Whereas, section 38 of the Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 provides for discharge of functions of the Mayor by Deputy Mayor, which reads as under :ô

- ::38. Discharge of functions of the Mayor by Deputy Mayor.ô (1) When the Office of the Mayor is vacant, the Deputy Mayor shall act as Mayor until a new Mayor is elected.
- (2) When the Mayor is absent from duty on account of illness or any other cause, the Deputy Mayor, shall act as Mayor during his absence."

WHEREAS, section 39 of the Municipal Corporation Act, 2000 provides for Resignation of Mayor and Deputy Mayor, which reads as under :ô

- ::39. Resignation of Mayor and Deputy Mayor.ô (1) The Mayor may, by writing under his hand addressed to the Deputy Mayor, resign his office.
- (2) The Deputy Mayor may, by writing under his hand addressed to the Mayor resign his office.
- (3) A resignation under sub-section (1) or sub-section (2) shall take effect from the date of its acceptance by the Mayor or Deputy Mayor, as the case may be."

AND WHEREAS, a difficulty has arisen in giving effect to section 39 of the Act as both Mayor and Deputy Mayor of Jammu Municipal Corporation have tendered resignation simultaneously leading to administrative difficulties thereby hampering smooth functioning of the Corporation and providing better services to public at large.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under section 427 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Corporation Act, 2000, the Government hereby makes the following order, namely :ô

b. In section 39, after sub section (3) following proviso shall be added; namely:ô

"Provided that in case both Mayor and Deputy Mayor resign simultaneously, the resignation(s) so tendered shall be addressed/submitted to Commissioner of the Corporation who shall be the authority to accept the resignations".
