Whereas, on the basis of an indent placed by the Project Director, National Highway Authority of India (NHAI), PIU-Jammu vide No. PD/JNU/11012/LA dated 02-12-2005, notification under Section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued by

Whereas, fresh notification under Section 4(1) of the said Act, was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (ADC), Kathua and accordingly recommended for issuance of declaration under Sections 6 & 7 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 vide No. ADCK/LA/2021-22/42-45 dated 08-07-2021 to the Deputy Commissioner, Kathua, who vide No. DCK/LA/2021-22/642-44 dated 12-07-2021 endorsed the same to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, who vide No. 502/1359/Acq/logate/Kathua/885 dated 18-08-2021 endorsed to Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K, and further to this department vide No. FCR-LAND/140/2021-06 (49585) dated 01-05-2023. Accordingly, notification under Sections 6 & 7 of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued vide No. 32-Rev (LAJ) of 2021 dated 15-11-2021 under endorsement No. Rev-LAJ/74/2021 (54435) dated 15-11-2021 by the Revenue Department; and

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Kathua, vide No. DCK/LA/2022-23/1939-42 dated 02-12-2022 submitted a report to the Divisional Commissioner, Jammu that a proposal has been received from Additional Deputy Commissioner (Collector, Land Acquisition), Kathua, vide No. ADCK/LAS/2022-23/123-26 dated 23-11-2022 for de-notification of land measuring 45 Kanals 18 Marlas situated at Village Logate, Tehsil and District Kathua; and

Whereas, the communication referred to above from Deputy Commissioner, Kathua reveals that Project Director, NHAI, PIU-Jammu vide No. PD/JMU/LA-Kathua/2022-23/2349 dated 27-10-2022 has intimated that indent for the said land was placed in the year 2005. Since, the land acquisition proceedings have not been concluded till date and green field Delhi-Katra Expressway is being developed as well as Service road has been constructed in the Logate Village within the existing 45 Mtrs. ROW and requested that the indent for additional land acquisition may be treated as withdrawn. The acquisition proceedings of the said land were underway with the Collector, Land Acquisition

Whereas, the matter has been examined, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu, vide No. 502/1359/Acq Logate/Kth/23/95 dated 15-04-2023 has sought some clarifications from Deputy Commissioner, Kathua, who vide No. ADCK/LAS/2022-23/160-61 dated 17-03-2023 submitted that Project Director, NHAI vide No. PD/JMU/LA-Kathua/2022-23/2349 dated 27-10-2022 has certified that the subject land has not been occupied by NHAI as the acquisition proceedings of the said land could not be completed since 2005 and due to Delhi-Katra Expressway viz-a-viz Service road constructed within 45 Meter ROW, the indent for the said land has been withdrawn and Tehsildar Kathua vide No. K/OQ/2022-23/1042 dated 01-03-2023 has also reported that land measuring 45 Kanals 18 Marlas is under the possession of land owners; and

Whereas, the land acquisition proceedings have been initiated under J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 and the said Act, has been repealed and ::The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 is now applicable in J&K and Section 93, of the said Act, has provision that the appropriate Government shall be at liberty to withdraw from acquisition of land of which possession has not been taken. It provides as under :ô

"Completion of acquisition not compulsory, but compensation to be awarded when not completed—

- (1) The appropriate Government shall be at liberty to withdraw from the acquisition of any land of which possession has not been taken.
- (2) Whenever, the appropriate Government withdraws from any such acquisition, the Collector shall determine the amount of compensation due for the damage suffered by the owner in consequence of the notice or of any proceedings thereunder, and shall pay such amount to the

Whereas, in another case of de-notification, the matter was referred to Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs for advice, who vide U. O. No. Law-Opn2/48/2022-10 dated 19-04-2022 advises as under :ô

"In terms of Clause (14) of Jammu and Kashmir Re-organization (Removal of Difficulties) Order, 2019, anything done or any action taken under any law (repealed now) shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the corresponding provisions of the Central Laws now extended and applicable to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. Thus the acquisition proceedings initiated under the Jammu and Kashmir Land Acquisition Act Svt. 1990 (repealed Act) shall be deemed to have been initiated under the corresponding provision of the Central Laws i. e. "Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013". Therefore, department is advised that any new action including withdrawal/de-notifying land in Question may be taken under Section 93 of the Central Act, 2013."

