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Circular No. 31-JK (GAD) of 2022 Dated 08-09-2022.

Government of Jammu and Kashmir has repealed the J&K Compassionate Appointment Rules, 1994 issued under SRO-43 of 1994

The above Scheme envisages appointment of the dependents of Government servants, who die in harness/retire on invalid pension/are killed in militancy related action/enemy action on International Border/Line of Control on compassionate grounds and grant of monetary compensation based on an objective and criteria based framework of appraisal, as outlined in Annexure-I to the said Scheme.

Further, the above Scheme also envisages electronic processing and disposal of applications of the dependents of the deceased Govt. servant or Government servant retiring on invalid pension.

It has been decided that all the Autonomous Bodies, Public Undertakings/Government Companies in UT of J&K, where SRO-43/1994 is currently in operation shall proceed to adopt the J&K Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme, 2022 forthwith with the approval of the respective competent authorities, namely, Governing Bodies, Board of Directors etc.

These organizations shall also put in place a mechanism for electronic receipt and disposal of applications under the said Scheme.

Accordingly all the Administrative Secretaries are advised to direct all the Autonomous Bodies, Public Sector Undertakings, Government Companies etc. under their administrative control to take immediate, measures for adoption of the J&K Rehabilitation Assistance Scheme, 2022, with the approval of the respective Competent Authorities. The said organizations shall also set up a dedicated portal for the electronic receipt and disposal of applications under the Scheme.

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Whereas, one Salma Qadir D/o Gh. Qadir Wani R/o Hiller, Arhama, Tehsil Kokernag, District Anantnag has applied for issuance of backward area certificate under SRO-294 dated 21-10-2005.

Whereas, the case was forwarded to field agency for report in detail, and the patwari concerned while furnishing the revenue extracts reported that the applicant is the permanent resident of Village Hiller, Arhama and has not migrated till date from the said village.

Whereas, the income/salary certificate produced by the applicant with the case has concealed the facts/income of her family/father and has deceived the competent authority/field agency of Revenue Department.

Whereas, the income of the family is reportedly above ceiling owing to which the claim of the applicant is not based on facts and the case of the applicant is not fit for issuance of RBA Certificate as per the provisions of SRO-294.

Government of India, Ministry of Defence has accorded acquisition sanction vide No. 204/249/ACQ/NC/DE/426/SO (II)/D (Lands)/2018 dated 30-10-2018 for acquisition of land measuring 01 Kanal 15 Marlas (Local), comprising Khasra No. 701/645, situated at Village Purana Daroor, Tehsil Katra, District Reasi at estimated cost of Rs. 72,52,000 (Rupees Seventy-Two Lac Fifty-Two Thousand only) under the provisions of J&K RAIP Act, 1968 in compliance to Honøble High Court Order dated 17-11-2014, passed in OWP No. 1115/2012, titled as Bhanu Partap Singh and Ors. Vs UoI and Ors.
- 5. Accordingly FORM $\exists \emptyset$ (Notice) under Section 7(1) of J&K, RAIP Act, 1968 AD, was issued vide this Office No. DC/RSI/2019-20/2313-17/SQ dated 05-03-2020, wherein objections were invited from the land owners regarding the acquisition of requisitioned land. Copy of the said notice was served upon to the land owners through Tehsildar Katra. No Objection was received in the prescribed time period.
- 6. Thereafter, case was submitted to the office of Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide this Office No. DC/RSI/20-21/280-83/SQ dated 08-07-2020 with request that FORM :: Jøø under Rule 8 of Requisitioning and Acquisition of Immovable Property Act, 1968 may kindly be obtained from competent authority. Tehsildar Katra, submitted three years average sale deed rate of Village Purana Daroor vide letter No. 173/OQ dated 30-06-2021.

Principal of Compensation:

Tehsildar Katra intimated that the three years average sale deed rates for the period April, 2018 to April, 2021 as Rs. 83,35,640/- (Rupees eighty-three lacs thirty-five thousand six hundred forty only) and the market rate is Rs. 85 lacs per kanal, irrespective of kind of soil. Stamp duty rates for the year 2021 have been notified for Village Purana Daroor, Tehsil Katra, as Rs. 17.30 lacs for irrigated Rs. 14.65 lacs for unirrigated and Rs. 69.20 for small plot as per local kanal.
