HIGH COURT OF JAMMU AND KASHMIR AND LADAKH (OFFICE OF THE REGISTRAR GENERAL AT JAMMU).

Subject:—Live Streaming and Recording of Court Proceedings Rules of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh, 2023.

#### Notification

No. 385 of 2023/RG Dated 27-02-2023.

**Preface**: Whereas to imbue greater transparency, inclusivity and foster access to justice, it is expedient to set up infrastructure and the framework to enable live streaming and recording of proceedings. These rules are framed by the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh in the exercise of powers under Article 225 and Article 227 of the Constitution of India and all other powers enabling in this behalf.

**Short title, applicability and commencement.**—These rules shall be called the 'Live Streaming and Recording of Court Proceedings Rules of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh, 2023'.

These rules will apply to the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh and to the courts and tribunals over which it has supervisory jurisdiction.

These rules will come into force from the date notified by the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh.

#### 1. Definitions.—

- **Archival Data:** means audio and visual data recorded during (i) the conduct of the proceedings and retained by the Court.
- (ii) **Bench:** means the Judge(s) assigned to hear the case filed before the court.

- (iii) Chief Justice: means the Chief Justice of the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh, including the Acting Chief Justice.
- (iv) Communication Device: means a hardware device capable of transmitting analog or digital signal over the telephone and other communication devices, whether wired or wireless.
- (v) **Court:** means the High Court of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh and/or all the courts/tribunals under its supervision under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.
- (vi) Court Master/Reader: means the court staffs that assist the court in the conduct of proceedings, including updating of the cause lists published on the display board.
- (vii) **Court Premises:** means and includes buildings and complexes under the authority of courts.
- (viii) Designated Officer: means the Registrar (IT) or any other officer mandated to carry out the function of granting access to copies of recordings under these rules.
  - (ix) **Designated Venue:** means and includes a courtroom or any other place where the proceedings are conducted, whether within the court premises or at a remote location.
  - (x) **Hardware:** means and includes equipment to be installed for live streaming and recording of proceedings or any ancillary activity.
  - (xi) IT Committee: means and includes a committee constituted by the Chief Justice to deal with matters concerning information and communication technology, also referred to as the High Court computer committee or e-Committee.
- (xii) Live stream/Live streamed/Live streaming: means and includes a live television link, webcast, audio-video transmissions via electronic means or other arrangements whereby any person can view the proceedings as permitted under these rules.

- (xiii) **Proceedings:** mean and include judicial proceedings, Lok Adalat proceedings, full-court references, official transfer, elevation, retirement, farewells organised by the Court.
- (xiv) **Recording:** means audio and video data of proceedings stored in electronic format, whether it is live streamed or not.
- (xv) Recording Device: means and includes a device capable of recording images or sound, including but not limited to camera, audio recorder, video recorder, mobile telephone or screen recorder.
- (xvi) **Registrar (IT):** means and includes any officer so designated by the Chief Justice of the High Court.
- (xvii) **Remote Location:** means and includes a geographical location, different from the court premises, from where proceedings are conducted.
- (xviii) **Transcript:** means the official written record of the proceedings published as per the directions of the court.

#### 2. Hardware-Placement and Control:

- 2.1. Cameras will be ordinarily installed in the courtroom covering at least five angles; one towards the bench, the second and third towards the advocates engaged in the concerned matter, the fourth towards the accused (where applicable) and the fifth towards the deponent/witness, as required.
- 2.2. If the court has employed an electronic evidence presentation system, an additional feed shall be captured therefrom.
- 2.3. A remote-control device shall be provided to the presiding judge on the bench to pause or stop the live streaming at any time.

- 2.4. Advocates, witnesses, accused, or any other person permitted by the bench, shall use appropriate microphones while addressing the court.
- 2.5. In so far as a remote location is concerned, appropriate hardware will be deployed to the extent practicable, bearing in mind the provisions made in the aforementioned subrules.
- 2.6. Where proceedings are conducted through weblinks, including video conferencing services, appropriate software and hardware will be employed, if necessary, to generate an integrated feed for live streaming.

