### Notification

Jammu, the 24th of December, 2021.

S.O.6435.ô In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Lieutenant Governor hereby makes the following rules, namely :ô

- 1. **Short title and commencement**.ô (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
- 2. **Definitions**. $\hat{o}$  In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires, $\hat{o}$ 
  - a. ::Administrative Department of means the Department of the Government in the Civil Secretariat holding the Administrative charge of the service;

- - b. "Board® means the Jammu and Kashmir Service Selection Board;
  - c. "Cadre" means the cadre of the service;
  - d. "Government" means the Government of Jammu and Kashmir;
  - e. **"Head of the Department"** means the Major Head of Department holding the administrative control of the organization;
  - f. :: Member of the Service means a person appointed to a post in the service under the provisions of these rules;
  - g. "Post" means a permanent post carrying a definite time scale sanctioned by the competent authority;
  - h. ::Rules@means the Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service Recruitment Rules, 2021;
  - i. "Schedule" means the schedule(s) annexed to these rules ;
  - j. "Service" means the Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service;
  - k. "Union Territory" means the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Words and expressions used in these rules but not defined; shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956/Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services Regulation.

- 3. Constitution of Service.ô (1) From the date of commencement of these rules, there shall be constituted the ::Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service@
  - (2) The Government may at the commencement of these rules, appoint to the service any person who at the commencement of these rules is holding in a substantive capacity any post included in the cadre of the service:

Provided that for the purposes of initial constitution of the service, the person holding any post in a substantive capacity to which he/she was appointed by the competent authority under rules included in the cadre of the service in its sanctioned scale of pay shall be deemed to have been appointed to the service under these rules, if he/she is fully qualified to hold the post under these rules unless he/she opts otherwise within 15 days from the commencement of these rules.

"Explanation: ô The word ::holding on means a person holding a post included in the cadre of Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis under orders of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on ad hoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on ad hoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement of the cadre of Jammu and Kashmir Animal Husbandry (Subordinate) Service in its sanctioned scale of pay on regular basis or of the competent authority and will not cover the persons holding a post on ex-cadre/deputation basis or on ad hoc basis or in a stop-gap arrangement.

4. **Strength and Composition of the Service**.ô (1) the authorised permanent and temporary strength of the cadre and the nature of the post included therein shall be determined by the Government, from time to time and shall at the initial constitution of the service under these rules, be such as specified in the **Schedule-I**, annexed to these rules:

Provided that the Government may create temporary posts in the cadre or the service for specified period or purpose as may be considered necessary from time to time.

- (2) The Government shall, at the interval of every five years or at such other intervals as may be necessary, re-examine the strength and composition of the cadre of the service and make such alternations therein as it deems fit.
- 5. Qualifications and Method of Recruitment.—(1) No person shall be eligible for appointment or promotion to any post in any class, category or grade in the service unless he/she possesses the qualifications as laid down in the ScheduleóII and fulfills other requirements of recruitment as provided in the rules and orders for the time being in force.

- - (2) First appointment to a service or class may be made :ô
    - (a) by direct recruitment; or
    - (b) by promotion or by transfer from another service or class; or
    - (c) partly by (a) and partly by (b) in the ratio and in manner as mentioned against each post in Schedule-II:

Provided that the Selection Agency shall conduct a written test for all advertised posts and the marks/points obtained by the participating candidates shall be apportioned proportionately against the marks earmarked for written test in the Selection Criteria. On the basis of marks obtained by candidates in written examination, the Selection Agency shall conduct an oral test which shall be restricted to five times the number of vacancies advertised. The Selection Agency shall thereafter prepare a selection list based on the merit obtained by the candidates in the written and oral test:

::Provided further that the Government in the General Administration Department, may exclude specified posts to be referred to Selection Agency from conducting oral test. In such posts, the Selection Agency shall prepare a select list based on merit obtained in written test only on

Provided also that all the posts to be filled by promotion/ transfer shall be filled through Departmental Promotion Committee, unless any post/category of posts is exempted from the purview of the Board. The Department shall refer vacancies in the direct/promotion quota to Board and Departmental Promotion Committee, as per SRO-166 of 2005 dated 14-06-2005.

6. **Probation.**ô (1) Probation of a person appointed to the service by direct recruitment shall be regulated in terms of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020, and in all other cases under the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956.

- - (2) The pay of a person appointed to the service under these rules through direct recruitment shall be regularized as per the provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Probationer (Condition of Service, Pay and Allowances) and Fixation of Tenure Rules, 2020 and in all other cases under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service Regulations or General Rules as issued from time to time.
  - 7. **Reservation in appointments**.ô While making appointments either by direct recruitment or promotion, reservation shall be made in accordance with the rules and orders issued from time to time for members of Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes/ Economically Weaker Sections or any other category or class of persons under the provisions of Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004 and the rules made thereunder.
  - 8. **Training and Departmental Examination.**—Persons appointed to the service by competitive examinations shall be required to undergo such training from time to time during the course of probation and to pass during the period of probation or trial such departmental examination as the Government may prescribe:

Provided that the Government may exempt persons from such training or departmental examination either wholly or partly, who have passed a departmental examination or undergone training declared by the Government to be equivalent to a departmental examination or training prescribed under these rules.

9. **Eligibility of Government Servants for Direct Recruitment**.ô A Person already in the Government service may apply through proper channel for direct recruitment to a vacant post in any particular class or category in the service if he/she possesses the educational and the other qualifications prescribed for recruitment to such class or category of posts. The upper age limit of such Government servants shall be as provided in the general rules.

Provided that in the case of a post which requires a higher degree of specialization and or experience, the Government may prescribe higher age limit.

- - 10. **Maintenance of Seniority Lists**.ô Seniority of the members of the Service shall be regulated under the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956. The Head of the Department shall maintain an up-to-date and final seniority list of the service.
  - 11. **Residuary Matters.**ô In regard to matters not specifically covered by these Rules, the members of the service shall be governed by the rules/regulations and orders applicable to the Union Territory Civil Service in general.
  - 12. **Interpretation.**—If any question arises relating to the interpretation of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Administrative Department, whose decision thereon shall be final and binding.
  - 13. **Repeal and Savings**.ô (1) All the rules corresponding to these rules and in force immediately before the commencement of these rules are hereby repealed.
    - (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment, promotion, selection, order made or any action taken under the provisions of the rules so repealed shall be deemed to have been made or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
