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#### Circular

Finance Department has received number of cases from various Administrative Departments seeking advice/opinion for change/correction/ alteration in name of a Government employee(s).

The Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training vide O.M. No.19016/1/87-Estt(A) dated 12-03-1987 has issued instructions/ procedure to be followed in relation to change of name by Government employees. The procedure that needs to be followed for change/correction/ alteration of name of Government employees in Union Territory of J&K, shall be regulated in the following manner :

I-All cases of addition/deletion or change in name/surname :

- i. A Government employee wishing to adopt a new name or to effect any modification in his/her existing name may do so, formally by a deed changing his/her name. The sample **deed** form is enclosed.
- ii. The execution of the deed should be followed by publication of the change in a prominent local newspaper at the Government employees own expense.
- iii. The change in the name shall be made with Aadhaar authentication and complete verification of record of e-HRMS.
- II—<u>Addition/change in surname only, on account of marriage/</u> remarriage of a female Government employee.

The following requirements may be met for this purpose :

- i. If the Government employee desires a change in surname on account of marriage/re-marriage, she should give a formal intimation to her appointing authority of her marriage and request for a change in her surname.
- ii. Particulars of the husband may be given for making necessary entries in the Service Book.

#### III—Deletion of surname or reversion to maiden name on divorce/separation or death of the husband of female <u>Government employee.</u>

Change may be permitted if a female Government employee gives :

- i. an intimation to the appointing authority regarding change in marital status ; and
- ii. a formal request for reversion to her maiden name.

Note :ô There is no prescribed form for items II and III.

#### Award/Judgment

#### Synopsis of the case

- 1. The petitioner/workman who was working with the respondent/Trust since December, 2004 as Electrician, continuosly except one year service break from 05/2014 to 06/2015 was allegedly terminated on 18-07-2017.
- 2. He was again called to join service in June, 2015 and was discharging all other allied work in the institution and its other locations even at the residence of the employer and was getting Rs. 10,000/- per month at the time of termination from service on 18-07-2017 but was not paid his gratuity at that time.
- 3. Facts of the case lies in a narrow compass. Before temination on 18-07-2017, allegedly administrator of the company Sh, Nitin Mahajan who is the family member of the proprietor asked the petitoner to submit two months workdone details and leave account within a period of two months to show the door without following any procedure on 18-07-2017 while terminating the service.
- 4. According to petitioner, his termination was passed in sheer violation of natural justice and also in violation of rule 25-F of the ID Act, 1947 in colorable exercise of powers and he was not paid dues under law thereby management has committed unfair lobour practice.
- 5. The respondents in rebuttal denied the allegations leveled against them in toto. At the very outset it has been contended that the present petition is not maintaninable before this Tribunal U/S 2(A) as the

Tribunal has no jurisdiction besides present petitioin is premature. The patitioner has not explained absence period and opted to approch the court. Morever he was not terminated and only asked to explain his absence period. Besides he is not a workman under I. D Act as Section 25-F of I. D Act, 1947 speaks about workman and not of an employee of the Trust. It is further stated that the respondent did appear before ALC, filed detailed reply and objectons to the said notice.

- 6. The controversy between the parties is that the respondent employer unlawfully without conducting an enquiry terminated the service of the petitioner Khazan Singh on the basis of absence from duties and even the concilliation proceedings culminated into failure. Consequently present petition challenging verbal termination order date 18-07-2017 came to be filed. Parties did appear, presented their submissions.
- 7. Heard Parties. Meticulously perused record. The petitioner appeared in the witness box in the shape of affidavit but was not subjected to cross examination by respondent. Hence his evidence goes unrebutted. The respondents also in their reply to the petitioner filed affidavit whenein it is categorically stated that the written notice dated 15-07-2017 was served to the petitioner. Besides attendance register is maintained of technical/non-technical staff of the institution, therefore plea of fabrication of record does not sustain being a white lie. Besides the petitioner was given another chance in writing vide communication no. 24-07-2017 to report for duties but he did not reported for duties as he was engaged somewhere else. It is further contended that the respondent trust is a charitable one and is not an industry hence the present petition is liable to be dismissed for want of jurisdiction U/S 2-A of I. D Act, 1947. Respondent also placed on record extracts of Attendance Sheets as well as copy of notices dated 24-07-2017.
- 8. Heard. The respondents again reterated in their response that the petitioner was not terminated and his application is premature besides the respondent is a research institute, **Sh. Sain Charitable Trust for Higher Education and Research** and therefore is not an industry

the jurisdiction of this Tribunal.