#### 3. Requisitioning and Positioning of Human Resources:

- 3.1. A dedicated control room (DCR) shall be set up for every court complex.
- 3.2. The DCR shall, *inter alia*, comprise an officer of the Court, technical and video-recording experts. The DCR will monitor and track proceedings as they are live streamed, recorded, and transcribed. The DCR shall ensure that nothing uncivil or inappropriate is streamed in the public domain.
- 3.3. The coverage of proceedings will be coordinated by the technical experts under the direct supervision of the Registrar (IT) or her/his nominee.
- 3.4. The Registrar (IT) and/or their nominee shall be subject to the directions of the IT Committee for the overall implementation of live streaming and recording of proceedings.

#### 4. Personnel positioned in the Court:

In addition to the court master and court staff attached to the bench, technical expert(s) shall be appointed/deputed in each of the court premises or designated venue to enable the live streaming of proceedings. The technical expert(s) shall function under the overall supervision of the DCR.

#### 5. Live streaming and Recording of Proceedings:

- 5.1. Subject to the exclusions contained within these rules, all proceedings will be live streamed by the court.
- The following will be excluded from live streaming:—
  - (i) Matrimonial matters, child adoption and child custody including transfer petitions arising thereunder.
  - (ii) Cases concerning sexual offences, including proceedings instituted under Section 376, Indian Penal Code, 1860 (IPC).
  - (iii) Cases concerning gender-based violence against women.
  - (iv) Matters registered under or involving the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO) and under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.
  - (v) Matters registered under or involving the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971.
  - (vi) In camera proceedings as defined under Section 327 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Cr. PC) or Section 153 B of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (CPC).
  - (vii) Matters where the bench is of the view, for reasons to be recorded in writing that publication would be antithetical to the administration of justice.
  - (viii) Cases, which in the opinion of the Bench, may provoke enmity amongst communities likely to result in a breach of law and order.
    - (ix) Recording of evidence, including cross-examination.
    - (x) Privileged communications between the parties and their advocates; cases where a claim of privilege is accepted by the Court; and non-public discussions between advocates.

- (xi) Any other matter in which a specific direction is issued by the bench or the Chief Justice.
- 5.3. Live streaming in certain cases may be restricted to final arguments.
- 5.4. The court master/reader shall duly inform the parties, before the commencement of the proceedings that the proceedings are being live streamed and that objections, if any, should be articulated at that juncture to the concerned bench.
- 5.5. Objections, if any, to live streaming may be raised at the time of institution of the case or any later stage. The final decision in that behalf shall be of the Bench:—
  - (i) Objection to live streaming, if any, shall be raised by the party by filing the form prescribed in Schedule-I.
  - (ii) A person objecting to live streaming at a later stage, shall do so by filing the form prescribed in Schedule-II.
- 5.6. The final decision as to whether to allow the live streaming of the proceedings or any portion thereof will be of the bench. However, the decision of the bench will be guided by the principle of an open and transparent judicial process. The decision of the Bench shall not be justifiable, provided that, in case of difference of opinion, the matter can be referred to a larger bench for a final decision.
- 5.7. In cases where the proceedings are not live streamed, the recording shall be maintained for usage by the Court and the appellate court(s), subject to the following:—
  - (i) Access to the recording of the testimony of witnesses will not be given until such time that the evidence is recorded in its entirety.
  - (ii) Transcript of the recordings would be made available to the advocate or litigant-in-person.

- (iii) In case of litigant-in-person, who is also a witness in the matter, the bench in its discretion will decide as to the stage at which the litigant-in-person should have access to the recordings of the testimonies concerning the other witnesses in the matter.
- 5.8. In criminal matters, the testimony of victims and witnesses will be recorded for the exclusive use of the concerned bench and the appellate court(s), as per the direction issued in that behalf. The anonymity of the victims and witnesses shall be maintained in the recordings via dummy names, face-masking, pixilation and/or electronic distortion of voice, as and when directed by the court.
- 5.9. Audio-video recording or recording of proceedings by any other means, beyond the mandate of the present rules is expressly prohibited.

#### 6. Manner of recording of proceedings:

- 6.1. The cameras in the Court shall be as per Rule 2.1.
- 6.2. Cameras shall not ordinarily audio-video record the media persons and the visitors present during the proceedings.
- 6.3. The following will ordinarily not be live streamed or saved in the archival data or transcribed :-
  - (i) Discussions between/amongst the judges on the bench.
  - (ii) Instructions given by a judge to the administrative staff during the proceedings.
  - (iii) Any communication/message/document given by the court master/reader to the bench.
  - (iv) Documents given to the judge during the proceedings.
  - (v) Notes taken down by the judge during the proceedings.
  - (vi) Notes made by an advocate either on paper or in electronic form. for assistance. while making submissions before the bench.

