Introduction :

The proceedings are as per the provisions of Section 23 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of additional land measuring 11 Kanals 07 Marlas (0.56 Hectares) required for re-alignment of AIIMS approach road at Awantipora. The acquisition proceeding were initiated on the basis of request made by the requiring body viz. Director Health Services, Kashmir vide his office No. DHSK/Plg/AIIMS Awantipora/019/5262-64 dated 24-12-2020.

Notification of Social Impact Assessment and Report of SIA :

The process for conduct of Social Impact Assessment report under the provisions of Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and

Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 was issued vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/272-80 dated 7-1-2021, whereunder following members already nominated by the District Collector vide his office order No. DCP/LA/2020/610-30 Dated 25-8-2020 were assigned the task for conduct of the field survey for the proposed project.

- 1) Tehsildar Awantipora
- 2) Assistant Executive Engineer R&B Pampore
- 3) Assistant Executive Engineer (Jal Shakti) PHE Awantipora
- 4) Assistant Executive Engineer Irrigation and Flood Control Awantipora
- 5) Range Officer Forests, Awantipora
- 6) Agriculture Extension Officer Noorpora.
- 7) Rep. of Indenting Department.

The report so prepared by the committee members for the instant land acquisition case was submitted to the Appropriate Government/ District Collector vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/288 Dated 13-01-2021 for accord of approval/authorization for issuance of Notification under Section 11 of the said Act.

Evaluation of Social Impact Assessment Report :

On the basis of the recommendations and the observations submitted by the committee constituted, it was established that the land for which the indent stands placed is required for legitimate and *bona fide* public purpose which necessitates the acquisition of land identified. Direction to the Collector for proceeding ahead under the provisions of Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was communicated by the District Collector vide his office No. DCP/LA/2021/1400-01 Dated 18-01-2021.

Publication of Notification and Issue of Notices :

The Preliminary notification under Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 was issued vide this office Notification No. 04 of 2021 Dated 21-01-2021 under endorsement No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/326-32 Dated 21-01-2021 for calling upon the objections, if any, from the interested persons/landowners. In response to the said notification, the objections were received and heard and accordingly submitted under Section 15 of the Act vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/580-82 Dated 02-11-2021 with recommendations to the Government through the District Collector Pulwama for a decision and issuance of declaration under Section 19 of the Act.

The case was examined by the Government and it was found that the Collector has given due opportunity to the interested persons and that the land under acquisition is required for re-alignment of AIIMS approach road at Awantipora. Therefore, the land is required for public purpose, as the acquisition of land outweighs the objections raised.

The Government has issued declaration under Section 19 (1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 vide Notification No. 03-Rev (LAK) of 2022 dated 12-01-2022 under endorsement No. Rev-LAK/3/2022 (115739) Dated 12-01-2022.

Public notice under Section 21(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued to the interested persons/land owners to state the particulars of the land so needed, and to state the nature of their respective interests in the land and the amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests, their claims to rehabilitation and resettlement along with their objections, if any, to the measurement made and to appear personally or by agent or advocate within a period of 30 days. During the prescribed period of time no such objection was received by this Collectorate.

Methodology used for determination of compensation :

On the basis of alignment given by the Health/PWD department revenue extracts, including Khasra Paimaish were submitted by the Tehsildar Awantipora. The type of land for Khasra number 3336/2604 (3 kanals 4 marlas) is recorded as Gair Mumkin Labroo, Pahad and Khasra Number 3335/2603 min (8 kanals 3 marlas) is recorded as Banjar Kadeem Gair Mumkin Pahad, Maidani and Gair Mumkin Sanglakh, however on spot it is in the form of orchard where fruit growing trees have been found, for which separate assessment was done by the Horticulture Department. The land rates per kanal as applicable to the type of land stands notified by the Chairman District Valuation Committee vide his office Notification number 09/DCP-SQ of 2020 Dated 31-12-2020 under endorsement number DCP-SQ/20-21/1808-22 dated 31-12-2020. The value of the land as per the market value guidelines for the corresponding year is as under :

There is no residential/commercial structure on or near the proposed site.

Compensation of Fruit Bearing Trees :

The compensation of fruit bearing trees stands assessed at Rs. 3,07,118/- by the Chief Horticulture Officer Pulwama and communicated vide his office number CHO/PUL/DEV/2021/22/2217-18 dated 2-11-2021. The same was authenticated by the Director Health Services Kashmir vide his office number DHSK/PLG/AIIMS/2022-23/2796-98 dated 5-05-2022.

Possession of Land :

With the intension of speeding up the development of AIIMS Hospital the land owners voluntarily handed over the possession of land in the month of November 2021 when the trees were cut and the land free of all encumbrances was taken over by the Tehsildar Awantipora who in turn handed it over to the requiring body for development of road.

