Whereas, on the basis of indent placed by the Project Director, National Highway Authority of India Limited (NHAI) vide No. PD/ Sgr/14010/01/2014/LA-BDG/13 dated 20-04-2016, notification under

Whereas, Project Director, NHAI vide letter dated 11-08-2020 raised observations regarding the alignment and requested for de-notification of the land and for fresh notification as per the approved alignment ; and

Whereas, a writ petition OWP No. 1339/2020 titled Ghulam Hussain Bhat and Others V/s State was filed in the Honøble High Court of J&K and vide Order dated 10-09-2020 it was ordered to complete acquisition proceedings strictly in terms of notification dated 28-03-2019, if there is no legal impediment. The operative part is as under :ô

"......meanwhile, subject to objections from the other side and till next date before the Bench, the respondents are directed to complete the acquisition proceedings with regard to the property in question, strictly in terms of notification dated 28-03-2019 and 29-03-2019, issued by the respondent No. 4, if there is no legal impediment."

Whereas, fresh demarcation was carried out in presence of representatives of NHAI and Project Director vide letter dated 22-03-2021 requested for preparation of fresh revenue papers as per the said demarcation. Accordingly, fresh revenue papers were prepared by the revenue field agencies for land measuring 19 Kanals, 14 Marlas and 62 Sft. and Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide letter dated 19-05-2021 submitted the case to Project Director, NHAI for authentication, who authenticated the revenue papers and returned the case vide letter dated 28-05-2021 ; and

Whereas, keeping in view of the approved alignment and fresh authenticated Khasra Paimaish of Village Surad, corrigendum to notification dated 29-03-2019 was issued vide No. DCB/LAS/016/F-330/1247-54 dated 26-02-2022 for land measuring 19 Kanals, 14 Marlas and 62 Sft., again calling upon the objections from the land owners/ interested persons ; and

Whereas, few land owners through Mr. Ghulam Hussain Bhat filed objections stating therein that the acquisition should be carried out as

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam intimated that notification under section 4 (1) and subsequent corrigendum was issued under Land Acquisition Act, moreover, the proceedings of land acquisition for the said project in other 43 villages have also been carried out under State Land Acquisition Act which are also subjudice before the Honøble High Court in various writ petitions. The land acquisition proceedings in two Villages Surad and Mamath are pending and if the proceedings for these two villages are carried out under the Central Act, that would result in incongruity and would lead to further litigation ; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Budgam vide No. DCB/LAS/016/ F-330/1762-68 dated 02-06-2022 has recommended the case duly endorsed by Divisional Commissioner, Kashmir vide No. Divcom/LAS-4217/337 dated 05-07-2022 and Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K vide No. FCR-LAND/148/2022-06 (225139) dated 19-07-2022 along with the objections of the land owners and requested for issuance of notification under sections 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act, Smvt. 1990 ; and

Whereas, the Honøble High Court while disposing of the writ petition No. 1339/2020 C/W CCP(S) No. 419/2020 titled Ghulam Hussain Bhat & Ors Vs. UT of J&K & Ors has directed the Deputy Commissioner to consider and decide the aforesaid objections, if any. The direction reads as under :ô

"The petitioner, at this stage submit that in view of the change of alignment of the road, a corrigendum has been issued modifying the notification issued under section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act.

It has been pointed out by the Ld. Counsel for the petitioners that the aforesaid corrigendum was actually challenged by the petitioners by filing a separate writ petition i. e. WP (C) No. 718/2022 which has been disposed of vide order dated 12-04-2022, with liberty to the petitioners

to file objections before the Deputy Commissioner. The petitioners have already filed the objections but the same have not yet been decided.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the writ petition stands disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Budgam, to consider and decide the aforesaid objections, if any, of the petitioners before proceeding ahead with the acquisition proceedings in relation to the land of the petitioners.

It goes without saying that in case the objections are directed by the Deputy Commissioner, Budgam, the petitioners, would be free to take appropriate remedy as may be available to them under law to challenge the same.

In view of above, the writ petition and the contempt proceedings CCP(D) No. 419/2020 stands disposed of."