- (vii) Communication between the advocate and client, interse the advocates and communications which is not a submission exchanged between the advocate and the court.
- 6.4. If one or more circumstances mentioned in Rule 6.3 occur, the monitor will display the message: "Live streaming paused as per applicable rules".
- 6.5. In case the judge concerned on the bench is desirous of opting out of live streaming while dictating the order/oral judgment, live streaming will be paused during that period. In such circumstances, the monitors will display a message: "Order-dictation in progress". Likewise, when the bench rises for recess or otherwise, the live streaming will be paused, and the monitor will display the message: "Court not in-session".

#### 7. Storage and Access:

- 7.1. The recordings will be archived.
- 7.2. Recordings may be uploaded, wholly or in part, on the Courts' website or made available on other digital platforms, as directed by the court.
- 7.3. Access to copies of the recordings not uploaded will be sanctioned by the designated officer, who will act as per law. An application for copies of recordings shall be made in the form prescribed in Schedule-III.
- 7.4. The archived data should ordinarily be retained by the court for at least six months, subject to special directions issued by the concerned bench in a particular case. The Chief Justice may issue practice directions regarding the cases and the period for which archived data will be preserved. Archived data shall be stored in electronic devices in encrypted form with a specific hash(#) value.

#### 8. Relay of Proceedings and Recordings:

8.1. General Precaution: Personal information such as date of birth of parties, home address, identity card number, bank account information, and the personal information of related parties, such as close relatives, witnesses and other participants, will be deleted or muted during Live streaming. Inter alia, any one of the masking techniques, as provided in Rule 6.8, may be adopted. However, such Proceedings will be preserved in the archival data.

8.2. The advocates and litigants-in-person may request the bench to redact personal and sensitive information inter alia of the kind referred to in Rule 8.1.

#### 8.3. Relay of Proceedings:

- (i) Subject to limitations contained in these rules, the live stream shall commence as soon as the bench assembles and instructs the court staff to start the proceedings and shall end when the bench signals its conclusion for the day.
- (ii) There shall be a delay of ten minutes in streaming, which may be changed as per the direction of the Court.
- (iii) The live streaming shall be carried out from the designated venue as decided by the bench.
- 8.4. **Relay of Recordings:** The content of the recording will be vetted and shall be posted, usually within three days of the conclusion of the proceedings. The same shall be posted on the Courts' website or made available on such digital platforms, as directed by the court.

#### 9. Disclaimers, Prohibitions and Restrictions:

#### 9.1. Disclaimers:

- (i) The daily cause list published on the website of the court shall contain requisite information and disclaimer regarding live streaming.
- (ii) The archival data shall not constitute the official record of the court proceedings unless otherwise directed by the bench.

- 9.2. Prohibitions and restrictions on usage of the recording or live stream:
  - (i) No person/entity (including print and electronic media and social media platforms) other than an authorised person/entity shall record, share and/or disseminate live streamed proceedings or archival data. This provision shall also apply to all messaging applications. Any person/entity acting contrary to this provision will be prosecuted as per law. The court shall have the exclusive copyright in the recordings and archival Data. Any unauthorised usage of the live stream will be punishable as an offence under the Indian Copyright Act, 1957, Information Technology Act, 2000, and other provisions of law, including the Law of Contempt.
  - (ii) Any party/litigant-in-person accessing the live stream will be bound by these rules.
  - (iii) The live stream shall not, without the prior written authorisation of the Court, be reproduced, transmitted, uploaded, posted, modified, published, or republished in any form.
  - (iv) The use of authorised recordings in their original form may be permitted by the Court, inter alia to disseminate news and for training, academic and educational purposes. Authorised recordings handed over for the aforesaid purposes shall not be further edited or processed. Such recordings will not be used for commercial, promotional purposes or advertising in any form.
  - (v) No person shall use a recording device for recording or for transcribing the proceedings, other than those authorised by the Court.
- 9.3. Use of communication device or recording device during proceedings:
  - (i) A person must not use a communication device or a recording device to disturb proceedings in a manner that may cause concern to a witness or other

participants in the proceedings or allow a person who is not a participant to receive information about the proceeding or the hearing to which the person is not otherwise entitled.