Whereas, the instant matter was also referred to Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, who vide U.O. No. LAW-Opn2/106/2023-10 (7269298) dated 31-08-2023 has advised as under :ô

"The legal position in an identical matter has already been conveyed to the department vide UO No. LAW-Opn2/48/2022-10 dated 19-04-2022 which holds good in the present facts and circumstances of the case and is hereby reiterated. Department is advised to take further course of action in the matter accordingly".

Whereas, the matter has been again examined in light of the advice tendered by the Department of Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs, as it has been reported by the Deputy Commissioner, Kathua that the, acquisition proceedings have not been concluded till date and green field Delhi-Katra Expressway is being developed and Service road has been constructed in the Logate Village within the existing 45 Mtrs. and

Whereas, based on the reports referred above, the Government is satisfied that the land measuring 45 Kanals 18 Marlas situated in Village Logate, Tehsil and District Kathua is not required by the NHAI.

Now, therefore, in terms of Sub-Section (1) of Section 93 of ::The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013%, land measuring 45 Kanals 18 Marlas situated in Village Logate, Tehsil and District Kathua shall and shall always be deemed to have been de-notified from the acquisition proceedings subject to the condition thatô

- a. The Deputy Commissioner and Collector, Land Acquisition concerned shall ensure that the possession of the said land has not been taken by the Indenting Department/Agency and the land was/is still in the continued physical possession of the land owner(s).
- b. The compensation of the said land has not been paid to the rightful claimants and if any compensation received by the land owner(s) in respect of the said land shall be recovered back before effecting necessary changes in the revenue records in pursuance of the proposed de-notification.
- c. The Deputy Commissioner/Collector, Land Acquisition shall ensure that the said land has not been proposed for any other acquisition/public purpose or is likely to be required.
- d. The proposed de-notification shall be without prejudice to the outcome of the writ petition(s), if any, pending consideration before the Competent Court(s).

Subsequently, a Joint Cordon and Search Operation was launched in the area and during the search. the hiding terrorists fired indiscriminatly upon the Search Party, with their illegal arms/ammunition, with the intention to

- 2. Whereas, based on the above a Case FIR No. 40/2022 under Sections 307, IPC, 7/25, 7/27 Arms Act, and the Sections 16, 18 and 38 of ULA(P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Sheeri and investigation of the case was set into motion. During the investigation, the injured Army Jawan identified as Kulbushan Manta of 52 RR succumbed to his injuries. Subsequently, the offences under Section 302 IPC and the Sections 13, 18-B and 20 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statement of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat, was in contact with a terrorist of LeT Banned outfit namely Hilal Ahmad Sheikh S/o Ab. Hamid Sheikh R/o Shrakwara, who motivated/lured the accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat, to Join the terrorist rank in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. The accused terrorist viz. Hilal Ahmad Sheikh, on the directions of PaK based terrorist namely Ali Sajad @ Sajad Bai made the contact of accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat, with the PaK terrorist namely Usman, who on the date of occurrence after indiscriminate firing managed his escape from the spot; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat and Hilal Ahmad Sheikh, were members of LeT banned outfit and were in contact with the Pakistan based terrorists namely Ali Sajad @ Sajad Bai and Usman. The accused terrorist viz. Hilal Ahmad Sheikh, under a well knit criminal conspiracy motivated and facilitated the joining of accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat, with the terrorist ranks, who on the date of occurrence fired upon the

Police/Security Forces which resulted in the death of one Army Jawan, besides, facilitated the escape of terrorist namely Usman, from the place of encounter; and

- 6. Whereas, the accused terrorist namely Hilal Ahmad Sheikh has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him and the investigation, in respect of Pakistan based terrorists viz. Usman and Ali Sajad @ Sajad Bai, shall continue to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet against the accused would be filed in the court of competent Jurisdiction; and
- 7. Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statement of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against his name :ô

- 8. Whereas, the Authority appointed by the Government under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, has independently examined the Case Diary File and all the other relevant documents relating to the case and has come to the conclusion that *prima facie* case is made out against the above accused; and
- 9. Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above mentioned accused for his prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Nisar Ahmad Bhat, for the commission of offences punishable under Sections 13, 16, 18, 20 and 38 of ULA (P) Act, arising out of FIR No. 40/2022 of Police Station, Sheeri.