Whereas, the objections have been examined in the department, the Collector has given due opportunity of being heard under section 5(2) of the Act to the land owners/interested persons and their statements were recorded which were corroborated with the written objections, wherein Ghulam Hussain and others have again objected to the change in alignment and requested for acquisition as per the previous notification/installation of pegs in their land i. e. probably in the year 2016 ; and

Whereas, the alignment has been fixed by the Indenting Department as per the technical feasibility, the revenue authorities have prepared revenue papers accordingly, as the process has already been initiated during 2016, which is also admitted by the objectors in their statement that the pegs have been installed in the year 2016, at this stage by taking up these acquisitions under Central Land Acquisition Act, it would result further delay and impact on other 43 villages where the acquisition have also been initiated and concluded under the Land Acquisition Act. Moreover the road has strategic importance as well as operational necessity and has now great public importance, therefore, the land is required for public purpose, hence the objections so raised does not merit consideration and are accordingly rejected ; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land measuring 19 Kanals, 14 Marlas and 62 Sfts. situated in Village Surad, Tehsil and District Budgam is required for public purpose i. e. construction of Semi Ring Road around Srinagar City.

Now, in pursuance of Section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat, 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 19 Kanals, 14 Marlas and 62 Sft. situated in Village Surad, Tehsil and District Budgam as per annexure to this notification is required for public purpose i. e. construction of Semi Ring Road around Srinagar City. Further, the Collector, Defence/Semi Ring Road, Budgam is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/rules.

Further, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in forcer while making the award. The Collector/Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

This notification shall be subject to outcome of writ petition pending in any competent court(s).

S.O.6303.ô Whereas, on 02-04-2021, a tip off was received by the Police Station, Zainapora, to the effect that Two persons namely Sajad Ahmad Bhat S/o Abdul Gani Bhat R/o Maldera, Shopian and Rouf Ahmad Bhat @ Jigah S/o Abdul Majeed Bhat R/o Sofipora, Shopian were working as OGWs for the terrorists and on the behest of selfstyled terrorist namely, Asif Ahmad Ganie @ Mustaqeem S/o Bashir Ahmad Ganie R/o Chitragam are reproviding safe passage and shelter to terrorists, besides transporting arms/ammunition from one place to another ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 26/2021 under Sections 18, 19, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Zainapora and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, Section 19 of ULA (P) Act was dropped and Section 23 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Sajad Ahmad Bhat and Rouf Ahmad Bhat were arrested in the case and were found in contact with terrorists of Al-Badr banned outfit namely Asif Ahmad Ganie @ Mustaqeem S/o Bahshir Ahmad Ganie R/o Citragam Shopian and Itimad Ahmad Dar S/o Mohammad Yousuf R/o Rawalpora, Shopian, who provided some ammunition to the accused for further distribution among the terrorists. Subsequently, during the investigation, 142 AK rounds were recovered from the above accused ; and

4. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, three other accused namely Muzamil Yousuf Ganie S/o Mohammad Yousuf R/o Chitragam, Shopian, Abid Hussain Dar S/o Ab. Hamid R/o Turkwangam, Shopian and Anayat Ahmad Lone S/o Fayaz Ahmad R/o Chitragam, Shopian were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused were arrested and during the investigation, 56 AK-47 rounds were recovered from the instances of the accused viz. Abid Hussain Dar ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Sajad Ahmad Bhat, Rouf Ahmad Bhat, Muzamil Yousuf Ganie, Abid Hussain Dar and Anayat Ahmad Lone were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists viz. Asif Ahmad Ganie @ Mushtaqeem and Itimad Ahamd Dar and were providing logistic support to them, besides, under a well-knit criminal were facilitating the transportation of arms/ammunition one place to another for carrying out the terror activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, the terrorists viz. Asif Ahmad Ganie @ Mustaqeem and Itimad Ahmad Dar have been killed in different encounters with the Security Forces and proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their name :ô

Ayayat Ahmad Lone, has been found juvenile during the investigation and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and

S.O.ó309.ô Whereas, on 29-12-2021, a tip-off was received by the Police Station, Dooru, regarding presence of unknown terrorists in the residential house of one Ab. Rashid Rather S/o Mohd Subhan Rather R/o Nowgam, Verinag, conspiring to carry out terrorist acts in the area. Subsequently, a joint Cordon and search operation was launched by the Police/Security Forces and during the Search, the hiding terrorists fired indiscriminately upon the Search Party with their illegally acquired arms/ammunition with the intention to kill them, resulting in injuries to

