Subject :ô Online Portal for Regular Departmental Action cases against public servants-regarding.

Pursuant to verifications, joint surprise checks, FIRs, preliminary enquiries, etc., conducted by Investigating Agencies viz. Anti Corruption Bureau, Crime Branch etc., the recommendations for institution of Regular Departmental Action against public servants are received in the General Administration Department. After examination of such cases in the General Administration Department, the cases are referred to concerned Departments for initiating Regular Departmental Action against public servants in terms of relevant provisions of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956 and extant circular instructions. Apart from this, departments, at their own, also initiate RDAs against its employees, who are found to have violated service conduct rules.

Detailed guidelines for institution of Regular Departmental Action and timelines for conducting the same have been issued from time to time, latest in this series issued vide Circular No. 24-JK(GAD) of 2021 dated 17-07-2021. However, it has been noticed that the guideline as well as the timelines are not being followed by Departments, resulting into protracted delay in conclusion of the cases. The delay in finalization of departmental proceedings leads to undue advantage/harassment to the charged official: such delays on one hand help the guilty official (s) in evading penalty, while unwarranted delays prolong the agony of the official (s), against whom proceedings may not sustain and is/are finally exonerated.

With a view to streamline the procedure laid down for conducting departmental proceedings and to monitor progress for enforcing adherence to the prescribed timelines, General Administration Department has developed an online portal for Regular Departmental Action cases initiated against public servants. The portal shall contain electronic data related to RDA cases in digitized format with a unique ID which shall be accessible to all the concerned departments/disciplinary authorities, with an overall real time monitoring of the cases by the General Administration Department. The portal was launched on 26-08-2023 and can be accessed on https://rda.jk.gov.in.

The portal provides a window for referral of cases from Anti Corruption Bureau to the General Administration Department and their further referral to the concerned Departments. It also provides a window for uploading RDA cases initiated by the Departments on their own. The portal shall work as a channel for communication w. r. t. RDA cases between the GAD and the Departments, as also between GAD and ACB.

The portal contains templates of draft charge-sheets, order for appointment of Inquiry Officer, relevant notices, circulars, guidelines etc. for aiding in conduct of the departmental proceedings. Consistent with the timelines prescribed for various stages of departmental proceedings till the conclusion of RDA cases, the portal has unique feature to generate alerts, wherever any requisite stage of proceedings exceeds the prescribed timelines this will be an aid in ensuring strict adherence of the prescribed timelines by the concerned authorities towards timely conclusion of the RDA cases. In case of deviation or delay at any stage of the proceedings, responsibilities shall be fixed upon the concerned, who shall be liable for action as warranted under rules.

- Each Department shall nominate a Nodal Officer, not below the rank of Deputy Secretary, who shall be responsible for uploading of cases and their progress at various stages of proceedings, regular monitoring of the cases, liaisoning with the General Administration Department, besides other issues relating to RDAs.
- Each department shall be provided with two login IDs; one for Nodal Officer and another for the Disciplinary Authority. The Disciplinary Authority in the Department shall have an access for monitoring of the cases on real time basis.
- 3. The legacy data of all the RDA cases received from the Investigating Agencies/GAD as well as the cases initiated by the Department on their own, which are pending with the departments as on date, shall be uploaded on the portal within a timeframe of one month positively, from the date of issuance of this Circular, by the General Administration Department and the Departments as well. Besides, fresh cases shall be uploaded by the Anti Corruption Bureau and the Departments on the portal as the case may be.
- 4. Administrative Departments shall review the progress of pending RDA cases on regular intervals for swift disposal of the cases.

All the Administrative Departments are, accordingly, impressed upon to adhere to the above instructions in letter and spirit.

INTRODUCTION:

The proceedings are as per the provisions of Section 23 of the Right to fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of land measuring 01 Kanal 04 Marla 05 Sirsai 20.25 Sft& under Survey No. 7 min, 16 min, 61 min, 92 min, 371 min, 384 min, 392 min required for the erection of 7 towers at Village Bathen and land measuring 01 Kanal 02 Marlas 01 Sirsai 29.5 Sft& under Survey No. 3819 min, 3822 min, 3826 min, 3827 min, 3842 min required for the erection of 4 towers at Village Khrew Tehsil Pampore, the acquisition proceeding were initiated on the basis of request made by the requiring body viz. Chief Engineer JK Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. Kashmir.

NOTIFICATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND REPORT OF SIA:

The process for conduct of Social Impact Assessment report under the provisions of Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was initiated as per this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/463-73 Dated 23-03-2021, in concurrence with the District Collector office order No. DCP/LA/2020/610-30 Dated 25-08-2020 whereby following member already nominated were assigned the task for conduct of the field survey for the proposed project.

- 1) Tehsildar Concerned
- 2) Assistant Executive Engineer R&B Pampore
- 3) Assistant Executive Engineer (Jal Shakti) PHE Sub Division Pampore.
- 4) Assistant Executive Engineer Irrigation Sub Division Khrew.
- 5) Range Officer SC Range Pampore.
- 6) Agriculture Extension Officer Zone Pampore.
- 7) Representative of Indenting Department.

The report so prepared by the committee members for the instant land acquisition case was submitted to the Appropriate Government/ District Collector vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/74-76 Dated 27-05-2021 for accord of approval/authorization for issuance of Notification Section 11 of the said Act.

EVAULLATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT:

On the basis of the recommendations and the observations submitted by the committee constituted, it was established that the land for which the indent stands placed is required for legitimate and bona fide public purpose which necessitates the acquisition of land indentified. Direction to the Collector for proceeding ahead under the provisions of Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was communicated by the District Collector vide his office No. DCP/LA/2021/420-22 Dated 07-09-2021.

PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATION AND ISSUE OF NOTICE:

The Preliminary notification under Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued vide this office Notification No. 06 of 2021 dated 11-10-2021 under endoresment No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/543-50 Dated 11-10-2021 for calling upon the objections, if any, from the interested persons/landowners. The same was got published in the official gazette on 9th December 2021 in Volume 134 and in two leading daily news papers viz. ::Srinagar Times Dated 14-10-2021@and ::Kashmir Vision Dated 15-10-2021@and wide publicity was also made. In response to the said notification, during the stipulated period of time, three objections, were received. heard and accordingly submitted along with approximate cost of land acquisition as laid under Section 15 of the Act vide this office No. ADC/AWP/

LA/21-22/814-18 Dated 28-03-2022 with recommendations to the District Collector Pulwama for a decision and if found appropriate issuance of declaration under Section 19 of the Act.

The case was examined by the **appropriate Government District Collector who after thoughtful consideration was satisfied that the land under acquisition is in the interest of the public purpose, therefore, the acquisition of land outweigh the objections raised. The **appropriate Government District Collector issued declaration under Section 19(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 vide Notification No. 11 of Rev/LA of 2022 Dated 28-04-2022 under endorsement No. DCP/LA/2022/37-40 Dated 28-04-2022, declaring that the land measuring 01 Kanal 04 Marlas 05 Sirsai 20.25 Sft. under Survey No. 7 min, 16 min, 61 min, 92 min, 371 min, 384 min, 392 min is required for the erection of 7 towers at Village Bathen and land measuring 01 Kanal 02 Marlas 01 Sirsai 29.5 Sft. under survey No. 3819 min, 3822 min, 3826 min, 3827 min, 3842 min is required for the erection of 4 towers at Village Khrew Tehsil Pampore.

Public notice under Section 21(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued to the interested persons/land owners to state the particulars of the land so needed, and to state the nature of their respective interests in the land and the amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests, their claims to rehabilitation and reseltlment along with their objections, if any, to the measurement made and to appear personally or by agent or advocate within a period of 30 days. The same was got published in the official gazette on 20th October, 2022 in Volume 135 and in two leading daily newspapers viz. ::Rising Kashmir dated 30-07-2022@and officeater Kashmir dated 30-07-2022@and wide publicity was also made. During the prescribed period of time no such objection was received by the Collectorate.

