-compatible land use in the peripheral areas of JMP-2032

Whereas, Jammu Devlopment Authority initiated the proceedure for modification of the plan for effecting changes in land use as per provisions laid down under section 12 of the Jammu and Kashmir Development Act, 1970; and

Whereas, pursuant to section 12 of the Jammu and Kashmir Development Act, 1970 read with rule 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Development Rules, 1976, objections/suggestions were invited from the general public through the medium of publication in the prominent newspapers as well as the website of Jammu Development Authority i. e. www.jda.jk.gov.in regarding proposed modification in JMP-2032 within a period of Sixty (60) days from issuance of notification. The last date of filing objections and suggestions was 27-06-2021; and

Whereas, the objections and suggestions received from the general public have been addressed by the Committee constituted for the purpose; and

Whereas, during the encounter, three terrorists of HM banned outfit identified as Shakir Ahmad Najar S/o Gulzar Ahmad Najar R/o Punipora, Mohammad Aslam Dar S/o Mohd Rafiq Dar R/o Redwani Bala and Sumair Ahmad Najar S/o Ab. Hamid Najar R/o Kanipora got killed. During the search, arms/ammunition viz. 02 AK-56 Rifles, 07 AK Magazines, 70 AK rounds, 01 Pistol, 01 Pistol Magazine, 02 Pistol rounds were recovered from the encounter site; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnessess acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Bilal Ahmad Dar was arrested in the case and on his disclosure two other accused namely, Ab. Shakir Ahmad Najar, Mohammad Aslam Dar and Sumair Ahmad Najar and were providing logistic support to them, besides under a well knit criminal conspiracy, constructed the hideout in the premises of accused viz. Bilal Ahmad Dar and voluntarily harboured the terrorists in the said hideout; and
- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Shakir Ahmad Najar, Mohammad Aslam Dar and Sumair Ahmad Najar have been killed in the said encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and