Ownership :

Names of the persons whose land is under acquisition, was ascertained from the revenue records and the same has been included in Award Statement.

Mutation of Occupancy in respect of the said land being acquired :

Consequent upon taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested persons, the Tehsildar concerned shall ensure that the revenue records and all the relevant documents relating to the ownership/occupancy of the said land are accordingly updated and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government.

Apportionment :

Compensation amount will be paid accordingly to the latest entries in the Revenue Record and as per enquiry conducted under Section 23. In case of any dispute, which I cannot settle within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the Court under Section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for the determination of ownership rights.

Encumbrances :

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and has been mentioned in the Award Statement.

Determination of Solatium :

As per the provisions of Section 30(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the market value is awarded as Solatium has been determined in the Award Statement.

Compensation of Land :

After considering the parameters provided in Section 26 across 29 of the Act, the compensation of the land stands determined. The total amount of award works out to be Rs. 3,63,66,736/- (Rupees Three Crores Sixty Three Lac Sixty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty Six only).

Approval of the Draft Award :

The Draft Award so framed vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/217-25 Dated 14-07-2022 for an amount of Rs. 3,63,66,736/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty Three Lac Sixty Six Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Six Only) involved in the instant land acquisition case was submitted before the District Collector Pulwama vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/237 Dated 16-7-2022 in terms of rule 32 and 34 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for accord of approval of the rates.

Accordingly, the instant land acquisition case was put before the Collectors meeting held on 22-7-2022 under the Chairmanship of District Collector Pulwama. The minutes of the meeting were circulated vide District Collector Pulwama's office No. DCP/LA/22/103-110 dated 28-07-2022.

Thereafter, the approval of rates was conveyed by the District Collector Pulwama vide his office No. DCP/LA/2022/117-23 Dated 8-8-2022 with the direction to disburse the compensation amount to the rightful claimants strictly in accordance with the rules in vogue and the conditions agreed upon in the meeting which are as under :

- (a) It shall be ensured that the payment of compensation to the rightful claimant is made after verifying the title/share of each individual owner strictly in accordance with various laws/rules in force.
- (b) The compensation for land belonging to the State or escheated to the State under any law in force shall be apportioned in favour of the State under the appropriate Government account head.

Payment of Compensation to the Interested Persons :

The interested persons are informed that the payment of compensation shall be made through Bank accounts only for which the land owners who are deemed lawfully entitled shall receive the compensation amount on submission of the below mentioned documents in my office :

1. Original Revenue extracts which transpires that the land is within *pro rata* share of the claimant and is encumbrance free.
2. Copy of Aadhaar Card
3. 16 Digit Bank account number with IFSC Code.
4. Two passport size photographs.

Whereas, while processing the cases for granting permission, prescribed rules shall follow and fees including levy of penalty in respect of said permissions shall be decided by the committee under rules ;

Whereas, a meeting was held on 19-04-2022 in which deliberations were held upon fixation of fees/*modus operandi* for permission of construction of commercial buildings in rural areas ; the participants of the meeting whereof include concerned Tehsildars, Development Officers, Assistant Town Planning Officer Srinagar/Chadoora and Sarpanch representative ;

Whereas, this office in its meeting dated 19-04-2022 deliberated upon issues of fixation of fees/*modus operandi* for permission of construction of commercial buildings in rural area, generating Government Revenue as also to streamline the construction process in rural areas taking in view the working/fee structure of Srinagar Municipal Corporation and Municipal Committee Chadoora ;

Whereas, in the meeting referred supra, following rates were proposed by the committee ;

SO-300.ôôWhereas, on 25-12-2015, a tip-off was received by Police Station, Srigufwara, to the effect that at Village Srihama, some miscreants are provoking youth to join the terrorist ranks and also instigating public against the security and territorial integrity of India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 86/2015 under section 13 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station,

 Srigufwara and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently,
 during the investigation, Section 39 of ULA (P) Act was added in the
 case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan
 of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and
 the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances
 of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, three persons namely Adil
 Ahmad Dar S/o Ab. Rashid Dar, Javaid Ahmad Bandro S/o Gh. Rasool
 Bandro and Mohd Yasin Bhat S/o Gh. Qadir Bhat Residents of Satkipora,
 Srigufwara, were found involved in the commission of offence.
 Subsequently, the accused were arrested in the case and during
 investigation, 12 Posters of HM banned outfit were recovered from their
 possession ; and

5. Whereas, during the further investigation, it was established that
 the accused viz. Adil Ahmad Dar, Javaid Ahmad Bandro and Mohd Yasin
 Bhat were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists
 of HM banned outfit and were providing logistic support to them, besides,
 on the date of occurrence raised anti national slogans, thereby instigated
 the general public against the sovereignty and territorial integrity of
 India ; and

6. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of
 witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer
 has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned
 accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of
 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their
 name :
