In terms of sub-section (2) and (3) of Section 3 of the Jammu
and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and Rules framed thereunder, it

A compliance report in this regard shall be furnished by the respective department to the General Administration Department within a month's time positively.

SO-227. In exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 of the Private Security Agencies (Regulation) Act, 2005 (Act No. 29 of 2005), the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules ; namely :

1. **Short title and commencement.** (1) These Rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Private Security Agencies (Regulation) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

No.5-a] The J&K Official Gazette, 5th May, 2022/15th Vai., 1944. 3
CID, J&K, for verification/report, which shall endeavour to provide it within fifteen (15) days of receipt of requisition.

(5) Wherever any applicant's antecedents have been verified in any other State earlier and license is granted, and such documents are furnished by the applicant, the same shall also be forwarded to the CID, J&K by the Controlling Authority and will be taken into account by the verifying agency.

(6) Form-I shall be accompanied by a demand draft or banker's cheque or electronic evidence showing the payment of fees as prescribed under sub-section (3) of section 7 of the Act, payable to the Controlling Authority of the State concerned where the application is being made.

(7) The application referred to in sub-rule (1) shall be either personally delivered to the Controlling Authority or sent to him by registered post or through electronic means.

(8) On receipt of the application referred to in sub-rule (1), the Controlling Authority shall after noting thereon the date of receipt by him of the application, grant an electronic or digital acknowledgment to the applicant.

(9) The Controlling Authority, after receiving an application in Form-I shall grant a license to the private security agency in Form-IV after making such enquiry as it considers necessary, and after compliance with the provisions of the Act.

(10) The Controlling Authority either by itself or through its officer or any other means shall verify the premises of the private security agency at the address or addresses provided by the agency.

(11) The Controlling Authority shall cause a physical copy of the licence to be delivered by post within fifteen days of issue to the principal office of the private security agency in the State concerned as mentioned in the application for grant of license which the private security agency shall be bound to display at its place of business.

(12) In case of rejection of the application for grant of licence, no order of refusal shall be made unless

(a) the applicant has been given a reasonable opportunity of being heard ; and

of character and antecedents irrespective of period fixed in sub-rule (5) of
rule 7 if it deem fit and proper.

(6) On the basis of character and antecedents verification, the agency shall issue in Form-VII a character and antecedents certificate and this certificate shall not be taken back by such Agency even if the person ceases to be employee of that Agency.

8. Security Training. (1) The Controlling Authority shall frame the detailed training syllabus required for training the security guards in accordance with National Skill Qualification Framework. For entry level, this training shall be for minimum period of hundred hours of classroom instruction and sixty hours of field training, spread over at least twenty working days. The ex-servicemen and former police personnel shall however be required to attend a condensed course only, of minimum forty hours of classroom instruction and sixteen hours of field training spread over at least seven working days.

(2) The training shall include the following subjects, namely :

- (a) conduct in public and proper wearing of uniform ;
- (b) physical fitness training ;
- (c) physical security of the assets, security of the building apartment, personnel security, household security ;
- (d) fire-fighting ;
- (e) crowd control ;
- (f) examining identification papers including identity cards, passports and smart cards ;
- (g) should be able to read and understand English alphabets and Arabic numerals as normally encountered in the identification of documents, arms license, travel documents and security inspection sheet ;
- (h) identification of improvised explosive devices ;
- (i) first aid ;
- (j) crisis response and disaster management ;

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 161/2021 under
sections 18, 20, 23, 39 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police
Station, Pampore and the investigation of the case was taken up.
Subsequently, during investigation Section 38 of ULA (P) Act, were added
in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan
of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the further investigation, the accused viz. Zubair
Gull, Adil Fayaz Ganie, Basit Ali Dar and Shahid Nabi Pandith, were
arrested in the case and during the investigation, arms/ammunition
i. e. 01 Pistol with 03 Magazines, 55 Pistol rounds, 02 hand grenades,
96 AK rounds and 06 SLR rounds were recovered from their possession
respectively. The accused were found in contact with a terrorist of JeM
banned outfit namely, Sameer Ahmad Tantray S/o Gh. Mohammad
Tantray R/o Baragam, Awantipora, who provided arms/ammunition to
them in order to promote unlawful activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the
accused viz. Zubair Gull, Adil Fayaz Ganie, Basit Ali Dar and Shahid
Nabi Pandith were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the
terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly terrorist Sameer Ahmad
Tantray and were providing logistic support to them, besides, under a
well knit criminal conspiracy were facilitated the transportation of arms/
ammunition for the terrorists from one place to another ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Sameer Ahmad Tantray, has
been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings
under the law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of
witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Zubair Gull, Adil Fayaz Ganie, Basit Ali Dar and Shahid Nabi Pandith for the commission of offences
