Whereas, the Horticulture Department is administering Schemes namely, Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH)/Prime Minister Development Package (PMDP)-2015/Prime Minister Formalization of Micro Food Processing Enterprise (PM-FME), Market Intervention Scheme and schemes under UT Capex Budget for the holistic development of Horticulture Sector in UT of Jammu and Kashmir;

Whereas, under various components of these schemes, subsidy/ Government assistance is given to the beneficiaries by the Implementing Agencies as per the scheme guidelines; and

Whereas, the aforesaid schemes involve recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby notifies the following :ô

- 1. (1). An individual eligible for receiving the benefits under these Schemes shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
 - (2). Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Schemes, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrollment before registering for the Schemes provided that he/she is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per Section 3 of the said Act and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar enrollment center (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDIA) website www.uidia. gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3). As per regulation-12 of the Aadhaar (Enrollment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the department through its Implementing Agency is required to offer Aadhaar enrollment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrollment center located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrollment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Schemes shall be given to such individual subject to the production of the following documents, namely.

- 2. If he/she has enrolled his/her Aadhaar Enrollment Identification Slip; and
- 3. Any one of the following documents, namely :ô
 - i. Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or
 - ii. Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - iii. Passport; or
 - iv. Ration Card; or
 - v. Voter Identity Card; or
 - vi. MGNREGA Card; or
 - vii. Kisan Passbook having photo; or
 - viii. Horticulture Passbook having photo; or
 - ix. Driving License issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or
 - x. Certificate of Identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or

- - xi. Any other document as specified by the Department:

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

- 4. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Schemes conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
- 5. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted; namely: (a) In case of poor fingerprint quality, Iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for Iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner; (b) In case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or Iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time based One Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered; (c) In all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Timebased One Time password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Schemes may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of QR code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.
- 6. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no *bona fide* beneficiary under the Schemes is deprived of his/her due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agency



Judgment/Award

Petition under section 33 C-2 of Industrial Act read with section 15 of Payment of Wages Act, 1936 and section 82 of Factories Act for release of D.A., COLA Arrears w. e. f. 01-01-2006 to 30-06-2010 has been filed by Applicant/Petitioner herein.

Synopsis of the present case is that petitioner/applicant allegedly was employee of respondent company for last 29 years under Token No. 532 as Assistant Manager was retired on 30-06-2010. Allegedly D. A., COLA Arrears due to applicant/petitioner w. e. f. 01-01-2006 to 30-06-2010 has not been released by non-applicants till date thereby causing much hardships to him for his survival as after retirement on 30-06-2010, he did not get anything due to him :□

- 1. This is further case of the petitioner that even effect of 6th Pay Commission was given from 01-01-2006 but non-applicant released only 6th Pay Commission till 2009 in the shape of -Cementøbut other arrears were retained.
- 2. Allegedly non-applicant has paid arrears of wages to other employees except applicant and devoid the same without any justification being employer of petitioner(workman).
- Respondents in their response dated 13-11-2018 categorically stated that all retrial dues of the petitioner has been paid except D.A., COLA. Besides company is trying to reconstruct the

record which was burnt in fire on 31-05-2015. Respondent@s tangible case is that release of D. A., COLA Arrears is subject to availability of funds and approval of Board of Directors. More over company was in financial crisis and is running in loss hence could not meet the expenditure of D. A., COLA Arrears. Besides company has to generate its own resources to meet all expenditures as company was in financial crisis and is running in loss.
