(Vigilance)

Subject :ô Lodging complaints against public servants-instructions regarding.

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Circular No. 34-JK(GAD) of 2022

Dated 03-10-2022.

In order to eradicate corruption for providing robust service delivery mechanism and increase participation of citizens in governance at various levels, citizens can draw attention of appropriate authority by making formal complaints regarding any action/inaction on part of public servant in writing or through other specified means for which complaint redressal mechanism

- - (i) Complaints can be lodged with appropriate authority by addressing a written communication either directly or through electronic mode or on portal available for this purpose. Appropriate authority, after gathering information about corruption, malpractices and misconduct may take appropriate action under law against such public servants in a time bound manner.
 - (ii) It is, however, reiterated that anonymous or pseudonymous complaints or complaints containing vague, frivolous, non-specific allegation should not be taken cognizance of. Further, complaints about sub-judice matters should also not be entertained. The guidelines regarding disposal of anonymous/pseudonymous complaints in the Departments/Autonomous Bodies etc. have earlier been notified by General Administration Department, vide Circular No. 29-GAD (Vig.) of 2014 dated 31-07-2014, which were reiterated vide Circular No. 22-GAD(Vig.) of 2015 dated 10-07-2015. These guidelines have been notified in consonance with those issued by the Department of Personnel and Training, Ministry of Personnel and Public Grievances and Pensions, Government of India, vide Office Memorandum No. 104/76/2011-AVD. I dated 18-10-2013 read with Office Memorandum No. 104/76/2011-AVD. I dated 18-10-2018 and Central Vigilance Commission circulars bearing No. 07-11-2014 dated 25th November, 2014 and No. 03-03-2016 dated 7th March, 2016.
 - (iii) As a standard procedure in these matters, the first step is to verify whether the complaints are filed by citizens who have provided their particulars viz. name, address and contact number. In case, the complaint is anonymous/pseudonymous, the same is to be filed without any further action. The culture of anonymous/ pseudonymous complaints is to be discouraged. The complaints which have been filed by persons who have provided their identity should be processed in accordance with law and where the complaints are genuine, due action be taken against the officers/ officials under extant rules and guidelines issued by CVC as well as GAD.

- (iv) It is also clarified that there are specific provisions in law to deal with fake, frivolous and motivated complaints. Importantly, in cases where it is established that the complaints were lodged with a *mala fide* intention or an ulterior motive to harass or harm an innocent Government servant, necessary action should be taken against such Complainants as per law. The following action can be taken against the persons making the false complaints:ô
 - a. Under Section 182 of Indian Penal Code a person making a false complaint can be prosecuted;
 - b. Under section 195(1)(a) of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 a person making a false complaint can be prosecuted on the basis of a complaint lodged with the court of competent jurisdiction by the public servant to whom the false complaint was made or by some other public servant to whom he is subordinate;
 - c. If a person making a false complaint is a public servant, departmental action may also be considered against them as an alternative to prosecution.

The above instructions are brought into the notice of all Administrative Departments/Autonomous Bodies etc., public servants and general public for strict adherence.

In order to provide an integrated platform for various employee related

The service related information i. e. Basic Information, Initial appointment/Joining, qualification, contact, posting, promotion details etc. of all the employees working in UT of J&K, already captured under Centralized Personnel Information System (CPIS), has been integrated with the proposed Jammu and Kashmir Human Resource Management System (JKHRMS). In order to ensure smooth implementation of the Jammu and Kashmir Human Resource Management System - JKHRMS, it is imperative that the details of the employees captured in various formats must be correct and updated.

The portal of Jammu and Kashmir Human Resource Management System (JKHRMS) shall be made live on 17-10-2022 and can be accessed at https://hrms.jk.gov.in. The employees can register themselves by using CPIS Numbers and check the basic as well as other service related details. In case the employee related information is not updated or incorrect, the employee must fill up the requisite -Correction Formø available on the dashboard and send it to DDO for approval. The informative videos regarding registration, filling up of correction forms etc. shall also be made available on the portal for facilitation of the employees.

Accordingly, it is impressed upon employees of all the Departments across Union Territory of J&K to visit Jammu and Kashmir Human Resource Management System (JKHRMS) on https://hrms.jk.gov.in from 17-10-2022 onwards and register on the system by using CPIS Numbers and check/modify their basic as well as other service related details.

