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Government Circular No. 18-JK (GAD) of 2023 Dated 14-06-2023.

Information is the currency of democracy and the Right to Information Act, 2005, in addition to fostering citizen-empowerment and eradicating

- (2) Each Ministry or Department shall, in relation to the public authorities whithin their jurisdiction, collect and provide such information to the Central Information Commission or State Information Commission, as the case may be, as is required to prepare the report under this section and comply with the requirements concerning the furnishing of that information and keeping of records for the purposes of this section.
- (3) Each report shall state in respect of the year to which the report relates,ô
 - a. the number of requests made to each Public Authority;
 - b. the number of decisions where applicants were not entitled to access to the documents pursuant to the requests, the provisions of this Act under which these decisions were made and the number of times such provisions were invoked;
 - the number of appeals referred to the Central Information Commission or State Information Commission, as the case may be, for review, the nature of the appeals and the outcome of the appeals;
 - d. particulars of any disciplinary action taken against any officer in respect of the administration of this Act;
 - e. the amount of charges collected by each Public Authority under this Act ;
 - f. any facts which indicate an effort by the Public Authorities to administer and implement the spirit and intention of this Act;
 - g. recommendations for reform, including recommendations in respect of the particular public authorities, for the development, improvement, modernization, reform or

Under the ambit of the *ibid* section, the Central Information Commission prepares an Annual Report on the implementation of the RTI Act and makes necessary recommendations to Public Authorities regarding steps for bringing their practices in conformity with the provisions and spirit of the Right to Information Act. All Public Authorities are required to submit four quarterly returns for yearly performance-assessment and finalization of the Annual Report. Public Authorities, which fail to submit returns, even for a single quarter, are treated as defaulters.

It has been intimated by the Central Information Commission that Public Authorities in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir are not submitting Annual Returns under Section 25 of the RTI Act, a matter which has been viewed with serious concern by the authorities.


It is accordingly enjoined upon CPIOs of various departments, their subordinate/field offices, Corporations, Boards and PSUs to register themselves and submit quarterly returns on the designated portal https://cic.gov.in/, by or before 30-06-2023. The work flow to be followed for registration/logging-in and submission of returns has been appended as Annexure to this circular.





Further respondents be directed to pay to the petitioner salary (from May, 2019 till disposal of this Petition or till the petitioner gets another job, whichever is earlier) and three months salary as unemployment Compensation along with compensation for mental torture and harassment suffered by the petitioner at the hands of respondents. With a further direction to the respondents to issue Relieving Letter in favour of Petitioner.

Sh. Tilak Raina is petitioner in person Respondent in *ex parte*.

<u>Judgement</u>

Synopsis

1. Sh. Tilak Raina ::petitioner@was working as a Storekeeper/Workman in BIBA (respondents) against a monthly salary @ Rs. 32,000/- and his services were terminated by the respondents on 25-05-2019, allegedly on false and frivolous grounds. He has assailed order of termination before this Tribunal/Labour Court and pray for (i) Reinstatement (ii) quashment (iii) back wages and (iv) compensation.

- - 2. Despite service of notices, the respondents omitted to contest, so they are *ex parte* in this judgement.
 - 3. The petitioner alleges that the respondents had started to harass him on false accusation without any of his faults. An audit of the Store was fixed to be conducted on 8-5-2019 when he was on sick leave but the same was postponed for the above stated reason. However in furtherance of their acts of harassment, on 15-05-2019, a surprise audit of the Store was conducted to which he fully co-operated with the audit team. Respondents 4 and 5 also visited the Store the same day. To his suprise the petitioner was transfered to another State without any justification and reasonable ground and directed to handover the charge of the Store to the respondents. This apart, the respondents also called police to harass him for no fault. Not only this, the respondents without adhering to procedure and without providing an opportunity of audience to him terminated his services by order dated 25-5-2019.
 - 4. Parties appeared before this tribunal i. e. on 03-02-2020, one Sh. Rameshwar Singh, Store Manager appeared for respondents sought time to file objections but till date nothing could be done so far and respondents did not file any response after putting appearance on 03-02-2020 and subsequently on 02-11-2022 therefore he was set *ex parte*.
 - 5. Petitioner in proof of his case filed his own affidavit evidence and did not examine any other witness. Since there was no cross examination, hence the evidence of the petitioner goes unrebutted.
 - 6.` Heard. Carefully perused minutes of the proceedings and evidence affidavit filed herein. Considered written arguments on behalf of the petitioner. Petitioner has reiterated in his arguments that he was sick on the date of surprise audit i. e. on 08-05-2019 and he informed to immediate manager but audit conducted on 15-05-2019 was fully co-operated and assisted with the audit team and respondents No. 4 and 5 visited the store on the same day.
 - 7. The forceful submission on behalf of the petitioner/workman is that he was unlawfully terminated without following any established process of law and he was thrown out without any salary and compensation for his survival.