Whereas, Preliminary Examination was conducted on 31-07-2022, in which 23,571 candidates appeared in the Examination; and

Whereas, as per the criteria fixed by the Commission, vide Notification No. PSC/Exam/2022/22 dated 17-08-2022, a total of 4944 candidates were declared to have qualified for the Mains Examination; and

Whereas, J&K Combined Competitive (Mains) Examination, 2022, was conducted from 20-02-2023 to 02-03-2023, both at Jammu and Srinagar in which 3891 candidates appeared in all papers; and

SO-165.ô Whereas, on 03-11-2022, the Police Station, Pulwama, received a docket to the effect that a Joint Naka was established by the Police/Security Forces at Khamri Chowk, Arihal and during the checking a suspect while seeing the Naka Party tried to lob a grenade upon the Naka Party but was tactfully chased down on the spot and identified as Zubair Ahmad Dar S/o Ali Mohammad Dar R/o Arigam, Pulwama. During his personal search, a hand grenade was recovered from his possession; and

- 2. Whereas; based on the above, a Case FIR No. 314/2022 under section 307 IPC, 5 ESA and the Section 18 of ULA (P) Act, was registered in the Police Station, Pulwama, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation, the offences under Section 20, 23 and 39 of ULA (P) Act were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the course of the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Dar, was found in contact with a terrorist of JeM banned outfit namely Umar R/o PoK through the virtual mode. The accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Dar, on the directions of the said PoK based terrorist received a hand grenade, 01 magazine alongwith an amount of Rs. 10000/- from an unknown person at village Allowpora, in order to promote terrorist activities in the area. Subsequently, during the investigation, 01 AK magazine, 10 rounds and an amount of Rs. 10000/- were recovered at his instances; and
- 5, Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Zubair Ahmad Dar, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of JeM banned outfit particularly the PoK based terrorist viz Umar, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy was providing logistic support to him, besides, on the directions of the said terrorist procured a hand grenade, magazine and an amount of Rs. 10000-from an unknown person for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of accused PoK based terrorist viz. Umar, and unknown person who provided a hand grenade, magazine and an amount of Rs. 10000/- to the accused shall continue to ascertain their actual identity and to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet against the accused would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction; and

Whereas, the Agriculture Production Department (herein referred to the Department) is administering the Holistic Agriculture Development Program (herein referred to as the HADP) to provide various incentives/subsidies (in-cash/in-kind) (herein referred to as the benefits) to the farmers/agri-entrepreneurs (herein referred to as the beneficiaries) from J&K which is being implemented through the Directorates of Agriculture (Kashmir/Jammu), Horticulture (Kashmir/Jammu), Horticulture Planning and Marketing, J&K, J&K, Sericulture, Animal Husbandry (Kashmir/Jammu), Husbandry (Kashmir/Jammu) and Fisheries, J&K as well as the Sher-e-University of Agriculture Sciences and Technology (Kashmir/Jammu) and Horticulture Produce Marketing Corporation, J&K (herein referred to as the Implementing Agencies); and

Whereas, under various schemes of the HADP, subsidy/government to assistance is given to the beneficiaries by the Implementing Agencies as per the extant scheme guidelines; and

Whereas, the aforesaid HADP involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016, the Government of Jammu and Kashmir hereby notifies the following:ô

- (1) An individual eligible for receiving the benefit under these Schemes shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- (2) Any individual desirous of availing benefits under the Schemes, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrollment before registering for the schemes provided that he/she is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per Section 3 of the said Act and such individuals shall visit

any Aadhaar Enrollment Centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDIA) website www.uidia.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3) As per Regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrollment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the department through its Implementing Agency is required to offer Aadhaar enrollment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrollment center located in the respective Block or Taluka or Tehsil, the department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrollment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the Scheme shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents:ô

- (a) if he/she has enrolled, his/her Aadhaar Enrollment Identification slip; and
- (b) any one of the following documents :ô
 - a. Bank or Post Office Passbook with photo; or
 - b. Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - c. Passport; or
 - d. Ration Card; or
 - e. Voter Identity Card; or
 - f. MGNREGA Card; or
 - g. Kissan Passbook having photo; or
 - h. Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or

- Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tehsildar on an official letter head; or
- j. Any other document as specified by the department:

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the department for that purpose.

- In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the (4) conveniently, scheme the department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
- (5) In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely :ô
 - (a) In case of poor fingerprint quality Iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for Iris scanners or face authentication along with fingerprint authentication for delivery of benefit in seamless manner;
 - (b) In case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or Iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time Based One Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
 - (c) In all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time Based One Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Scheme may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of QR code reader shall be

provided at the convenient locations by the department through its Implementing Agency.

(6) In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no *bona fide* beneficiary under the HADP is deprived of his due benefits, the department through its Implementing Agency shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the office memorandum of DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat Government of India dated 19th December, 2017.

This notification shall come into force from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.