- (ii) During proceedings, all personnel shall follow the instructions of the presiding judge, adhere to courtroom etiquettes and discipline, and shall not engage in the following actions-audio and/or video recording, taking screenshots or using mobile communication tools to relay the proceedings.
- (iii) Violation of Sub-Rules (i) and (ii) will result in prosecution as per law. Additionally, the bench may also direct seizure of the communication device or recording device.

#### 10. Transcription and Access:

- 10.1. Transcripts shall be prepared of recordings only when directed by the court.
- 10.2. The transcripts may be translated into other scheduled languages.
- 10.3. Recordings that are uploaded will be made accessible for differently abled persons.

#### 11. Dedicated room(s) for live streaming:

In order to decongest the courtrooms, dedicated room(s) for viewing the live stream may be made available within the court premises. Access shall be given to law researchers, staff, litigants, academicians, and media personnel authorised to enter the court premises upon receipt of necessary permissions/approvals. Appropriate arrangements shall be made to enable viewing of live streams from multiple benches within this/these room(s). Special arrangements will be made for differently abled persons.

#### 12. Power to Relax:

The High Court may, if satisfied that the operation of any rule is causing undue hardship, by order, dispense with or relax the requirements of that rule to such extent and subject to such conditions as may be stipulated to deal with the case in a just and equitable manner.

#### 13. Reference to Words and Expressions:

Words and expressions used and not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as assigned to them by the law for the time being in force, including the Information Technology Act, 2000, CPC, the Cr. PC, Indian Evidence Act, 1872, and the General Clauses Act, 1897.

#### 14. Residual Provisions:

Matters concerning which no express provision is made in these rules shall be decided by the Court consistent with the principle of furthering the interest of justice.

#### Terms of References:

- a. Assess the number of AMRUT cities in the UT and monitor cities which shall be implementing 24x7 water supply projects and regularly interact with National Task Force.
- b. Support cities in establishing a City-level Task Force (CTF) on 24x7 water supply system and extend handholding support.
- c. Organize region-wise meeting inviting all the City Engineers for AMRUT cities for handholding and dissemination of knowledge on 24x7 water supply.
- d. Emphasize on the immediate goals and need for implementation of 24x7 Water Supply in AMRUT Cities, in at least one ward or one DMA or District Metering Areas with 2000 households as envisaged under AMRUT 2.0.

- - e. Organize the capacity building program and training to all the respective engineers/staff working in the cities regarding 24x7 water supply.
  - f. Ensure that all the cities have sustainable and 95% reliable water source. To ensure this, members of STF shall take up site visits as and when required.
  - g. Disseminate various components for implementation on 24x7 water supply brought out in the ::Guidelines for Planning, Design and Implementation of 24x7 Water Supply Systems@ and revised Manual on Water Supply and Treatment, to be published by the Ministry.
  - h. Identify and study the National and International best practices of 24x7 water supply from the view point of effectiveness, efficiency, sustainability, impact and share the success and failure experiences. The service delivery models, O&M, community engagement, institutional setup, adopted technology and lessons applicable/learnt to Indian cities will be identified and shared with the cities.
  - i. Extend handholding support to cities in preparing City Water Balance Plan, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs), and reduction in Non-Revenue Water (NRW).
  - j. Advise cities in setting up Non-Revenue Water (NRW) cells in all AMRUT Cities in the UT of J&K.
  - k. Standardize the rate for works relating to surveying and hydraulic modeling, SCADA implementation etc. and DPR preparation and request cities to maintain uniform rate of charge across the UT.
  - Advise cities to undertake the initiatives of capacity building, institutional strengthening of utilities and facilitating the twinning program for Cities/ULBs within and outside the Country.
  - m. Monitor, city 24x7 water supply projects on the Web Portal which will be developed by CPHEEO to maintain data on digital mode and also monitor MIS on 24x7 Water Supply Systems.

n. The duration of the STF shall be initially for 3 years (2022-2024) and will be extended till completion of AMRUT 2.0.

