Whereas, on the basis of indent placed by PMGSY, Division Reasi vide No. PMGSY/Udh-II/R/1785-89 dated 19-12-2014, a notification under section 4 (1) was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi vide No. COL/LA/ACR/Reasi/16/242-45 dated 07-12-2016 for land measuring 88 Kanals and 07 Marlas situated at Village Bhagga, Tehsil and District Reasi, calling upon the objections from the land owners/interested persons ; and

Whereas, pursuant to the above referred notification, some objections were received from land owners/interested persons and the Collector concerned vide No. DC/Rsi/17-18/1607-10/SQ dated 27-03-2018 returned the case to Tehsildar Reasi, in light of contents of the objections. After conducting field visits fresh revenue papers were prepared and submitted to the Collector concerned who got the same authenticated by the indenting department and Collector issued corrigendum vide No. CLA/ACR/2020-21/161-67 dated 27-01-2021 to notification under section 4(1) of the Act for land measuring 72 Kanals and 15 Marlas which was again served upon the land owners/interested persons asking to file objections, if any ; and

Whereas, no objection was received from any one on the revised notification and the Collector, Land Acquisition submitted the case to the Deputy Commissioner, Reasi vide No. CLA/ACR/20-21/197 dated 19-02-2021, who endorsed to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu vide No. DC/Rsi/20-21/2029-33/SQ dated 19-02-2021 read with DC/Rsi/21-22/460-64 dated 03-05-2021 for issuance of declaration/notification under sections 6 and 7 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat, 1990, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu Vide No. 502/4306-4307-4308-4309/PMGSY/Reasi/21/6495 dated 05-03-2021 and 502/4306/4307 4308/21/PMGSY/Rei/281 dated 11-05-2021 sought some clarifications ; and

Whereas, pursuant to the objections raised by the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, District Collector (DC), Reasi vide No. DC/Rsi/21-22/1150-54/SQ dated 12-07-2021, has reported that there was no objection with respect to the instant land acquisition even at the time of notification dated 07-12-2016 under section 4(1) of the Act, in fact land owners made an application stating therin that the alignment of road has changed and land involved in the acquisition is not as per spot position. So, the notification needs rectification and has no objection received with respect to the acquisition of land in question and again re-submitted the case to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, who endorsed to Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K vide No. 502/4306/PMGSY/Bhaga/Reasi/21/800 dated 06-08-2021. Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K forwarded to this department vide No. FCR-LAND/129/2021-06-FCR (46085) dated 07-09-2021; and

Whereas, pursuant to this department's letter No. Rev-LAJ/84/ 2021 (54873) dated 09-11-2021, District Collector, (DC), Reasi vide No. DC/Rsi/21-22/SQ/5177-78 dated 04-03-2022 has furnished the requisite documents ; and

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi vide letter referred to above duly endorsed by District Collector (DC),

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i. e. construction of road from Sirla to Kalra Chanjood under PMGSY Scheme, Stage-I, Phase X Length=4.60 KM for land measuring 72 Kanals and 15 Marlas situated in Village Bhagga, Tehsil and District Reasi.

Now, in pursuance of section 6 of the J&K State Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 72 Kanals 15 Marlas situated in Village Bhagga, Tehsil and District Reasi as per annexure  $\therefore A \phi \phi$  to this notification is required for public purposes i. e. construction of road from Sirla to Kalra Chanjood under PMGSY Scheme, Stage-1, Phase X Length=4.60 KM. Further, the Collector, Land Acquisition (ACR), Reasi shall be directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/Rules.