All DDOs shall ensure that the information of all employees under their control is updated and verified as per service record of the employee. DDOs shall be personally responsible for any mismatch in the verification

In this context, a detailed programme of events has been planned by the Central Vigilance Commission, New Delhi, which amongst other things includes taking of integrity pledge, sensitizing employees/public about corruption and allied issues through workshops for dissemination of information regarding menace of corruption and different measures that the public can undertake to redress it.

In connection with these celebrations, the Chief Secretary shall administer integrity pledge to all Administrative Secretaries and officers of various departments at 11:00 A.M on 31st October, 2022, in Civil Secretariat, J&K. The venue shall be Meeting Hall, 3rd Floor, Civil Secretariat, Srinagar,

It is, accordingly, enjoined upon all the Administrative Secretaries to participate in the said pledge taking ceremony along with officers of their Departments. Further, Divisional Commissioners, all Deputy Commissioners, Heads of Departments and Managing Directors of PSUs and Autonomous Bodies shall also organize similar pledge taking ceremonies in their offices as per the prescribed format of the pledge enclosed. Subject :ô Deputation of Junior/Senior Assistant for undergoing the J&K Secretariat Assistant Training Course (SATC) at J&K IMPARD.

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Circular No. 47-JK(GAD) of 2022

Dated 01-12-2022.

Pursuant to the information/requisition received from all Administrative Departments and their subordinate offices, the General Administration Department has deployed various batches of Senior/Junior Assistants for undergoing the J&K Secretariat Assistants Training Course (J&K SATC) at the J&K Institute of Management, Public Administration and Rural Development, Srinagar/Jammu (J&KIMPARD).

It has however been observed that there is still a significant number of Junior/Senior Assistants in respect of whom the Administrative Departments and their subordinate offices have not furnished the requisition for their deputation to JKIMPARD to undergo J&K SATC. Further, despite the orders of deputation issued by this department from time to time, the concerned Administrative Departments/HoDs are not relieving the deputed officials for attending the said training course. The issue has been viewed seriously by the authorities.

It is accordingly enjoined upon all Administrative Secretaries and Heads of Departments to furnish the exact details of left-out Junior/Senior Assistants who have not been deputed to undergo the J&K Secretariat Assistants Training Course at J&K IMPARD, so that the final batch of these left-out officials can be deputed for undergoing the training before the end of the current financial year.

The information should reach the General Administration Department within one week of issuance of these instructions, failing which it shall be presumed that there are no left-out Junior/Senior Assistants who are yet to undergo the training and the figures so received are final in respect of the defaulting departments/subordinate offices.

Lapses, if any, shall be the personal responsibility of the concerned. These instructions are brought into the notice of all concerned for immediate compliance.

Subject :ô Filling of Annual Property Return by the J&K Government Employees through Online Property Return System (PRS-Portal).

Dated 22-12-2022.

Sub-Section (2) of Section 9 of the Jammu and Kashmir Public Men and Public Servants Declaration of Assets and other Provisions Act, 1983 lays down that it shall be incumbent on the part of every public servant to submit annual returns of the assets held by him and his family members in the month of January every year and shall indicate the reasons for increase, if any, in the assets and source thereof.

- 2. The Jammu and Kashmir Public Servants Declaration of Assets Act and Rules made thereunder provides for imposing a penalty for non-submission of the property returns by the public servants. It is further provided that if any public servant without any reasonable cause which he shall be required to show, fails to submit the return annually, he shall be guilty of committing criminal misconduct under the Prevention of Corruption Act and shall be punishable under the said Act.
- 3. The said Act and Rules also lay down that every public servant shall submit annual property returns as per instruction issued by the Government from time to time, in respect of all the assets possessed by the him and his family members.
- 4. With a view to make the process of filing of property returns employee friendly, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir has launched online portal for filing of annual property returns (PRS-Portal) by each and every J&K Government Employee, as mandated under the Jammu and Kashmir Public Servants Declaration of Assets Act and Rules made thereunder and also as per the provisions of the Employees Conduct Rules, every year ending 31st December, by or before 31st January of the next calendar year.
- 5. The PRS-Portal is accessible on http://prs.jk.gov.in. The employees can file their annual property returns on the said portal from 1st of January and the facility automatically gets closed on 31st of January every year.
- 6. The non-submission of property returns by the employees shall invite action against them under the Prevention of Corruption Act, besides, shall result in denial of their Vigilance Clearance.