(ii) It shall implement Model RFP by Inviting tender (or appointing consultant for city who will do major works/activities required for preparation of the DPR for executing the 24x7 water supply project. Appointing consultant for carrying out planning of city

- - (iii) To monitor activities that come under the duties of the appointed consultant who will be responsible for all the works till commission of the regular major works pertaining to 24x7 water supply.
  - (iv) To prepare GIS mapping of water supply infrastructure for the operational zone of the respective DMAs/city. Design the transmission main from water works or clear water sumps to the overhead reservoirs and water distribution network in the operational zone/cityô
    - (a) To ensure that maps of water supply infrastructure of the operational zone are available with them.
    - (b) Operational Zones/Cities may have proper digitized map of the water supply network.
    - (c) Cities may have CAD data in form of :: As-Built-Drawings of water supply network for the Operational Zone.
    - (d) Need to adopt a GIS strategy to convert their existing data of network into a GIS ready format. The Maps need to be properly Geo referenced using Geographic Control Points (GCPs) collected in the city.
    - (e) Need to digitize the ward boundaries and convert them to GIS format with attributes of ward-wise area and census population of last 5 decades.
    - (f) City land-use maps for the Operational Zone/City should be created by taking help of City Development Plan (CDP).

- - (g) Should direct the city engineer, through their GIS cell, to geo reference these maps and get them converted to GIS format, as most of the cities have their maps of water supply scheme including Transmission and Distribution network on Auto CAD format.
  - (h) Condition assessment of the existing pipelines and valves should be carried out. In GIS mapping, the usable existing pipes should be shown and considered in the design.
  - (v) To ensure that the city has perennial sustainable water source with 95% dependability.
  - (vi) To forecast population for Intermediate and ultimate stage of 15 years and 30 years, respectively ahead of base year; base year being expected year of commissioning of the proposed project. The population forecast shall be done ward-wise by considering the ward-wise population density and equivalent area method for the Operational Zone/City.
  - (vii) To ensure that the distribution system is designed with peak factor of 2.5 and all pipelines from source and that of the distribution system are designed for projected demand of ultimate stage for the Oerational Zone/City.
  - (viii) To ensure that the transmission mains which are the main lines of the Project shall be designed properly by optimizing the capital and energy.
  - (ix) To ensure that the GIS based hydraulic model is prepared showing the existing and proposed new pipelines and the newly planned service reservoirs.
  - (x) To ensure the following for distribution system :ô
    - (a) There is one operational zone per service reservoir/pumping station.
    - (b) All the proposed district metered areas (DMAs) are hydraulically discrete.
    - (c) Boundary of the operational zone should be so decided that the service reservoir would not get empty nor overflow.

- - (d) The distribution pipe network is for existing as well as newly proposed pipes required for 100% coverage in the proposed DMA.
  - (e) After running the model, the nodal pressures are checked for required heads (say 17m for cities with population more than 1 lakh and 12m for cities with population less than 1 lakh) and the velocity of flow in pipes shall not be more than 3m/s.
  - (f) House service connections are given for pipes having diameter more than 100 mm. For this purpose, additional rider pipes should be shown and included in the design of the distribution system.
  - (g) Critical points such as nodes of highest elevation and the farthest place are shown in the GIS based distribution maps. These points are required for the design of the SCADA system.
  - (h) Wherever road width is 6m and above, pipeline on both sides should be laid.
  - (xi) To ensure the following with respect metering :ô
    - (a) There is 100% consumer metering.
    - (b) Each meter is GIS tagged.
    - (c) Tariff is with telescopic rate based on volumetric consumption.
    - (d) Bulk meters are installed at all strategic and suitable places so that NRW computation is possible, and its reduction becomes possible.
    - (e) All bulk meters are connected to the SCADA system.
    - (f) For commercial, industrial and societies of high-rise buildings, Automatic Meter Reading (AMR) meters are planned.
    - (g) The required Control Valves (FCVs/PRVs for hilly areas) are planned for designed distribution of water.
    - (h) VVTP, MBRs, ZBRs (Zonal Balance Reservoir), ESRs, pumping stations are located on all season roads and the roads for missing lanes.

(xii) The Chairman may invite/co-opt any official or non-official member as a Special Invitee.

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

The proceedings are as per the provisions of Section 23 of õThe Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013ö for determination of compensation in respect of additional buildable land measuring 272 Kanals (13.6 Hectares) required for development of AIIMS at Awantipora. The acquisition proceedings were initiated on the basis of request made by the requiring body viz. Director, Health Services, Kashmir, vide his office No. DHSK/Plg/AIIMS Awantipora/019/5120-22 dated 05-11-2020. On the basis of alignment given by the Health/PWD Department, a field survey with the help of ETS was got done where it was observed that the entire land is falling under one Khasra number i. e. 2603 min shamilat Section 5 land, therefore, on the basis of possession of land as maintained by the land holders a map was prepared, and plots were numbered from Serial No. 1 to 65.

# NOTIFICATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND REPORT OF SIA:

The process for conduct of Social Impact Assessment Report under the provisions of Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/244-54 dated 26-12-2020, where under following members already nominated by the District Collector vide his office Order No. DCP/LA/2020/610-30 dated 25-08-2020 were assigned the task for conduct of the field survey for the proposed project:—

- (1) Tehsildar Awantipora.
- (2) Assistant Executive Engineer, R&B, Pampore.
- (3) Assistant Executive Engineer (Jal Shakti), PHE, Awantipora.
- (4) Assistant Executive Engineer, Irrigation and Flood Control, Awantipora.
- (5) Range Officer, Forests, Awantipora.
- (6) Agriculture Extension Officer, Noorpora.
- (7) Representative of Indenting Department.

The report so prepared by the committee members for the instant land acquisition case was submitted to the Appropriate Government/District Collector vide this Office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/281-83 dated 12-01-2021 for accord of approval/authorization for issuance of notification under Section 11 of the said Act.

#### **EVALUATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT:**

On the basis of the recommendations and the observations submitted by the committee constituted, it was established that the land for which the indent stands placed is required for legitimate and *bona fide* public purpose which necessitates the acquisition of land identified. Direction to the Collector for proceedings ahead under the provisions of Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was communicated by the District Collector vide his office No. DCP/LA/2020/1353-54 dated 14-01-2021.

#### **PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATION AND ISSUE OF NOTICES:**

The preliminary notification under Section 11 (1) of the Right of Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and

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Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued vide this office Notification No. 01 of 2021 dated 15-01-2021 under endorsement No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/291-97 dated 15-01-2021 for calling upon the objections, if any, from the interested persons/landowners. In response to the said notification, the objections were received, heard and accordingly submitted along with approximate cost of land acquisition as laid under Section 15 of the Act vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/21- 22/601-03 dated 18-11-2021, with the recommendations to the Government through District Collector, Pulwama for a decision and if found appropriate issuance of declaration under Section 19 of the Act.

The case was examined by the Government and it was observed that the establishment of AIIMS at Awantipora is required for public purpose, therefore, the acquisition of land outweigh the objections raised.

The Government issued declaration under Section 19(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 vide Notification No. 01-Rev(LAK) of 2022 dated 10-01-2022 under endorsement No. Rev-LAK/1/2022(112415) dated 10-01-2022.

Public notice under Section 21(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/694-702 dated 22-01-2022 to the interested persons/land owners to state the particulars of the land so needed, and to state the nature of their respective interests in the land and the amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests, their claims to rehabilitation and resettlement along with their objections, if any, to the measurement made and to appear personally or by agent or advocate within a period of 30 days. During the prescribed period of time total 8 applications were received out of which 4 applications that required name correction were rectified after clarification and report from the Tehsildar, Awantipora, 2 applications for stopping of payments, one from general public requesting for framing of award as per the provisions of Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 and one from Haffeza Ahkter W/o Bashir Ahmad Munjkhal requesting for deciding of land compensation amount in light of Sale Deed executed in her favour on 27-08-2019 @ Rs. 37 lac

per Kanal. Her representation was considered and was found to be devoid of merits. In addition to this Tehsildar, Awantipora has furnished a report in respect of Plot Nos. 46 to 49 wherein he has corrected the land particulars from 11 Kanals 13<sup>1/2</sup> Marlas to 11 Kanals 10<sup>1/2</sup> Marlas, thereby decreasing the measurement by 3 Marlas. As such the award is announced for 271 Kanals 17 Marlas instead of 272 Kanals.

