Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 17 and 39 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, three more persons identified as Aasif Lateef Naik S/o Lateef Ahmad Naik R/o Babapora, Zainapora, Afloq Yousuf Digoo S/o Mohd Yousuf Digoo and Umer Hussain Dar S/o Mohammad Amin Dar R's/o Naina, Batpora, Pulwama, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused were also arrested in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz Aaqib Hussain Nanda, Gowhar Manzoor Bhat, Aasif Lateef Naik, Afloq Yousuf Digoo and Umer Hussain Dar, were found in contact with two terrorists of LeT banned outfit namely Raqeeb-Ullah R/o Pakistan and Uzair Ashraf Dar S/o Mohammad Ashraf Dar R/o Melahora, Shopian, through the virtual mode. The accused viz. Aaqib Hussain Nanda and Gowhar Manzoor Bhat, received an amount of Rs. 25000/- from an unknown person at Arwani, on the directions of terrorist viz Raqeeb-Ullah, and deposited an amount of Rs. 12000/- in the account of accused viz. Afloq Yousuf Digoo, who purchased a hand grenade from the accused viz Umer Hussain Dar, and handed over the same to accused viz. Aasif Lateef Naik. Subsequently, during the investigation, 01 hand grenade was recovered at the instance of accused viz Aasif Lateef Naik; and

Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz Aaqib Hussain Nanda, Gowhar Manzoor Bhat, Aasif Lateef Naik, Afloq Yousuf Digoo and Umer Hussain Dar, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly the terrorists namely Raqeeb-Ullah and Uzair Ashraf Dar, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support

- 8. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Uzair Ashraf Dar, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and
- 9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô
- 2. Gowhar Manzoor Bhat S/o Manzoor Ahmad Bhat R/o Drabgam, Pulwama.

- 11. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Raqueb-Ullah, is absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against him; and

- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons identified as Shahbaz Ahmad Thoker S/o Mushtaq Ahmad Thoker R/o Waghama, Bijbehara and Sabzar Ahmad Ganie S/o Farooq Ahmad Ganie R/o Halimpora, Marhama, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, both the accused were arrested and were found in contact with the terrorists of Ansar-Gazwat-ul-Hind (AGUH) outfit, namely Owais Ahmad Khan S/o Gh. Mohammad Khan and Fayaz Ahmad Kumar S/o Mohammad Ramzan Kumar Røs/o Waghama, Bijbehara, who on the date of occurrence fired upon the SPO Gh. Qadir Kumar, with the help of accused viz. Shahbaz Ahmad Thoker and Sabzar Ahmad Ganie, and escaped from the spot; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established the accused viz. Shahbaz Ahmad Thoker and Sabzar Ahmad Ganie, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of Ansar-Gazwat-ul-Hind (AGUH) outfit particularly the terrorists namely Owais Ahmad Khan and Fayaz Ahmad Kumar, and were providing logistic support to them, besides, on the date of occurrence, under a well knit criminal conspiracy facilitated the said terrorists to carrying out the attack upon the SPO Gh. Qadir Kumar, which resulted injuries to him; and

- 6. Whereas, the accused terrorists namely Owais Ahmad Khan and Fayaz Ahmad Kumar, have been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of the witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of the Unlawful Actvities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names:

SP had demanded an amount of Rs. 3.00 lacs from him and accepted illegal bribe/gratification of an amount of Rs. 2,20,000/- for releasing of his sons namely Manoj Kumar and Manohar Lal, arrested by the Police in a suicide case of a women under FIR No. 121/2012 in Police Station, Ramnagar; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 10/2015 under Sections 5(2) of Jammu and Kashmir Prevention of Corruption Act, Samvat, 2006 and Section 161 RPC, came to be registered in Police Station, VOJ (now ACB) and investigation of the case was taken up. Subsequently, during the investigation, Section 5(1)(d), Section 4-A PC Amendment Act and Section 342 and 120-B RPC were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurence and the seizure memos were prepared and statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that on 22-10-2013, Shri Makhan Lal, the then Master in Government Higher Secondary School, Chowki, Jandrore, was called by the then SDPO, Ramnagar in his office chambers, where he was directed to produce his son namely Manohar Lal, who was involved in case FIR No. 121/2013 of Police Station, Ramnagar. Subsequently, the said accused viz. Manohar Lal, was produced on 24-10-2013 before the officer and was arrested in connection with the said case; and
- 5. Whereas, on 26-10-2013, Shri Makhan Lal, was again called in the office of the then SDPO, Ramnagar, where he alongwith his arrested son namely Manohar Lal, were produced before the then SDPO, Ramnagar, Shri Manish Aggarwal, who ill treated both the persons and thrashed them in the office. The said Makhan Lal, was directed to inform his another son namely Manoj Kumar, who was pursuing education in NIT College, Srinagar, to appear before the then SDPO, Shri Manish Aggarwal on 27-10-2013. Subsequently, the said Makhan Lal, was detained and lodged in the lock-up of the Police Station, Ramnagar; and