- 9. In rebuttal, the petitoner has pleaded that Jammu Institute of Ayurveda and Research falls within definition of industry hence this Tribunal U/S 2(J) of the I. D Act, 1947 has jurisdiction to entertain the petition. The petitioner is a workman U/S 2(s) being a Techincal person and was working as 'Electricianø hence his petition is maintainable before this Tribunal. In written submissions as well the petitioner has taken a stand that he was terminated verbally on 08-07-2017 and not even a singal warning letter was given to him. Subsequently he approached to ALC. And concillation proceedings failed and case was referred to this Labour Court for adjudication directly U/S 2(A) of I. D Act, 1947 to adjudicate on follwoing issues :ô
  - (i) Whether the respondent terminated the services of the petitioner in violation of process of Industrial dispute Act without conducting an enquiry?
  - (ii) If issue No. 1 is proved in affirmative to what relief the petitioner is entitled?
- 10. The petitioner has negated the stand taken by the management that a letter dated 24-07-2017 was shot at him seeking explanation from him. It is argued that neither any notice was given for his conduct nor any enquiry was conducted and it is only on 15-07-2017 at about 1 PM the petitioner was given a letter seeking workdone report of two months. Besides attendance record placed by the respondent is a fabricated one and the petitioner had never seen attendance register ever. According to the petitioner, the respondents want to justify their allegations with respect to his absence from duties.
- 11. It is reiterated that objections taken by the respondent are supported by an affidavit and they have brought to notice of this Tribunal that it is a case of absence from his duties and not a case of termination. Besides, despite asking him to report for his duties back he did not turn up, hence question of quashing of termination does not arise.

Thus no inference can be drawn that the petitioner was verbally terminated by the repondent which is liable to be set aside. Record reveals that there is no proof of termination order except notice issued to petitioner for reporting duties. Besides on petitioner so own saying that there was one year service break from May, 2014 to June, 2015 but even in that time, also no gratuity was given hence question of setting aside order of alleged termination order does not arise. But the pititioner/workman is held entitled to be adequatey cormpensated, hence he is entitled to back wages and required to be suitably compensated, Honøble Apex Court, has in such a situation held that õcompensation is the rule and reinstatement is only an exceptionö otherwise also much water has flown since -2018ø when he was unlawfully terminated from the service on 18-07-2017 as per record and it would not be order for his reinstatement. Reference may be made to Honøable Apex Court judgement in -Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj vs. State of Maharashtra,ø on 8th April, 2020.

12. At the time of alleged termination, he was getting Rs. 10,000/- per month, It is directed that the respondent shall pay to the petitioner/ workman an amount equivalent to Rs. 10,000/- per month. He shall also be entitled to compensation from the time when he was ousted from his job and was litigating before differnet forums hence the respondent shall pay an amount of Rs. 50,000/- as compensation. Both the issues are decided accordingly. Hence this Tribunal has jurisdiction to entertain this petition and the petitioner is also held entitled to compensation and other allowances under rule if any. The reference is answered accordingly. Award may be forwarded to the Government Press for publication under rules. File shall be completed in all respects and be consigned to records.

#### Award/Judgment

#### Synopsis of the case

The petitioner Gorav Kumar is seeking quashing of his termination order dated 10-01-2017 through the present claim petition filed under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947.

Synopsis of the present the petition is that petitioner was working in :DPSø School Jammu since 09-11-2004 and remained in continuous service for 13 years on the post of peon against a salary of Rs. 9100/-.