## METHODOLOGY USED FOR DETERMINATION OF COMPENSATION:

The revenue extracts, including Khasra Paimaish so prepared were submitted by the Tehsildar, Awantipora. The type of land for survey number 3335/2603 min, 3674/3335/2603 min, 3416/3335/2603 min, 3423/3335/2603 min, 3423/3335/2603 min, 3423/3335/2603 min recorded as shamilat Sec. 5 (Maidani, Banjar Qadeem, Gair Mumkin), however on spot it is in the form of orchard where fruit growing trees have been found for which separate assessment was done by the Horticulture Department. The land rates per kanal as applicable to the type of land stands notified by the Chairman, District Valuation Committee vide his office Notification Number 09/DCP-SQ of 2020 dated 31-12-2020 under endorsement number DCP-SQ/20-21/1808-22 dated 31-12-2020. The value of the land as per the market value guidelines for the corresponding year is as under:—

There is no residential/commercial structure on or near the proposed site.

#### **COMPENSATION OF FRUIT BEARING TREES:**

The Compensation of fruit bearing trees stands assessed at Rs. 39,24,156/- by the Chief Horticulture Officer, Pulwama and communicated vide his Office number CHO/PUL/DEV/2021-22/2227-

28 dated 18-11-2021. The same was authenticated by the Director, Health Services, Kashmir vide his office number DHSK/PLG/AIIMS/2022-23/2796-98 dated 05-05-2022.

#### POSSESSION OF LAND

With the intention of speeding up the development of AIIMS Hospital the land owners voluntarily handed over the possession of land in the month of Nov. 2021 when some of the trees were cut and the land free of all encumbrances was taken over by the Tehsildar, Awantipora who in turn handed it over to the requiring body for development of allied structures of AIIMS.

## MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED:

Consequent upon taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested persons, the Tehsildar concerned shall ensure that the revenue records and all the relevant documents relating to the ownership/occupancy of the said land are accordingly updated (mutated) and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government through Health Department.

#### **APPORTIONMENT:**

Payment shall be made according to the spot verification, latest entries in the Revenue Record, pro rata basis and as per enquiry conducted under Section 23. In case of any dispute, which I cannot settle within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the court under Section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for the determination of ownership rights.

#### **ENCUMBRANCES:**

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and has been mentioned in the Award statement.

#### **DETERMINATION OF SOLATIUM:**

As per the provisions of Section 30(1) of the Right to Fair

Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the market value is awarded as Solatium has been determined in the award statement.

#### **COMPENSATION OF LAND:**

After considering the parameters provided in Section 26 across 29 of the Act, the compensation of the land stands determined. The total amount of award works out to Rs. 86,41,75,812/- (Rupees Eighty-Six Crores Forty-One Lacs Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve Only).

#### APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT AWARD:

The Draft Award so framed vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/228-36 dated 16-07-2022 for an amount of Rs. 86,41,75,812/(Rupees Eighty-Six Crores Forty-One Lacs Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred and Twelve Only) involved in the instant land acquisition

case was submitted to the Government through Deputy Commissioner, Pulwama vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/237 dated 16-07-2022 for accord of approval of the rates.

Accordingly, the instant land acquisition case was put before the Collector meeting held on 22-07-2022 under the Chairmanship of District Collector, Pulwama. The minutes of the meeting were circulated vide District Collector, Pulwama office No. DCP/LA/22/103-110 dated 28-07-2022 whereby the members of the committee agreed and decided that the case should be submitted to the Government in terms of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for accord of approval of the rates.

The approval of rates was conveyed by the Government vide office No. Rev-LAK/1/2022(112415) dated 20-10-2022 with the direction to disburse the compensation amount to the rightful claimants strictly in accordance with the rules in vogue and the conditions which are as under:—

- 1. The Collector, Land Acquisition shall verify the title/share of each individual owner in the land and all other formalities as required under the rules before making the payments to the rightful claimants/land owners as per their legitimate share.
- 2. The individual/co-sharer cannot claim compensation for shamilat land under their possession beyond their entitlement. In case the balance shamilat land is left in their possession is more than their share (entitlement) in the shamilat land, they will not be eligible for any compensation. In other words while making payments of the compensation of shamilat land under possession of any persons, the individual/co-sharers shall be paid only to the extent of difference between their share and the land left in their possession, rest of the compensation amount shall go to the village Panchayat for community development.
- 3. The amount calculated on state land or any other land escheated/vested in Government shall be deposited in the

relevant Government account head.

4. The approval shall also be subject to the outcome of any writ petitions pending in the Honøble High Court of J&K or any other court of law.