<u>METHODOLOGY USED FOR DETERMINATION OF</u> <u>COMPENSATION</u>:

On the basis of alignment given by the Executive Engineer TLMD-IV Pampore revenue extracts including khasra Paimaish were submitted by the Tehsildar Pampore. The type of land khasra numbers of both of the Villages are recorded as Maidani. The land rates per kanal as applicable to the type of land stands notified by the Chairman, District

Valuation Committee vide his office order No. 12/DCP-SQ of 2021 Dated 31-12-2021 under endorsement No. DCP-SQ/20-21/1689-1703 dated 31-12-2021 under the Market Value Guideline Rules of 2011 for the year 2022 for the corresponding year is as under ,ô

POSSESSION OF LAND:

The possession of the land proposed for the erection of 7 towers at Village Bathen and 4 towers at Village Khrew Tehsil Pampore District Pulwama shall be taken after compliance of Section 38 by the Collector Land Acquisition (Additional Deputy Commissioner) Awantipora and shall be handed over to the requiring Department i. e. Executive Engineer TLMD-IV Pampore.

OWNERSHIP:

Names of the persons whose land is under acquisition, was ascertained from the revenue records/spot possession and the same has been included in Award statement.

MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED:

Consequent upon taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested persons. the Tehsildar Concerned shall ensure that the revenue records and all the relevant documents relating to the ownership/occupancy of the said land

are accordingly updated and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government through JK Power Transmission Corporation Ltd. Kashmir.

APPORTIONMENT:

Compensation amount will be paid accordingly to the latest entries in the Revenue Record and as per enquiry conducted under Section 23. In case of any dispute, which I cannot settle within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the Court under Section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for the determination of ownership rights.

ENCUMBRANCES:

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and has been mentioned in the Award statement.

DETERMINATION OF SOLATIUM:

As per the provisions of Section 30(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the market value is awarded as Solatium has been determined in the award statement.

COMPENSATION OF LAND AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES:

After considering the parameters provided in Section 26 across 29 of the Act, the compensation of the land stands determined. The total amount of award for both the villages works out to be Rs. 32,30,484/(Rupees Thirty Two Lakh Thirty Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty Four only) and the administrative charges @ Rs. 2.5% to the tune of Rs. 80,762/- (Rupees Eighty Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty Two only) as admissible under the provisions of Rule 5 of Sub-Section 1 of the Act.

APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT AWARD.

The draft Award so framed vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/488 Dated 19-1-2023 for an amount of Rs. 32, 30,484/- (Rupees Thirty Two Lakh Thirty Thousand Four Hundred and Eighty Four only) involved in the instant land acquisition case was submitted before the District Collector Pulwama vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/489 Dated 19-01-2023 in terms of rules 32 and 34 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for accord of approval of the rates.

Accordingly, the instant land acquisition case was put before the Collector meeting held on 09-08-2023 under the Chairmanship of District Collector Pulwama. The Minutes of the meeting were circulated vide District Collector Pulwama office No. DCP/Coll/2023/206-210 dated 17-08-2023, where rates adopted and the action taken was approved with the direction that Collector Land Acquisition shall proceed further strictly in accordance with the rules in vogue.

PAYMENT OF COMPENSATION TO THE INTERESTED **PERSON:**

Subsequently the offences under Sections 147, 148, 149, 336, 307, 212 RPC were dropped and the offences under Sections 302 RPC and the Sections 13, 16, 18, 19, 20, 38 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and

Whereas, during the investigation, dead bodies of two killed terrorists of LeT banned outfit who were later on identified as Aijaz Ahmad Makroo S/o Ghulam Rasool Makroo R/o Ghat, Qaimoh and Waris Ahmad Malik S/o Bashir Ahmad Malik R/o Rakh-e-Momin, were recovered from the place of encounter. During the investigation, arms/ammunition viz. 01 AK-56 rifle, 01 SLR, 01 AK magazine,19 rounds, 01 UBGL, 02 SLR magazines and 92 SLR rounds were also recovered from the place of occurrence; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused house owner viz. Mohd Ayoub Dar, was arrested in the case and it was found that he along with one more person namely Tariq Ahmad Dar S/o Mohd Yousuf Dar R/o Redwani Bala, Qaimoh, were working for the terrorists of LeT

- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Mohd Ayoub Dar and Tariq Ahmad Dar, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly the killed terrorists viz. Aijaz Ahmad Makroo and Waris Ahmad Malik, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, on the date of occurrence, the accused viz. Mohd Ayoub Dar, voluntarily harboured the said terrorists in his residential house for carrying out the terrorists activities in the area; and
- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorists viz. Aijaz Ahmad Makroo and Waris Ahmad Malik, have been killed in the said encounter with the Security Forces and the proceeding under the law would abate against him; and

Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô