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 138/2021 under sections 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 16, 18, 19, 20, 39 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Dooru and the investigation, of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, one of the injured Army personnel succumbed to his injuries. Subsequently, Sections 302, 324, 326 IPC, Section 23 ULA (P) Act, and 7/25 Arms Act, were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, the dead bodies of three terrorists of HM/LeT banned outfit, later identified as Mohd Altaf Shah S/o Gh. Mohd Shah R/o Nathipora, Nowgam, Sameer Ahmad Dar S/o Mohd Subhan Dar R/o Gundibagh, Pulwama and a foreign terrorist whose identity could not be ascertained, were recovered from the encounter site along with arms/ammunition i. e. 02 AK-47 rifles, 01 M4 rifle, 01 Chinese Pistol, 02 AK Magazines, 07M4 Magazines, 02 Pistol Magazines, 03 Hand Grenades, 30 AK rounds, 107 M4 rounds, 15 Pistol rounds and 01 Pouch ; and

4. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquinted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

5. Whereas, during the further investigation, the accused house owner viz. Ab. Rashid Rather R/o Nowgam, Verinag was arrested in the case and during the investigation 01 AK rifle, 03 Hand Grenades and a pouch were recovered from his residential house. The said arms/ ammunition was obtained by the accused viz. Ab. Rashid Rather from the killed terrorist namely Mohd Altaf Shah to promote terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused house owner viz. Ab. Rashid Rather, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit and was providing logistic support to them. The accused was voluntarily harbouring the terrorists particularly the killed terrorist viz. Mohd Altaf

7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Mohd Altaf Shah, Sameer Ahmad Dar and unidentified foreign terrorist have been killed in the said encounter and the proceedings under the law would abate against them ; and

8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :ô

Notification

Srinagar, the 4th July, 2022.

SO-321.66Whereas, in compliance of directions contained in the Order dated 5 October, 2015 of the Honøble Supreme Court of India in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 202 of 1995 in the matter of TN Godavannan Thirumulpad versus Union of India and others, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has issued Wood Based Industries (Establishment and Regulation) Guidelines, 2016 ; and

Whereas, the States and Union territories are required, to conform their rules according to the said Guidelines.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by clause (d) of Section 76, and Section 76-A of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act 16 of 1927), the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby makes the following rules ; namely :ô

1. Short title and commencement.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Wood-based Industries (Establishment and Regulation) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Definitions**. $\hat{o}$  (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, $\hat{o}$ 

- (a) **"Act"** means the Indian Forest Act, 1927 (Act 16 of 1927);
- (b) "Chief Conservator of Forests" means the Chief Conservator of Forests, Jammu or the Chief Conservator of Forests, Kashmir as the case may be ;
- (c) "Divisional Forest Officer" means the Divisional Forest Officer of the Territorial Division including the Divisional Forest Officer, Urban Forestry Division, Jammu/ Srinagar;
- (d) "Form" means the forms appended to these rules ;
- (e) **"Furniture unit"** mean plants and machinery and the premises including the precincts thereof in which or in any part thereof wood based finished products are manufactured using sawn timber, cane, bamboo, reed, plywood, or any other wood-based product except a log, procured from legitimate sources and operating without a band saw or re-saw or circular saw of more than thirty-centimetre

> Provided that if a furniture unit processes only timber of species exempted from transit permit under the Jammu and Kashmir Forest Produce Transit Rules, 2020, and no other species, use of logs as raw material and installation of circular saw of up to 60 centimeter may be permitted by the licensing authority ;

- (f) **"Government"** means Government of Jammu and Kashmir ;
- (g) **"Industrial Estate"** means industrial area/estate notified as such by the Government from time to time. This will also include industrial estates as notified by the Government for relocation of the existing five or more licensed woodbased industries ;
- (h) "Licence" means the licence issued under these rules ;
- (i) **"Licencing Authority"** means the Territorial Conservator of Forests concerned ;
- (j) "Log" means a piece of wood in its natural form whether stripped of bark or sapwood or not and includes logs whose round surfaces have been made flat by any means to form wood of roughly rectangular cross-section and having mid girth or perimeter of forty-two centimeter or more under bark ;
- (k) "Municipal Area" means the area falling within the territorial limits of Municipal Committee, Municipal Council, Municipal Corporation, as the case may be;
- (l) "Owner" means the person(s) in whose name(s) the license or certificate of registration has been granted under these rules; provided that in case of a partnership or a limited company, the ownership of licence or certificate of registration shall be in the name of the concern with nominated person(s) or managing partner(s) as person(s) responsible for day-to-day affairs;

- (m) **"Registration"** means the certificate of registration issued under these rules ;
- (n) **"Sawmill"** means plants and machinery in a fixed structure or enclosure for conversion of logs into sawn timber ;
- (o) **"Sawn timber"** means beams, scantlings, planks, battens, and such other product obtained from sawing of a log;
- (p) "Section" means section of the Act ;
- (q) "Timber" means timber as defined in the Act ;
- (r) "Veneer Mill, Plywood Mill, Particle Board Mill and Fibreboard Mill" means plants and machinery and the premises in which or in any part thereof, conversion into required size, slicing, peeling, chipping. fashioning, or seasoning of timber/wood, including preservation and treatment thereof either by mechanical or chemical process with the aid of electrical or mechanical power or manually is carried out ;
- (s) "Wood-based Industry" means any industry which processes wood as its raw material and includes sawmill, veneer/plywood/particle board/fibreboard mill, units manufacturing katha or kutch, wood oil, etc. but will not include furniture unit and wooden handicrafts unit as defined in Rule 2(e) and 2(t) ; and
- (t) **"Wooden handicrafts unit"** means a unit that deals in making of goods using hand tools, and includes traditional domestic carpentry, and making of furniture, handicrafts, small wooden toys, and small joinery and sports goods, and which are not involved in sawing or resawing of logs or sawn timber using mechanical saw.

(2) The words and expressions used in these rules, but not defined shall have the same meanings as assigned to them in the Act.

3. Restrictions on establishment of wood-based industry and furniture unit.ô No person/authority shall establish, expand installed

Provided that :

- I. no wood-based industry shall be installed or operated within 8 kilometres (aerial distance) from the boundary of nearby reserved forests, unless located within the boundaries of õMunicipal Areaö and/or õIndustrial Estateö notified by the Government irrespective of distance from the nearby reserved forests ;
  - **Exception :**ô Nothing contained in aforesaid proviso (i) shall apply to the existing saw mills installed and operated by Forest Department or by Jammu and Kashmir Forest Development Corporation Limited as may be specified by the Government ;
- II. no new wood-based industry shall be installed/operated without consent to establish/operate from Jammu and Kashmir Pollution Control Committeel Board ;
- III. no furniture unit shall be installed or operated within 3 kilometres (aerial distance) from the boundary of nearby reserved forests. unless located within the boundaries of õMunicipal Areaö and/ or õIndustrial Estateö notified by the Government irrespective of distance from the nearby reserved forests ;
- IV. the Government may, on the recommendations of a broad-based committee constituted for the purpose, restrict the maximum number of wood-based industries that may be installed in any given locality.

#### 4. Issue of licence/certificate of registration.ô (1)

- (i) Any person, seeking a licence under these rules for woodbased industry shall make an application to the licencing authority in **Form-I** along with specified annexures.
- (ii) Any person, seeking registration under these rules for furniture unit, shall make an application to the licencing authority in Form-2 along with specified annexures.

- (iii) No licence or registration will be required for wooden handicrafts unit.
- (iv) The licence or certificate of registration issued under these rules shall be non-transferable, except by inheritance.

(2) On receipt of an application under sub-rule (1) (i) and (ii) of Rule 4, the licencing authority shall seek a report from the concerned Divisional Forest Officer regarding feasibility of installing/continuation/ relocation of wood-based industry or furniture unit, verification of antecedents of the applicant the facts of application, and based thereon his precise recommendation on the application. On receipt of such verification report, and recommendations thereon, from the Divisional Forest Officer and after recording his own satisfaction, the licencing authority shall issue a licence in Form-3 for wood-based industry, or a certificate of registration in Form-4 for furniture unit.

