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Circular No. 06-JK(GAD) of 2023

All Government orders relating to appointments set out, amongst others, the following condition as a condition precedent for joining in the Government Service :ô

"Production of certificates from the concerned (Deputy Director, Employment and General Manager, DIC) to the effect that no

loan under self-employment scheme has been taken by the appointee".

It has been seen that a vast number of youth do not take up self-employment opportunities on offer in the various Government Sponsored/ Self -Employment Schemes under which banks provide credit on easy terms and/or where Government subsidy is also available for setting up the businesses/trade as they believe that they may not be able to liquidate loan liabilities to become eligible for Government employment in case they are subsequently selected.

This has acted as a significant disincentive for them to take up self-employment as a viable livelihood option under various Government Sponsored/Self-Employment Schemes, besides adversely impacting the uptake of these schemes in J&K. Consequently, the matter has been examined in consultation with Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs and it has emerged that there is no legal bar in dispensing with the aforesaid condition and substituting it with the following condition, which would not only promote self-employment activities, but also guard against any possible loan default in J&K :

::That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from DIC/ Employment Department, to be ascertained from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment and Counseling Centre of the domicile District, he/she shall relinquish the proprietorship of unit/enterprise and also stakes, if any, in such self-employment unit/enterprise before joining the Government service. He/she shall be required to repay the entire loan liability in suitable EMIs to be worked out by the DDO concerned from his/her salary. DDO concerned shall obtain an affidavit from the concerned appointee regarding both relinquishment of proprietorship and stakes, if any, in such a self-employment unit/enterprise and recovery to be made and also personally monitor its recovery.

Accordingly, it has been decided that the condition as indicated in para (1) shall henceforth cease to be the part of the conditions prescribed in the appointment orders for joining the Government service and shall instead be replaced with the following condition :ô

::That if the candidate has taken loan for self-employment from DIC/ Employment Department, to be ascertained from the District Industries Centre (DIC) and District Employment and Counseling Centre of the

Finance Department has received a communication quoted under reference from Ministry of Law and Justice along with enclosures received from Legislative Department, Budget and Account Section and Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance regarding the cited subject.

2. The Ministry has intimated that it has been observed that while registering beneficiaries for DBT Schemes, departments have not provided the mandatory AADHAAR numbers of the beneficiaries while putting the request for account validation in PFMS.

3. In view of above, it is impressed upon all the Programme Divisions of all the departments to update Aadhaar numbers of the beneficiaries in PFMS in the following manner :ô

a. For external systems integrated with PFMS by submitting account validation update request with the beneficiaryøs

b. For schemes using PFMS portal, the beneficiaries of Aadhaar number may be updated using the edit facility available.

4. In case Aadhaar numbers of some of the beneficiaries are missing, the same may be collected and updated in PFMS in the aforesaid manner.

5. It is further impressed upon all that the beneficiary and account both should be Aadhaar based. Editing facility also needs to be incorporated as per guidelines and weeding out of ineligible persons need to be confirmed on DBT portal.

Subject :ô Counting of previous service on joining new service in UT Government/Centre Government/Autonomous Body for the benefit of gratuity in respect of Government employees covered under Defined Contributory Pension Scheme (NPS).

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CIRCULAR

The Benefit of Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity was extended to NPS employees of UT Government service vide SRO-484 dated 29-11-2017 and SO6328 dated 24-09-2021 issued by Finance Department, on the same terms and conditions as is applicable to employees covered under Defined Pension Scheme (Old Pension Scheme) on the analogy of the pattern adopted by Government of India vide O. M. No. 38/41/06-P&PW (A) dated 05-05-2009 and O. M. No. 7/5/2012-P&PW (F)/B dated 26-08-2016.

Doubts has been expressed by various departments as to whether the service rendered by NPS employees who have taken another appointment in the UT Government after quitting the former service is entitled for counting of service for pensionery benefits (Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity).

The issue has been examined in the Finance Department. The counting of service for the purpose of gratuity on mobility of a NPS Government employee from one department to another department may be regulated in the following manner :ô

- (i) On mobility from one department to another department of UT Government service, the service rendered in the previous department shall be counted for the purpose of grant of Gratuity.
- (ii) On mobility from Central Government Service to UT Government Service or vice-versa, having NPS with provisions of retirement gratuity/death gratuity for its employees, the service rendered in the Central Government or in UT Government, as the case may be, shall be counted for the purpose of grant of gratuity. There shall be no sharing of gratuity liability between the Center and UT Government.
- (iii) On mobility from UT Government Service to UT Autonomous Body having NPS with provisions of retirement /death gratuity for its employees, similar to that in UT Government, the service rendered in the UT Government would be counted for grant of gratuity. The Government will discharge its gratuity liability by paying the amount of retirement gratuity for the service rendered in the Government to the UT Autonomous Body. This procedure shall be followed *mutatis mutandis* in respect of NPS employees going over from one autonomous body to another autonomous body or from an autonomous body to UT Government having NPS with provisions of retirement/death gratuity for its employees similar to UT Government employees.
- (iv) On mobility from UT Government Service to a UT Autonomous Body, where the provision for grant of gratuity similar to that in UT Government does not exist or to a Public Sector Undertaking, the NPS Government employees shall be granted retirement gratuity as per rules for the service rendered in the UT Government subject to the condition that the total gratuity admissible in respect of the service rendered under the Government of J&K, shall not exceed the amount that would

> have been admissible, had the Government servant continued in Government Service and retired on the same pay which he/she drew on retirement from later organization.

The above provisions would be applicable to Government employees covered under NPS who resign (technical resignation) to take up another appointment, with proper permission, in Centre/UT Government or Central/UT Autonomous Body or a PSU.

The accused has been arrested by the Enforcement Directorate (ED) in FIR No. 04-02-2007 under section 3/4 PMIA 2002-P/S ED and is presently loged at Tihar Jail, New Delhi ; and

Award/Judgment

- On being reference made under SRO No. 316 vide notification dated 14-09-2015 by Commissioner/Secretary to Government (Labour and Employment) Department for adjudication, present petition came to be filed against management/respondent company in terms of Sub-Section (1) of Section 10 of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. Facts of this case lies in narrow compass. The petitioner/applicant a Welder was employee of respondent company till 20-05-2015 and respondent Management forcibly/illegally and arbitrarily terminated him from service thereby causing immense loss to him.
- 2. The controversy between the parties is that respondents herein (employer) unlawfully terminated the service of Welder, Sh. Nanak Chand, chiefly on the ground that he superannuates on the basis of office record where his D.O.B. is recorded as 07-05-1955 [ESIC], when he reached at the age of 58 years, the petitioner controverted and contested that his correct D.O.B. is 05-08-1958 and not 07-05-1955. According to petitioner he was acting as a Union leader as a "President Workers Unionø due to which the respondent nourished **ill-will** as such they did not act on the correct date of birth of the petitioner rather unlawfully terminated his services prematurely at the age of 56 years in the guise of imaginary D.O.B. The respondents contested his contention and as the reconciliation proceeding culminated into failure, appropriate Government made reference (supra).

- - 3. Parties appeared before this Tribunal and presented their respective proof.
 - 4. Heard parties and thoroughly perused record on file. The forceful submission on behalf of the respondents is that the petitioner has been lawfully superannuated on attaining age of 58, which is the valid date as per his date of birth, recorded in respondent¢ office record. On the other hand, petitioner¢ thrust is on his D.O.B. as per school record and that his service has been done away with *sheer malice* on account of the fact that he used to represent worker¢ case before respondent¢ management, which irked the respondents and they being at dominant position arbitrarily and unlawfully removed him from service on telling that, his D.O.B. is 07-05-1955.
 - 5. Parties were given sufficient time to prove their respective contentions. The petitioner examined Ms. Anuradha, Record Keeper and principal Sunita Sharma who proved the School Certificate produced by the petitioner, issued vide S. No. 132 dated 16-09-2014 from the Govt. High School Palliø Vijaypur, District Samba. The PWs of record confirmed that the correct D.O.B. of the petitioner as per school record is 05-08-1958. The petitioner also examined himself as own witness. Despite satisfactory cross-examination by the respondents not even an iota of suspicion is brought on record regarding fabrication of School record. Obviously the record is in custody of the school officials and petitioner cannot be expected to have access for fabricating the same. Besides, a bare look at the school register/record, no erasing or insertions etc. are found to suspect the genuineness of school record, rather it has the presumption of truthfulness. On the other hand respondentsø record has been in their possession and custody to which the petitioner cannot have access. There is no doubt to believe that the petitioner worked as Union leader in the respondent Industry and presumably he represented his fellow workmen and therefore, ill-will and malice could be easily nourished by the industrialists/employers. So the fact that in order to get rid of him, probabilities of the respondents fabricating his false D.O.B. in the

record in their custody cannot be ruled out. The respondents have not brought on record any fact/evidence evincing that their record was in safe custody under **foolproof** safeguards and could not be accessed and forged as per their convenience. There is catena of judgment that Scbool record is **authentic proof** of date of birth as it is the earliest and can be rarely suspected upon unless there is material on record that the same was fiddled with and forged. This Tribunal has no grain of doubt that the D.O.B. of the petitioner, as per school record, is authentic and reliable.

- 6. Accordingly the petitioner could not have attained the age of superannuation on the basis of his erratic D.O.B. viz. 07-05-1955 as projected by the respondents, whereas his correct and proven D.O.B. is 05-08-1958. It is therefore held that respondents action in superannuating the petitioner on the basis of erratic D.O.B. i. e. 07-05-1955 is not justified. Consequently the petitioner is held entitled to be adequately compensated as his reinstatement to service/welder is only an exception as his service for merely two years was remaining when his unlawful termination came and at this stage he is entitled to back wages and compensation. It is added that the respondents have paid him gratuity at the time of his retirement. Honøble Supreme Court of India has in such a situation held that compensation is the rule and reinstatement is only an exception otherwise also when much water has flown since he was unlawfully terminated from the service on 20-5-2015 at the age of 58 years as per record it would not be just to order his reinstatement. Reference may be made to Honøble Apex Court judgement in 'Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Vs. State of Maharashtra on 08 April, 2020'.
- 7. At the time of unlawful termination (not superannuation) the petitioner Welder was getting Rs. 10,425/- per month which he has been unlawfully deprived of since. It is thus directed that the respondents shall pay to the petitioner an amount equivalent to 26 months 16 days salary @ Rs. 10,425/- per month, for the months when he attains superannuation. He shall be paid the amount of salary etc.

within three months from the date of this order. He shall also be entitled to prevalent bank interest at the relevant time on the total amount of salary. The gratuity amount for the months subsequent to his date of termination till his correct date of superannuation shall also be paid without any loss of time. Needless to reiterate that the petitioner is also entitled compensation for his **unlawful** termination which is tantamount to punishment. The respondents shall pay an amount of Rupees Fifty thousand (Rs. 50,000/-) as compensation. The reference is accordingly answered and the award may be forwarded to the Government Press for publication under rules. File shall be completed in all respects and be consigned to records.
