Whereas, on the basis of indent placed by the Executive Engineer, PWD (R&B), Division Ramban vide No. 12258-62 dated 20-03-2010, notification under section 4 (1) of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat, 1990 was issued by Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM) Goal, under endorsement No. 261-70/SDM/G/PWD dated 07-03-2017 for land measuring 23 Kanals as per description as Annexure-A situated in Village Wanding, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban, calling upon the objections from the land owners/interested persons; and

Whereas, pursuant to above notification, no objection was received from anyone within the prescribed time period, accordingly, declaration under Sections 6, 7 and 17 of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990 was issued vide Notification No.380-Rev (LAJ) of 2017 dated 16-08-2017 under endorsement No.Rev/LAJ/198/2017 dated 16-08-2017. Deputy Commissioner, Ramban has reported that final award has not been issued

Whereas, Deputy Commissioner, Ramban vide No. DC/LA/Rbn/1782-83 dated 10-02-2023 again recommended the case to Divisional Commissioner, Jammu for issuance of declaration under Sections 6, 7 and 17 of Land Acquisition Act, Samvat, 1990, who vide No.502/4653/Acq/PWD/Wanding/Rbn/23/2329 dated 16-03-2023 read with No. 502/4653/Acq/Wanding/Rbn/23/1154 dated 19-09-2023 endorsed to Financial Commissioner (Revenue), J&K who vide No. FCR-LAND/64/2023-06 (7153294) dated 25-09-2023 forwarded to this department for the said purpose; and

Whereas, the report furnished by Collector Land Acquisition (SDM) Goal vide letter referred to above, duly endorsed by District Collector (DC) Ramban, Divisional Commissioner, Jammu and Financial Commissioner, (Revenue), J&K has been examined and it has been found that no one has filed any objection to the proposed acquisition; and

Whereas, the Government is satisfied that the aforesaid land is required for public purpose i.e. construction of Fareedabad to Mohila road under PWD situated in village Wanding, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban.

Now, therefore, in pursuance of Sections 6 of the J&K Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is declared that the land measuring 23 Kanal as per description at **Annexure-A** situated in Village Wanding, Tehsil Gool, Dstrict Ramban is required for public purpose i. e. for construction of Fareedabad to Mohila road under PWD. Further the Collector, Land Acquisition (SDM), Gool is directed under section 7 of the said Act to take orders for acquisition of the said land after giving prescribed notice to the interested person (s) as required under the Land Acquisition Act/rules.

Further, in pursuance of section 17 of the Land Acquisition Act, Samvat 1990, it is also ordered that on expiry of fifteen days from the publication of the Notification under Section 9 (2) of the said Act, the Collector will take possession of the aforementioned land at village Wanding, Tehsil Gool, District Ramban required for public purpose, subject to fulfillment of the conditions prescribed under Section 9 (2) and Section 17-A of the Land Acquisition Act and Rule 63 of the Land Acquisition Rules.

However, the Collector concerned shall be held specifically responsible for identification and proper title verification of all types of lands involved in the case for making apportionment of compensation amongst all the interested persons/rightful claimants, in accordance with the relevant laws/rules in force, while making the award. The Collector/indenting department shall also ensure that no compensation shall be made for the portion of land which has already been acquired for the road in question.

# **INTRODUCTION:**

The proceedings are as per the provisions of Section 23 of :The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013¢ for determination of compensation in respect of land measuring 01 Kanal 06 Marlas under survey numbers 1251 min recorded as Proprietary land required for the construction of 6.3 MVA Receiving Station at Village Shar Shali Tehsil Pampore, the acquisition proceeding were initiated on the basis of request made by the requiring body viz. Chief Engineer Distribution KPDCL Kashmir through Executive Engineer STD Pulwama.

# NOTIFICATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND REPORT OF SIA:

The process for conduct of Social Impact Assessment report under the provisions of Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was initiated as per this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/20/101-12 Dated 22/09/2020. in concurrence with the District Collector office order No. DCP/LA/2020/610-30 Dated 25/08/2020 whereby following member already nominated were assigned the task for conduct of the field survey for the proposed project,ô

## **EVALUATION OF SOCIAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT:**

On the basis of the recommendations and the observations submitted by the committee constituted, it was established that the land for which the indent stands placed is required for legitimate and *bona fide* public purpose which necessitates the acquisition of land identified. Direction to the Collector for proceeding ahead under the provisions of Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was communicated by the District Collector vide his office No. DCP/LA/2020/1188-89 Dated 08-12-2020.

# **PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATION AND ISSUE OF NOTICES:**

The preliminary notification under Section 11(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 was issued vide this office Notification No. 02 of 2021 Dated 19-01-2021 under endorsement No. ADC/AWP/LA/20-21/311-16 Dated 19-01-2021 for calling upon the objections, if any, from the interested persons/landowners. The same was got published in the official gazette on 25th November 2021 in Volume 134 and in the daily news paper ::The Kashmir Monitor Date 21-10-2021, and wide publicity was also made. In response to the said notification, during the stipulated period of time no objection was received by this Collectorate and accordingly the case was submitted under Section 15 of the Act vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/21-22/773-77 Dated 14-03-2022 with recommendations to the District Collector Pulwama for a decision and issuance of declaration under Section 19 of the Act.

Public notice under Section 21(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabiliation and Resettlemant Act, 2013 was issued vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/47-54 Dated 22-04-2022 to the interested persons/land owners to state the particulars of the land so needed, and to state the nature of their respective interests in the land and the amount and particulars of their claims to compensation for such interests, their claims to rehabilitation and resettlement along with their objections, if any, to the measurement made and to appear personally or by agent or advocate within a period of 30 days. During the prescribed period of time no such objection was received by this Collectorate.

# <u>METHODOLOGY USED FOR DETERMINATION OF</u> <u>COMPENSATION</u>:

On the basis of alignment given by the PDD/KPDCL department revenue extracts, including Khasra Paimaish were submitted by the Tehsildar Pampore. The type of land for khasra number 1251 is recorded as Maidani. The land rates per kanal as applicable to the type of land stands notified by the Chairman District Valuation Committee vide his office Notification number 12/DCP-SQ of 2021 Dated 31-12-2021 under endorsement number DCP-SQ/20-21/1689-1703 Dated 31-12-2021. The value of the land as per the market value guidelines for the corresponding year is as under.

There is no residential/commercial structure on the proposed site.

# **POSSESSION OF LAND:**

The possession of the land was handed over by the land owner to the Executive Engineer KPDCL Sub Transmission Division Pulwama prior to initiating the land acquisition proceedings. Therefore the department had already started the developmental activities.

# **OWNERSHIP**:

Names of the persons whose land is under acquisition, was ascertained from the revenue records and the same has been included in Award statement.

# MUTATION OF OCCUPANCY IN RESPECT OF THE SAID LAND BEING ACQUIRED:

Consequent upon taking over possession of the said land and the payment of the compensation to the concerned interested persons, the Tehsildar Concerned shall ensure that the revenue records and all the relevant documents relating to the ownership/occupancy of the said land are accordingly updated and show the transfer of the said land solely in the name of Government.

# <u>APPORTIONMENT</u>:

Compensation amount will be paid accordingly to the latest entries in the Revenue Record and as per enquiry conducted under Section 23. In case of any dispute, which I cannot settle within reasonable time, the amount of compensation will be remitted to the Court under Section 64 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquistion, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for the determination of ownership rights.

# **ENCUMBRANCES**:

The land under acquisition is free from all encumbrances and has been mentioned in the Award statement.

# **DETERMINATION OF SOLATIUM:**

As per the provisions of Section 30(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, 100% of the market value is awarded as Solatium has been determined in the award statement.

# **COMPENSATION OF LAND AND ADMINISTRATIVE CHARGES**:

After considering the parameters provided in Section 26 across 29 of the Act, the compensation of the land stands determined. The total

amount of award works out to be Rs. 18,56,400/- (Rupees Eighteen Lac Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred Only).

# APPROVAL OF THE DRAFT AWARD:

The draft Award so framed vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/607 Dated 29-03-2023 for an amount of Rs. 18,56,400/- (Rupees Eighteen Lac Fifty Six Thousand and Four Hundred only) involved in the instant land acquisition case was submitted before the District Collector Pulwama vide this office No. ADC/AWP/LA/22-23/619 Dated 29-03-2023 in terms of rules 32 and 34 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for accord of approval of the rates.

Accordingly, the instant land acquisition case was put before the Collectorsø meeting held on 09-08-2023 under the Chairmanship of District Collector Pulwama. The minutes of the meeting were circulated vide District Collector Pulwamaøs office No. DCP/Coll/2023/206-210 dated 17-08-2023, the verbatim of which is.ó

"It was decided that an affidavit/undertaking attested by the Judicial Magistrate shall be taken from both the parties i. e. Indenting Department and the land holder and thereafter the case shall be submitted to the Law Department J&K for opinion/guidance so as to proceed ahead as per law".

Consequent, to the directions imparted in the Collectorsø meeting a joint affidavit duly attested by the Additional Special Mobile Magistrate Awantipora was obtained from both the parties i. e. Indenting Department through Executive Engineer KPDCL Sub Transmission Division Pulwama and the Land owner, whereby the land owner admits that he will receive only 12.00 lac for acquisition of the said land and the remaining amount has already received by him from the Auqaf Committee Shar Shali. As such the amount of the award is restricted to Rs. 12.00 Lac only. The landowner shall hereafter have no further claim on amount of compensation which he agrees upon.

- 2. Whereas, based on the above, a case FIR No. 19/2022 under Sections 8/21, 29 NDPS, 120-B, 121, 121-A IPC, and Sections 13, 17, 18, 39 and 40 of ULA(P) Act was registered in the Police Station, CIK/SIA, Srinagar, and the investigation of the case was set into motion. Subsequently, during the investigation the offences under Sections 8/21 NDPS, 120-B IPC and Section 17 of ULA(P) Act were dropped and the offence under Section 27-B NDPS Act and Section 201 IPC were added in the case; and
- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the accused lady viz. Rubeena Nazir, was arrested in the case and she alongwith one more person identified as Ishfaq Ahmad Mir S/o Mohammad Maqbool Mir R/o Mir Mohalla, Tarzoo, Sopore, were found in contact with some LeT banned terrorists of Sopore area who had crossed the LOC and are presently operating from Pakistan, through the virtual mode. Subsequently, the accused viz. Ishfaq Ahmad Mir, was arrested in the case; and
- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused lady, viz. Rubeena Nazir, on the directions of accused viz. Ishfaq Ahmad Mir, received 47 kgs of narcotics from one Mudasir Ahmad Poswal S/o Nazir Ahmad Poswal R/o Amrohi, Tangdhar, Karnah, through two persons identified as Safeer Ahmad Mughal S/o Abdul Rashid Mughal R/o Taad, Karnah and Iftikhar Ahmad Sheikh S/o Abdul Lateef Sheikh R/o Amrohi, Tangdhar, Karnah, and delivered the same to other two persons namely Abdul Rashid Bhat S/o Ghulam Mohammad Bhat R/o Lakripora, Padgampora and Abdul Rashid Mir S/o Mohammad Sultan Mir R/o Amargrah, Sopore. During investigation, the accused viz. Mudasir Ahmad Poswal, was also arrested in the case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused lady viz. Rubeena Nazir, transferred an amount of Rs. 20 lacs and 72 thousand among the terrorists of LeT, JeM and HM banned outfit and

their associates as well as their families which was generated from the proceeds of smuggled narcotics/sale of drugs. Subsequently, during the investigation, an amount of Rs. 1,99,800/- were recovered at her instance; and

