Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by the Superintending Engineer, PMGSY, Circle, Reasi/Udhampur, notification under Section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi vide No. CLA/ACR/2017-18/607-15 dated 02-03-2018 for land measuring 124 Kanals 01 Marla situated in Village Kothian, Tehsil Pouni, District Reasi, calling upon the objections from the owners/interested persons ; and

Whereas, pursuant to the above referred notification, one Mr. Sita Ram S/o Nanak Chand R/o Kothian, on 31-03-2018 filed objections stating therein that instead of Khasra No. 519, road has been constructed through Khasra Nos. 529 and 539 and the Collector concerned returned

the case to Tehsildar Pouni, in light of contents of the objections and the Tehsildar concerned conducted spot verification and submitted report to the Collector, Land Acquisition that land measuring 10 Marlas is to be de-notified and 04 Kanals 08 Marlas is to be added ; and

Whereas, the Collector concerned accordingly issued corrigendum to the notification under Section 4(1) and included the land measuring 04 Kanals 08 Marlas coming within the alignment of said road calling upon objections from the land owners/interested persons. Besides, the Collector concerned de-notified the land measuring 10 Marlas falling under Khasra No. 519 min vide No. CLA/ACR/2021-22/103-09 dated 06-07-2021 ; and

Whereas, no objection was received from any land owner/interested person and the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR) submitted the case to the Deputy Commissioner, Reasi vide No. CLA/ACR/20-21/193 dated 12-02-2021 who endorsed to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. DC/Rsi/20-21/1885-89/SQ dated 16-02-2021 for issuance of declaration/notification under Sections 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 ; and

Whereas, after examining the case Divisional Commissioner, Jammu returned the case to Deputy Commissioner, Reasi vide No. 502/4306-4307-4308-4309/PMGSY/Reasi/21/6495 dated 05-03-2021 and No. 502/4306/4307/4308/21/PMGSY/Rsi/281 dated 11-05-2021 with some observations which were clarified by the Deputy Commissioner, Reasi vide No. DC/RSI/21-22/450-54/SQ dated 03-05-2021 and No. DC/Rsi/21-22/1137-41/SQ dated 09-07-2021 ; and

Whereas, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu endorsed the case to Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K vide No. 502/4308/PMGSY/Kothian/Reasi/21/801 dated 06-08-2021, who forwarded to this department vide No. FCR-LAND/130/2021-06-(FCR) (46098) dated 07-09-2021 for the said purpose ; and

Whereas, the case was examined in the department and vide No. Rev-LAJ/83/2021 (54867) dated 08-11-2021, Deputy Commissioner, Reasi was requested to clarify the observations, regarding actual quantum of land under Khasra 425 min who vide No. DC/Rsi/SQ/22-23/6131-33 dated 18-11-2022 clarified that actual quantum of land under Khasra No. 425 min is 10 Kanals 04 Marlas, but inadvertently the area was mentioned as 10 Kanals 14 Marlas in the field book at S. No. 24 ; and

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi, vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector (DC), Reasi, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu and Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K was examined and it has been found that the objections raised earlier has been examined and is already addressed and on the revised notification no objections have been filed by anyone for the proposed acquisition ; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i. e. construction of road from Kothian to Sadeen under PMGSY Scheme, Phase-VII.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Section 6 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 127 Kanals 19 Marlas situated at Village Kothian, Tehsil and District Reasi is required for public purposes i. e. construction of road from Kothian to Sadeen under PMGSY Scheme, Phase-VII, Length=6.00 Km. Further the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi is directed under Section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Further, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/ Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

- (iv) The Prabhari Officer for each Town, shall be the mentor for that town and shall be the overall supervisory officer for success of the initiative in that town.
- (v) The Programme shall be implemented for a period of five years initially.
- (vi) For utilizing URIF, all the ULBs shall strictly adhere to all the codal provisions/formalities, Financial Rules and guidelines as notified by the Government from time to time.

1. The Police Challan at hand was presented in the Court on 11-08-2022 by the Police Station, Banihal against accused Mohd. S/o Farooq Ahmad Mir R/o Satoora, Tral and Muzaffar Ahmad Chopan
S/o Khazir Mohd Chopan R/o Khanmoh. During their personal search,
the Police recovered 02 Hand Grenades from their possession
respectively ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 51/2022 under
Section 4/5 ESA, Sections 18, 23, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, was
registered in Police Station, Pampore and the investigation of the case
was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the
Section 4/5 ESA Act was dropped and the Section 7/25 Arms Act and
Section 20 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the
place of occurrence and seizure memos were prepared and the statement
of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case
were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Arsheed
Ahmad Mir and Muzaffar Ahmad Chopan, were found in contact with
a terrorist of LeT banned outfit identified as Saqib Ahmad Khan S/o
Mushtaq Ahmad Khan R/o Khanmoh, who provided the hand grenades
to the accused in order to promote terrorist activities in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that the accused
viz. Arsheed Ahmad Mir and Muzaffar Ahmad Chopan, were working
as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit
particularly the terrorist viz. Saqib Ahmad Khan, and were providing
logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy
procured hand grenades from the said terrorist for carrying out the
terrorist activities in the area ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Saqib Ahmad Khan, has been
killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under
the law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence
collected, the Investigating Officer has established, *prima facie*, involvement
of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable

8. Whereas, the accused viz. Muzaffar Ahmad Chopan, has been found juvenile during the investigation, and in view of Section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act ; and

9. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused ; and

10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Arsheed Ahmad Mir, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 51/2022 of Police Station, Pampore.