(3) A licence granted under these rules to a wood-based industry shall remain valid for five years from the date of such issuance or renewal of licence.

(4) The licencing authority may refuse issuance of the licence or certificate of registration, as the case may be, for reasons to be recorded in writing and inform the applicant accordingly.

(5) The licenses issued under the Saw Mills (Registration and Control) Rules, 1968, shall be deemed to be invalid. However, licenses issued under the Jammu and Kashmir Wood-based (Saw Mills, Veneer and Plywood) Industries (Registration and Regulation) Rules, 2012 shall continue to remain valid till they are due for renewal.

5. Fee for grant of licence/certificate of registration.ô The person seeking licence for wood-based industry or registration of furniture unit shall pay such fee, as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

6. **Renewal of licence**.ô (1) Any person who has been granted licence under these rules, may apply for renewal of the licence in **Form-5** within a period of three months before the expiry of the period for which licence was granted to him, along with prescribed documents and such fee as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

(2) On receipt of an application under Sub-Rule (1), the licencing authority, after obtaining verification and recommendation of the Divisional Forest Officer concerned, and on its satisfaction, shall renew the licence, within a period of three months, for further period of five years from the date of renewal.

(3) In case, the renewal of licence is refused, the licencing authority shall provide an opportunity of being heard to the person(s) concerned and record the reasons for refusing such renewal.

(4) In case an application for renewal of the licence for woodbased industry is neither renewed nor refused by the licencing authority within three months as provided in Sub-Rule (2) above the licence shall be deemed to have been renewed for one year from the date of receipt of application of renewal by the licencing authority. However, for subsequent years, deemed renewal shall not be valid.

(5) In case the owner fails to apply for renewal of license before expiry of the period for which licence was granted to him, the license shall be deemed to have been suspended after expiry of the said period :

Provided that the after 90 days of expiry of the period for which licence was granted, the licensing authority may cancel the license under Rule 11.

7. **Duplicate licence/certificate of registration**.ô If a licence or certificate of registration issued under these rules is defaced, lost, destroyed or otherwise rendered illegible, the licencing authority shall, on receipt of application made in **Form-6** for issuance of duplicate licence/certificate of registration, along with such fee as may be specified by the Government from time to time, issue a duplicate licence or certificate of registration as the case may be.

8. **Directions of licencing authority**.ô The licencing authority may, from time to time, issue such directions to the owner of the wood-based industry or furniture unit as it deems necessary, with regard to any matter directly connected to the business of the industry, and the same shall be binding on the owner.

9. Maintenance of record.ô Every owner shall maintain proper record of the receipt and disposal of timber in Form-7 for wood-based

10. Power to inspect, search and seize etc. $\hat{o}$  (1) Any Forest Officer not below the rank of Range Officer, or an officer authorized by the licencing authority in this behalf, may with a view to securing compliance of these rules : $\hat{o}$ 

- i. require the owner to furnish such return, information, or statistics, or to produce such accounts, books and documents relating to his business for inspection/verification as may be specified ; and
- ii. enter and search, or authorize any person to enter and search the premises of any wood-based industry, furniture unit or wooden handicrafts unit, and seize or authorize the seizure of any raw material or any finished and/or semi-finished products, together with all tools, equipment or machines, in respect of which there are reasons to believe that contravention of the Act, or of these rules, or condition of a licence/certificate of registration issued thereunder has been/ is being or is about to be committed. The property so seized shall be liable to confiscation under the Act.

(2) Any person associated with the working of the wood-based industry, furniture unit or wooden handicrafts unit referred to in Sub-Rule (1) and present at the time of inspection/search, shall afford all reasonable facilities for entry and search of the premises, otherwise it will amount to commission of an offence under these rules and will be dealt with under Rule 13.

11. Cancellation or suspension of licence/registration.ô Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the licencing authority, where it has reasons to believe that the owner is operating the woodbased industry or furniture unit in contravention of the provisions of these rules or conditions of the licence/registration, or the owner is indulging in activities prejudicial to the interest of forest conservancy or is involved in any forest offence, or is found in possession of illicit timber or any other forest produce, or has committed any offence under

Provided that where such hearing or perusal of record or site inspection involves time, the licencing authority may, pending decision on cancellation of licence/registration, suspend the licence/ registration up to a maximum of 90 days by passing a reasoned order. A copy of the order suspending or cancelling the licence/registration shall be communicated to the owner.