Allegedly on verbal instructions of Sh Karandeep Singh, Manager Operation, the pititioner used to attend Delhi Public School, Nagbani since 3rd October, 2016 for duties and remained there till 9th of January, 2017. It is further stated herein that the management, DPS School, Jammu paid his salary for the month of September and October 2016 in cash and salary for the month of Nobember, 2016 was paid by DPS School -Nagbaniøvide cheque dated 14th December, 2016 Rs. 9100/- only and similarly salary for the month of December and for 9th January 2017 was deposited in his Bank Account (J&K Bank dated 11th January, 2017 and 8th Febuary, 2017).

It is further the case of petitoner that on 7th of January, 2017, he was asked by the Pricipal, DPS School Nagbani to discharge duties as security guard though he was appointed as a peon for the last 13 years. According to the petitioner, he requested for written orders as well as for transfer orders and subsequently he became sick and was

advised rest by doctors and after recovery when he reached on duty, the Principal, Nagbani School did not allow him to resume his duty and he was also not allowed to mark his attendance.

Allegedly the petitioner frequenly went on duty i, e on 23rd January, 2017, 24th January, 2017, 25th January, 2017 respectively but the Principal of the said school kept him outside the school gate even in rains up to 12 noon with malafide intention and did not allow him to enter the school gate. It is further the case of the petitioner that he again went to duty on 27th January, 2017 and on 28th January, 2017 but was not allowed to join by the Principal of the said school. Consequently a complaint was filed to ALC, Jammu on 30th January, 2017 with a request that Principal DPS School, Nagbani be asked to take him back on duty, but despite visit of Labour Officer in the School personally the management did not attend his office and notices were issued by ALC to the Principal of the said school for appearance before ALC along with record on 9th February, 2017. Even Labour Officer reported to ALC, Jammu on 22nd February 2017 that the Principal has refused to take the petitioner on duty and subsequently a dispute was raised by the petitioner with respondent employer before the Conciliation Officer under the provisions of ID Act, 1947 under Section 2A(2)b(Amendment Act, 2010) and on 06-04-2017 Conciliation proceedings were conducted but despite much endeavour the settlement could not be reached and concilation proceedings failed and then further at the request of the petitioner, the Condiliation Officer granted a certificate enabling the petitioner for approching to this Industrial Tribunal cum Labout Court for adjudication of the dispute under Section 2A(2) of the Industrial Desputes Act vide notification E-No-5-110-12/1/2017.

Allegedly the respondent without following any porvisions of law, illegally terminated services of the petitioner on 10-01-2017, despite the fact that he was continuously in service w. e. f. 09-11-2004 to 09-01-2017.

According to the petitioner, without following disciplinary proceedings the petitioner was terminated with malafide intention as no charges were framed agaist him. The grievance of the petitioner is that no enquiry was conducted and no opportunity of hearing was efforded to him while terminating his services in utter violation of principal of natute justice.

The respondents in their response/arguments has taken a stand that the peritioner remained absent without any intimation or leave application, hence the answering respondent by virtue of order dated 10-01-2017 directed the committee to probe into the matter against the petitioner for his conduct and unathorized absence on 07-01-2017. Respondent has reiterated that the petitoner was asked to discharge his duties as security guard as well as in Nagbani School as a requirement, but the petitioner flatly refused to comply order. On the contrary, he misbehaved with the respondent and left the organization, besides the Labour Officer was warmly received on his visit to Nagbani. The respondent has admitted the fact of termination on account of dereliction of duties, poor performance besides insubordination on part of the petitioner. The respondent has further added that disciplinary committees already constituted in the school conducted investigation, consequently petitioner was dismissed.

#### Heard.

Considered respective subsmissions and entire material on record. It appears that impugned order dated 10-01-2017 is passed in utter violation of õPrincipal of Natural Justiceö as petitioner was neither put on notice nor was associated with any enquiry process, moreover there is no record placed herein by respondent in their regard. Which reflects that the entire porcess of alleged enquiry is merely as eyewash which is not sustainable at all. Thus termination order dated 10-01-2017 being malafide, intentional, one sided and against principals of natural justice and also violation of Section 25-F of I.D. Act is set aside and the prayer of petitioner to the extent of reinstatement with back wages as prayed for, besides litigation charges Rs. 15,000is granted in light of supra. Award is passed in favour of petitioners accordingly. At the time of unlawful termination, the workman/petitioner was getting Rs. 9100/- per month which he has been unlawfully deprived of since 10-01-2017. Needless to say that the petitioner is also entitled to compension for his unlawful termination which is tantamount to punishment. The respondent shall pay an amount of Rupees Twenty thousands (Rs. 20,000/-) as compensation as well. The reference is answered accordingly. Award may be forwarded to the Government Press for publication under rules. File shall be completed in all respects and be consigned to records.