- 7. Accordingly, all the employees working under the Jammu and Kashmir Government are advised to file their property returns for the year 2022, on the PRS-Portal, from 1st of January, 2023 up to 31st of January, 2023.
- 8. Further, it is enjoined upon all the DDOs to ensure registration of those employees, who have not yet registered on the PRS Portal. Besides, ensuring filing of property details by their cent per cent employees, within the specified timelines. The portal will automatically close on 31st January, 2023.

Subject :ô Guideline for Deductions and Deposits of TDS by the DDOs under Goods and Services Tax Law.

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CIRCULAR

Instances have come to the notice of the Finance Department that some DDOs are not following the provisions of TDS as envisaged under Goods and Services Law (J&K GST Act, 2017/CGST Act, 2017/ IGST Act, 2017). Accordingly, the following comprehensive guidelines are issued for strict compliance by all the Government Departments of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

2. Section 51 of the Jammu and Kashmir GST Act, 2017 provides for deduction of Tax by the Government Agencies (Deductor) or any other person to be notified in this regard, from the payment made or credited to the supplier (Deductee) of taxable goods or services or both, where the total value of such supply, under a contract, exceeds two lakh and fifty thousand rupees. The amount deducted as tax under this section shall be paid to the Government by the deductor within ten days after the end of the month in which such deduction is made along with a return in Form GSTR-7 giving the details of deductions and deductees.

- 3. In order to comply with the provisions of the said Act for the purpose of TDS, the following steps are required to be taken by the DDOs :ô
 - A. Registration as Tax Deductors in the GST common portal.
 - B. Deduction of TDS amount as per the provisions from the bills to be paid to the suppliers/deductees.
 - C. Deposit the TDS amount into appropriate Government account(s).
 - D. File Tax Returns for TDS within the prescribed time limit.
- 4. As per Section 51 of the Act, the following entities are required to comply with the provisions of TDS and thus are required to register themselves as Tax Deductor under Section 24 (vi) of the said Act :ô
 - (i) Central and State Government Departments/Establishments
 (e. g. Departments, Heads of Departments, Collectorates, other sub-ordinate/field offices etc.)
 - (ii) Local Authority (e. g. Municipalities, Panchayati Raj Institutions etc.).
 - (iii) Government Agencies.
 - (iv) An Authority/Board/Any Other Body set up by an Act of Parliament/State Legislature or established by any Government with fifty-one per cent or more participation by way of equity or control to carry out a function.
 - (v) Society established by Central Government or State Government or a Local Authority under Societies Registration Act, 1860.
 - (vi) Public Sector Undertakings (Central and State).
- 5. **Registration**.ô For Registration as Tax Deductor, the following documents/information are required :ô
 - (i) TAN/PAN of the entity;
 - (ii) Proof of Address of the place of the entity (any proof issued by Government authority/by Local Authority/Municipal Khata Copy/Electricity Bill/Legal Ownership Document/Rent or Lease agreement etc.) - to be uploaded;

- - (iii) PAN of the DDO (or Authorized Signatory);
 - (iv) Photograph of the DDO (or Authorized Signatory)-to be uploaded;
 - (v) Aadhaar Card/Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of the DDO (or Authorized Signatory);
 - (vi) Valid email ID (preferably official email ID) of the DDO (or Authorized Signatory) Mobile Phone Number of the DDO (or Authorized Signatory);

The DDO or the Authorized Signatory is required to make an application online on GST Common Portal on behalf of the Tax Deductor.

- 6. After the application is successfully submitted by the applicant, the same would be processed by the respective jurisdictional tax officer. Once the application is approved, the DDO (or Authorized signatory) will receive the GST Number in the given email ID along with the initial password.
- 7. **Deduction of TDS and deposit thereof.**ô The Tax Deductor is required to deduct TDS amount from the payment to be made to the Supplier/Deductee at the rate of 2% (i. e. 1 % JKGST + 1% Central GST in case of intra-State supply and 2% IGST in case of inter-State Supply). Once such deduction is made by the Tax Deductor, the TDS amount is required to be deposited by the Tax Deductor in the Government account (JKGST/CGST/IGST, as the case may be) within 10 days from the end of the month in which the deduction is made.

Tax is required to be deducted from the payment made/credited to a supplier, if the total value of supply under a contract in respect of supply of taxable goods or services or both, exceeds Rs. 2,50,000/- (Rupees two lakh and fifty thousand). This value shall exclude the taxes leviable under GST (i. e. :Central taxø :State taxø :UT taxø :Integrated taxø & Cess).