Appeal against the refusal, suspension or cancellation of licence/registration or refusal to renew license.ô (1) Any person, who has been refused the licence/registration under Rule 4, or renewal of licence under Rule 6, or whose licence/registration has been suspended or cancelled under Rule 11, may, within a period of thirty days from the date of the receipt of information of such refusal or suspension or cancellation of the licence/registration, as the case may be, appeal to the Chief Conservator of Forests concerned.

(2) On receipt of the appeal filed under Sub-Rule (1), the Chief Conservator of Forests shall decide the same within a period of 60 days, after giving the concerned person reasonable opportunity of being heard and after perusal of all relevant record.

(3) The decision of the Chief Conservator of Forests on such appeal shall be final.

13. **Penalty**.ô Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these rules, is liable to be punished by the competent Magistrate with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years but shall not be less than three months, or with fine which may extend to twenty-five thousand rupees but shall not be less than five thousand rupees, or both.

14. **Application of other laws not barred**.ô The provisions of these rules shall be in addition to, and not in derogation of any other law for the time being in force, save as otherwise expressly provided in the Act.

15. **Guidelines**.ô After the coming into force of these rules, the Government may issue guidelines in conformity with the Act and these rules for effective implementation of these rules.

16. **Repeal and savings**.ô (1) The Jammu and Kashmir Woodbased (Saw Mills, Veneer and Plywood) Industries (Registration and Regulation) Rules, 2012 are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any action taken under the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.

Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 08/2022 under Sections 18, 23 of ULA (P) Act, 7/25 Arms Act, was registered in the Police Station, Sadder and the investigation of the case was taken up. Suhail Qadir Khanday, Suhail Mushtaq Waza and Asif Maqbool Dar (Doctor), were members of TRF outfit (an offshoot of LeT banned outfit) and the accused namely, Imad Nasir Naikoo, Basit Bilal Makaya, Umer Farooq Lone and Adil Muzaffar Dar, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of the TRF outfit particularly terrorists viz. Suhail Qadir Khanday, Suhail Mushtaq Waza and Asif Maqbool Dar (Doctor) and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, the accused viz. Imad Nasir Naikoo, on the directions of terrorist viz. Ahmad Parray R/o Qasbayar, Rajpora, Zahid Ahmad Wani S/o Manzoor Ahmad Wani and Irfan Ahmad Sheikh S/o Ab. Rashid Sheikh Rø/o Karimabad, Pulwama, who provided a hand grenade to the accused in order to promote terrorism in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Nazir Ahmad Dar @ Nazir Puj, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit viz. Subsequently, during the investigation Section 19, 20 of ULA (P) Act, and Section 506 IPC were added and Section 120-B IPC was dropped from the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons namely, Basharat Ahmad Pampori S/o Bashir Ahmad Pampori R/o Maidanpora, Chattabal, Sringar and Adil Shafi Bhat S/o Mohammad Shafi Bhat R/o Daresh Kadal, Bagh-i-Sunder Payeen, Srinagar were found involved in the case. Subsequently, both the accused were arrested and it was found that accused viz. Basharat Ahmad Pampori was in contact with a PoK based terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Rehan, through the virtual mode, who provided some posters to the accused for pasting the same in Sringar City. Accordingly, the accused viz. Basharat Ahmad Pampori, and his associate Adil Shafi Bhat, pasted the same in area to terrorize the people ; and

Whereas, during the investigation, three other persons namely, Muzamil Fayaz Sofi S/o Fayaz Ahmad Sofi R/o Bagh-i-Sunder Payeen, Kaka Sarai, Karanagar, Mohammad Ansar Khan S/o Mohd Ashraf Khan R/o Saidpora, Eidgah, Srinagar and Adil Mushtaq Mir S/o Mushtag Ahmad Mir R/o Bagh-i-Sunder Payeen, Srinagar were found involved in the case. Subsequently, the accused were arrested and it was found that accused viz. Muzamil Fayaz Sofi, was also in contact with the PoK based terrorist namely Rehan. The accused viz.