- 6. Whereas, on 27-10-2023, Shri Manoj Kumar, appeared in person before the then SDPO, Ramnagar, Shri Manish Aggarwal, in his office chambers, where he was also detained and lodged in the lock-up with his father, Shri Makhan Lal and his brother Shri Manohar Lal. In the evening the said Makhan Lal, was directed by Shri Manish Aggarwal, then SDPO, Ramnagar, to arrange an amount of Rs. 3 lacs for the release of said Makhan Lal, and his two sons viz. Manohar Lal and Manoj Kumar. Subsequently, Shri Makhan Lal and his son Shri Manoj Kumar, were released in the evening with the agreement to arrange the demanded money; and
- 7. Whereas, on 28-10-2013, Shri Makhan Lal, arranged an amount of Rs. 2,20,000/- only and went to the official residence of Shri Manish Aggarwal, then SDPO, Ramnagar, where he handed over the money to Shri Yudhvir Singh, Reader of SDPO, Ramnagar, who later handed over the amount to Shri Manish Aggarwal, then SDPO, Ramnagar but his another son viz. Manohar Lal, was not released after receiving an amount of Rs. 2,20,000/- as the said Makhan Lal, could not pay the demanded money to the accused Shri Manish Aggarwal, then SDPO, Ramnagar; and
- 8. Whereas, during the investigation, some documents pertaining to Case FIR No. 121/2013 of Police Station, Ramnagar, were seized and it was found that Shri Makhan Lal and his son viz. Manoj Kumar, were not arrested by Shri Manish Aggarwal, the then SDPO, Ramnagar, in the instant case. The accused Shri Yudhvir Singh, the then constable had been cited as witness to prove the articles which were seized by Shri Manish Aggarwal, during the investigation of the instant case and his statement has been recorded. The accused Constable had remained associated with the investigation and was acquainted with the game plans of Shri Manish Aggarwal, in detaining the said Makhan Lal and his son viz. Manoj Kumar and for their release a bribe amount of Rs. 3 lacs was demanded by Shri Manish Aggarwal, the then SDPO and his reader Shri Yudhvir Singh; and
- 9. Whereas, the case FIR No. 121/2013 was registered in the Police Station, Ramnagar on 25-09-2013 under Section 306 RPC and 67 Information Technology Act, 2000, and the investigation of the instant

case was carried out by the then SDPO, Ramnagar, Shri Manish Aggarwal, who during investigation arrested two accused namely Sh. Kiran Kumar S/o Vishwa Nath and Shri Manohar Lal S/o Makhan Lal, Rsøo of Kaanah, Ramnagar for having prepared a video clip of deceased Smt. Shami Devi W/o Mangal Singh R/o Panala, Ramnagar. Makhan Lal and his son viz. Manohar Lal, were arrested by Shri Manish Aggarwal, the then SDPO, in the said case and his another son namely Manoj Kumar, was later on called and detained by Shri Manish Aggarwal, the then SDPO, Ramnagar, in the same case. Later on the challan of the said case was produced in the Honøble Court of Sessions Judge, Udhampur under Section 306 RPC and 67 IT Act, against two accused namely Kiran Kumar and Manohar Lal; and

- 10. Whereas, during investigation, it was found that accused viz. Yudhvir Singh, the then constable was threatening the said Makhan Lal, of dire consequences with malafide intention to withdraw his name from the complaint of corruption case lodged by him in Vigilance Organisation, Jammu and to this effect an application was moved by Shri Makhan Lal, on 12-03-2015. Subsequently, the accused constable Yudhvir Singh, was arrested and an Istigasa under Section 107, 117 Cr. PC. was filed against the said constable in the Court of Executive Magistrate, 1st Class, Ramnagar and it was found that the said constable was threatening Shri Makhan Lal, and forcing him for withdrawal of complaint against him; and
- 11. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that Shri Makhan Lal and his another son viz. Manoj Kumar, in a well knit conspiracy were wrongfully confined by accused Manish Aggarwal, the then SDPO, Ramnagar and his Reader viz. Constable Yudhvir Singh, and were lodged in the lockóup of Police Station, Ramnagar, without any charges and later on were released after the demand/accepting bribe of an amount of Rs. 2,20,000/- from Shri Makhan Lal, through his Reader accused viz. Yudhvir Singh; and
- 12. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned

accused in the commission of offences punishable under sections as shown against each :