#### Award/Judgment

Synopsis of the case,

On being reference made by the Government of Jammu and Kashmir, Labour and Employment Department vide SRO-185 of 19-06-2008 for adjudication of dispute between aforesaid parties, for adjudication on the following two issues :6

- 1. Whether the termination of services of Sh. Karan Singh is legally justified?
- 2. If not, to what relief he is entitled?

The matter as projected through this claim petition before this Tribunal can be precisely be adumbrated thus :6

The petitioner/applicant is seeking release of wages from the respondent Corporation for performing his duties as Chowkidar against a monthly payment of Rs. 1500/-. It is the case of the petitioner that the respondent Corporation purchased a land from one Captain -Murthyø for developing a Housing Colony in the year 2001-2002 and the petitioner/applicant was appointed as Chowkidar along with one Hoshiyar Singh against Rs. 1500/- Salary, which was however enhanced from Rs. 1500/- to Rs. 2000/- per month and it was paid up to January, 2007.

It is further the case of the applicant that the respondent withheld his salary thereafter i.e. after January, 2007 but Hoshiyar Singh, his

counterpart, was being paid salary on regular basis. Besides, the applicant was not allowed to mark his attendance after December, 2007, in the register maintained by the respondent. Moreover he was not informed whether his services were terminated. Therefore, the applicant/petitioner is presumably performing his duties till date.

The applicant/petitioner has further pleaded that he is entitled for wages @ Rs. 2000/- per month from the month of January, 2007 plus enhanced salary as being paid to the other Chowkidar serving in the Corporation of the opposite party.

The respondents in their response have denied the allegations leveled against them also. Besides denied the fact that applicant was ever their employee. It is stated herein by respondents that he was simply engaged as labourer by the Corporation on monthly payment and subsequently he was disengaged as his services were no more required by the respondent.

The tangible case of the respondent is that petitioner was neither daily nor casual worker but was engaged on just need basis hence is not entitled to any amount and his services were no more required. Besides he is not a -workmanøfor the purposes of the Act.

Parties filed their evidence affidavit. The respondent Corporation also besides affidavit of Managing Director filed affidavit of Sh. Sunil Koul, Inspector, J&K Housing Corporation, wherein it is denied that the petitioner was ever appointed as a Chowkidar but was only engaged as labourer for some days on need basis and was never appointed as regular/casual worker of the opposite party. The respondents have taken a stand that services of the petitioner/claimant were temporary and in January, 2006 the land purchased by the Corporation fell in dispute and the work was stopped and subsequently temporary engagement of the claimant was ended.

In rebuttal, the petitioner besides filing his own affidavit has filed affidavit of Sh. Kheru Ram S/o Sain Dass, Age 70 years, who has supported version of Karan Singh only partly. He has further deposed that wages of Karan Singh have been withheld while terminating his services without following legal recourse. Even Karan Singh, the petitioner on affidavit has deposed that he was appointed along with Hoshiyar Singh as Chowkidar for the watch and ward of the said land and the respondent Corporation in the year January, 2007 did not release the salary in favour of the deponent and informed the deponent that he was discharged but his wages have not been released. Additionally, he has proposed that the respondent shall pay Rs. 48000/- per month between January, 2007 and December, 2008 @ Rs. 2000/- per month and Rs. 50000/- as compensation on account of mental agony and harassment and Rs. 3,60,000/- @ Rs. 2000/- per month from January, 2009.

Heard :

Considered respective submissions. After hearing both sides and consideration of material on record and after careful perusal of evidence on record, it transpires that the petitioner was never engaged as Chowkidar for watch and ward for land and he worked with the respondent for plenty of times as there is no document placed on record in this regard. Though respondents in their affidavit have denied the fact that the petitioner was ever engaged as a Chowkidar but added that he was engaged as a labourer on need basis only and was subsequently disengaged. It is further contended herein that services of the claimant were purely temporary.

Respondent reiterated that petitioner was simply engaged as a labourer on the site and was never appointed as regular/casual worker of the opposite party. It is further contended herein that services of the claimant were purely temporary and in January, 2006 the land purchased by the Corporation fell in dispute and the Corporation was forced to stop the work at the site. On cross examination also, Sh. Bharat Bhushan, Managing Director deposed that there was no attendance register in respect of the claimant as he was not regular employee of the Corporation. He further deposed that the petitioner along with Hoshiyar Singh was working in Bhalwal as worker/labourer and were getting wages and now even Hoshiyar Singh is not working with the Corporation. So nothing is due to the petitioner now as he was being paid as per work done. Sh. Sunil Koul, respondentøs witness has corroborated the statement of Sh. Bharat Bushan, Managing Director. He too deposed in the witness box in the shape of affidavit. It has come in his statement that the claimant was simply working as a labourer for some days on need basis. In that month he was being paid as per wage engagement.

Now the moot question before us is :

Whether the termination of services of Sh. Karan Singh is legally justified and to what relief he is entitled to?

As the case goes, precisely stating there is voluminous documentary evidence evincing that the petitioner was engaged on need basis only and was never employed as daily wager/casual worker, hence question of termination of service does not arise. Regarding next issue i.e. whether petitioner is entitled to any relief in this regard.

I shall address each point vehementally agitated by the parties. In the first place, the most canvassed and pivotal point of discussion is whether the petitioner was appointed as Chowkidar and was a -workmanø and not a labourer on need basis. In this regard, there is ample evidence on file that respondent only engaged petitioner as a labourer on need basis who was subsequently disengaged when work was stopped regarding which there is no demurer by the petitioner. His stand is only that he has worked till 2007 as Chowkidar for watch and guard but his sole witness -Kheru Ramø S/o Sain Dass also denied that he has even filed affidavit. In his deposition, he only deposed, that he knows Karan Singh, the petitioner, who was working with the Corporation. The onus to prove that the petitonerge services was not on need basis but he was under employment of Corporation, but he miserably failed to prove so, suffice it would be to say that rendering a need based service on monthly basis, employee does not *ipso facto* gets an indefeasible right to be a regular employee and this is no more res integra.

In view of the above this Tribunal finds no substance in the petitioner argument that the respondents ought to have paid his salary for the period he was working as such, the argument is repelled. The petitioner has argued that he is entitled to compensation and back wages as well. Since issue No. 1 is decided against him as he was never terminated by respondents being not in the employment but was just engaged as a labourer on need basis, hence he is not entitled to any wages as well as compensation.

Thus the reference, whether termination of petitioner is legal or not is accordingly answered in favour of the respondent. Resultantly, as it has been held that the petitioner¢s engagement on need basis as a labourer was for a limited period on monthly basis, hence is not entitled to any relief as sought for through claim petition. Therefore, the reference is accordingly answered. Thus the award may be published accordingly.

2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 61/2019 under Sections 10, 11 and 13 of ULA (P) Act, came to be registered in Police Station, Budgam and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, the Section 10 and 11 of ULA (P) Act were dropped from the case ; and

3. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons namely Gulzar Ahmad Bhat @ Pahlwan S/o Sonaullah Bhat R/o Warpora Budgam and Mohammad Ashraf Dar @ Ashraf Bin Salam S/o Abdul Salam Dar R/o Ompora A/P Sheikhpora, Budgam, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, during the investigation, the accused viz. Gulzar Ahmad Bhat @ Pahlwan, was arrested in the case and the accused viz. Mohammad Ashraf Dar @ Ashraf Bin Salam, is evading his arrest ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Gulzar Ahmad Bhat @ Pahlwan and Mohammad Ashraf Dar @ Ashraf Bin Salam, were members of Jammu and Kashmir Liberation Front (JKLF) association and were carrying out the unlawful activities in the area, despite the association was banned by the Government of India ; and

5. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable under section as shown against their names of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967.
