Manzoor Wani S/o Manzoor Ahmad Wani Røø/o Brah, Mattan, are pasting the threatening posters of terrorist organization Janbaz Force in the area in order to spread terror among the general public and to threaten the sovereignty and integrity of the Union of India ; and

2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 32/2021 under Section 506 IPC and Section 13 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Mattan, and the investigation of the case was set into motion ; and

3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law ; and

4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Mubashir Hussain Shah, Shahid Ahmad Bhat and Yawar Manzoor Wani, were arrested in the case and it was found that on the date of occurrence two unknown terrorists later on one terrorist was identified as Basit Ahmad Ganie S/o Abdul Rashid Ganie R/o Oudsoo, Shangus, affiliated with LeT banned outfit, handed over some posters to the accused viz. Mubashir Hussain Shah, Shahid Ahmad Bhat and Yawar Manzoor Wani, with the directions to paste the same in the area ; and

5. Whereas, during the investigation it was established that on the date of occurrence the accused viz. Mubashir Hussain Shah, Shahid Ahmad Bhat and Yawar Manzoor Wani, procured some posters from the terrorist namely Basit Ahmad Ganie, and pasted the same in the area in order to create terror among the general public, thereby threatened the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Union of India ; and

6. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Basit Ahmad Ganie, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him ; and

7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the

provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :
