#### INTRODUCTION

These proceedings are under provisions of Section 23 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for determination of compensation in respect of net area of land proposed to be acquired measuring 26 Kanals 05 Marlas for Construction of link road namely Telan to Hari-Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar. The land acquisition proceedings were initiated with the publication of Preliminary Notification under Section 11 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013.

The requiring department PWD (R&B) submitted letter of indent for acquisition of land for Construction of link road namely Telan to Hari-Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar. The Tehsildar Kishtwar vide No. 3313-14/OQ/Gen. Dated 22-02-2022, had submitted the land acquisition papers to this office duly completed in all respect for further necessary action.

## 1. <u>PUBLICATION OF NOTIFICATIONS AND ISSUE OF NOTICES:</u>

The local SIA team was notified as Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) under Section 4 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 for conducting Social Impact Assessment Team (SIA) vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/97-103 Dated 02-05-2023. Accordingly, the concerned committee members has submitted the Social Impact Assessment Study report within a time bound manner and the same was submitted to the District Collector Kishtwar for appraisal under under section 7 of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013 vide No. ACR/LA/2023-

24/168 Dated 06-06-2023.

The District Collector Kishtwar, constituted a committee of expert group for appraisal of Social Impact Assessment Study report. Accordingly, the Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group for appraisal constituted vide Notification No. DCK/LA/22/F. No. 102/107 Dated 08-06-2023 submitted its recommendation.

The SIA report and the recommendation of Multi-Disciplinary Expert Group was then approved and a Preliminary Notification No. ACR/LA/2022-23/207-213 Dated 20-06-2023 was issued under Section 11 of the Act stating that the land described in the schedule thereto (thereafter referred to as the said land) was needed or likely to be needed for the public purpose. The notification issued for inviting objections within 60 days.

No objections were received against the Preliminary Notification. The proposal was then submitted to the Appropriate Government i. e. Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/252. Dated 19-07-2023 seeking approval to proceed with acquisition process and the same was approved; and

Further, on approval of Appropriate Government i. e. Deputy Commissioner (District Collector) Kishtwar, vide Declaration No. 09 of 2023 Dated 27-07-2023 read with endorsement No. DCK/LA/23/F.No. 294/181 Dated 27-07-2023, it was declared under the provisions of Section 19 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 that the land was required for the public purpose namely Construction of Link Road namely Telan to Hari-Part 2nd in Village Palmar of Tehsil and District Kishtwar to facilitate causation of the above requirements, Notice vide No. ACR/LA/2023-24/428-34 Dated 21-08-2023 was served under Section 21 of the RTFCLARR Act, 2013, stating that all person having interest in the said land may submit their objections within 30 days and may appear personally or through an agent.

The Principal for assessing the amount of compensation to be awarded has been laid down down under Section 26(1) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 read with endorsement No. REV/LAJK/254/2020 Dated 26-08-2020 and accordingly the market value of the land was determined for further determination of compensation.

- 4. Whereas, during the investigation, one more person namely Khursheed Ahmad Sheikh S/o Mohammad Ramzan Sheikh R/o Nazneenpora, Shopian, was found involved in the commission of crime. Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa, and subsequently, joined the terrorist ranks of HM banned outfit and later on, was arrested by Kulgam Police in Case FIR No. 05/2020 of Police Station, Qazigund, and is presently under the custody of National Investigating Agency (NIA); and
- 6. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused Constable viz. Naveed Mushtaq, was member of HM banned outfit and the other accused viz. Khursheed Ahmad Sheikh, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of HM banned outfit particularly the terrorist viz. Zakir Rashid Bhat @ Zakir Musa, and was providing logistic support to them for carrying out the terrorist activities in the area; and

- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4, Whereas, during the investigation, three more persons namely Mohammad Rafiq Wani S/o Bashir Ahmad Wani R/o Bangdara, Kreeri, Faheem Nabi Bhat S/o Gh. Nabi Bhat R/o Ambarpora, Tarzoo, Sopore and Farooq Ahmad Bhat S/o Habibullah Bhat R/o Surigam, Lolab, Kupwara, were found involved in the commission of crime. Subsequently, the accused were arrested in the case and during the investigation, 01 Hand Grenade, 02 UBGL Grenades, 30 AK Rounds and 35 Pistol Rounds were recovered at the instances of accused viz. Mohammad Rafiq Wani and Faheem Nabi Bhat, respectively; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Mohammad Abass Mir and Faheem Nabi Bhat, received ammunition from the accused viz Farooq Ahmad Bhat, and the accused viz. Shabir Ahmad Mir @ Shabir Molvi, also purchased arms/ammunition from the accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Bhat, against an amount of Rs. 02 lakhs for the terrorists. Subsequently, during the investigation, an amount of Rs. 02 lakhs were recovered at the instances of accused viz. Farooq Ahmad Bhat; and
- 6. Whereas, during the further investigation, one Asif Ahmad Alwaie @ Asif Gull S/o Ghulam Mohammad Alwanie R/o Ganie Haman A/P Kanispora, Baramulla, was found involved in the case, who was

- 3. Whereas, during the investigation, the site plan of the place of occurrence and the seizure memos were prepared and the statements of witnesses acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case were recorded under the relevant provisions of law; and
- 4, Whereas, during the investigation, two persons identified as Talib Hussain Shah S/o Haider Shah R/o Draj, Kotranka, Rajouri, and Mohd Auraf Sheikh S/o Ghulam Din Sheikh R/o Bharansal, Gulabgarh, Mahore, Reasi, were found involved in the case, who were found already arrested by Reasi/Jammu Police in case FIR No. 83/2022 of P/S Mahore and FIR No. 38/2023 of P/S Bahu Fort, Jammu, respectively. Subsequently, their custody was changed in the instant case; and
- 5. Whereas, during the investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Talib Hussain Shah and Mohd Auraf Sheikh, were in contact with a Pakistan based terrorist of LeT banned outfit namely Mohd Qasim @ Salman S/o Mohd Shafi R/o Angralla, Mahore, Reasi A/P PoK, who provided 02 stick IEDs, 01 Hand Grenade and an amount of Rs. 10000/- to the accused viz. Mohd Auraf Sheikh, through an unknown person, with the directions to plant the IED in any vehicle in the area and as per the directions, the accused viz. Mohd Auraf Sheikh, planted the IEDs in the said Bus at Katra Bus Stand, which later on, exploded at Kadmal, Katra, resulted death of 05 passengers and burnt injuries to other 29 persons on the spot. Subsequently, during the investigation, 01 hand grenade and other incriminating material was recovered at the instances of accused viz. Mohd Auraf Sheikh; and
- 6. Whereas, during the further investigation, it was found that the accused viz. Talib Hussain Shah, was a close associate of Pakistan based terrorist viz. Mohd Qasim @ Salman, and was procuring arms/ammunition from him through drone for further distribution among the

- 7. Whereas, during the investigation, it was established that the accused viz. Talib Hussain Shah and Mohd Qasim @ Salman, were members of LeT banned outfit and the accused viz. Mohd Auraf Sheikh, was working as Over Ground Worker (OGW) for the terrorists of LeT banned outfit particularly with the terrorist viz. Talib Hussain Shah and Mohd Qasim @ Salman, and under a well knit criminal conspiracy was providing logistic support to them, besides, on the date of occurrence planted IEDs in the said Bus which exploded, resulted death of 05 passengers and burnt injuries to other 29 persons on the spot; and
- 8. Whereas, the investigation, in respect of an unknown person who provided IEDs/hand grenade and an amount of Rs. 10000/- to the accused viz. Mohd Auraf Sheikh, on the directions of Pakistan based terrorist viz. Mohd Qasim @ Salman, shall continue to ascertain his identity and to bring out his role/involvement in the case and the supplementary charge sheet against the said accused would be filed in the court of competent jurisdiction; and

Whereas, on the basis of investigation, and other evidence collected the Investigating Officer has established *prima facie*, involvement of below mentioned accused in the commission of the offences punishable under Section of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, 1967, as shown against their names :ô