- 7.1 **Conditions for and amount of deduction**.ô Tax deduction is required if all the following conditions are satisfied :ô

7.3.2 Supplier is registered and contract value is inclusive of GST:

Example 2 : Supplier Y of Mumbai makes taxable supply worth Rs. 10,000/- and exempted supply worth Rs. 20,000/- in an invoice/ bill of supply to Finance Department of GoI located in J&K where contract for supply is for Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rs. 2,60,000 for taxable supply including GST and Rs. 3,40,000 for exempted supply). The rate of GST is 18%. Following payment is being made by GoI to Y: Rs. 10,000/- (value of taxable Supply) + Rs. 1,800 (Integrated Tax) + Rs. 20,000/- (value of exempted Supply).

7.3.3 Supplier is registered under composition scheme :

Example 3: Supplier ZA is a person registered under the composition scheme in J&K who makes taxable supply worth Rs.10,000/to a Local Authority of J&K where value of taxable supply under the contract is for Rs. 2,55,000/- Following payment is being made by the Local Authority of J&K to ZA: Rs.10,000/- Value of taxable supply under the contract is Rs. 2,55,000/- which is more than Rs. 2.5 Lakh and hence deduction of tax is required.

8. Deposit of GST TDS and TDS Certificate. The amount of TDS deducted should be deposited with the Government by the deductor by the 10th of the next month in Form GSTR 7 through the online portal gst.gov.in. The deductor would be liable to pay interest if the tax deducted is not deposited within the prescribed time limit as mentioned above.

TDS Certificate in Form GSTR7-A will only be generated on the system once the deductor (DDO) furnishes a return in Form GSTR7 on the GST portal.

The TDS so deducted would also be visible to the suppliers in Form GSTR 2A and the supplier can include and avail the same in GSTR 2. The supplier can take this amount as credit in his electronic cash register and use the same for payment of tax or any other liability.

- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Rouf Ahmad Mir, was found in contact with three persons namely, Rayees Ahmad Sheikh S/o Gh. Nabi Sheikh R/o Khanpora, Newa, Yawer Ahmad Ganie S/o Ab. Rashid Ganie R/o Gudoora, Pulwama and Naseer Ahmad Malik @ Molvi S/o Ab. Hamid Malik R/o Wasoora. Subsequently, all the three accused were arrested in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the further investigation, two more persons namely, Imtiyaz Ahmad Rather S/o Mohammad Shaban Rather R/o Chewa, Kallan and Bilal Ahmad Sherjogri S/o Ab. Salam Sherjogri R/o Zadoora, were found in contact with the accused viz. Rouf Ahmad Mir and another terrorist of the JeM banned outfit namely Aqib Mushtaq Bhat S/o Mushtaq Ahmad Bhat R/o Karimabad. Subsequently, both the accused viz. Imtiyaz Ahmad Rather and Bilal Ahmad Sherjogri were also arrested in the case; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Rouf Ahmad Mir and Aqib Mushtaq Bhat, were members of JeM banned outfit and the other accused namely, Rayees Ahmad Sheikh, Yawer Ahmad Ganie, Naseer Ahmad Malik, Imtiyaz Ahmad Rather and Bilal Ahmad Sherjogri, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly terrorists namely Rouf Ahmad Mir and Aqib Mushtaq Bhat, and were providing logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy were facilitating the terrorists for transportation of their arms/ammunition from one place to another for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and

The fire was retaliated by the Search Party triggering an encounter; and

Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 45/2022 under Sections 307 IPC, 7/27 Arms Act, 16, 18, 19, 20, 38 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Nowgam and the investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, Section 39 of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, three dead bodies were recovered from the encounter site who were later on identified as terrorists of LeT banned outfit namely, Adil Ahmad Teli S/o Gh. Nabi Teli R/o Chandhara, Pampore, Yasir Ahmad Wagay S/o Ab. Rehman Wagay R/o Kujjar, Frisal, Yaripora and Shakir Ahmad Tantray S/o Gh. Mohammad Tantray R/o Ranipora, Shopian. During the search, arms/ammunition viz. 01 AK-47 rifle, 03 AK Magazines, 14 AK rounds, 02 Pistols, 03 Pistol Magazines, 06 Pistol rounds and 01 Hand Grenade were recovered from the killed terrorists; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of place of occurrence and the seizure memo of recovered arms/ammunition were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquanited with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and