#### <u>PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO THE INTERESTED</u> PERSONS:

Pursuant to the directions and the conditions as laid under approval No. Rev-LAK/1/2022(112415) dated 20-10-2022 a team headed by Tehsildar, Awantipora was framed to ascertain the claim of each individual as per pro rata. The report of the committee shall frame the basis of entitlement of compensation to each assessee.

Now, while announcing the award, the interested persons are informed that the payment of compensation shall be made through Bank account only for which the land owners who are deemed lawfully entitled shall receive the compensation amount on submission of the below mentioned documents in my office.

- 1. Original Revenue extracts which transpires that the land is within pro rata share of the claimant and is encumbrance free.
- 2. Xerox copy of Aadhaar Card.
- 3. Xerox copy of PAN Card.
- 4. 16 digit bank account number with IFSC Code.
- 5. Two passport size photographs.

Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 116/2022 under Sections 4/5 ESA, 121,121-A IPC, and Sections 13 18, 39 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in Police Station, Doda and the investigation of the case was set inot motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 23 of ULA(P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Irshad Ahmad Sheikh, was found in contact with a terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Mohammad Amin Bhat @ Khubaib S/o Dawood Batt R/o Kathawa, Phagsoo, Doda A/P Pakistan, who provided the said explosive material (IED) to the accused through an unknown person in order to promote terrorist activities in the area; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Irshad Ahmad Sheikh, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the above terrorist of LeT banned outfit particulary the terrorist namely Mohammad Amin Batt @ Khubaib, and providing logistic support to them, besides, under a well knit criminal conspiracy procured explosive material (IED) from the said terrorist through an unknown person for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area and to wage war against the Union of India; and
- 6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of the terrorist viz. Mohammad Amin Bhat @ Khubaib and an unknown person who handed over the explosive material (IED) to the accused viz. Irshand Ahmad Sheikh, shall continue to ascertain their actual identity and to bring out their role/involvement in the case; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against his name of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and IPC:ô
- - I. Irshad Ahmad Sheikh S/o Mohammad 13, 18, 23, 39 of Yousuf Sheikh R/o Dhar, Kishtigarh, ULA(P) Act Doda. 121, 121-A IPC.

- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.
- 10. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevent documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused under the aforementioned provision of the Indian Penal Code (IPC); and



- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and

Adil Ahmad Rather, Anayat Mohi-ud-Din Parray, Ubaid Pinchoo and Arif Mohammad Bhat, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly the terrorist namely Waseem Qadir Mir, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to him, besides procured arms/ammunition and hand grenades from the said terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and

- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Waseem Qadir Mir, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces at Zolwa Kralpora, Chadoora on 06-01-2022, and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and
- 8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under sections of the Unlawful Actvities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:

- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned asccused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Adil Ahmad Rather, Anayat Mohiud-Din Parray, Ubaid Pinchoo and Arif Mohammad Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 18, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 80/2022 of Police Station, Panthachowk.

# Notification

Jammu, the 23rd January, 2023.

SO-43.—Whereas, on 16-03-2022, the Police Station, Bijbehara, received a docket to the effect that during the search of one missing person namely Aasif Bashir Ganie S/o Bashir Ahmad Ganie R/o Hassanpora, Taweela, Bijbehara, who got missing from his home on

11-03-2022, subsequently, it came to be learnt that the said missing person had joined the terrorist ranks of LeT banned outfit in order to carry out the terrorist activities in the area; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 35/2022 under Sections 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Bijbehara, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 18-B of ULA (P) Act was added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of the witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Aasif Bashir Ganie, was arrested by a Joint Naka Party of Police/Security Forces at Hassanpora near Railway crossing on 02-04-2022 arms/ammunition for which a separate case FIR No. 43/2022 was registered in Police Station, Bijbehara. Subsequently, the custody of the accused was changed in the instant case and it was found that he was in contact with a terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Nisar Ahmad Dar S/o Ghulam Hassan Dar R/o Redwani, Kulgam, who motivated the accused viz. Aasif Bashir Ganie, to join the terrorist ranks; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Aasif Bashir Ganie, was member of LeT banned outfit and was in contact with a terrorist of the said outfit namely Nisar Ahmad Dar, who motivated and facilitated his joining with the outfit in order to carry out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Nisar Ahmad Dar, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces at Sirhama, Srigufwara, on 09-04-2022, and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under

sections of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Aasif Bashir Ganie, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 35/2022 of Police Station, Bijbehara.