- - 8. Parties were given sufficient time to prove their respective contentions but respondents did not file their response to the allegation leveled by the petitioner, hence evidence of the petitioner goes unrebutted.
 - 9. No inference can be drawn that enquiry was conducted to settle procedure of law hence it appears that order dated 25-05-2019 with respect to termination of the petitioner/workman was illegal and not justified. As his termination order dated 25-05-2019 is set aside and the petitioner/workman is held entitled to be adequately compensated as his termination is unlawful, hence he is entitled to back wages and required to be suitably compensated. Honøble Apex Court, has in such a situation held "compensation is the rule and reinstatement is only an exception" otherwise also much water has flown since ÷2019 when he was unlawfully terminated from the service on 25-05-2019 as per record and it would not be order for his reinstatement. Reference may be made to Hongble Apex Court Judgment in 'Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Vs. State of Maharashtra', on 8th April, 2020.
 - At the time of unlawful termination workman/petitioner was getting Rs. 32000/- per month which he has been unlawfully deprived of since 25-05-2019. It is thus directed that the respondent shall pay to the petitioner /workman an amount equivalent to 3 months salary @ Rs. 32000/-per month. Needless to say that the petitioner is also entitled to compensation for his unlawful termination which is tentamount to punishment. The respondent shall pay an amount of rupees fifty thousand (Rs. 50,000/-) as compensation. The reference is answered accordingly. Award may be forwared to the Government Press for publication under rules. File shall be completed in all respects and be consigned to records.

SO-169.ô Whereas, on 28-9-2022, the Police Station, Poonch, received a docket to the effect that a reliable information was received that some unknown persons have kept a steel container in a bag containing some explosive material in Prade Ground, Pritam Park, Poonch and one unknown lady was sitting near the bag. Subsequently, a Joint 'Search Operation was carried out and during the search, the said bag containing explosive material was recovered on the spot; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 202/2022 under section 4/5 Explosive Substances Act, was registered in the Police Station, Poonch, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 13, 18, 23, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, one lady identified as Mst. Zatoon Akhter W/o Mohd Azad R/o Village Qasba A/P Mohalla Suka, Katha, W.No. 01 Haveli, Poonch, was found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the said lady was arrested in the case and it was found that she has received the consignment from her husband namely Mohd Azad S/o Faiz Mohd R/o Village Qasba A/P Mohalla Suka, Katha W.No. 01, Haveli, Poonch, with the directions to hand over the same to an unknown person in the said park Accordingly, the accused viz Mohd Azad, was also arrested in the case and during investigation, 01 poster of JKT militant outfit was recovered at his instances; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Mohd Azad, alongwith one more person identified as Qamar Din S/o Mohammada R/o Kirni, Haveli, Poonch, who was already arrested by the Poonch Police, in case FIR No. 203/2022 of P /S Poonch, were in contact with three PoK based terrorists of LeT /HM banned outfits namely Mohd Bashir @ Tikka Khan S/o Bhadur Ali R/o Qasba, Haveli, Poonch A/P PoK, Najab Din @ Naja S/o Mohammada Hajam and Mohd Latief S/o Mohammada R's/o Kirni, Haveli, Poonch A/P PoK and were facilitating the transportation of arms/ammunition for the terrorists from across the border in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. Subsequently, the custody of the accused viz. Qamar Din, was changed in the instant case and during investigation 01 Pistol, 02 magazines and 43 rounds were recovered at his instances; and

- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, two more persons identified as Wazhaid Akbar S/o Said Akbar and Kamal Din S/o Qamir Din R's/o Village Qasba, Haveli, Poonch, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused were arrested in the case and were also found in contact with the PoK basted terrorists viz Mohd Bashir @ Tikka Khan, Najab Din @ aja and Mohd Latief. and were facilitating the terrorist for transportation of their arms/ammunition from across the border; and
- 7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mst. Zatoon Akhter, Mohd Azad, Qamar Din, Wazhaid Akbar and Kamal Din, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT /HM banned outfit particularly the PoK based terrorists namely Mohd Bashir @ Tikka Khan, Najab Din @ Naja and Mohd Latief, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, the accused viz. Mst. Zatoon and Qamar Din, procured arms/ammunition and explosive material for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 8. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established a *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô
- 2. Qamar Din S/o Mohammada R/o Kirni, Haveli, Poonch.
- 3. Mohd Azad S/o Faiz Mohd R/o Village 13, 18, 39 of Qasba A/P Mohalla Suka, Katha W.No. 01, ULA (P) Act. Haveli, Poonch.

- 5. Najab Din @ Naja S/o Mohammada Hajam 13, 18, 38 of R/o Kirni, Haveli, Poonch A/P PoK. ULA (P) Act.
- 6. Mohd Latief S/o Mohammada R/o Kirni, Haveli, Poonch A/P PoK.
- 7. Wazhaid Akbar S/o Said Akbar R/o 18, 39 of Village Qasba, Haveli, Poonch. ULA (P) Act.
- 8. Kamal Din S/o Qamir Din R/o Village Qasba, Haveli, Poonch.
- 9. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Mohd Bashir @ Tikka Khan, Najab Din @ Naja and Mohd Latief, are absconding and the proceedings under Section 299 Cr.PC have been proposed to be initiated against them; and
- 10. Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 11. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Mst. Zatoon Akhter, Mohd Azad, Qamar Din, Wazhaid

Akbar, Kamal Din, Mohd Bashir @ Tikka Khan, Najab Din @ Naja and Mohd Latief, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (8) above, arising out of FIR No. 202/2022 of Police Station, Poonch.

SO-180.ô Whereas, on 17-06-2019, a reliable information was received by the Police Station, Pulwama, to the effect that some unknown terrorists targeted a Army Patrolling vehicle with an IED near village Arihal, and fired indiscriminately upon the Army personnel boarded in the vehicle, resulting in injuries to some Army personnel on the spot, who were shifted to the hospital for treatment. The fire was retaliated by the Security Forces and the unknown terrorists escaped from the place of occurrence; and

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a Case FIR No. 125/2019 under sections 307 RPC, 7/27 Arms Act and the Section 4/5 ESA, was registered in the Police Station, Pulwarna, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. During the investigation, two Army personnel identified as Ajeet Kumar and Amarjeet Kumar, succumbed to their injuries. Subsequently, the offences under Section 302 RPC and the Sections 13,16,18,20 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons identified as Yasir Ahmad Parray S/o Ghulam Mohammad Parray and Muntazir Ahmad Bhat S/o Abdul Gani Bhat R's/o Qasbayar, Pulwama, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused viz Muntazir Ahmad Bhat, was arrested in the case and it was found that he alongwith the accused viz. Yasir Ahmad Parry, were in contact with a Pakistan based terrorist of JeM banned outfit namely Junaid Bhai R/o Pakistan, who provided an amount of Rs. 40000/- to them with the directions to purchase a vehicle for carrying out the attack upon the Police/Security Forces in the area and as per the directions both the accused purchased a vehicle from one Asif Ahmad Sofi, and handed over the vehicle to the said terrorist which was later on used for the said IED blast. The accused viz. Yasir Ahmad Parry, after the said incident went missing from his home and joined the terrorist ranks of JeM banned outfit; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, six other persons identified as Faisal Manzoor Sofi S/o Manzoor Ahmad Sofi, Soham Showkat Raina S/o Showkat Ahamd Raina R's/o Arihal, Pulwama, Muzaffar Ali Wani S/o Ali Mohammad Wani R/o Sharshali, Khrew, Imran Nazir @ Zahid S/o Nazir Ahmad Najar R/o Mandakpal, Khrew, Shahid Ahmad Ganie S/o Guizar Ahmad Ganie and Basit Ahmad Khan S/o GuIzar Ahmad Khan R's/o Panjran, Pulwama, were found involved in the commission

- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Faisal Manzoor Sofi and Soham Showkat Raina, procured some explosive material from the accused viz. Muzaffar Ali Wani and Imran Nazir @ Zahid, who were lateron arrested by Awaniproa Police in case FIR No. 33/2019 of P /S Khrew, and handed over the same to the accused viz. Shahid Ahmad Ganie and Basit Ahmad Khan, who further handed over the explosive material to the accused terrorist viz. Juanid Bhai. Subsequently, during the investigation, 06 gelatin road and some explosive material were recovered at the instances of accused viz. Faisal Manzoor Sofi, Muzaffar Ali Wani, Imran Nazir @ Zahid, Shahid Ahmad Ganie and Basit Ahmad Khan, respectively; and
- 7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Muntazir Ahmad Bhat, Faisal Manzoor Sofi, Soham Showkat Raina, Muzaffar Ali Wani, Imran Nazir @ Zahid, Shahid Ahmad Ganie and Basit Ahmad Khan, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly the terrorists viz. Yasir Ahmad Paray and Junaid Bhai, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, facilitated the terrorist viz. Juanid Bhai and Yasir Ahmad Parray, to carry out the attack upon the Security Forces, which resulted in the death of two Army personnel; and
- 8. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Yasir Ahmad Paray and Junaid Bhai, have been killed in the different encounters with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and
- 9. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions

- 1. Muntazir Ahmad Bhat S/o Abdul Gani 13,18,39 of Bhat R/o Qasbayar, Pulwama. ULA (P) Act
- 2. Faisal Manzoor Sofi S/o Manzoor Ahmad Sofi R/o Arihal, Pulwama.
- 3. Soham Showkat Raina S/o Showkat Ahamd Raina R/o Arihal, Pulwama.
- 4. Muzaffar Ali Wani S/o Ali Mohammad Wani R/o Sharshali, Khrew.
- 5. Imran Nazir @ Zahid S/o Nazir Ahmad Najar R/o Mandakpal, Khrew
- 6. Shahid Ahmad Ganie S/o Gulzar Ahmad Ganie R/o Panjran. Pulwama.
- 7. Basit Ahmad Khan S/o GuIzar Ahmad Khan R/o Panjran, Pulwama.
- 10. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Muntazir Ahmad Bhat, Faisal Manzoor Sofi and Soham Showkat Raina, have been found juvenile and in view of section 1(4) of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015, the apprehension, detention, prosecution, penalty or imprisonment shall be governed by the said Act; and

Whereas, the Authority, appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that a *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 12. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of Section 45 the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz.