- 6. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of accused viz. Safeer Ahmad Mughal, Iftikhar Ahmad Sheikh, Abdul Rashid Bhat and Abdul Rashid Mir and the other accused shall continue to bring out their role/involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet shall be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction against them; and
- 7. Whereas, during the investigation it was established that the accused lady viz. Rubeena Nazir, Ishfaq Ahmad Mir and Mudasir Ahmad Poswal, were working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the banned terrorist organization and under a well knit criminal conspiracy, were providing logistic support to them, besides, were facilitating the transportation and selling of narcotics for the terrorists so that the money generated could be utilized to commit terrorist activities in Jammu and Kashmir and to wage war against the Government of India; and

Whereas, on the basis of the investigation, the statements of witnesses recorded and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer, has established *prima facie* involvement of the below mentioned accused for the commission of offences punishable in terms of the provisions of Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967 and the Indian Penal Code, 1860 as shown against their names:

Whereas, during the investigation, dead bodies of four killed terrorists of HM banned outfit who were later on identified as Waqoor Farooq Itoo S/o Farooq Ahmad Itoo R/o Chawalgam, Kulgam, Sahid Sadiq Malik S/o Mohd Sadiq Malik R/o Khull, Ahmadabad, Ajaz Ahmad Naik S/o Mohd Iqbal Naik R/o Chimmer and Mohd Ashraf Malik @ Sadam S/o Bashir Ahmad Malik R/o Arwani, Bijbehara, were recovered from the place of encounter. During the investigation, arms/ammunition viz. 01 AK-47 rifle, 01 INSAS rifle, 01 SLR, 01 Pistol, 03 AK-47 magazines, 04 INSAS magazines, 02 SLR magazines, 01 Pistol magazine, 45 AK-47 rounds, 74 INSAS rounds, 28 SLR rounds and 02 Pistol rounds were also recovered from the place of occurrence; and
- 4. Whereas, during the course of investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, two persons identified as Farooq Ahmad Lone S/o Mohd Maqsood Lone and Mudasir Ahmad Lone S/o Gh. Mohammad Lone Røs/o H.M. Guri, D.H. working as Over Ground Workers (OGWs) for the terrorists of HM banned outfit particularly the killed terrorists viz. Waqoor Farooq Itoo, Shahid Sadiq Malik, Ajaz Ahmad Naik and Mohd Ashraf Malik @ Sadam, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them, besides, on the date of occurrence voluntarily harboured the said terrorists in their residential houses for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and

- 7. Whereas, the accused terrorist viz. Waqoor Farooq Itoo, Shahid Sadiq Malik, Ajaz Ahmad Naik and Mohd Ashraf Malik @ Sadam, have been killed in the said encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against them; and

Shahbaz and Ajaz Ahmad Bhat, under a well knit criminal conspiracy were providing logistic support to them and were facilitating the terrorists for transportation of arms/ammunition from one place to another, besides, the accused viz. Showkat Ahmad Digoo and Hilal Ahmad Mantoo, procured arms/ammunition and explosive material from the said terrorists for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and
- 8. Whereas, accused terrorist viz. Ajaz Ahmad Bhat, has been killed in an encounter with the Security Forces and the proceedings under the law would abate against him; and
- 9. Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected, the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie* involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under Section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô

Whereas, after perusing the Case Diary File, the relevant documents and also taking into consideration the views of the Authority appointed under Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government is of the view that there is sufficient material and evidence available against the above-mentioned accused for their prosecution under the provisions of law.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (2) of Section 45 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, the Government hereby accord sanction for launching prosecution against the accused viz. Showkat Ahmad Digoo, Firdous Ahmad Bhat, Hilal Ahmad Mantoo and Shahbaz, for the commission of offences punishable under the relevant Sections of ULA (P) Act, as indicated against the each accused at Para (7) above, arising out of FIR No. 10/2023 of Police Station, Litter.