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents:ô

- a. If he/she has enrolled, his/her Aadhaar Enrollment Identification slip and;
- b. Any one of the following documents:ô
 - i. Bank or Post Office Passbook with Photo; or

Subsequently, during the investigation, the offence under Section 16 of ULA (P) Act was dropped and the offences under Sections 122 IPC, 7/25 Arms Act and Sections 20,21,23,39 and 40 of ULA (P) Act, were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, three more persons identified as Sharnsher Singh @ Sheary S/o Late Prem Singh R/o Camp Gole Gujral, Jammu, Balvinder Singh @ Ballu S/o Late Jagbir Singh R/o H. No. 02, Lane No. 10, Sector-B, Near Jodha Mal School, Sainik Colony, Jammu A/P European and Sajid Bhai @ Sajid Jutt @ Habibullah Malik @ Saifullah S/o Muhammad Rafique R/o Village Shangamanga, Kasur, Pakistan, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused viz Shamsher Singh @ Sheary, was arrested in the case and during investigation, 04 Pistols, 08 magazines, 47 rounds and an amount of Rs. 56770/- were recovered at his instances; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz Balvinder Singh @ Ballu, was in contact with the Pakistan based terrorist namely Sajid Bhai @ Sajid Jutt @ Habibullah Malik @ Saifullah. The accused viz Chander Bose and Shamsher Singh @ Sheary, on the directions of accused viz. Balvinder Singh @ Ballu, received the consignment of arms/ammunition from the terrorist namely Sajid Bhai @ Sajid Jutt @ Habibullah Malik @ Saifullah, from across the border through the drone in order to promote terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of accused viz Balvinder Singh @ Ballu and Sajid Bhai @ Sajid Jutt @ Habibullah Malik @ Saifullah, shall continue to bring out their role/ involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet against the above accused would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction; and
- 7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz Chander Bose and Shamsher Singh @ Sheary, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit

- 8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Indian Penal Code, as shown against their names :ô

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 10. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law; and

- 11. Whereas, the Government has independently examined the Case Diary file and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused under the aforementioned provision of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, and Section 196 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz, Chander Bose and Shamsher Singh @ Sheary, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant sections as indicated against the each accused at Para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 196/2022 of Police Station, R.S Pura.

SOó213.ô Whereas, on 26.07.2012, the Police Station, Pulwama, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received about the hiding of terrorist namely Mohd Mohsin Thoker @ Abu Hamza S/o Gh. Mohi-ud-Din Thoker R/o Awneera, Zainapora, in the residential house of one Aijaz Ahmad Najar S/o Mohd Yousuf Najar R/o Wahipora. Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and Search Operation was launched by the Police/Security Forces and during the search the said terrorist was arrested on the spot. During his personal search, some incriminatory material was recovered from his possession; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 239/2012 under Section 18 of ULA (P) Act was registered in the Police Station, Pulwama and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Sections 3/25, 7/25 Arms Act and the Sections 19, 20 and 23 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz Aijaz Ahmad Najar, was arrested in the case and was found providing shelter/logistic support to the accused terrorist namely Mohd Mohsin Thoker @ Abu Hamza, in order to carry out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, one more person namely Sajad Ahmad Allaie S/o Ab. Aziz Allaie R/o Naina, was found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused was arrested in the case and was found in contact with the accused terrorist viz Mohd Mohsin Thoker @ Abu Hamza, who provided arms/ammunition to the accused viz Sajad Ahmad Allaie, in order to promote terrorist activities in the case. During the investigation, arms/ammunition viz 01 12-Bore rifle, 01 AK magazine and 50 AK 47 rounds were recovered at the instances of accused viz Sajad Ahmad Allaie; and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz Mohd Mohsin Thoker @ Abu Hamza, and Sajad Ahmad Allaie, were affiliated with the terrorist organization of LeT banned outfit and the accused viz Aijaz Ahmad Najar, under a well knit criminal conspiracy was voluntarily harbouring the terrorists in his residential house, besides, the accused viz Sajad Ahmad Allaie, procured arms/ ammunition from the accused viz Mohd Mohsin Thoker @ Abu Hamza, for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the