Further, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification off all types involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/Indenting Department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

Harbans Lal R/o Ward No. 02, Bishnah, Jammu filed a Writ petition bearing No 1230/2021 titled Sunny Sharma V/s Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Others before the Hon'ble High Court of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh at Jammu seeking directions for payment/clearance of work done liability amounting Rs 3,73,100/- on account of various works alleged to be executed by the petitioner in the said Municipal area ; and

Whereas, the department in order to ascertain genuineness of claim of the petitioner constituted an enquiry committee vide order dated 248-

Whereas, after a detailed enquiry, the committee submitted its report, and the following pertinent findings were recorded by the committee :ô

- i. That the mandatory prescription of obligatory functions in terms of PWD manual have been bypassed in the year 2019 itself as these works have been executed on the verbal instructions of the President, Municipal Committee Bishnah, departmentally without any authority and jurisdiction against which even the payment has also been released. The said work has never been checked by concerned engineering wing which is the competent authority to check the execution of work through proper tendering process.
- ii. The copies of bills/supply orders and muster sheets annexed with the Writ petition against which the alleged work done claim projected by the petitioner are not in records of Municipal Committee Bishnah.
- iii. The work orders of different dates issued by the President Municipal Committee Bishnah are without any authority and jurisdiction and the same have been found without any dispatch number of the Municipal Committee Bishnah and as such cannot be construed as office document issued by the Municipality.
- iv. The date wise bills mentioned herein above against which the petitioner is claiming alleged payment of the goods supplied I material used for construction of lane and drain in question, have been found having cuttings in the dates column of each bill.
- v. Once the question of the said lane and drain in question happened in the year 2019 and even the payment released from time to time in the year 2019 itself against the material supplied and labourers and masons engaged in construction work though executed without any authority and Jurisdiction, there is no occasion to again construct the same in the month of Jan 2020.

Whereas, President Municipal Committee, Bishnah was afforded an opportunity to present his case/defense by the Inquiry Officer. The President, Municipal Committee, Bishnah (Sh. Rajan Sharma) appeared before the Inquiry officer on 13.09.2021 and 18.09.2021 and submitted a written statement of defense which was taken on record. The Inquiry Officer has recommended that the President Municipal Committee, Bishnah has acted in a manner which is unbecoming of a public servant and has abused his official powers as the President of the said Municipal Committee and therefore is liable for action under the relevant provision of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000, and has committed misconduct on the following counts :

- a. The President Municipal Committee, Bishnah cannot in his individual capacity issue any verbal order for execution of a work, unless the same has been technically vetted by the engineering wing and approved by the Municipal Committee.
- b. The President Municipal Committee, Bishnah has no authority to issue any verbal order for execution of any work which would involve using resources of the Committee unless same is processed as per norms by the office of the Municipal Committee.
- c. The President Municipal Committee, Bishnah has no authority to issue any work order without any estimate which would indicate the cost of the work to be executed.
- d. The President Municipal Committee, Bishnah has no jurisdiction! authority to issue any written or verbal instructions for execution of any development work under any provision of law except in case of emergency involving extensive damage to the property or damage to human life or grave inconvenience to the public. Such powers can be exercised under Section 37 of Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000. In his case, no such record note is available in the office record of Municipal Committee Bishnah which would indicate any of the conditions prescribed in the above referred

Now, in exercise of powers conferred by Section 26 of the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000, the Government hereby removes Shri Rajan Sharma, President, Municipal Committee, Bishnah from his office on the ground of abuse of his powers, with immediate effect.

Subsequently, all the accused persons were arrested and during investigation 01 hand grenade and 20 AK rounds were recovered from the possession of accused Wasecm Ahmad, Sabzar Ahmad and Ashiq Hussain ; and

6. Whereas, during investigation, it was established that accused Mohammad Altaf Shah is member of HM banned outfit and accused Waseem Ahmad, Sabzar Ahmad, Ashiq Hussain and Aadil Ahmad were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the said terrorist and were providing shelter/logistic support to him, besides were voluntarily harbouring the terrorist for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused persons

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under sub-section (2) of section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the accused persons for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by Sub-Section 02 of Section 45 ULA (P) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused persons for the commission of offences punishable under sections 18, 19, 20, 23, 39 of Unlawful Activities (prevention) Act, 1967, in the case FIR No. 77/2021 of Police Station Dooru.

Accordingly, his custody was changed in this case and during investigation, it was established that the accused Sheikh Rouf went missing from his home since 27-05-2020 and joined the HM banned outfit to harm the integrity and sovereignty of the nation ; and
